JOE LIPPENCOTT-CELO NC CAROLINA Please do not faint because you are hearing from me. I know its a long time since I last wrote but one reason is that I have an old radio and it works only on a 6 volt battery. Half the time the battery does not work so I am out of a radio. It is dead again now. I have had an idea of putting up a real long antenna but it is still an idea and I do nothing about it. You may wonder what DXing I have done since I last reported. Well I managed to get HJCU to verify during this summer. Its the only verie worth mentioning since I came here over a year ago. I have hrd ZNS a number of times lately on 640 from 8:15-10PM. After that at about 11PM I have hrd a spic on 640 (Think its HOK or YSS on 638) I hrd DX from WMAN on Nov 26 and sent a report. They came in well here. Tried for KWON but hrd WALA on adjacent freq and never pulled KWON out on top on 1400. Have reports out to WKZO-WHKY hrd a noon recently and WMAN-WALA. WJHP verified by letter addressed to DXers saying they are on 6:05-6:30 AM for the DX fan every morning on 1290 kc. They came in swell here. Verie from WIBA also received recently. So far I have hrd only 155 BCB stations on my 6 volt set, these are located in only 7 or 8 countries 14 in Ohio; 12 in NY; 11 in N.C.; 10 in Fla and 10 in Cuba. I wish I could find out the QRA of the station on 800 kcs relaying CMQ. It is strong here most of time. (According to info here Joe its CMKJ in Holguin, Cuba) What are DXers doing now for station lists? I noted in movie Radio Guide that there is to be a complete list of stations for US-Canada and Mexico this week. I noted in a borrowed copy of this same magazine a list of late broadcasters in each issue. (Send in your list Joe if you will and I will try to get some in the Kilocycle Komment column each week-day)

Wonder who will get the box of cigars? On Sw hrd WCEX on 9480 experimental freq Dec 3 10-10:30PM & WCL on 9390 Dec 5 at 7:30 Pm hrd 45 R9. Veries received, Caras KARM-CKRN and letter ZNS not censored, who signs KTTs, havent got mine from NRC DX. (Frank Barker, c.e.) Sent WNOE a thank you as they certainly deserved one from each and every one of us for permitting 2 swell specials to come thru. Kenny Page said he didnt hear KBON, whats the matter with his receiver? (Guess he better move back to Silver Creek eh Grant?)

J WARREN ROUTZAHN-YORK PLNM since last report i logged KLBM-KWON-KWBW-KWAL-WHIT. Got veries from KGNC-KARM-WKNY-WRRF-KLBM-KICD-KSKY. 12/1 WALA was on at 2:30; KWON was fair on their DX but WMBR and one other station were also on. 12/2 WALL did not DX but someone s-off at 4 but missed call on 1340! Hrd KWBW behind WNOE 5:30-6 but received too noisy to make rept. 12/4 KWAL came in very well on their DX with WNOE standing by. A west coast station butted in but I missed call letters (KSAN Warrne) 12/5 WHIT DX program like a local here and again WNOE stood by the entire hr. We owe plenty of thanks to them for such cooperation. KVGB was r7-3:30 AM ending their freq check. WMGA checked beginning at 3:30AM.

Speaking of KGVO Mr Wamble said he got no less than 103 reports on DX program. He said he will be very glad to go on the air again this year for the club. KGVO will be on from 3-6 AM EMT on Dec 25th with special program to the boys in Alaska. Delinquent reports out to WQBC-WGPC-WJDA-WGST-KRRV; CKRN received well here & also KGVO but with fading. What happened to our friend in Brooklyn???? Cant he hear KGVO, must be getting old Hi hi. Tnx to Joe Becker for arranging KWAL. Really needed them as did lots of fellows. KWAL hrd wonderfully here 43 R7 no fading. Sent thank you to WNOE.

JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE NY DX not going quite so good just now, plenty signals but few new ones. Only new ones here since last report are KWAL XESM, new veries are letters from WKNY-KFFA-WAYS-WSBA-WRRF all received same day. CBJ-WHLN-KXEL and WTTM show signs of becoming overdue. WHLN is a second report after first was unanswered last spring. On the programs WMAN was like a local here. CKRN had a good signal but air was very noisy here. Overslept on KGVO, same with KWON. (That's not bad Joe as both test every month, KGVO will be on Dec 25th 3-6AM EWT and KWON 1st Tues from 2:30-3 AM EWT) KWAL was good all the way with only a little interference, mostly from KSAN; WHIT clear as a local, hope they verify this time. WHIT and WHLN are only holdouts from last season in USA for me. Incidentally WHIT had an interesting program and I found out there why I could not get WALL on the 2nd. Will try to as soon as possible. When I mentioned seeing studios here I meant the bldg from the outside I havent visited any of them inside as yet but hope to. Naturally I find it hard to get specials due to rooming conditions. Hope to hear some tho.

DAVE THOMAS-PROCTORVILLE O SPECIAL-XGOY on 6135 kc from 10AM-12:30 PM. German Subs have developed a receiver so sensitive it can pick up the oscillation of a regular receiver for home use and entertainment for a distance of 100 miles or under ideal conditions even more. Many ships have been sunk due to this. To overcome this Scott has developed a SAFE MARINE RADIO Receiver which has new low radiation and therefor does not reveal the ships position. This new model is SCOTT marine SLR-12-A and has been given FCC approval for use on vessels of all classes. All other receivers are banned for use on vessels for entertainment for the duration. EVERY MEMBER OF THE NRC SHOULD DROP WNOE A THANK YOU CARD FOR STANDING BY FOR WHIT AND KWAL. I SENT THEM ONE FOR IT WAS SWELL OF THEM TO DO THIS. Both KWAL-WHIT was well received on NRC DX.
