Some news of DX interest. WGOG-1000 sent v/l by Roy W. Phillips, CE. RS starts 4/1 on 1000 kc/s., tested 3/14-15-16. They have the first fully-transistorized XR in the SE, using only one tube, in the final. DX: MM 3/22- Had ET/M from WDXB-1490 @ 3am. CBD-1110 @ 3:40 w/CBC, weak. HJEW-1110 AN; IDing as "Cadena Todelor desde Cali." HJKW-1180, Radio Santander, is NSP, according to verie. They are S-9 SMS. SCers, WAME-1260 has 'em, send me your SASEs & duplicates. I did some interesting DX on the car RX at Homestead AFB, about 35 miles S of Miami. "Radio Veintiseis" was tremendous on 1220 & 1240 kc/s., no sign of domestics at all! The 1560 Reloj Nacional is definitely a move from 1580. 4VEF-1035 very strong @ lpm w/FF hymns. 800 kc/s. seemed entirely clear - no more reloj! 750 had Jamaica, very weak. Every frequency from 620 to 710 solid Cubans parallel from 660 to 700 kc/s. WWL-870 fair, hard to get daytime in Miami Beach. CMCA & ZNS w/local signals too, botn a little better than in Miami.
