DOC JOHN KIRK-PT PLEASANT W VA TO JOE ENZ-As to your questioning the identity of the station on 1149 kcs. I dont think you checked far enough, before making your report. This station is listed in the Official lists as being simply European Service located in Great Britain with a power of 70,000 watts. It is my personal belief that the xmtr is the one at Brookmans Park (suburban-London) I have at hand some info that tends to suggest that this is true. There is no USA station on this freq and the station there is definitely not on 1150 kc. For further proof I suggest that you do the same trick that I have done. That is tune one receiver to 1149 kc on the station there, and another receiver to 200 kc (long wave) to the Droitwich xmtr. I have done this on several times and have always found the programs identical. It is a definite established fact (not only by myself but also by FCC) that the 200 kc xmtr is also in the European service. The most recent time of checking the 2 English xmtrs under question was at 2AM today Dec 5th. The English stations in the European service use a variety of languages and I personally have heard them using at least a half dozen different ones. The drum beats are for identification. The signal is utter unmistakable. Here he comes in often always with good signals. I might mention in passing that as I had thought the Europeans are really hot this winter. Have hrd 12 or 15 of them so far without even trying. Have airmail rpts out to several.
