DX conditions are definitely improving. Many of the commoner IA's are again audible, and LA reception, while not phenomenal, is uniformly good. No Scandinavians yet have appeared, but stations as far North as England and Poland are now audible some evenings. Bob Foxworth, North Carolina, comments, "January 22-24 seemed to be the tail end of good LA conditions and by 1/25 N-S paths, i.e., signals from NYC and the Midwest, had returned to significant strengths. There was only a gradual transition lasting about a week and no sharply defined discontinuity in favored-areas. West Coast signals were much better on 1/30 than on 1/23, leading me to think I may have had some ZCO through the KDKA-KGBS mess on 1/30 where none was heard 1/23. However on 1/30 I could not get a trace of KORL or any DU's, this may be due to high noise level." Alan Merriman, Virginia, adds, "Well, LA condx cooled off a bit. Europeans noted on several occasions. This evening, 2/4, many stns in around 1800 but nothing new."

Topical tips for the South Pacific seem to be in order, judging from information in Randy Seaver's IRCA section this week. Give special attention to:

- 890 Fiji. Lautoka seems to be the stn being hrd by several West Coast DX'ers on MM with native music, perhaps in Hindi.
- 1020 Tonga. ZCO is being widely hrd all over the country at the present time. Look for it mixed with KGBS on MM after about 0200, a man announcer (in both EE and native) with frequent 5 chime IS.
- 1120 American Samoa. WVUV hasn't been definitely nailed for a long time. Supposed to s/off 0300. Next good chance will be on MM 3/6 when KMOX is off.

* * * * *

Chinese broadcasting stations appear to be still in the hands of the pro-Mao faction, according to the information reaching Hong Kong. Many of the individual Provincial Broadcasting Enterprise Administration Bureaus are not willing to bet on the outcome of the present power struggle, however. As of 1/26, only 7 of the 27 Provincial stations were relaying CJKT news broadcasts (pro-Mao) preferring instead to transmit nonstop music. The head of the CCP Propaganda Bureau, who is in charge of broadcasting was recently sacked. Ex-Vice Premier Tao Chu was replaced by Wang Li on January 13th. We suspect that it's still a bit early to find out if they now have a new QSL policy, hi.

As we type this on Tuesday afternoon, we are literally snow-bound. In order to avoid an inevitable mail delay in getting the stencils to Richard, we're going to hold back the QSL's and a magnificent El Salvador list from Silvera until next week.
