Each time at 12:30AM on the dot and each time they are in the clear for abt 2 minutes until qRmed. Hrd on 10/22-11/6-11/7. Possibly this may be a Canadian or American station rebroadcasting a British program but I do not think so. A number of stations were on during the AM of Nov 4th with el- ection returns among which were KTFI-KIDO-KFBC-KHJP-KGCA. There have been quite a number of stations runing tests yesterday and this AM, hrd on 10th were WJMC-WICA-WAIR-KWOC-KELD-KOVO-WTAC-WLBC-KCMC-WHBY-KTOK-KMAC- WMFR-KAND-KDLK-KOCY-KBTa. Hrd on 11th WBOV-WCOS-WCBI-KRIC-WIZE-KBST-WEOA WHBC-KWRC-KRMD-KNEL-WTAW-KPDN-WJBC-WDWS-KPLY-KGKY. I spent so much time tuning back and forth across the dial that I failed to record the time when these tested. Little mention was made as to details of the test periods but most of the stations solicited reports on reception and prac- tically every one played the song about "On a Ferris wheel". WDAF & WOW keep their xmitters on alnite which covers up their frequencies badly. I believe they are part of a communications system for defense purposes. WDAF announces occasionally during reg periods that special messages will be broadcast from time to time and requests listeners not to phone the station about them as such calls will jam the telephone lines.
