Sometimes this brings me into the seascrlike depression in which I find myself. NCR reprints and receiver modification data may help me break out. (SERV - National Cash Register?? -ERC). INTRODUCING - the GE 3-5280J

GENE MARTIN - 3303 East Evans Avenue - Denver, CO - 80210
There was a Woolco ad in Sunday's paper Nov. 29. for the GE AM-FM combination cassette player model 3-5280 for \$99. This was the first ad I had seen for what was rumored to be the GE Superadio combined with a cassette player. On Dec. 1, I made my way to the store to check it out, reading the manufacturer's specifications, etc. So I bought it, having little sales resistance for a product which held the promise of being what many DXers are looking for when they go travelling. Besides I figured on returning it in case it didn't live up to my expectations. My verdict: I am quite pleased. Possibly the AM side is even a better DXing tool than the Superadio; in any event it is every bit as good. The 3-5280 is larger and heavier than the Superadio. It is 15 1/2" long, 4 1/2" wide, & stands 9 1/2" tall before the handle is pulled up. The GE Superadio is about the same height but is only 12" long & 3 1/2" from back to front. Performance: The most distant daytime regular here is KWMT on 540, and there are times when CBK is heard daytimes on the same frequency. The 3-5280 pulls in KWMT on its ferrite rod as well as my EQ-180 on its loop antenna, and I am sure the Canadian can be delivered too when Horthorn DX are good in the daytime. The 3-5280 has several novel features, front and back sides, and I'm not sure I understand them all completely. I will let others fill in all the graphic details. Of course, the 3-5280 will go to Hawaii with me at Christmastime. Meanwhile, perhaps this is the first DXer's report on the quality of this new took for the radio nut who travels. My preliminary examination of it makes me think it's the best set-up yet for use away from your home base.
