They put on our first DX this season and that morning was the worst in a couple seasons, with the result they received 6 correct reports. No one's luck could be bad enough to have two such mornings for two DX programs so we should fare better this time. Mr Chapman is anxious for reports you see, for he hasn't had many on reception of the new 1,000 watt job there. As a 100 watter on 1210 kcs CKNB put on several shows with good results. So this makes still another Canadian DX for the good old NRC. Don't forget this program, fellows as we near the end of a surprizingly good DX season. Reports should be addressed to Mr. Stanley Chapman, station manager. Arranged by Ernest Cooper.

French-Canadian Network-CHAD-CKVD-CKRN. Well our CPCer Al Bartholomew hit a home with the bases loaded this time with this history making network DX program. Each station is going to sign its own individual station breaks. Be sure to copy them word for word, for definite verifications. As to clearness of channels, there just isn't any time that all 3 are clear so this time should be as good as any. CKRN should fare best, for not only are they the most powerful (250w) but they may be the only one in the clear. We haven't heard from our pleas to WEXL, so we don't know if CHAD will have a free spot or not. Listen for WEXL to sign from 3:45 4 if they do sign at all. CHAD & CKVD are 100 watts. CHAD is their new outlet and the one they are most anxious to get reports on but let's try to have our reports cover all three stations. Send reports for all three in one envelope, addressed to Mr. George H. Pope, chief engineer, Radio Station CKRN-Rouyn, Quebec. Remember 3 separate reports, one for each station in one envelope to the above address. It is asked by Al Bartholomew to enclose 10¢ in coin instead of the usual stamps, to help cover the coat of stationery expenses. Remember you verify 3 stations if you send a report on reception of each. This is the first network DX to take the air in at least 10 years so let's not let it go by without a bevy of reports. (It was WBNY and I called them so they went off very nicely as did KICD when I called as KBIZ were on-Ray) Fine publicity from WCBI. 2/20 weak signal on 1430 which I logged as best I could and sent data to KwKw, here's hoping. (whats the matter down there Ernie. KwKw was copied here in Bfdo for the full 2 hours by Kenny and I.-Ray) All I could tell was the time of their announcements, and selections. I hope others had better luck. 2/22 WSRR had short test, finished at 12:09; WSAP R7 behind WWSW-WJBK until 2:02; KICD picked the same time as KBIZ for a test. KICD s-off 2:10-2:40. FRANK LEE-WILDWOOD N.J. Have been taken up with other duties besides my regular job, so that I have been unable to do any DX worth this season. Believe it or not but I got up on Feb 12th for my first turn at the dials to log CHPS. Hrd their entire broadcast from 4:18 till 5:09-3/4 AM when they s-off. Had a fine program and I sent them a good report, still waiting for verie. (Me Too) Feb 20th I tuned in KWKW in Pasadena on our club special and had an excellent broadcast, poorly received here due to heavy static. Any one know what station was in back of KWKW after 5 AM? TA reception has been fair this season. Only have listened in between 5:30 & 7 PM to European stations with the following results; TAs heard on the following frequencies; -548-585-577-648-658-667-695-750-767-776-785-804-885-877-925-1113-1195-1213-913-1077. Most consistently hrd were (776 kc Toulouse France) (658kc Cologne, Germany) (1195kc-Frankfort, Germany) and on (304kc London, England) VOCM-1005kc St Johns Newfoundland hrd quite a few times between 5-6:30PM with weak signals; ZNS Nassau, Bahamas hrd very well at times, and once I listened for 30 minutes without interference from the Cuban on their Freq. CHK Watrous, Sask hrd occasionally with a fair signal. HJCU in Columbia, S. America rides over WGN at times. This AM Feb 22 I tuned in KBIZ on 1240. Put in a fair signal here, also a splendid broadcast for our club. KBIZ announced that CHLT would be on their freq as soon as they signed. (But they didnt come on-ray) WINN-1240 pounded in after KBIZ. They were followed by KICD. After KICD signed the channel was clear, no sign of CHLT. Were they on? Tried for CJFX but the band was covered by WDBO in Orlando, Fla. (I didnt hear CJFX either and believe they are not on the air-ray) At 6:05PM this evening Feb 22 VONF on 640kc came in with a very strong R7-8 signal. The best I ever received them. Some interference, but VONF predominated. My TA list from last season has gone astray. (Will Frank it sure is swell to hear from you again, I was beginning to think that you might be in our Armed forces or that you just dropped out of sight, the TA list will have to be a memory Frank as when I was told to move account of the house being sold and when packing our stuff I tossed out all the Club correspondance and have started a new file in this house. I had to clean house at that time because we had to store out entire household equipment for a month.-Ray)

MARSHALL BLANCHARD-BROOKFIELD, ILL boy things going fine this week compared to last. 13 veries, cards from KARM-WBIR-KNEL-KWYC-WQBC and letters from WMAN-WSRR-KYA-KALE-KWAL-WABY. Received WTCM with their propaganda. KORN merely autographed my report. I have been taking notes on CKMO for 6 mornings now, they seldom rise above KERK. Reports have gone out to KPHO-KGER-KWKW-WLOF-WSKB-KTNM-WISE-KAST-KWRC-WHBL-KGCX. On 2/18 I finally caught Radio Lyons Q5 R7; KTNM on fbfreq ck on 2/19 from 3:15-3:30; 2/20 I hrd KWKW R5 at most. 2/21 KGCX was on all night to broadcast flood warnings for the Lower Yellowstone and Upper Missouri Valleys; FOR GRANT B KMO verie signed by J.D. Kolesar, c.e. According to VRC Jay Tapp signs KGER's. Could anyone tell me when the following can be heard? KDFN-KIEM-KUJ-KIDO-KFBB. How powerful is Radio Lyons? To EARNEST GRIBEL Your Spick on 660 is probably XEBZ in Mex City. Reports were sent to WJLD-KMYC-WBM-WCBT-KGFJ-WTCM-CBF-WSAM-CMJL-WBTA-KWBW KEYS-KWKW-WKPA. WCBT was hrd quire well thru the QRM of WLVA-WFTC on their DX of 2/2; Following them I was able to log KGFJ complete from 4:21 to 4:56AM. KWAL had a good sig on their freq ck from 4:45-4:56; 2/5 WNOE was off the air; 2/9 WSAM was testing on 1400 from 3:14-3:25. CMJL was hrd on 2/12 3:46-5:01 testing with a recorded program from studios of CMQ, Havana but not broadcast over that station. WBTA was fine on their DX for the club 2/14 even the portion from 5:45-6AM came in clearly. Just before tuning WBTA, VONF in Newfoundland was hrd blasting thru KFI-640 kc. They were conducting a test broadcast with announcements between each selection. KEYS was hrd thru WWSW and WJBK on their regular 3rd Friday freq ck on 2.19 from 3:30-4:02AM. KWKW was just strong enough to be hrd clearly and logged here in Eastern Penn on their club special on 2/20. SID STEELE-COLUMBUS O. Here is a short report prompted by Cooper's call for help on WTTM. Only a few veries to report, letters from KROD-WINN and cards from CHEX-WLOG-KXEL, also the jackpot from WTTM. My report of Nov 30th went unanswered but a follow up brought three veries, a very nice letter, on an attractive blue-rec letter ~~maxx~~ card verification and a card which I myself had sent to be signed on the follow-up. All were signed by William K Betz c.e. (Dick Cooper please note) Total veries now 972.

JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE N.Y. Not much listening lately but the few hrc were all good, new stations KYUM-KYMC & KWKW. New veries are KYUM (2 letters) and a candy card & letter from WTTM by Wm Betz c.e. Took about 3 months but well worth it. Tried for KYUM on 2/5 and hrc bits of program behind WJW, verie came back promptly, tuning again on 2/8 at 2:40 hrc KYUM announce Q5 R7 on top of KHOY's program, KYUM clear as a local. so after waiting several years I got 2 reports and 2 veries on this one in less than a week. KYMC hrd quite clearly over WNOE-KORE etc on reg program-s-off at 3AM. KWKW hrd about as well as the average 250 watt west coaster on their very welcome DX program. Missed several of the DX programs but sent on thank you notes to most of them. Every one tuned for came in good as could be expected, except CHPS and CJFX in N.S. I could not locate this one. Sounded like most of the interference at CHPS originated right in their own xmitter plus the strong hetrocayne with KSAN due to CHPS being off its assigned channel, a regular condition in DAing 10 years ago, but rare now days. One unusual station hrd over the weak end was KGCX-Sidney Mont with flood condition reports, on alnite, good signal here. Recalling memories of the time about 12 yrs ago when KGCX came in here R7 from Wolf Point with 25 watts and the antenna here a temporary one about 25 ft of bell wire draped over a small cherry tree, no insulation etc. I hope KBPS still has its old efficient signal, hrd here several times around 1931-32 one of my veries is for reception when they were running on about 60 watts during a test. And coming in better than the average 250 watter out there does nowadays. Have not her them in 10 years. (Gueses you did)

GRANT PATSON-WESTFIELD N.Y. Only 4 rpts sent out. 2/17 WCBI Q4 R9 short but swell; 2/17 KWBW 5:30-6AM Q4 R9, 2/20 KWKW NHC special 4:07-6:03 Q3-4 R 3-9 at 4:36 the Square Dance Buffalo Cal. I was suprising how well they came in; 2/22 KBIZ DX well hrd in spite of KICD testing. Where was CHLT as announced by KBIZ? CJFX didnt come on either. Veries a plenty, letters KGDM-KYA-WJOB-WCAL-WTCM-KLPM-KWBW-Cards WMBD-WSAJ-WGAN. Hope I can get KBPS. WCED better here in daytime than on test. WEAL says they will not s-off as they are off every 2nd wed from 2-6AM EWT. TO FRANK JOHNSON, WFAS used to test on 1210 in 1940 2nd Fri 3:40-3:55. WBOW verified for me in 4/39 in 3 days. GEORGE LUTHER-KERRVILLE TEXAS. Not so good past week much needed rain in offering but successful only in producing good static. Only new ones are WSON-WCRS-KWKW. KWKW was a cinch here. WSON on freq ck 3-3:30 on 3rd Fri WCRS 3:30-3:45 same date, hard pulling latter thru WNOE. Iowa fired both barrels 2/22 mostly KICD ran ahead of KBIZ here. (Did you hear KICD salute to Buffalo-Ray?) (Yes thats when they signed off from 2:10-2:40 AM after I had called them on the phone-Ray) No luck on 22/22 on Canadians but if I had heard them at this location with the interference I would go out and bet all the 100-1 horses. (You could have Geo as neither of them came on. Dont know what happened to CHLT but with CJFX it is almost sure they are not on the air as yet-Ray) I reported fine reception from WSRR (and got a fine letter from them) very strong signal, no fading and could have understood nearly every word with my 6 tube Delco. A San Antonio friend, only 60 miles away hrd it and said it faded badly, sounded like shortwave, quite indistinct, listened only 20 minutes and heard only part of one call and then only enough of tunes to identify part of them. Ain't radio waves funny sometimes? Maybe there was an air funnel to my antenna. (They do work tricks Geo, Norm Maguire also heard them OK-Ray)
