Your Editor can not separate these items from your reports as it would take up too much time which would require you members to have your reports and information into Club HQ several days ahead of the present deadline. By using the above system in which the members themselves list this information in the proper order the deadline can stay as is, Thursday of each week. Credit will be given to each one as it is done in our SW section. The one thing to keep in mind is that only items of real help to the other members is included in this section. KID is the only station not received on reg sked, and only the 3rd Idaho station reported from here. They just wont come in down here. Sent a report to KTFI last year but no dice. Gled to see the DX Calendar again, will try for those specials I missed KHMO. Total veries now 668 (675 Norm-Ray) The mexicans are all over the dial. (OK Norm will try to get info on review of frequencies)

STEVE MANN-HANOVER N H My DX shack and equipment is now somewhat different and better then I stated last week. I have 3 receivers, a Meissner Pm job, A Hallicrafters S20R Sky Champion and a Hallicrafters SX17F, a special model super Skyrider especially built for the FCC. My antennas are these. A "T" antenna 203 ft high-74 ft long; A 66 ft Doublet 132 ft high and a Spider web 118 ft high. Evening DX is still superb on 1040 sometimes I hear a Brazilian, sometimes HJ CZ. CMK and LR5 battle on 830 CMAY and YV1RF on 1120; HJCT-HJAN and many others. To Frank Coryell, The Epick on 1590 in Ams is XEMO in Mexico City. My shack is located in a former BCB station studio & xmitter. Maybe you old timers remember WFBK on 1170 kes with 100 watts in 1924. Call was changed to WDCH in 1925. Station was deleted voluntarily in Dec 1925. Students of Dartmouth did the broadcasting. Much of the old xmitter is still up in the shack. My aerials are supported by two 98 ft steel towers on top of the Physics building which is 105 ft high. Have only DXed one morning so far and it was pretty noisy but will be getting up fairly often from now on.

JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE NY DX is getting back in form again. New stations here WLIB-KWKW-CBJ-KFRB-KTTS. Veries in are letters from CKWS-WLIB and a card from WFNC. WLIB sends letter and monthly program guide. Chief Engineer, Arthur Faske wants reports from all listeners, schedule 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM daily, address is 846 Flatbush Ave., Brooklyn, frequency 1190, heard best around sunset here, too much WOWO later. 10/14 put in first long morning session of the season. WEXL and WMBR silent as was WEDC which helps a lot. KFRE logged signing off at 3AM with clear channel. To Eric Bristow It must have been WRLC you hrd for WGOV was hrd testing on 10/12 This weeks DX here 10/7 KHMO hrd nicely thru WEXL, they gave us a swell build up and again thanks to them and Jim Wedewer. I hrd my name and the other directors etc of the club at 3:37 while WEXL was talking luckily. WATW over-rode WMBR on its monthly test 1st wed 4-4:30; 10/12 A real old fashioned harvest of new stations for me-4 in all. Finally I reported to WJLB who were a terrific R9.
