KBLF - Red Bluff, California. The National Radio Club's "Parade of the States" gets under way with a program from sunny California. KBLF is a new station, and few of us have been successful in hearing them as yet. Here is a fine opportunity, but there will be competition on that 1490 channel, of course. WJBK in Detroit will be on, and so will WTMV, in East St. Louis, Illinois, we believe, but WWSW will be silent. No other station opens on 1490 until 7:00 a.m., so there should be just those two to buck. Here's hoping KBLF gets through. It is believed they will play marches or something other than the popular music the other two will be playing. Your Editor hasn't the name of the person or persons at KBLF who OKed this program, but it would be a good idea to send those reports, and thank-you cards, to the Chief Engineer. Thank you, KBLF!

WNOC - Norwich, Connecticut. Stop Number Two on our Parade of the States brings us all the way East to Connecticut, and to another new station, and one which again, few of us have managed as yet to hear. They have no frequency check schedule, and when they conducted their equipment tests, they were bothered by several other stations on that 1400 frequency. This time the air should be clear for at least a portion of that program, so there is a good chance of their being heard far out west. WJLB, Detroit, will be off, but there may be a frequency check from KCHS, and also KBIO, for parts of that program with which to contend. The clearest portion should occur between 4:00 and 4:15, but since KCHS' test uses only a dead carrier interspersed with a short announcement every 2 minutes or so, that carrier might act as a booster out west. We thank WNOC for this kind gesture, and wish them good reception. Send these reports again to the Chief Engineer. Both these programs were arranged by Richard H. Cooper.
