What causes the question in my mind is when Marshall hrd them they were broadcasting in English. Heard WLAG test. Tried for KFUN, no luck. Got a verie from WBRE and KMBC today.

JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE N.Y. DX slow this past week, nothing new hrd, several poor nights, with plenty noise. Veries in are letters from WNAB and CHPS and cards from WBIR and CHEX, the latter a dandy. CHPS says that rpts on test periods mostly came from our gang (NRC).

CMC s-off with "Liboneg" and Cuban anthem at 1:15AM; CMBL s-off with Anthem at 12:10AM. FOR E COOPER-and others. WPDQ sked is 6:30AM to 12:05AM. (maybe) 1/30 WEBC was on with description of Duluth Athletic Club fire. WJPR was testing 3-3:15 regular 4th Sat test. TO WARREN- think your French station is Radio-Lyons--they have an amazing signal. WIND QRM's WQAM. TO GRANT-You hrd KYA in clear because WOL is silent every Monday morning. Thanks to GENE FRANCIS on tip for KFBI. WENY is on till 2 AM Sundays and WFCI till 2:07AM. They (WFCI) s-off with "Arms for the Love of America"; CKBI is often on after 2AM on Sun when XEW signs. CJOC was hrd h7 on 1/17 s-off at 1:32AM in the clear.

BILL GABRIEL JR-LAKEWOOD O. Not much to report though reports out to WALL (sent f-up) WBTH-WTAW-KEVE-WAIM-CHEX-WTSP-WNBF-WSTV-WRRF-WRNL-WLAG. Veries in from WTSP-WNBF-WSTV-WRNL-CKMO. The latter sent a nice letter and a purple and black card making me a member of the Midnight Prowlers. Ross L. Whiteside, c.e. said mine was the only report CKMO has received since they started sign off at 2:30AMEWT. (KERN usually covers them) Any one know the signer of KEVE? (Yes Bill its Mildred mittet, secretary. This from a verie Nov 13 1943) No DX from KTUC, said they s-off at 11PM EWT & it would be inconvenient for the station to remain on any later. But hope everyone will listen for KBIZ. They should have a honey of a program judging from past DX broadcasts from em. WLAG hrd on short test 1/23 at 2:58-3:05 ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ WRRF hrd for 17 minutes on Sunday the 17th 2:58-3:15 checking equipment; WRNL same AM testing aux xmitter with a weak signal. Wonder if anyone hrd KFUN? I think I hrd em at 3:25 reading a list of DX programs, reception was noisy and weather wasnt cold enough. (Yes Bill that was them) While I think of it I wonder if any member who came across any unusual meanings of any call letters I would appreciate them. I know all the regular ones and am looking for those not commonly known. (Bills QRA is 1471 Arthur Ave-Lakewood, Ohio)

ERIC BRISTOW-CHICAGO ILL I have a few in and sent out a few. Have a PO examination coming up so will have to do some studying, also have a bum shoulder, feels like Lumbago. I think I hrd KwAL in wallace Idaho s-off last night 1/26 couldnt get much as WNOE came in and covered them up. I still have less than 300 US stations heard but I am creeping up little by little. Think I will have to send a few follow-ups on some of those delinquent ones. Veries received are from WKWK-WJLS-WJBO-WHIT-WWNC-KGHL WJEJ-WOR-KVOR-KFBK-CHML-WNOE-CHEX-WSLB-WHEC-W SUN. 42 reports are still out. Am going to go back trying code again, was up to 10 words per min.

KERMIT GEARY-WALNUTPORT PA. Since my last report, veries received are letters from CHPS-KFFA-KICD-KTUC-KWON-WALL-WHIT-WSNY-WSTV and XECF; cards from CBJ-CHLP-CKRN-KWLK-KXOK-WAIT and WSOO. Also received some SW QSLs among them are Brazzaville out 8 months-VLGz-HCJB-PUS-PSF and KJN3. Reports were sent to KLA-CMK-KIT-YV4RE-XEG-WCRS-KLAE-KMIL-CJVI-KPRO-KPHO-WCBI and XEMR. Delinquents here are KVOD-WLSL-HJAI-CKBI-XED-WIAC-XEKS-XECZ-WAIR-CHNS and KLX. KWON-WALL-WHIT and CKRN were verified on their fine club specials. CHLP was verified thru the mess on 1490 kcs, on their New Years Eve program. Among the stations hrd on Xmas and New Years morn were HJCJ-HJGG-HJCS-XEH-YV4RA and YV4RE. Because of censorship I didnt bother logging and SA except YV4RE on 1400 kc., Valencia. Took a chance on him and the report hasnt came back yet so maybe it went thru. WSNY desires reports and considers Walnutport pretty good DX (wait till they are heard in Calif) Chief Engineer Irving P. Beck says, "I'm always glad to get reports as I installed this station myself and therefore have a rather personal interest in its performance! On Sun morn 1/24 HJAK and XETB were on till agter 3AM, also Torreon, Mex on 600 kc. Can anyone help me on the call letters of this one? It sounded like XEDM, last RADEX lists it as XEOH but it has evidently been changed. (How about this Norm Maguire or Geo Luther?) The best verie in many a moon comparable to last years HJCU comes from XECF, Los Mochis, Sinaloa, Mex. In a very friendly two-page letter they state that the reason for the test when I hrd them was that they had changed a condenser and were trying it out. They use 1000w on 1330 kc with an RCA ET-4331 xmitter, but a small 1/8 wave marconi type antenna which they used with their former 150w job. They are only 12 ft above sea-level and their ground is connected with the Pacific Ocean. XECF is operated by the Perez Family, father and 3 sons. The elder Peræxis 49 years old, graduated in San Francisco, Cal as an Electrical Engineer and became a Colonel in the Mexican Army during the revolution of 1914-1922. The 3 sons 26-28-24 years old are Radio operator-manager and Clerk respectively. They also own 50% of station XEOX, located in Ciudad Obregon, Sonora, Mex.

GRANT BATSON-WESTFIELD N.Y. Well DX and veries has been good the past we k. Veries in from, cards WHB-KGA-WAIT-WGLS-CHEX, letter from CKBI. (Say Grant who signed your CKBI verie) Reports sent 1/20th 3rd wed KLUF on 1400 4:30-4:40 Q4 R9; 1/23 WLAY-1450 3:45-4AM Q4 R9 over WNOE; 1/24 WDBO-580 5:44-6:15 Q4 R9; 1/25 WWVA-1170 at 7-7:30 PM Q4 R9; 1/26 KHBC 1230 kc from 3:35-3:46 s-off Q3 R7; also KEUB 1450 at 3:20-3:35 AM Q3 R6 behind WNOE and KGDM-1140 from 4-4:30 and last to WSAN-1470 from 6:45-7PM Q4 R9; KGDM announced as being the 3rd night testing and 1 more to go, a very strong signal and in the clear, no carrier of WRVA was on. Since WWVA upped the power to 50 Kw I wanted to get all the big ones logged. On 1/22 at 8PM on 790 YV5RB of Caracas pounded in Q4 R9 over everything, the 1st time this happened, sounded like a local for 5 minutes, also on 1/23 3-3:30 again on 1393 that French station in Lyons was Q3-4 R7. TO GENE FRANCIS-KGFL verified a report last year (April) 10th 5:15-5:31 on 1400 in 6 days by letter signed by Melvin Unger, c.e., never tried for KWEW. I hope Dave Thomas wins his case, phooey, that aerial is no more dangerous than his own pasture wire fence or grape wires in a vineyard (during a thunderstorm, here you cant hire a man to go in a grape vineyard) I've seen the results and these things attract lightning more than any skywires. (Well grant you should know, your right in the heart of both)

TED BAMBERGER-SHAKER HGTS O Not too many reports in past 3 weeks because of semester exams. Those out are WTSP-KWON-NRC Spec-WLVA-KATE-WGH-WRDO. However veries are failry plentiful, cards from KATE-CHEX a beauty-KFWB & letters from WLVA-WTSP-WALL who said they rec 20 rpts on special. Sent follow-ups before verie. WFCI-WLOF-KGB-WDAE-WHOM-KTUC (Ari)-WNAB (Conn) The last 2 gave me 42 states. (Well Ted you are climbing right along so no matter if only a few come in they all count in the end)

GEORGE LUTHER-KERRVILLE TEXAS Well here goes for my first report. I must say you give service. In my application I said that KFUN was one of the stations I most wanted to hear and the bulletin you mailed right back contained it for a special. Had a good morning this AM 1/23 with 3 new ones, WLAG on test s-off at 3; WEBC with graphic broadcast of DAC fire, next door to them and KFUN. In case some of you didnt hear them, they were only on reg test period 3:15-3:30 instead of an hour. Said they couldnt run more than test period without permission of the Army. Used live music, their local Air-Corps Band and dedicated to Bill Gabriel-Lefty Cooper-Norman Maguire. Other unusuals for me, though not new were KTOH coming in almost as though there wasnt any WJBK, and KOTH completely killin; KGFJ, after KFUN went off. A tip in the sample bulletin led me to logging WATL a few mornings ago, so I'm getting results on my membership early. To answer a few points brought up by various members, here are a few Mexicans that I logged on one or more nights prior to Xmas, which are not really regulars. 1270-XEFM-Leon; 1370-XETQ-Orizaba; 1330-XEBO-Irapuato 970-XEK-mex City; 1420-XEWE-Irapuato; 1320-XEAI-mex City; 1170-XECD Puebla. Also XEMX on 1380 but as they have continued since, I presume everybody has them. A few others I could not understand calls on, but the above might help somebody to straighten out their dope. (who is on 600-Torreon)

HERB CAMPBELL-ATHENS PENN Could hear nothing of WGIL, conditions lousy here. Missed KFUN. Remember the interference heard on WALL program which you and others suggested was KRMD? SULLY SULLIVAN-DORMONT PA. Missed WGIL because my bulletin did not come until Friday and wasnt advised of the change, tuned in between 2:30-3AM but of course no soap. (well Sully you didnt miss anything as they didnt come on-Ray, also let me know if your bulletin takes so long again) Reports since last ~~letter~~ to KSO-KVOR-KMO-KEX-KORN-WSLB-KGER-KXYZ. Veries in are CHEX-WNEW-WFAA-KSO-KVOR-WSLB all cards and letters from CFCN-KUOA. HJCU hrd over WGN twice but no good data for report, also have hrd the Frenchie around 1390 but could not identify despite a slight knowledge of French. Too weak and quite noisy. I have 10 delinquents. (List them Sully and maybe some of us can help you on them-Ray)

It may be interesting to the members that I have written to KGY-KWKW-WSAP-KBPS-CFLC-WGAL-KTUC-WMFR-CHWK-KwJB-KGLU for specials and I am going to write to WSNY-WBML to wind up my efforts. Of these KGY-KWKW are long overdue, out since Dec 14th and probably wont reply now. Believe me I have kept the typewriter hot on Sundays, quite a job. And those that reply favorable require the second and third letter. Its well worth it tho and I am getting a big kick out of it especially on the Canadians. As a result havent DXed this season as much as in the past, have been up a lot but never seem to catch any new ones. Cant DX as long as a time as I need the sleep, working 10 hours a day, 6 days a week. Note Vincennes, Ind station has changed call. On the stations arranged on Specials WBTA-WTCM-CHOV-CHPS-WSRR-CJFX have never attempted a DX program before and didnt know what it was all about so lets everyone at least send them a thank you card if not a good report, but report if at all possible. Only veries in today, WLAY came back air-mail after follow-up and a few days ago CHEX on new card, nice one too. DON MEYER-BOSTON N.Y. Recent reports to KSAL-WISH-KEVE-WEBR-WRDW-WKPA-WERC while veries have come in from KXEL-WSNJ-WNOX-WBAB-WSFA they surprised me-WHBJ-WISH cards. TO GRANT BATSON-I dont even have WAC verified, also CBA hrd here frequently at mid-day on 5 tube miget using a grounded antenna. 1/14 KSAL over-rode on 1150 for a short while at 8:30. Who was under WMSL on their freq check? Also who signs WTTM-WPAD-KGNC veries. They are over due here. 1/26 Noted WAPO s-on at 6:30 Also.

HAROLD WAGNER-BRIE PENN I was really surprised when I received the bulletin today that nobody had raved about the morning of January 16th. I'm telling you it was one of the best mornings I have ever heard, English station on 668 was pounding in from 3AM on and I mean on. Imagine my surprise to find the English station on 804 kc coming in with readable signal under CKLW at 4AM. He gave news in every language under the sun from 4 to 4:30 AM. Then he had a French program after 4:30. The most amazing thing of all happened at 5AM when I signed off and nit the hay. I tuned up to 650 kc and the Zedder was just starting to break thru with music, but voice still unaudible. Then I went back to 668 and the English station was still there with just about the same strength as the Zedder. If that isnt globe-trotting or globe-girdling tell me a better one. (I'll say if must have been a swell night and of course I wasnt up, OK on the mat if you need it, Harry might have a mat laying, if he hasnt I have).

They will transmit a Special DX for us on the morning of Feb 20th from 4-6 AM EWT. KWKW Pasadena Calif. Mr. Paul W Spargo the c.e. states he is not sure KWKW will be received in the East as they are directional West and have less than 75 watts toward the East. He hopes to hear from Club members after the broadcast. I especially urge all members to send him a thank you card even if they do not hear KWKW as that will be a big help in getting another DX out of them at some future date if this is not successful due to reception conditions.
