The war affected stations very little in this local ity in regard to personal changes as they informed me of having only 2 or 3 leave for that reason. The largest station visited tole me that their engineers had been deferred from the draft for the time being because of their work. Personally I question if all stations engineers are automactically deferred, except remote broadcasts such as the man in the Street there has been little or no change. However they did note a ·little change with programs originating from the networks. All in all radio advertising did not suffer up to this time but no doubt will see affects of the war like everything else according to the commercial manager of station WasT.
