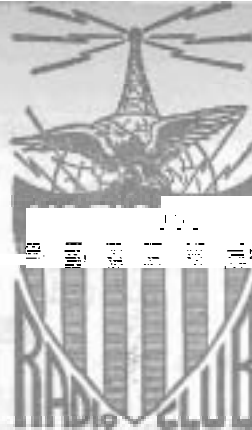

So many of us think of history as having left off when today's generation was born that I was struck on my recent visit to CBJ-1580 by the amount of living history built into that CBC FF outlet. Operations began in 1933, when the Marconi Co. opened a 100w. station, CRCS, to extend the "Commission Canadien de la Radiodiffusion", the Canadian Radio Broadcasting Commission FF Network, to Chicoutimi & the Saguenay district. CRCS became the CBC's CBJ on 5/1/39. CBJ's most interesting heirloom, perhaps, is not electronic equipment but an aged desk in the announcers' room. The desk dates, I am assured by J.E. Roberts, CE, from network pioneering days at CNRA, Moncton, one of seven stations operated by Canadian National Railways from 1922 or 1923 to 1930 (including CNRM, Montreal, CNRO Ottawa, CNRT Toronto, CNRV, Vancouver). The stations provided RF feed along railroad-side lines, & antennas atop CNR trains picked up the signals for passengers. Canada's first "network" failed, Mr. Roberts believes, after performers - the novelty gone - all wanted to be paid. CNR engineering talent went, in the main, to the CRBC. Mr. Roberts himself can look back even further. He worked on IOPA, a pioneer Canadian outlet, in 1919! Interesting people in broadcasting, and not all of them are at the mike! I'm going to see what CNR has in its archives that might be good for an article.

While NA afternoon reception of China is unprecedented on the ECB, it is possible; an all darkness path (polar path) exists from Western China to Eastern N.A. until about 1800 in December. On

12/9, a weak carrier faded in at 1625 on 1524.98, and was in until 1758 when it either went out of off. The next day it faded in at 1716 on 1524.89 and provided traces of audio around 1740; a woman was talking, but I couldn't get lingo. The DF situation on this one is very frustrating because I am unable to tell if the signal is coming from the North or South because I am rebuilding my absolute sense amplifier. If the signal is from the NORTH, the bearing indicates a path a little bit west of Urumchi, China. If I'm measuring a SOUTH null, then the station is merely a Central American. Either it is a pennywhistle L.A. or the best catch of my career! EUROPEANS: WHEN DOES 1525 SIGN OFF? (Nelson, Mass.)

Editor goofed. Did not correlate Nelson's report, which was here in time. Left this important tip out of order: 780 HR. VIRGIN IS./VENEZUELA. English speaking Caribbean station heard mixed with YVOD from 1720 to 1750 on 12/9 is almost certainly the planned B.V.I. station. Announcer was a woman; accent and general modulation quality very similar to the WIBS outlets. Had local newscast, then gal read piece on what seemed to be the Role of Woman in Society. Last NRC country list says ZV11, Rodetown, was planned; Dec. NNRC has a reported reception for ZFB-1, Lower Toxtula Island. I've got enough for a CSL, but would rather have more info regarding call, address, etc. Signal fairly good at times around 1740, but from that time on 780 was dominated completely by YVOD. WBDM looped out; Cuban on 779.886 sliced away. (Nelson, Mass.) Original tip from Ernie Weselowski said ZBVI. ZFB-1, of course, is the Bermudan on 960. Roadtown (Correct spelling, per Natl. Geographic) is located on Tortola Island. (Ed.)

- 1460 PUERTO RICO. WRBA, R. Pepino, San Sebastian. Form letter verie re 11/22 DX. From Ricardo Vega, C.E. Says will DX again early January, as CX weren't good this time. (Dangerfield, Pa.)
