The change to EDT would appear to be only for the convenience of Eastern Time residents, There are many members in Central, Mountain, & Pacific Time zones, as well as one or more in nearly every zone of the world. I have only two clocks in the shack, GMT for amateur operations, & EST for BCB work. I think in GMT, I think in EST, & convert to local time when necessary, no local time clock in the shack. If you think this doesn't work, give it a fair trial, use only an EST clock at the listening post for a year, then decide. Of general interest - 46 states this year are on daylight time, Mich. stays on EST (Michigan is completely within the Central Time Zone), Indiana & Ky. will each have four different times, & Hawaii will stay on EST less five.
