Who hrd R9 at 12-30 in the clear--WSUN hrd R5 in the mess on 620 at 1:11AM; WBCI-1420 off at 2AM hrd carrying WBS R9; KSO-1460 off at 2AM hrd R7 with QRm; WBYN hrd testing its emergency xmitter on 1430 with 500 watts R7 at 2:50AM. KLCN hrd R9 on special test, signed at 4:45AM; KSKY hrd R5 at times before WEAJ comes on the air at 9AM Sunday. 3/21 CPPL R7 thru XEAW; WSPD 1370 hrd behind WFEA which was R9 plus. WMEX and WLAC fight it out on 1510 both hrd R7 at times. (OK Ed glad to have your report, anytime-Ray)

ART ROBB-TOPEKA KAN. No luck with WOSH on 3/11 too much QRN on 1490 kcs Same trouble with KRJF on 1340 on 3/19. Haulea in KFUN on the 17th. KPFA on the 19th and WKRO on the 21st. KLCN was testing on 900 most of Am of the 22nd; WSON signing off on 860 at 7PM on the 22nd. To Norma Maguire-Your note about KGEK didnt cause me the disturbance you feared it might This station has been feeding us that same line for years until it is now practically an institution. I mentioned it merely to call to attention that at least one thing yet remains unchanged by the turbulent times Incidentally I have a verie card signed by some E G Beebler when KGEK was located at Yuma Colorado. Card is dated Dec 29 1931 and concludes with, "we appreciate your kindness in writing us, Say North Eastern Colorado wants you folks" what a whale of a difference ten years make.
