Bob Foxworth reports that the Adams-Russell Co. of Waltham, MA has created an active communications antenna featuring extremely wide bandwidth coverage, by linking a miniature antenna element and a wideband amplifier. They claim "extraordinarily good linearity with low noise and negligible intermodulation problems." It is designed for 10 kHz to 108 MHz and was developed for the Army who will buy most of the initial production run. The rest will go to a European customer.

SONY UPDATES THE TFM-1600

For some time the Sony 6-band portable model TFM-1600 has been known as one of the best - and best priced - portable rx in its class. Now the TFM-1600 has been replaced by a new model called ICF-8000. This is essentially a slightly updated model as far as the interior is concerned. The exterior has become more streamlined, but the dimensions remain about the same. Thanks to the use of integrated circuits (and more plastic in the chassis?) Sony managed to cut out one pound of the weight (now 7 lb 1 oz), which of course is important for the airborne globetrotter. Among the improvements are a somewhat higher output, and a very good fine tuning knob. The rx still covers FM, BCB, plus SW1-4 bands, from 1.6-26.1 Mhz. It still operates on DC or 100-240V AC (built-in transformer). The net price in Tokyo is around \$80 US.

This new model also comes in a version called TFM-8000W. The exterior is the same, but this version comes with a public service band, 147-174 Mhz, and only three SW bands, 1.6-22 Mhz. Most probably this is the version that will be marketed in the USA, as it operates on DC or 120 V 60 Hz.

A Brief Follow-up on Graveyard DX

One great big omission in my article, under "Things to Remember..." part three - I forgot to mention maps. Detailed road maps of each state are one of the most useful things any DXer can have, to identify neighboring towns that may be mentioned in a broadcast. This problem is most easily solved by buying the Rand McNally Road Atlas, for \$2.95 (+ whatever tax). The 50th edition of this Life Magazine-sized book with over 100 pages is now available. It is possible your bookseller may have earlier editions, which are just as good for our purposes, that he might let go for less than list price. An even cheaper alternative is to contact a major oil company's touring service, asking for a full set of state road maps. In New York, the Exxon Touring Service will give you a set of state maps free; I am sure the others do too.

Another omission was my omitting the aspect of DXing sports networks. Fortunately, Ed Krejny and Tom Sundstrom have had useful contributions along these lines in the latest two bulletins. About all I can add is the observation that, when listening to a baseball game on a Class IV channel, where several stations on the frequency are listed as belonging to the network, one will often find that the game audio is heard quite clearly, but when the stations along the line break for local identification, each one becomes nearly unreadable. 10 seconds later, the game feed is again well heard, due to the 2 or 3 signals' audio adding together. All I can say is -- persevere!

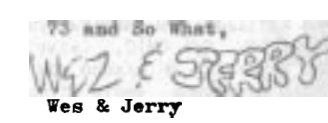

Greetings. Not much happening judging from reports, but a couple of "goodies" have been reported (see 1040 and 1169). Apparently no one heard anything on MM 4/22 after the Colombian elections as nothing has been reported. Here is what we have as of 5/18.

- 550 -JAMAICA RJR Montego Bay was logged 2/25 between 0901 and 0910. Tough to make out the programming (believe it was RR) but numerous ID jingles and one spot were noted. Severe QRM of course. (Krejny)
- 570 -MEXICO XETJ Torreon, Coah. 5/8 0220-0300 w/boleros and IDs w/4 note chime as "Radio Romantica". First time heard. Voice ID after each song, followed by chimes and ads. (Gleason)
- 630 -UNID XE Under KHOW 5/6 0850. Could not null KHOW enough to hear. (Lobel)
- 690 -MEXICO XEN Mexico, DF, "Radio Mundo" end of song, typical R. Mundo ID w/ xylophone notes from a song called "El Mundo" and voice ID, then fast fade u/XETRA. 0218 on 5/8. First time here. (Gleason)
- 720 -CUBA CMGN Colon in food w/Latin mx 5/6 0755. Was in most of the night w/ no sign of any other IA station on this frequency. (Lobel)
- 760 -CUBA CMCI Havana in like a local w/regular TC and news at 0750 5/6. Male announcer only, no sign of the usual female. They were really making a big deal of the French Political Party (Socialist Party). KFMB off as usual this first MM. (Lobel)
- 800 -NETHERLANDS ANTILLES PJB Bonaire w/what sounded like Latin (Portuguese, ED) certainly not SS. 5/6 0810. Later (about an hour) they were in EE. (Lobel)
- 910 -MEXICO XEAO Mexicali, BC w/good sig and ID as Radio AO. 5/6 0835. (Lobel)
- 1000 -COLOMBIA HJAJ Cartagena, Radio Miramar 5/6 1040. Many good IDs as Radio Miramar and HJAJ. Heard underneath KOMO testing until about 1100 when KOMO's test tone came on loud and overpowering. (Lobel)
- 1040 -FUERTO RICO AFNG Fort Buchanan was noted on 2/24 from 0650-0726 and 0759-0829. MoR mx. No IDs or other announcements. Occasionally heavy QRM from PRG2 and HJCJ. Fair signal at best. Hvy QRM and severe QSB also hurt. (This originally was a tentative for me, but reception confirmed through v/l received). (Krejny) And, an 809 to you! (ED)
- 1169 -GHAD Ft. Lamy, 0018 5/16, 48 db at times, clearly readable til tune out at 0048. Political speech in native FF, // 4904.5 khz. Called G. Nelson, R. Moore (also Bill Grant who wasn't home). Very little fading, so could be new higher power entr. They were on an extended program this evening, well beyond their usual s/off. (Bailey) Very nice! (ED)
- 1277 -UNID 5/3 0215-0430 SS station w/very old Mexican rock hits, almost all announcements in Male/Female two voice style. One promo said "Buena musica para un buen auditoria". Was apparently a spur, as no carrier on this thing and covered 1275-1279. Gone the next night. (Gleason)
- 1329 -MEXICO XEAJ Radio Bonita, Saltillo, Coah. 5/4 0300 w/ranchera mx, ID by name and call letters. Very rough copy w/KFAC a powerhouse on 1330. (Gleason)
- 1348,6 -MEXICO XELBL San Luis Rio Colorado, heard 0210 4/24 // to XECB-1450. Definite ID as "XECB R. Ranchito y XELBL R. Amor". Programming was that of XECB (Ranchera) probably to save extra staff costs on daytime XELBL during late summer s/off. (Gleason)
- 1360 -MEXICO XESA Culiacan, Sin. 5/4 0350-0415 w/local KRUX dead. Very strong XEPI w/International MoR mx made very difficult to log, but dug enough off tape to report. Has identical format as XETK-630, US rock w/oldies. ID is over first notes of "Dancing in the Moonlight". (Gleason)
- 1423 -UNID I'll have to guess that this is a CA, if not the nominal 1425 Costa Rican station. 5/8 0230 almost readable in an opening that had 1548, 1175, 1325, 1375, 1025 all good. Mexicans only average at time. (Gleason) How about some of our members in the South checking this out and see if we can come up with an ID. Dave would appreciate some help with this. (ED)



This is the second (and last) 1974 edition of the Mexican list. The first edition published by ICA over a period of several weeks. This edition takes into account much new information, particularly slogans and hours of operation. I am greatly indebted to David F. Gleason for providing the most recent data from Mexican industry sources and for his extensive personal observations. This version, completed 1 May 1974, incorporates NRC member reports in IDDX through 22 April, and ICA member reports in DXW through 6 April. Also included are a small number of items from WRTN 74 which are the only changes to an earlier Mexican list published there as the Mexican section. Others sources upon which this exhaustive and inclusive list is based: Mexican (NOT) information buried in forums or Mustangs or misplaced in domestic DX sections; my own DXing and travelling in Mexico during the same period. My sincere thanks to the many, many DXers whose reported Mexican DX helps to make this list accurate. Users of the list are urged to avoid perpetuating errors by not reporting slogans unless they have been heard. Vacations in Mexico can also help us in future updates by checking slogans, hours of operation, and status of OPS.

States and cities are in proper Spanish alphabetical order under each frequency; state abbreviations are standard ones recognized by the Mexican PO and should be familiar to DXers. Cd. = Ciudad. A distinction is made between slogans known or believed to be used on the air, enclosed in quotation marks, and those which may be only corporate names. Many of the stations for which no slogan is known may use call letters only, or part of them (e.g., 'La XX').

Power is in watts; all nighttime stations are 100 W and all daytime stations are 100 W (i.e., non-directional) unless otherwise specified by an underlined symbol in the Notes section. See NRC Domestic Log or WTH for explanation of antenna pattern symbols. Times are GMT, but days of week refer to Mexico. DST has been rare, observed at only a few border cities, particularly in BC, Jalisco, and Baja California. Stations generally operate 0700-1900 local time, but vary from month to month according to a different system than that used in the USA.

It is not unusual for more than one MW station in a single city to be in the same building and/or under common ownership. These groups are shown at the first entry by an asterisk in the group column and the remaining frequencies in parentheses in the Notes column. Frequencies in the group column are references to the first entry for that group. (Except for the special case of DXW) programming is ordinarily different, except for common newscasts in some cases. No attempt has been made to show groups of stations operating from different cities. Frequencies at the right margin show where the same programming may be heard as the station with which they are listed, preceded by one of these symbols: c - shortwave; e - STL; f - FM; h - harmonic; net - net; a - spur; v - variable frequency. Spurs and harmonics are not shown unless they have been heard beyond the local area.

Addresses consisting of a number alone are Alcaldia (box) numbers. This word must be inserted before the number. Others are street addresses. Prepositions and articles are sometimes omitted from addresses and slogans to save space. Anyone with a minimum knowledge of Spanish can replace them. 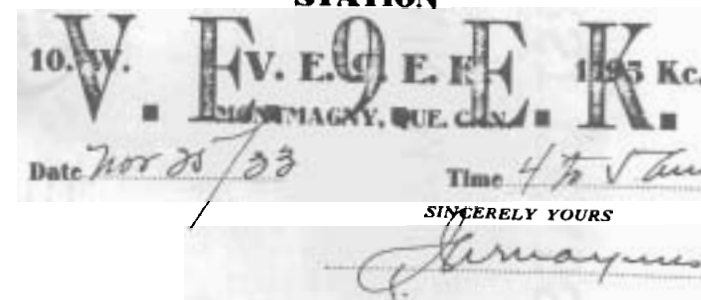
