He says this is NO LONGER in operation but that it came about quite by accident when their old single tower (when 1 kw) was being moved and they found that two of four parts had broken, and they did something to bolster the antenna up higher which turned out to be this new system which was thus discovered accidentally. He is writing to Glenn Hauser about this, in a more technical vein, and I hope Glenn will write us about it, as your Editor is strictly non-technical and what Mr. Hollingsworth told me went in one ear and out the other (nothing in between to stop it, hi). He says WTBE is now 10kw, w/a three-tower directional. He is hoping to sell his one-tower no-sky-wave transmission to other stations, and he will inform DX NEWS if and when he does so that we can be alerted to try for it.
