This bulletin is dedicated to the Memory's of Donald A Wattenbarger and C.E. Sleichter. The passing of these members has been learned here in the past month. C.E. Sleichter died from illness and from Donald's parents comes this information. "We regret to advise you that our son Donald died in a plane crash on Friday April 13th, 4 miles south of San Juan, Cal while on a training flight in a Navy Torpedo Bomber to which he was assigned". Cards expressing our sympathy has been send both families in the names of the Officers and Members of the National Radio Club.

Len Kruse, who is now back home for good sent several letters he received a couple years back in regard to the verification policy's to a number of station in the mid-west. Compiling them all it can be said that as a whole the stations do welcome reports. They all however say that definite proof of reception should be sent including the titles of songs, station announcements including the call. they also say they like to receive info on quality-fading-static-interference and by whom along with other information that will be of some value to the station. Signal strength should also be included, a truthful report and not exaggerated just in order to impress them. The correct time was also stressed, especially when selections were played and announcements were made. Weather and temp should also be included and if you have a barometer, its reading should be included. So from the above include all usefull information but keep it in order so as to make it easy for the station to pick out what they believe is most usefull to them. A neat report with good information will most likely be answered more quickly than one that is all messed up and contains nothing.

It has been noticed that more and more stations are not answering as they have in the past. This may be blamed on the shortage of help and it may also be that they do not care for reports. However there is nothing much we can do about it except to be sure that when we do report it will be a good one and it might be a help in some way to start the veries coming from these slow verifying stations. The shortage of help is no doubt the cause of many of the stations not answering as promptly as they did, but it is believed that some of the stations might be using this as an excuse for not answering at all. Let us hope that in this latter case there are not too many stations. As to WAGM, Dick Cooper has sent the verie cards and your verifications will be coming along shortly.

If my dial was calibrated and I knew the freq you fellows might be able to help me out. Havent time for anymore right now but thanks for the bulletins and good tuning for all. PFC S HENRY FRANKEL-CAMP CROWDER, MO. Things are going with renewed vigor now that half the job of winning the war as been done. And action is being taken here and in other camps throughout the country to insure an early and complete victory in the Pacific. I am now putting the finishing touches on a telephone repeatermans course, following which I enpect a bit of radio link training (F-M Carrier telephone channels) This is the Army telephone communication system for the Pacific. DXing has come to a standstill for me, not for lack of interest but a definite lack of time. Practically every one of my week ends is used in visiting Kansas City (Mo) where I have a number of pleasant acquaintances. On one of my recent visits I looked over the Kansas City Star bldg, housing WDAF and the K.C. Associated Press Offices besides the newspaper. The lifting of the curfew means more time for weekend fun so I am glad. Although Missouri still sells no liquor after MDT, Now that none of our soldiers are prisoners of war in Germany, treatment of Germans we have captured is becoming more strenous. German PWs are no longer being fed meals an equal with those fed our men here. Thats abt all the news from this part of the country. I'll do my best to keep rpts newsy and to report more often.
