Greetings DXers. It's been several issues since I've reported, so I guess it's about time I let you know how DX has been at this den. During the latter part of October, SSS from the SW prevailed over most of the band & several 250 & 500w. Texans were logged. On 10/26, KFIF-1550 Tucson made it in with a strong clear signal until s/off for a nice half-hour report; however, still no verie. No sign of KYND nor of ~~what~~ I KDAY - always too much XEDM. On 10/31 during the early evening hours I received what I believe to be an illegal radio station operating on 760 kc/s. The programming consisted only of rr request tunes, & the announcer sounded very young & amateurish. No type of ID was given whatsoever, & the only announcements that were made concerned a teen-age club. The only clue I have as towards location is a telephone number, so any help would be appreciated. DX of late, anyhow, includes the following: 11/9- The new WGEN-1500 Geneseo, Ill. was heard u/o KSTP with a poor signal at 12:45pm. It sure didn't take them long to get on the air. On 11/5, WBSC, Bennettsville, S.C. was noted with a nice clear signal at 6:30pm. I used to hear them all the time, but that was back in the days when there were only six or seven stations on 1550. Now there are over 50, & all this in just two or three years. The amount of applications now being approved by the FCC is making DXing rather discouraging. On 11/10 I was very surprised to receive WTPR-710 ay llam with a fairly good signal for only 250w. The following Saturday, CX were excellent, with both WTIC & KRLD in all day, even at high noon. Last night, 11/27, I had CMQ-640 mullied out with the loop antenna, & was surprised to note KFI in at the early hour of 8:30 & under much-needed Guadeloupe, which is now one of my better catches. Another surprise came with the logging of CKWX-1130 Vancouver, for about a minute at 10pm. Well, I guess that does it for now, so 73s.

CX have been excellent here lately & lots of new stations are being logged. The MM of 12/2 saw almost every station in Venezuela on AN with ER, many of them on clear or semi-clear channels. The Venezuelans on the following frequencies were on AN 12/2: 560 590 610 650 660 670 700 720 740 770 780 800 810 870 880 890 910 920 940 960 1000 1020 1050 1080 1090 1100 1110 1120 1150 1180 1190 1210 & 1290 & possibly 1+10. As you can see there is an abundance of MM clear channels so I presume many new loggings were made by NRCers. A complete list of the stations & networks I IDed is in this week's IDXD. Have now logged 42 YVs. Other DX here has been two or possibly three excellent catches on 1340 kc/s., one of them a new country. These were WGBY in Guantanamo Bay & WGRF in Puerto Rico. Also believe I heard YVNH in Santa Barbara del Zulia, Venezuela, which is listed on 1350. Other catches: New station WOGA-1540 Sylvester, Ga. on ETs; HJKD-1587 Neiva, Colombia on late nightly; KFIF-1550 Tucson, Ariz. on ET for new state; new station in Mississippi on 1530 at SSS, who & where is it? (WRPM, Poplarville?-ERC) WMEX-1510 Boston behind WLAC; WLOK-1480 Memphis on ET; WBAR-1460 Bartow, Fla. s/off 6 pm; KADO-1410 Marshall, Tex. on RS; WEED-1390 Rocky Mount on f/c first MM as listed; WGBY-1340 (see IDXD); WMPM-1270 Smithfield, N.C. on r/c first MM; WALO-1240 in Humacao P.R. fading in/out all evening 12/3, completing all P.R. graveyarders here except new WVOZ-1400 (not much chance for that one with WFTL NSP). KARK-920 Little Rock on RS; WEVA-860 r/c; WAMI-860, Opp, Ala. s/off 6:16 with Cuban off all day 11/30; CBN-640 St. Johns Nfld. AN over KFI with CBC junk mx. Lots of other new LAs being logged here lately; see Pete's section. Other tidbits of supremely useful info: New Guatemalan on 840 s/off @ lam on a clear channel so should get around, "Radio Emperador" IDed by RFS. Local WAME-1260 may go NSP with Negro programming; local WFAB-990-SS is now AN except MM s/off midnight. IDs in EE/SS on hour & half hour, never seen 'em reported. Finally, is there a WLTI or WLTY on 1300 kc/s.? 73.

Here is a long report. DX includes: 11/22- A very sad day. I got WISK-1390 which s/off about midnight, which stayed on to bring all nx concerning the late President's death. WC DL-1440 s/off 5:30pm. WAVP-1390 5:30pm. In wee hours of AN 11/23, WICK (calls sounded like it)-1400 s/off @ 1:33 on usually crowded 1400. The s/off announcer said "Let us pray that we'll never have another day like this!" Did anyone else hear it? 11/23- WMES-1570, 7:04pm. 11/24- WBTS-1480 s/off 5:45pm. 11/25- WEIC-1270 s/off 5:45pm. 11/26- WBHT-1520 s/off 5:45, hi. What's the power of WBHT, how? 11/28- WEAG-1470 at 5:22pm. Tried years for it, hi. Also WEFJ-1540 s/off 5:30pm. 11/29- WLSI-900 reports 1.96" of snow at 5pm, in the clear; amazingly strong at 6pm. On edge of my seat at 850 kc/s. that same evening; heard a French Network station which made me angry when it IDed as KFUC, St. Louis, an old timer for me. 12/2- The greatest DX day in history for me. I also haven't gotten completely over my daze yet. On 550 kc/s I heard KFYZ, new state for me at lam. WGR @ 1:03 AN; CBK-540 fourth Canadian Province ID @ 1:15 as CEK-540 with 50kw. They gave WX forecast for all of Canada (I guess). WFFF-1360 TT u/WSAI @ 1:35am. At 2am, state #42, Montana, in form of KOJM-610, Havre, o/u WSGN, apparently WSGN is AN too. I had a s/off at 2am, apparently KOJM. WOW was a little quiet & an SS ID as "Radio Contiente". A check in the old WRH showed it as YVKL, Caracas, my first SA station, hi. Country #11 (#10 of my mystery stations on 730 is not Puerto Rico). Report has been sent. And at 2am I got YVKL. Then at 3:25, on 750 a strong strong stations with NX & ID every minute or so with TX in SS. The ID was "Radio Nacional" on apparently either 750 or 760 & a look/ in WRH showed only one Radio Nacional anywhere near it, at 750, LRA7, Cordoba, Argentina, my second SA, country #12. My S-119 "Sky Buddy II" is RX for all these 1,212 stations. Radio Nacional was exceptionally strong & clear. Nothing to getting SA stations after you get the hang of it. 12/2, also got KNBR-680 4am s/off, WFUN-790 AN @ 3:55. Then 12/4, WYNR-1390 1:15am. Totals include 986 stations in 42 states, four provinces, 12 countries. I also have 90 Tennessee stations. Now, goal 1,000 ny 1/1. I'll make it. What's easiest R.I., Vt. & Idaho stations to try for? Are there any AN on 1140? Only one I've heard at all on that frequency is WRVA. That's it - more next weej. 73.

Being very busy with other commitments, I can't set my goals too high or else it gets discouraging & I quit DXing. Last verie received was KDAY-1580 for 1/16/62 reception. First report since then sent out last Thanksgiving - no veries yet. Some of the DX: KWEA-1500 testing 3:16-3:30 cover KSTP; KHUM-1580 s/on u/KPIK very clear & nearly zero-beat; KLOV-1570 9:03-9:15 until KWIC s/on at 9:15, & my ex-hometown station of KDEY s/on 8:45 with the familiar jingles & voices brought on nostalgia. They were still using some of my taped spots & WX intros. KQRS-1360 overrode them at 9am s/on, for first Wyoming report. Eleven reports out; survey total, 577. For those who listened for KATI-1400 12/2, don't get discouraged if you didn't hear us, as that was my first f/c where I overslept; try again next MM. After 1/1/64, we'll be on at the same times every FIRST MM.

Regarding the Constitution and Bylaws which according to info from Denver, has been or will be sent to every NRC Member. Thus those will not be re-published as it would only be duplication resulting in a waste of time and mimeo paper.

The following statement by the present "NRC GOVERNING BODY", whose actual signatures appear at the end, definitely re-assures all NRC Members that the "NRC" will be operated as outlined in "RULES and PURPOSE" adopted and mailed to all NRC Members during the First part of August 1963.

"Our Statement"

To NRC Members, particularly the 32 who signed the Constitution and Bylaws, devised at the 1963 Denver Convention.

We, the Governing Body of the NRC, have received a copy of the new, proposed Constitution and Bylaws, which were drawn up at the Denver Convention, 1963. Heading it is a sheet of paper containing 32 signatures of NRC members in attendance there, stating they approve these documents and sign our names in testimony of our desire for the official adoption of them by the National Radio Club. The signatures are followed by the following; "Subscribed and sworn to before me this 2nd day of September, 1963. My Commission expires June 19, 1966. Shacon S. Skibba, Notary Public. (We cannot guarantee that the Notary Public's name is spelled correctly as it is not easy to decipher even with a 4 inch magnifying glass-however it was signed by someone with a similar name)

We call your attention to Article II, Page One, of "Constitution of the National Radio Club" (proposed). It says, "The purpose of the National Radio Club shall be to promote the hobby of radio listening on the A.M. Broadcast Band"

Gentlemen, this has always been our purpose, is now, and ever shall be. This is what we have now - 34 issues of the latest in DX, sent out on time, clearly, and the very latest news it is, as supplied by you and the other NRC Members. It is put together through the efforts of Ernie Cooper, Pete Taylor and Ray Edge, week in and week out 26 - 27 times during each year while the remaining 7 or 8 issues are once a month 4 times and twice a month in September and usually 3 in April. Yes, 34 issues each and every year.

Since our present form of Club Government took effect in 1959, things have run smoothly and efficiently. The only squabble of anything approaching proportions was over the Bu@ Barto incident. When Mr. Barto apparently reformed and began to send creditable reports, and report believable DX, the then three officers of the Club voted to give him a second opportunity to prove he belonged in our fine Club. This apparently met with much opposition among some of the members.

The incident is closed - closed when Mr. Barto did not renew when his membership expired in December 1962.


Ernie Cooper notices in this new Constitution that he would have absolutely nothing to say regarding the running of the Club, or even of his own section of DX News. He by this document is reduced to a typist. The same situation would exist with Pete Taylor. We note that seven proposed titled members would be running the Club's policies, while the same three, Cooper, Taylor and Edge are doing the hard work of putting out DX News, and without any power to control their own efforts.

We can see no way this proposed Constitution, if adopted, would make the NRC any better than it is at the present time. We again pledge ourselves to continue to deliver the goods as we have for so many years - to continue DX News, at \$4.00, or at the lowest possible minimum in case bulletin supplies rise in cost, per year, 34 times a year, and on time, loaded to the hilt, as always, with the very latest on the BCB DX front.

You 32 gentlemen who signed this new pact, by doing so, apparently indicated that you would like it adopted. By the same token, it would seem that by you expressing yourselves, you therefore disapprove of things as they are now, and have been for the past four highly successful seasons. Therefore, we feel called upon to remind you of the present Rule 15, which points out that anyone not satisfied with the NRC as it is now constituted may at any time receive the unused portion of his dues, plus any other money he may have in a first class or air-mail postage fund, in a refund, and may thus terminate his membership in the NRC at no loss financially to himself.


For the reason that we can see no improvement by the adoption of this new (proposed) Constitution and Bylaws, we vote "NO" on its adoption by the NRC.
