It is intended for inductive coupling. They want \$15.95 for it, and you could build it, without the plastic for about \$4.00. Enuf said.

If you are interested in bidding for the NRC's 1976 Convention, NJPC has discovered that continuation of a mid-August date for same inevitably causes conflicts with other clubs' convention dates. Likewise, our experiment with mid-August for 1974 & 1975 gives us one day less for the big wing-ding. We have one bid already for the 1976 convention, which would require going back to Labor Day. In addition, the mid-August date also gets in the way of the DXN publishing sked, as we discovered last year. For these reasons, we feel that it is best to return to Labor Day weekend for our conventions in the future. We realize, of course, that any decision will inconvenience some of our members, but we have also discovered that those who are truly interested will attend regardless.

- 540 -MEXICO XEWA San Luis Potosi, SLP, a long time I didn't hear this stn, due to closer stns in the area on freq. Noted at 0145 on 3/22. (Objio) * Great sig 0500-0534 3/5 obliterating CBK. News in SS followed by commentary seemingly about oil shortage and world economic crisis. (Sorensen) / (Lehr)
- 544 -UNID TP Weak audio 0934 3/30. Slightly better 1037-1055 w/YL speaking, language uncertain due to weak sig, but sounded like RR. Inaudible at 1100 possible ID time. Noted agn 1338, hetting someone on 545. Carrier on 548 also.
- 548 -USSR FES Vladivostock best ever 3/21 1250 w/wicked het on 550 domestics and opera snatches floating thru. Also noted 3/23, but mostly a carrier then. (Rittenhouse) * Fair to good at 1247 on 3/30. (Wilkinson)
- 570 -CUBA CMHI destroying superlocal WMCA w/RR lesson at 0050 on 3/29. (Brotsky) * W/SS talk and mx u/WMCA 3/26. First time I've ever been able to null WMCA here. (Shaftan) Wonder if they've ever been able to null you. (ED)
- 575 -USSR FES Khabarovsk noted on 3/31 at 1315 w/musical program in RR. S5 sigs and readable w/local KIAC on 570. (Finkle) * Good w/musical program at 1243 and 1324 on 3/30. (Wilkinson) * In 3/22 1321 w/unbelievable strength almost equal to local KMJ on 580. Had opera in RR. Also noted 3/27 at 1200 w/HS IS and six pips on hour. (Rittenhouse)
- 580 -MEXICO XEAV Guadalajara, Jal. good w/Canal 5-8 ID at 0334 3/26. (Strentzsch)
- 584 -USSR FES Svobodnyl fair to good w/musical program at 1245 on 3/30. Kremlin Bells ID at 1330. (Wilkinson) * Noted 3/22 at 1325 and 1357 w/mw alternating in RR. Sig was at least as good as 575 above and maybe a bit better. Domestics no problem. (Rittenhouse)
- 590 -UNID In regards to my report of KGMB on this freq on 3/3 0605, I received a nice 2 page letter from the CE telling me it sounded like KGMB on my tape but he doubts it was KGMB. He sent a 10 minute segment of their taped log and asked me to let him know if I could make any correlation between the 2. On a long shot I wrote to KGLE, even though they are a daytimer only, and explained I had gotten a letter from KGMB saying it wasn't them and was just wondering if KGLE was on the air testing or something. The CE wrote back that they were not on the air at the time. There are no other stns w/the letters KG as the first 2 on 590; suggestions anyone? I know it wasn't KOGO (Lobel)
- 595 -SOUTH KOREA HLSA Seoul, legged at good volume from 1213-1243 on 3/30. Was stronger at 1325. First time heard this season. (Wilkinson)
- 615 -UNID TP w/YL in CC 1329 3/30. Mx interlude 1329 $\frac{1}{2}$, OM in KK 1330 $\frac{1}{2}$. Suspect HLSA from 600 khz, per 12/16/74 IDXD. (Lehr)
- 615 -CHINA YL and OM in CC 1322-1328 3/30, holding up well against KFRC slop. (Lehr) *Unid Chinese (not listed here) w/S6 sigs on 3/30 w/piano mx announced by a woman in CC at 1345. (Finkle)
- 625 -COSTA RICA TIXE San Jose, Radio Omega is now 50 kw, at least, per powerful sig into Uleta. Noted 3/30 eve LT on my return from Sto. Domingo. Noted slight drop in precision freq; used to be 625.5. (Schatz)
- NORTH KOREA Haeju listed, Net 1 program 3/31 1123 OM talk, 1158-1200 mx, YL //655, S9 signal. (Seaver) * Poor at 1129 on 3/30. (Wilkinson) * Excellent 3/21 1259-1302 w/YL in KK to hour, 4 pips identical to NHK's on the hour and frenzied OM in KK after. Also good 1329 3/23 in chorus. This stn has never had more than a weak carrier and very slight audio before. (Rittenhouse)
- 635 -NORTH KOREA Chongjin noted w/fair audio and YL yakker 3/24 1254. (Rittenhouse)

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-CUBA CMQ noted w/mention of "Habana, Cuba" 0617 o/KFI 3/31. (Shaftan)
 -CHINA Peking fair 1251 3/21 in oriental talk in unid language. This fair sig was ~~heard~~ torn up rather badly by KFI/KNBR slop and the RR on 647. (Rittenhouse)
 -USSR FES Vladivostok listed at good volume w/Kremlin Bells and IL anor at 1130 1/2 on 3/30. March mx and musical program followed. Hardly audible on 3/31. (Wilkinson) * Foreign Service 3/31 1008 in KK, 1030 Kremlin Bells, S9 level w/KFI off. (Seaver) * Very good 3/22 1330+ in apparent KK FS w/OM in KK. (Rittenhouse)
 650 -JAPAN Toyama tentatively the one mixing w/KORL and others 1305 3/23. Had ~~sig~~ in JJ in typical NHK type pgn. KNBR, as usual, a pain. (Rittenhouse)
 655 -NORTH KOREA Pyongyang, Net 1 program 3/31 1042-1107 //735, 1158 //625 w/mx, OM and YL. Net 1 program has more talk and less diatribe, more singing and less martial mx. S9 best. (Seaver) * Pegging the meter in fine style 3/21 1235 w/OM ranting in KK. Though this is in on virtually every TP opening, it rarely has clear audio for me. (Rittenhouse)
 -UNID TP Something here very weak 3/21 and 3/22 w/flutey type mx way u/the KR. Sounded like what I heard on Dave Williams tentative tape of Vietnam here, but really too weak to tell w/the KK and KNBR's everpresent crap. (Rittenhouse)
 660 -JAPAN/SOUTH ~~TOYO~~ Two Asians taking turns on this freq from 1133-1200 on 3/30. S. Korean atop at 1300. Both audible again at 1128 on 3/31. (Wilkinson) * Synchros probably the strong TP carrier w/apparent weak JJ noted 1305 3/21 and 1322 3/22. (Rittenhouse)
 -MEXICO XERPM, this one w/US rock, ID's as *(whirl) Radio Uno*. Not HJ ID format. 0609 played "Get Dancing" 3/31. (Shaftan)
 665 -USSR Noted on 3/30 at 1320 w/mx program announced in RR w/S5 sigs. (Finkle) *Fair to good sig at 1206 on 3/30. (Wilkinson) * Probably the weak talk hrd here 3/21 1304. Carrier was respectable, but KNBR messing up most of the audio. May KNBR's final tubes be seized by the electrical equivalent of cardiac arrest.
 670 -UNID Believe TG, soccer game w/mentions of Guatemala. Good at (Rittenhouse) 0355 on 3/22. (Strentzsch) / (Objio)
 680 -DOMINICAN REPUBLIC Radio Zamba, Santiago Rodriguez, moved to this freq 3/23.
 -MEXICO XELG Leon, Gto. "La Grande L G" and mentions of Leon, 0911, 3/23.
 692.3-COLOMBIA La Voz de Colombia, Bogota, HJIZ, announcing freq as / (Strentzsch) 690 khz. IDing at 0205 on 3/29 w/inst mx. (Objio)
 700 -CHINA/JAPAN JOFB/JOJKD and CC speaker alternating at 1305 on 3/30. (Wilkinson)
 -UNID TPS 2 or 3 stns fighting it out here 3/21 0552. One almost surely the JJ synchros and another probably the CC at Nanking. (Rittenhouse)
 712 -SOUTH KOREA Seoul in 3/21 1305 as well as I've ever heard them w/flutey oriental mx easily clear of 710 domestics. (Rittenhouse)
 720 -CHINA Very good 1320-1402 3/22 w/CC marches for the most part and YL w/CC ID 1330. At 1400 had 6 pips, 5 los and 1 high. The pips were short, sharp and spaced fairly widely, and the last was very high. Had female CC IDs after the hour w/apparent Peking mention. Pretty fair 3/21 1307 also w/marches. Have had slight traces several times, but it has never boomed in like this. KCBS, KNBR slop a bother but mostly loopable. (Rittenhouse)
 -CHINA/JAPAN Noted at 1332 on 3/30 w/gent in JJ (1 stn) and woman in CC (2nd stn). Both stns about equal at S5. (Finkle)
 725 -NORTH KOREA Kim-chaek listed, 3/31 w/Net 2 program //876 1108, 1155, 1203, up to S9 at times. (Seaver) * Extremely loud at 1307 on 3/30. (Wilkinson)*1332+ 1403 3/22 best ever w/KK OM very strong o/KCBS slop. (Rittenhouse)
 726 -UNID A carrier noted hetting the 725 KK 1041 3/24. Could be IA this early; only TP listed here is a 55 kw Thai on 725. (Rittenhouse)
 730 -COLOMBIA R. Melodia, Bogota w/a Cuban. ID at 0055 on 3/29. (Brodsky)
 735 -ECUADOR R. Melodia, Quito heard at 0213 on 3/23, IDing 2 mins fast. (Objio)
 -NORTH KOREA Pyong Kang listed, 3/31 w/Net 1 program 1107 //665, S8 at best. (Seaver) * First ever trac of this one noted 3/24 1040 w/fair carrier and weak KK talk. KCBS was off but CKLG/KNBR (!) slop was rough. (Rittenhouse)
 750 -JAPAN JOIB Sapporo w/EE lessons 3/31, Auld Lang Syne at 1057, ...- pips and tone at 1100. KKL ET at 1100 ruined the tape. JOIB steady S9. (Seaver) * Excellent 1140 3/24 w/theme mx and NHK ID by YL. About the best ever for this one. (Rittenhouse)
 -NICARAGUA YNK Managua 3/5 0552-0601 fair mixed w/WSB. LA mx including "La Bomba" at 0552. Several mentions of "La Equis". (Sorensen)
 758.5-CUBA CMCI R. Reloj Nacional poor to fair w/continuous rx under time ticks. Much WABC splash. (Brodsky)

760 -MEXICO XEABC Mexico, DF great w/"ABC Internacional" ID at 0325 on 3/22.
 770 -JAPAN JOUB Akita excellent thru KOB 1141 3/24 //750 w/theme / (Strentzsch) mx and NHK ID by YL in JJ. Very fine reception considering that KOB is always super strong here and JOUB was battling it to a virtual stalemate.
 774.7 -NORTH KOREA Hyesan listed, Net 2 program seemed //785 3/31 at / (Rittenhouse) 1119. Very weak, S6 best, w/KOB slop. (Seaver)
 775 -UNID TP Fair to good carrier and choral mx noted here 3/24 1243. Maybe Hyesan NK-773 drifting. Thai listed on 774 and I think a CC has been hrd on 775 in the past. KCRL slop was pretty rough at times. Nothing ever heard here before. (Rittenhouse)
 785 -NORTH KOREA R. Pyongrang carrying same program as 875 freq at 1126 on 3/31. 875 much louder. (Wilkinson) * Net 2 program //876 on 3/31 1111 w/singing, S6-7. (Seaver) * Pretty good 1245 3/24 a little better than the unid on 775 in KK talk. (Rittenhouse)
 790 -CUBA CMCH Havana, ID at 0100 as "Cadena Habana, R. Metropolitana". (Brodsky)
 800 -MEXICO XEROK Ciudad Juarez, Chih. 3/5 0535-0547 fair o/CHAB w/EE rock - ads for El Paso - promos as "X-Rock 80". (Sorensen)
 810 -UNID Man speaking RR and playing salon type mx from 1121-1123 GMT on 3/31 when KGO carrier came on and spoiled the whole thing. (Wilkinson)
 818 -UNID Fair carrier noted 3/24 0610 thru KGO/WBAP slop. Around 0620 I hrd what seemed to be chanting of some sort in odd language, but could have been power of suggestion as KGO slop forced me to tune very slightly and everything was pretty distorted. KGO went off around 0650 and carrier remained until 0720 fade, but WBAP was just too strong and I couldn't get anything more than very distorted tentative audio. Dakar-764 didn't seem to be in but there was a very slight trace of something on 1214 at 0535. The sig definitely looped NE and cx were ripe for TAs. Could some KCR enlighten me as to whether either Morocco or Andorra were in particularly well that night? (Rittenhouse)
 820 -NORTH KOREA Noted on 3/30 at 1340 in KK w/S6 sigs. //725, which was S7. (Finkle)
 -SOUTH KOREA HJCN Kwangju atop freq at good level w/mx pgn at 1118 on 3/31.
 -UNID TPs Here 3/22 1404-1415 and 3/23 1343. Seemed to be two / (Wilkinson) weak carriers quite close together w/weak audio occasionally filtering thru rough KGO slop. Looping NW and too late for IAs. NK and SK have been reported in the past. Anyone else ID anyone here? (Rittenhouse)
 830 -JAPAN JOBB Osaka, 3/31 1050, 1125 w/EE lessons at 1200 pips and tone, then NHK ID by YL and into news in JJ. (Seaver) * 3/23 1242 w/OM in JJ talk //770 etc. w/super sig. CCO just a whisper way under. These TPs sure mess up all the domestic DX, hi. (Rittenhouse)
 -THAILAND (?) Bangkok possibly the source of choral mx in odd language floating thru JOBB at 1341 3/23. Others have had tentatives on this and the 100 kw looks impressive also. Nothing else very likely anyway. (Rittenhouse)
 835 -CHINA Nanchang heard 1404 3/22 w/CC march mx and excellent strength. Also id well 3/21, 23 and 24. (Rittenhouse)
 840 -JAPAN JOJK Niigata good w/OM //890 1339 3/23 just a little o/the RR HS also here. (Rittenhouse)
 -HAITI AVEF Cap Haitien on 3/20 w/ID in FF at 1930. Was ~~sig~~ unid of last time. Lone Ranger theme used as IS. Talk on S. Vietnam in FF. Also another FF under, possibly Castries and domestic WHAS also. (Brodsky)
 -USSR Noted w/Majak programming at 1300 on 3/31 w/IS, time pips, Moscow time and RR programming. (Finkle) * In nicely w/RR opera 1339 3/23 w/JOJK. Never really noted these 2 so clearly at the same time. (Rittenhouse)
 847 -UNID TP Fair carrier here 1337 3/22. CC and RR listed for 845; maybe drifting. KGO/BOA too rough to get any audio. (Rittenhouse) / (Rittenhouse)
 854 -USSR Amga probably the one w/fair carrier and poor audio 1047-1049 3/24. Could be IA, but cx definitely favored TPs that nite and IAs were not too good.
 860 -MEXICO XEMO Tijuana, BC noted in passing w/EE religion and good signal 3/5 at 0547. (Sorensen)
 -MEXICO XEUN (tentative) 3/31 0635 tune in w/inst mx a la XETRA/CMBC/WBPM. No ~~sig~~ so not XEMO, ZYD68 eliminated due to no cx that way but very strong cx towards WC/IE w/XETRA, KFI, XEW all in. Still in at 0808. Doesn't correspond to XEUN sked but possible change. Anyone else hear it? (Shaftan)
 -PANAMA R. Reforma, Chitre, heard very strong at 0100 w/ID. I don't think they operate w/1 kw, too strong on portable Sony. 3/23. (Objio)
 865 -UNID IA Something has been tormenting me here all year. On geomagnetically quite nites I have heard an IA carrier here from about 0500 on. (Cont.)

865 -UNID IA (Cont) I've only noted it as late as 0900, but really haven't looked for it any later. XEMG, which puts in a local type sig here, has precluded any ID. Has anyone out of the range of QRM IDed anything here? (Rittenhouse)
- 870 -JAPAN JOGB Numamoto fair 3/23 1336 //JOBG, JOUB u/KIEV. (Rittenhouse)
- 872 -NORTH KOREA Wonsan drifting down to here w/usual emotional OM 1338-1340 3/22. This stn was noted simultaneously w/one on 887, so apparently this and 887 are separate entities. (Rittenhouse)
- 876 -NORTH KOREA Wonsan Net 2 pgm 3/31 1000 ...- pips 1108 //725, 1111 //785. S8 at best. This is usually the first Korean to show due to its higher freq. Typical program is YL diatribes, martial mx, revolutionary songs, etc. Approximate freq is 876 now. (Seaver) (Rittenhouse)
- 880 -CHINA Fukien Prov. fair 1337 3/23 w/YL yap, then typical yowling CC song.
- 887 -JAPAN JOPK Shizuoka at good volume at 1309 on 3/30. (Wilkinson)
- 887 -THAILAND (?) Finally pulled something out here w/the 872-877 KK pegged. Had fair to poor carrier and very weak audio 1339 3/22. This is the only thing listed. (Rittenhouse)
- 890 -ALASKA AFRN Adak fairly regular for the past 6 weeks w/WLS nulled. In already at 0622 3/24 w/rock mx, IDs 0630 and 0632. This one is easy to spot, they are about 90 hz below WLS. (Lehr)
- CHINA/SOUTH KOREA Noted on 3/30 both w/S5 sigs at 1352 w/woman speaking in KK and another woman speaking in CC. There was another w/a gent in Asian lingo, too weak to identify, but probably the JO. Noted again the next day at 1249 w/CC stn dominating the freq. (Finkle)
- JAPAN JOHK Sendai good 1338 3/23 //JOQK w/OM in JJ o/Pusan. (Rittenhouse)
- SOUTH KOREA HLKB Pusan in at room volume w/lively play at 1312 on 3/30. (Wilkinson) * Putting in a good sig 1338 3/23 YL in easily recognizable KK strong u/JOHK. Never hrd these 2 so clearly at the same time. (Rittenhouse)
- UNID Possibly HJCE hrd the La Voz de ?? clear but not enough, was rock in SS.
- 905 -EL SALVADOR Radiopolis, San Salvador, good and clear ID w/pop (Strentzsch) mx at 0306 on 3/28. Hrd for the first time. (Objio)
- 910 -CUBA Camaguey, C. Agramonte here from 1030 khz, apparently permanently. Fair sig all day long. (Schatz)
- 975 -CHINA Harbin w/fair carrier and martial mx 1342 3/22. Only the 2nd time this year for this one. KABK/KKIS/KFWS slop bad, but not unbearable. (Rittenhouse)
- 978 -UNID TP Nothing listed, but definite TP carrier detected 1342 3/22. Maybe a CC from 980 or something. Anyone else hear anything here? (Rittenhouse)
- 980 -CUBA Guantanamo, R. Revolution here from 950 khz w/increased power. Noted // 840, 850, 770, etc. while in Elias Pina, R.D., eve of 3/22. (Schatz)
- 990 -UNID Possibly XET w/MoR inst and SS o/u WNOX 4/7 0815. Very strong o/S9 and cx seemed somewhat WC (KFBK, XERH, XEW) however no other WCs were in, not even KSL/KKAA! (Shaftan)
- 995 -UNID TP Carrier w/weak audio here 1343 3/22. WRTH lists a clandestine stn broadcasting to China here, but it doesn't seem like a pattern to China could make it over here unless I'm getting it off the back of the beam or something. Unid has been reported here by others this year. (Rittenhouse)
- 1005A -COLOMBIA (?) HJDP possible. 1000 was knocked out, this came in w/YL singing, piano in back, 0242, 3/27, no good IDs. S4. (Strentzsch)
- 1010 -JAPAN JONR Osaka, very good at 1034 on 3/31. (Wilkinson)
- 1015 -EL SALVADOR San Salvador noted 1146-1150 3/24 w/SS mx and R. Internacional ID at 1148. (Rittenhouse)

CLANDESTINE (?) An AP story about the Falkland Islands in the 3/9 Denver Post mentions, "Argentina ... beams bilingual radio broadcasts to Stanley." No stations appearing in the W2TVH 75 have an overtly Malvinian Clandestine name, and no such programs are listed. There are several MW stns not far from the Falklands near the southern tip of Argentina; or it may be a SW service. In any event, it may be worthwhile to tune around for such a stn the next time 536 is booming in ... (Hauser)

SOUTH AFRICA A letter from Gerry Wood, Radio RSA IX Editor, dated 3/10 says: "There have been more MW changes in SA. Due to public protest the SABC reinstated the EE and Afrikaans Services in Cape Town, Johannesburg (Maraisburg) and Fort Elisabeth. Springbok did not come back on MW and the All Night Service of Radio South Africa is broadcast on all MW channels including those used for IM Radio relay. That is the situation to date. The SABC still intends to close MW radio but when that will be now no one knows. IM Radio will continue on MW. It is rumored that IM Radio SW will cease when Mozambique gains independence in June and that IM Radio will be renamed Happy Day Radio in South Africa." And in a recent broadcast Gerry mentioned that American MW stns are sometimes heard in the pre-dawn hours in SA. (Hauser)

SWITZERLAND Per verie, the new xtr on 1562 kHz is located in Sarnen, central Switzerland, w/power of 300 kw, vice 500 kw as previously reported. This xtr will, or probably already has, replace the 150 kw one at Beromunster. (Barns)

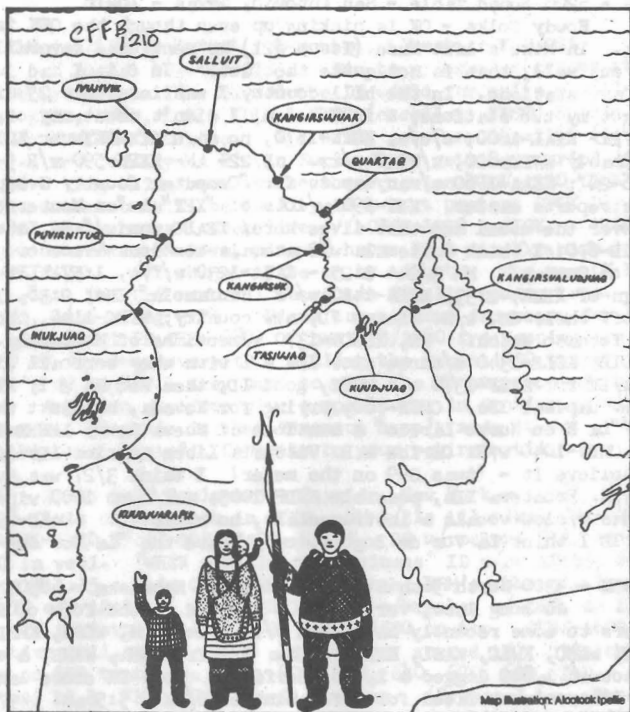

FCC Probing Radio Station For Rebroadcast of Old News

The Federal Communications Commission has begun an investigation of the rebroadcast of an eight-month-old newscast by radio station WKND of Windsor, the station manager said Friday.

Kenneth Dawson, manager of the station which bills itself "Truth and Soul Radio," blamed accounts of the incident by "white-owned news media" for provoking the investigation.

The Tuesday rebroadcast drew fire from Hartford Police Chief Hugo J. Masini be-

cause it included an account of the July shooting of two city patrolmen on a downtown street.

Dawson said the headline on a Courant story, and the text of a United Press International dispatch, erroneously called the rebroadcast an April Fool's Day joke.

Though the broadcast was aired on April 1, Dawson said it wasn't meant as a joke. He said the station intended it to "test listener apathy and the public's knowledge of current events" and told listen-

ers the newscast was old a few moments after it was aired.

Dawson said that advertisers believing the incident was an April Fool's gag have been cancelling contracts with the station.

Further, he said, a lawyer representing the two patrolmen, both now recovered from their injuries, has threatened to sue the station for the "mental anguish" he claims the rebroadcast caused the officers and their families.
