Their antenna is a longwire, 225', purposely mismatched to the transmitter in order to detune it. Probably program content will be pop tunes of a few years ago, plus frequent station breaks. MISCELLANY MAILBAG

DAVE GLEASON says he has visited 150 LA stations in 8 countries. "I feel qualified to say that in most cases it is utterly useless to consider an LA station's call letters. Firstly, most LA's use only their slogan on the air. Then, since local residents only know a station by the name it uses on the air, a report addressed to the slogan will be recognized in the post office, while one with the call letters will often not be, causing the report to be returned. Finally, the stations themselves do not care about their calls. At YNDS I was told by the manager, "Yes, our call is YNDS, but we don't always use it, and sometimes we shorten it to YND." And at "La voz de Medellin" no one at the station knew the call." In June, Dave will leave for Venezuela, Colombia, Ecuador, Peru, Bolivia, Chile, Paraguay, Uruguay, Argentina, Brazil, Surinam, and possibly the Dominican Republic. He will be visiting stations, and has volunteered to try and obtain veries based on worthy reports. He will not accept reports in English, and reserves the right to reject poor reports. First come, first served, and write him for further information, direct. Please help finance his trip by buying his log, hi!
