880 -4V2A Radio Nationale. Religious programs. 1 kw. Address 121, route de Bizoton (Frontamara). Sked 1000-1400 and 2300-0300. Non-stop on Sundays and Holidays. Future plans call for a move to Cite Simone O. Duvalier, near Port-au-Prince. They need classical music records for their library, so if you hear them and send a report, send some along.

910 -4V-- Radio Nouveau Monde. 10 kw. Sked 1045-0500 (Sundays 1300-0300). Adr. Place de l'Hotel de ville. Slogan "La Voix d'Haiti dans les Ameriques".

960 -4VCD Radio Carillion. 1700-0300 (Sunday 1200-0030). Address 159, rue Dr Aubry.

1000-4VCPS Radio Cacique. Frequency varies 990-1000 khz.

1080-4VA La Voix de la Revolution Duvalieriste. Irregular operation. During Victors visit this station was off the air but he was told that "important changes were going to take place including the addition of shortwave".

1120-4VF Radio Union. Delete, they have been off the air for several years. This frequency has been assigned to Radio Haiti-Inter and they plan to have an all Creole station here.

1150-4VAB Radio Caraibes. 0945-0400 (Sundays 0300).

1330-4VW Radio Haiti-Inter. 10 kw. Building Brandt, Rue du Quai, B.P. 737. Sked 1000-0500 (they have been on 1325 khz in the past).

1385-4VS Radio Port-au-Prince.

1430-4VGM Radio M. B. C.

1475-4VAA La Voix du Peuple. 700 watts. Commercial and cultural programs. Sked 1000-1700 and 1900-0500. 121, route de Bizoton (Fontamara).

1500-4VOC Radio Select. Most likely this station is off the air.

There is one other station in Port-au-Prince, Radio Lumiere on 660 khz. All addresses are in Port-au-Prince. Our thanks to Victor for this info.

USSR (DXN Vol. 42, #2) Japanese DXers confirm that the station on 548 khz is still on the air but all programming is in Russian. (Ryden)

584 -SPAIN RNE Madrid finally noted hetting Cuba 580 mixed w/em 10/14 0422. SS mx came thru a lot. (Shaftan, last 2)

595 -DOMINICA R. Dominica was in well 10/18,19 but copy tough due to 590 splatter from the Cuban/WOW. S/off at 0233 on 10/18. Noted again 10/21 at 0035 w/nx of the UN; probably a relay from U N Radio. (B. Reynolds)

600 -COLOMBIA HJHJ R. Libertad, Barranquilla 10/14 noted cutting thru Cuban w/power-house sigs and beautiful taped ID. 0427. (Shaftan)

610 -COLOMBIA HJKL Emisora Nueva Granada, Bogota 10/14 noted booming in w/WIOD in at same time o/an annihilated WIP. In all nite. Everyone I spoke to also had them in too! 0449. (Shaftan)

620 -UNID (2) 2 stns in 10/14 0807. Mixed w/unid EE MoR stn. Bayside DXer Eric Fader got the YN and the YV in there that evening so I guess that its them. Only thing tho...can I count both as being heard??? Px SS talk on both w/an occasional IA cut w/NSP WVNJ off. (Shaftan) I wouldn't count them. (ED)

625 -COSTA RICA TIXE 10/14 0507 noted o/unid SS playing some "IA RR" type mx, a Ray Charles song, a Carley Simon #, ID sounded like R. Tiral or similiar but was temp. covered by IA u/LA faded out perm. at ca 0512. Format fits Omega per Foreign log items. Also PT ID. also noted lo in fq. slightly. Anyone know who could be u/maybe Peruvian?? but they should be off 0500, maybe AN for Columbus day or something?? Help?? (Shaftan) 110 (ED)

635 -UNID Unlisted IA stn was noted here on 10/20 almost level w/Cubans on 630 and 640 w/MoR US instrumentals from 0150-0158 when it s/off w/unid NA. IDs were passed just prior to s/off but missed due to my little girl waking up and diverting my attention. (Burns) Ask her, maybe she caught ID, hi. (ED)

645 -PARAGUAY Coronel Oviedo, R. Caaguazu now every AM since building new LSCA. Especially good early Oct. Perfect test stn for trans-equatorial condx. Ranges faint to good. Mx played is "guaranian", w/harps and guitars. (Schatz)

650 -COLOMBIA HJUX Emisoras Monserrate, Bogota 10/14 0533 noted w/MoR inst. format fits them. Also reported a lot in Foreign log and SS px helped. Also Aurora too - hi! (Shaftan)

-COSTA RICA TIBAS R. Monumental, noted w/ID at 0100 10/9. WSM looped. Tape sent. (B. Reynolds)

-HAWAII KORL Honolulu up to S4 at times 1212-1235 10/6 w/hulas and thickly accented ancor, much stronger than ever before here. (McCurdy)

655 -EL SALVADOR YSS San Salvador excellent on car rx (!) 10/21 0215-0300 w/sports event, probably BKB, between Quat. and El Sal. Stronger than I ever get them on NC-125, hi. Belize-834 was overpowering on car rx, too. (McCurdy)

-GUATEMALA/JAMAICA Radio Mundial and JBC's "Radio One" RR were tops on this channel on the evening of 10/19. No sign of WLW as late as 0200. Mundial still much stronger than WLW at 0413. (B. Reynolds)

-UNID W/rapid SS talk, some phone calls and rancheras, seemed to say a slurred "R. Mundial" and mentioned "Hermosa" at times, 1140-1145 10/17. (McCurdy)

720 -CUBA (?) Unid 10/14 way o/WGN at times, 0517-0630; 0530 kept mentioning "sesenta y cuatro" (64) and said "R. Nacional"; 0620 had man and woman alternating in reading mx, S4 at times. (McCurdy)

730 -COLOMBIA HJCU R. Melodia, was dominating this channel around 0015 10/9 w/nx. Beautiful signal..JEX no problem. Tape sent. (B. Reynolds)

735 -UNID Never quite readable and always weak, but could ID language as SS 0543 10/5. Heard often (but very weakly) this month. Whats being heard? (McCurdy) Likely HCBG1 Radio Melodia, Quito. (ED)

740A -CUBA (?) CMJL? wicked het noted here on lo side of 740. At first thought to be RNE 737 but noted again at 0746 so I guess not, the Cuban has been reported as being on 738 so...10/14. (Shaftan) Likely WOR, see last week. (ED)

740 -UNID Old logging, wanted to check it with what was being heard at the time (before I joined NRC). This was 3/11, someone w/British accent, hard to copy but did mention Sydney often in nx or amnts. 0905-0910, then covered by an OC. I suppose this is something Caribbean or even CBL, but couldn't help thinking about DU. (McCurdy) Nothing in Caribbean fits, CBL should have been off and CENM not on yet. 2BL a good possibility. (ED)

750 -NICARAGUA (?) Possibly YNX, o/WSB, seemed to mention "Ekksis" and/or "La Ekksis" often in between easy listening mx 0409-0415, when WSB covered them. What is YNX slogan? Was a pretty solid S5 for a while. (McCurdy) Mostly use just "Equis", so sounds like you had them. (ED)

760 -HAWAII KGU Honolulu finally logged after years of trying 1240-1245 10/6-KORL's coming in was tip off. Hlack vocalists, then ad for Rams broadcast, then "When it comes to sports, Hawaii depends on KGU", 1243. Signal was S4 at best. QSL from Takumi Shigetani, CE disappointing: "We appreciate your reception of our signal", with time and date pinned in. Is that acceptable verification language for most DXers? (McCurdy) Certainly would be good enough for me. (ED)

770 -PANAMA R. Libertad ID briefly on top, tropical mx 10/21 0803. (Hauser)

780 -BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS ZBVI good and clear 2300 BBC nx to 2309 then had spots for cigarettes and gin, things we never hear up here. Radio Rebelde still up on 783. (Foxworth) If I make many more mistakes typing this column I'm going to quit and get some of that gin. (ED)

-UNID Who is Radio Norte here? Heard 10/19 0203 along w/ZBVI. Weak WBBM looped. (B. Reynolds) Don't know, YVOD most common IA here. (ED)

785 -CUBA CMJN Camaguey, R. Rebelde noted here intermittently early Oct..This is good nx for Fla. DXers who can now work 780. (Schatz) 10/13, t/in 0320, IDs 0330 unreadable, super ID 0401, t/out. Good mx format, little talking. Off 780, WBBM for first time in many years not garbled by SAHS. (Sundstrom) * Has been noted here since at least 10/13 w/the usual format. (Burns) * Logged here 10/13 0459-have they moved from 780, and is this CMJN per RFS list? They seem to drift a bit now, but still on a split. (McCurdy)

- 810 -COLOMBIA HJCY 10/14 0605 noted w/MoR but rate poor for its power vs 820,840. Funny thing, 250 kw was weakest followed by 50 kw and strongest was 10 kw HJBI. (Shaftan)
- 818 -MOROCCO Rabat, poor u/o local QRN on 10/11 0014-0035 w/AA mx and male ancr noted at 0032. (Burns)
- 820 -CUBA CMGA Radio Metropolitana, Habana back on the air after brief hiatus and w/new name. Gives QTH as Ave. 26, No. 877 (or 867?); Nuevo Vedado. (Schatz)
- 825 -COSTA RICA TIOS R. Titania, San Jose. Presume this is the IA first heard on 10/6 0020-0038 w/mixed SS and US pop/soul mx. YL ancr gave no dialogue just the recording artist's name just after each record began. Male ancr noted at 0032 w/prob ad for Casablanca? Heard frequently since. (Burns)
- 840 -UNID Noted as late as 0657 10/14—is there an AN SS here? (McCurdy)
- COLOMBIA HJBI Ondas del Caribe, Santa Marta noted stronger than other 2 (810, 820) w/all no WHAS booming in 10/14 0619. (Shaftan)
- CUBA CMKC noted in null of HJBI 10/14 0621. Lotta IA mx, DJ said something about "Ocho de Cuba" 0630. Px sounded LVDC so I guess its them. (Shaftan)
- HAITI 4VEH believed the one here at 0003 10/19 w/religious flavored lessons. (B. Reynolds)
- ST LUCIA Castries, FF speaker here between 0030-0100+ w/unid SS QRM. Didn't sound like 4VEH so I believe this was Radio Caribbean. Couldn't decipher an ID so sent tentative report and tape. - 1000 -COLOMBIA HJAQ R. Miramar topping XEOY 0352 10/19. Tape sent. (B. Reynolds)
- MEXICO Radio Mil (pronounced "meal") ID o/KTOK until KTOK took over 0606 10/14-XEOY used to use this slogan; do they still? (Yes, ED) Does anyone else use it? (McCurdy) Several other 1000 IAs use R. Mil but this was likely XEOY. (ED)
- 1025 -UNID IA SS S5-6 mentioning Nicaragua 0259 10/4, had carillon bells, armt, more carillon, then faded out. SS here again 10/18 0024, seemed to say "Camino Internacional". (McCurdy)
- 1030 -MEXICO [REDACTED] noted 10/14 w/LA mx 0847 w/WEZ off on reg MM SP. PT ID helped. (Shaftan) Who is PT? I thought he had died and gone to DXers heaven but I see you must have him tied up in your basement just so he can ID stations for you. (ED)
- 1035 -HAITI 4VEF Cap Haitien in strong, first time, 0019-0030 10/18 w/EE religious program; solid S7 at first. (McCurdy)
- 1040 -COLOMBIA HJAI (?) noted w/LA mx 10/14 0840 w/no sign of WHO. Though PT says it probably is them, may also be the other HJ which is often reported equal to HJAI. This one alone though. (Shaftan) Last time I checked 1040 on a SM HJAI was there all alone. (ED)
- UNID possibly Colombian, S9 0540, still strong 0559 10/14. Said both "R. Super and Super Radio", mentioned Bogota but also El Salvador, the "Super Radio" w/a slight reverb canned ID. (McCurdy) Tis HJCJ Bogota. (ED)
- 1050 -MEXICO XED Mexicali w/u XEG 0220-0227 10/4, may have said "La Voz del Pacifico", and for sure "R. Internacional", heard often since. (McCurdy)
- MEXICO XEG noted 10/14 0830 w/EE rel px and soul mx. First thought to be CHUM. Tnx to Fader for ID. (Shaftan) Is he in basement w/PT? (ED)
- 1060 -CUBA CMEQ noted 10/14 w/background mx tent. 0825. KYW on reg SP. Fader says its them, so does everyone else so... (Shaftan) Ever think of waiting for ID?
- 1125 -COSTA RICA R. Capital, Well, not quite over. Despite reception on 1130 (and I have rechecked the tape which had a clear ID), 10/16 0215 and since, back on 1125 is R. Capital de Costa Rica, noted at that time w/sports coverage. (Hauser) * S7-8 0435 10/14, and often since—the only sure CR here so far, and by far the strongest. (McCurdy)
- 1160 -COLOMBIA Soledad (suburb of Barranquilla), R. Aeropuerto. No definite ID yet, but caught ads for the "Robertico" supermarket chain on sundry listening occasions, thus indicating this newie is now on the air. (Schatz)
- 1170 -COLOMBIA Cartagena, La Voz de la Heroica is correct name, not WRTH's "Bocagrande" nor RFS's mis-ID "Pueblo" (Tsk, Tsk! ED) phoned to PT. Usually dominant eves in Miami. (Schatz) According to my map, Barranquilla and Cartagena are rather close together to have stns only 10 khz apart. I'm not disputing you, RFS, just making an observation. (ED)
- 1180 -BRAZIL PP definitely the language, noted at 0555 10/20. One may as well call SS "weird PP". (Hauser)
- DOMESTIC VOA Marathon, Fla. 10/12, Yankee Doodle IS of VOA picked out of SS w/WHAM null'd at 0330, not often hrd here, must be highly directional. (Sundstrom) Si, ED. * W/SS speech o/WHAM 0425-0430 10/18, then a VOA ID heard after they went u/WHAM—missed the location, but sounded like began w/M. Who and where? (McCurdy) One of the highlights of the Miami Convention was a visit to this station. (ED)
- 1196 -UNID Someone barely audible here on 10/10 at 2315 and again at 2322. At first thought is was my imagination as what sounded like a stringed-type instrument could barely be heard at 2315. Anything been heard here except for Germany? Morocco seems the best bet w/Agadir-935 and Rabat-818 both copyable and hets also noted on 1007, 1097 and 1394. (Burns) Likely Agadir II, often heard. (ED)
- 1205A -CUBA Reloj Nacional. Either CMKL or CMKD has been noted here sporadically since 10/13 at 1230 w/the usual filibustering and time pips each minute and putting a terrific het on WCAU. (Burns) Is that time correct? Seems kinda late for Cuba. (ED)
- 1215 -CUBA (probably) UNID—seemed like R. Reloj Nacional program 0835 10/20. (McCurdy)
- 1225 -COSTA RICA R. BB San Jose in quite well 10/14 at 0045 w/LA MoR vocals and clear ID as R. BB at 0048. (Burns) * S9 0459, caught end of ID which sounded like "Ay Bay"—then no more sound 0500 and after, though het there—s/off I suppose. (McCurdy) 117

- 1241 -DOMINICAN REPUBLIC HIAU La Voz de la Libertad, Puerto Plata 10/12, super sig 0100-0130 w/fair to good signals, remarkably good audio, at times wiping out 1240 het even w/o "null" function of Q-M. (Sundstrom)
- 1270 -CUBA R. Reloj Nacional 0619 10/7—per RFS list, this would be GMJG. (McCurdy)
- 1295 - SINT MAARTEN PJD2 gone from here since 10/1, // fate of PJA6. (Schatz)
- 1376 -FRANCE (Tentative) Lille II, almost certain this was the FF stn heard quite well 10/5 2327-2354 w/a recorded pop concert by a male FF pop singer (clapping, screaming, etc) after each song and ann by a YL between tunes. Signal peaked around 2350 but faded shortly thereafter so no ID heard on the hour. On a check at 10/6 0105 they were still on playing Beatles records w/male ancr. Direction definitely indicates a TA but is Lille normally on this late? (Burns) I'm not sure what current sked is but they used to s/off earlier. Are you certain of freq? I would suspect St Pierre-1375 which has been heard here w/excellent signals frequently this season. (ED)
- 1430 -MEXICO 10/18 0322 Mexican mx dominating freq; "W-D" ID, 9:28 TC; SAH of roughly 12 hz w/center channel; audible only on SM-2. This is XEWD, Cd. Miguel Aleman, Tams. No R. Favorita ID noted. (Hauser)
- 1480 -MEXICO (Harmonic) XETKR Monterrey, NL now back on frequency, since its harmonic on 2960 produces a SAH w/somebody; noted 10/13 1142 w/mx; 1206, 1209 anmts; 1211 "Oiga T-K-R" jingle (In case this isn't clear, the likelihood of a drifter producing a SAH either on its fundamental or harmonic, is rather remote. (Hauser)
- 1550 -ECUADOR La Voz del Guabo, El Guabo. While trying for good signals for taped verie for Merriman's edification, found this one missing too. Not noted since the NRC convention. Anyway, I solemnly swear that this is/was not Colombia. (Schatz) The big problem Ron, is that your imagination hasn't been working too well since the convention. In checking back in my log, I find that on 10/4/69 HJLP Tulua was logged (and subsequently verified) on this frequency. There may be an HC here, but at one time there was also a HJ here. I have no idea who is here now, but someone is as there is a noticeable het on Nice when they are in. (ED)
- 1510 -DOMINICAN REPUBLIC R. Pueblo, Santo Domingo is believed to be the one heard w/good sigs several times during the past week, but no IDs noted. Generally up-beat mx, as many as 4-5 songs in a row w/no anmts. Completely dominates the frequency at times. (ED)
- 1541A -UNID There has been a het on this freq for quite some time. RFS says he thinks it is the HR, but this evening, 10/26 audio was noted for the first time, between 2230-2300. Loop indicates that this is probably R. El Mundo in Santo Domingo, D.R. Can you check this Cesar? (ED)
- 1560 -UNID Like ERC heard a SS w/MOR mx u/Cuba here on MM 10/21. Anyone ID this one? (B. Reynolds) No definite ID, but I believe this is WRSJ R. San Juan. Loops from here to Caribbean area, and this is most likely. (ED)
- 1580 -COLOMBIA HJQZ R. Principe, Barranquilla noted w/fair/good sigs on 10/21 2345-2355. Played a vocal version of a song lasting about 7 mins, then brief anmt which included ID and into inst version of same song. Second IA briefly under them at one point; I suspect another HJ but possibly the one below (not XEWD as they were clearly audible w/loop turned 90 degrees. (ED)
- NICARAGUA YND Managua, 10/12, surprising, noted w/R. Uno ID above din 0230. Primarily man talking, seemed to be news, continuously thru 0300, IDs 0244, 0300. At times quite good, new. (Sundstrom)

A NOTE RECEIVED AT HQ FOR ANY OF YOU WHO ARE ALSO SATELLITE DX-ING FREAKS....

An amateur group of space eavesdroppers is being organized to monitor the Apollo-Soyuz joint space mission next July 15th. We need interested people with simple radio equipment which can receive telemetry and voice signals on the 20 MHz and 120-145 MHz bands. Before next summer, we expect to practice monitoring some other Russian space missions.

A group is already in existence. Founded by a science teacher in Kettering , Great Britain, these space eavesdroppers have been monitoring Russian and American space shots for a decade. Often these people are the only source of news about Russian space failures. New members are always needed.

Some of the most interesting accomplishments in 1974 included receiving signals from the Luna-22 probe in lunar orbit, being the first to announce the launchings of Soyuz-14 and Soyuz-15, and monitoring the last days of the Salyut-3 space station. When newspapers refer to "radio amateurs" as the source of information, they are talking about the "Kettering Group".

Observers are needed all over the world, but there are four main locations which are important because they are near Russian tracking sites: NE North America, the Caribbean, the South Atlantic periphery, and the Japan/Korea area. Observers here can pick up the actual voice communications from the Russian cosmonauts. We have facilities for translating this material.

This activity can be enjoyable and educational for individual amateurs, even those with only a simple receiver tuned to 20 MHz. It can be the basis for radio clubs or science classes who want to try something more advanced than OSCAR work. It involves real space detective work and a lot of unexpected surprises.

Please send self-addressed stamped envelopes for return correspondence. Also mention what kind of radio gear you have, your phone number, and your latitude/longitude. We're going to have a lot of fun!!
