Hello! mighty little DXing since last report, but here 'tis: 3/7- KIFN-860 Phoenix, relogged on ET 3:06-4:33am as I continue my "860 watch"! 3/8- KIOA-940 Des Moines, relogged at s/on 6am unusually in the clear; KHUM-1580 Santa Rosa Cal. WEST easy; relogged; HJAY-1580 Batranquilla, Colombia quite strong 4-6am, although heavy hetro as apparently off frequency a bit. Veries: 2KP-680 (all it took was a comment in Musings that I doubted if would ever answer!); Vilnius I & WTLN-1520. Latter is 11th 1520 verie leaving only PHOW logged but unverified on this channel on which I started the season w/only KOMA & KACY verified. 2KP is verie #31 from Australia leaving only long holdout 2PK-1400 as logged but unverified there. I refrse to give up on 2KP; not as long as I hold a tape w/clear ID & advertisements! If any of our International DXers has a v/s at 2PK, even if not real new, would appreciate knowing. Maybe I'll have to call on them personall\$ next time I'm in Parkes, NSW! Vilnius-I verie completes all European reports except for DDR-1034; must have wrong approach here as others report veries. Probably strongest & most often heard European of last Winter, too! Rich Heald- Dominant Alaskan Net station on 790, at least prior to KCAM going on the air has been ZFRS/AN Naknek AFB, King Salmon, 250w, regardless of what WRTH may say. King Salmon is at the head of Bristol Bay. First verified in 1/55. Heard just after Alaskan earthquake of year ago. CBM letter in 3/6-DX NEWS of interest; wonder if they don't consider tape recordings of definite CBM station IDs as "sufficient program details?" I'll write Mr. Busby shortly. Letter from PJD2 not a verie; no reference to my report etc., just says "Bro. Mayer has gone to the States & I'm taking his place fo about six weeks." Hope my report is brought to his attention when he returns! Expect to take the HQ180 into Seattle shortly to leaf@ on consignment; anybody interested, cash offer requested. This is late model w/Vernier Tuning control; no clock. On matter of Club dues, would wonder if whole problem won't be shortly resolved in DX NEWS returning to two ounces level as CX taper off? And believe me, they have, at least in these parts! I doubt very much if we will see too many more IDEDs running o/four page mark; & not too many of us really have enough DX going to justify a Musing in each issue! Greetings DXers. It's been several issues since I last sent in a Musing, but I have been pretty busy lately, so haven't had too much time for DX. Last week I had a pleasant surprise, because school was closed on account of snow. However, I was rather disappointed because CX weren't up to my expectations. Back in January, we had several inches of snow on the ground, & DX was very unusual. KHMO KMAQ WBAY KDTH & WCON were in well all day, & even KCFI-1250 could be heard weakly around noon. Recent DX 9ncludes the following: 2/11- Urm KNX-1070 was heard w/a fairly good signal at the early hour of 9:30pm w/WIHC & WKOW nulled out w/the loop. 2/12- Rather good CX to the S were noted w/KMMO-1300 KNBY-1280 & WKBL heard w/good signal around 9am. 2/13, finally heard WFRX-1300 w/their s/off at 6:30. Much to my dismay, I did not get enough for a report, but will have to try again before WTAQ goes 5,000w. 2/21- CFAC-960 noted w/good signal at 2:44am. 2/25- WJUD-1580 heard at 7:30 s/on. 2/27- KSGM-980 heard finally at 6:30. They IDed as Chester, Ill. which means they really have moved from Ste. Genevieve Mo. & that they are the only station in Ill. beginning w/a K. 2/28- WATW-1400 noted for several minutes at 6:55pm. 3/6- While trying for KFJA-1370 f/c, I instead heard WABD-1370's f/c. The latest veries are as follows: v/q- WVOK KNX KVMA (the CE said mine was the nst complete report he had ever received) WJBK & CFRB. v/l KADL WAZY KRAD (CE said he believes my report is the most distant he has received) KLIK WNAD WOKY WWJC WATW CKLB & CKGB. CKSL-1410 can be heard just about every evening now they've moved from 1290. WMAQ-670 went off for a few minutes the other evening, but I didn't log anything because 670 sounded like an LA graveyard! Last evening, I had WTMJ-620 nulled out w/the loop & much to my amazement WVMT Vermont was heard, but w/only a fair signal. These loop antennas can do wonders! My loop, however, is a homemade brew; is very simple to build, & doesn't look at all like the regular type. It utilizes a high gain ferrite core loopstick antenna tuned w/a 365 mmf capacitor, & the loop antenna from an old table model radio is also used. Well, 73s as I have a feeling that I am nearing the 30 line limit.
