Community Broadcasters Wins New Miami AM

After considering new evidence, the FCC Review Board has granted Community Broadcasters the right to build an AM station in Miami to replace United's defunct WFAB. The original winner to the four-way contest, New Radio America Broadcasting, later withdrew after charges were leveled that it made misrepresentations to the FCC. Community won out over Dadeland

Broadcasting and New Continental Broadcasting because it has the highest percentage of minority and female ownership that will be involved in fulltime management of the new station. The Review Board said runner-up New Continental failed to prove its charge that Community violated FCC rules by not reporting that the owner's husband had become a part-owner and manager of WOCN/MIAMI.

U.S.-Canadian AM Pact Gets FCC Okay

A new AM broadcasting agreement between the United States and Canada has won the FCC's approval. But it won't take effect until Canada signs off, which U.S. officials hope will happen by the end of November. Until Canada gives formal approval, day-timers won't be able to use their new extended hours, which are one feature of the agreement. Other terms of the pact include nighttime power of 1000 watts for Class 4 AMs, new fulltime stations on Class A AMs, clear channels within 60 miles of the border, and full, wide-area protection for 16 Alaskan stations. The FCC says it won't accept any applications relating to the Class 4 and clear channel provisions until it has a chance to revise its own rules.

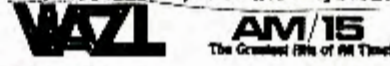

Chrysler Signs Motorola For Radio Chip, Circuitry

SCHELMBERG, Ill. - Motorola, Inc.'s C-QUAM AM Stereo broadcasting chip and circuitry will be used next year in the radios Chrysler Corp. builds at its Huntsville, Ala., electronics plant and installs in its cars and tractors, Motorola said.

Motorola indicated that Chrysler decided on its C-QUAM chip and circuitry after extensive testing. A Chrysler spokesman would not specify which other units were tested.

Motorola's Frank Hubert, manager of the AM Stereo program, claimed momentum for the C-QUAM system is "on a roll" and Motorola expects to produce about two million C-QUAM systems in 1984 for Chrysler and other users.

Neither company would disclose the value of the agreement.

I took my Superadio and Zenith R-70 rx and a 12' wire. On November 11 at 11:11 I logged WHKP-1450 Hendersonville, NC in the car, while my wife Mary was driving. Also on the 11th, 15:18 WITA-1490 Knoxville, TN; 15:15 WSKT-1580 Knoxville, TN; 16:15 WRDP-980 Pensacola, FL; 16:41 WPLO-870 Farmville, VA; 17:20 WGBS-710 Miami, FL. I'm sure that the Wiz and the publications center are both busy answering all the queries resulting from this broadcast. // A belated note on the Convention: was really great to meet some real fine folks down in Enfield. Only sorry that my personal commitments only allowed me to stay the one night. Hats off to the organizers for doing a fine job. // Special thanks to George Hakiel who introduced me to the Martens Loop. Mine arrived a couple of days ago. No chance yet to fire it up, but looks like a winner. Will be moving the Kenwood R-2000 upstairs to take advantage of the loop. Special arrangements have been made with the wife to allow the use upstairs as long as I bring everything back down here to the "cave" when done DX'ing for the night. // Was pleasantly surprised to catch St. Kitts-555 here recently, especially with WSGO-550 and WBYN-560 only about 40 miles away. This with the longwire. The 2.9 kHz filter on the R-2000 really seems to do the job. // The GMT vs. LT wall-taken, but it seems to me that the Brits still use the "pounds/ounce" system and have not yet gone over to the metric system for measurements. Correct me if I'm wrong. Also, the two wars mentioned were 180+ years ago. I feel that LT should be used for domestic reports and GMT (UTC) used for foreign DX catches. (Speaking of the Martens loop ... I have found that it nulls well and is especially useful on freqs. where strong locals are adjacent. However, it is ticklish to use ... definitely a "two-hander", as tweaking the regen control requires re-setting the fine tuning. I hope to do a more complete report on it in the near future. As for LT vs. ELT and UTC ... let's keep the comments coming, WITH your Muses -pls)

A Report on the WECO DX Test

Tom Connatser - Route 9, Box 78 - Sevierville, TN 37862 (pm 11-16; rec'd and pm'd in Van Nuys 11-18 and 11-19; rec'd 11-21. Hmmm...) Hello again from the Smokies. Time for a report on the WECO-940 CPC test of 10-31. So far, the station has gotten about 38 reports basically from up the East Coast. The greatest number of reports (4) have come, believe it or not, from Ontario, Canada. We also got reports from PA (4), MO (3), MA, MD, NY, and NC (2 each), and one each from OH, MN, ND, IL, NH, CT, VA, CO, WI, DE, DC, and TN. Most of the reports were quite good, I'm happy to report. Most listeners reported good reception during at least a part of the test. Primary sources of interference were cited as XEG-Mexico by nearly half the respondents. CBM-Canada was also listed as a problem by many in the early part of the test before their 1:15 s/off. Other sources of interference were R. Relej-Cuba, K10A-IA, WMIX-IL, WINZ-FL, and KIXZ-TX. All in all, I'd rate it as a good test, and we at WECO were happy to do it. (And thanks to you for doing it for the hobby! -pls) Now a couple of personal observations: the signal here wasn't as good as I expected; I've actually heard the station better in daytime. CBM wasn't that much of a problem; they were audible, but WECO easily over-rode them. The real headache here was WMIX-IL. He was the dominant station on the channel when I tuned in a few minutes before scheduled test time. While WECO never faded to inaudibility during the test, there were at least 4 times during the test when WMIX was even with WECO. If song titles were verifiable items on reception reports, I'd also send a report to WMIX for the period! Really makes you wonder

how well we'd get out post-sunset when and if the FCC approves it. With WCPG running 50 kw, I doubt that even I could've heard the station. Noticed an ad in Broadcast Equipment Exchange: For sale, RCA 50 kw XR, contact XERF; looks like they're planning on going fulltime with the 250-kw rig from now on. That ought to make a lot of noise on 1570! (They have been rather weak up through 11-23 here -pls) Steve Francis' comments in No. 6 concerning WDGR-1210-GA were very interesting; will be interesting to see what the FCC does about this one. I think ALL DXN columns should use ELT as a standard, except IDXD and references to international broadcasting where GMT should be used. I am very much opposed to using local time in Musings; if it isn't stated, we have to look it up each time we read someone's Muse. '73's for now.

Donald S. Voorhies - Rd. 3, Box 97 - Oswego, NY 13126 (pm 11-18; rec'd 11-21) In a previous Muse, I reminisced about the Good Old Days of DX'ing in the 1930's. One thing I forgot - does anyone remember listening to the Newark News Radio Club Saturday afternoon broadcasts on 948-WA5T, a 500-watt Jersey City daytime, listing the upcoming DX programs? Since retiring 3 years ago, I decided to take DX'ing up again to help pass the snowy days we often get here in New York's snowbelt. I purchased a Realistic DX-300 and put up 2 1/2's, 65' and 175'. Up to now I have logged 922 stations, including a number in the W. I. C. A., and S. A. Reception this fall has been very good certain nights. On 9-28 1200-KFNM ND came in loud and clear. And on 9-29 got 1070-WKDR NY at signoff, 1048-WSKR PA, 1150-WAYW WI, and finally scate 443 as 1140-KSOO SD was briefly on top of WRVA at 20:30. 10-20 was another good night as 1000-WKYB SC broke through at 18:38 with wx and temp. (72 degrees). Later at 21:38 1548-ZNS-1 Radio Bahamas was W/PTR/KXEL. 23:00 brought 555-Z13 St. Kitts signing off. From 23:10-23:30 Radio Capital, Venezuela was on top of 710 - no sign of WOR. Also that nite I had a basketball game on 1830 W/WBZ at 20:40 but could not get an ID. I got a pleasant surprise on 11-10 when I caught 1110-WTBO Warwick, NY signing on at 06:47. On 11-14 1060-WHPB MI signed off at 17:30 using those call letters. Yesterday (11-17) freqk wx conditions brought in at 1300 hours 1580-WLM NY, 1580-WPIP CT, and 1510-WBAN NJ. All for now.

Karl V. Jeter - 2115 Scarbrough Rd. - Stone Mountain, GA 30086 (pm 11-22; rec'd 11-25) DX continues to roll in respectably; however, veries are not doing quite as well. The returns are disappointing once again, with only 5 returns in 14 tries since resuming reporting in early Oct. Latest are WDIA-1870 w/v/f and both WMK-560 and KANI-1500 w/v/l's. I guess I shouldn't complain, as from Jan. to April this year I had an 89% return rate (17 for 19). The only thing is that getting that kind of return required pulling tooth and nail. It seems definitely to be getting harder to obtain veries - though not impossible with patience and perseverance! I phoned WXOK-970 recently to inquire about a verie and got an exasperated GM telling me he had a small station with a small staff and he wasn't about to pull one of them off their duties to answer reports. I can certainly understand this and his plight, so I sympathized with him and offered to send a pp/c/ which he agreed to sign and return - and he did. Looks like in dealing with such stations the pp/c is becoming more and more a necessity. (I bet the personal touch, as with your phone call, would make a big difference, too -pls) Well, on to something more exciting (for me, anyway, hi) - recent DX. My west beverage continues to work charms: 11-28 a pair of 1140 newbies KSKS-Conroe, TX in briefly with ID and what sounded through the moss like a rigs pgm and 6:24 ELT solo by KATT-Oklahoma City with s/off 6:30 no 555. Same eve, on 1150, hrd someone with call like "KBOX" with mentions of Jacksonville and Little Rock with CHR, female DJ, and slogan "The new KBOX?" Assume this to be the North Little Rock AR station, ex-KXLR with new calls? In between, 5:55-6 pm, WSAO-1140 with strange combination of "King Biscuit Hour" r/r show and a rigs pgm before s/off. Back to 11-19, unkn KVOI-1330 noted 6:06 pm with severe wx annot and the slogan "The station you grow up with" (and apparently have forgotten, hi). However, the catch of the season so far has to be back on the eve of 11-9, when KUKQ-1060 Tempe-Phoenix hrd w/urban contemp. mx, promo for the "Rick James Contest" and ID's as "1060-KQ" for AZ #2 from here. A few local notes: WDGR-1210 apparently signs off Sun. eves at normal SSS time, noted 5:30 pm at full pwr. ends with slow choral "Dixie". The call switch in Gainesville, GA is in effect; it seems as WDMN-550 (ex-WGGA) noted with c/w 11-13. Haven't checked 1248 to see if reverse is true! '73's.

Greg Ledbetter - Box 953 - Purvis, MS 39475 (pm 11-22; rec'd 11-25) Greetings, DX'ers! I am about to overflow here because of a verie arriving 11-18. I got some info on the WSGO/WQUC changeover, sent it in, and when I had just about given up, "13-Q" verified my report. I reported it briefly in DDXD, but a close-up of the last six minutes had the Sons of the Pioneers doing "Tumbling Tumbleweeds", the announcer came back on, ID'ing himself, bidding us all farewell, and to remember one-four-three (What the heck is a 1-4-377) (Either a locomotive or a subversive numbers message, hi -pls) There were four toms, a time check, four seconds of silence, then, "WSGO, New Orleans is the new 13-Q, then "Cum On Feel the Noise" (yes, it's spelled right, hi). In my request I also mentioned other stations received on the channel, others received in the area, and remarking that I was a frequent listener to their FM station. THE STATE OF MONTANA REPORTS...

BGB REPORT BY K.E. POUNDER OF FT. BENTON, MONTANA (RADIO NEWS 1934)

I have read your publication for many years (RADIO NEWS), but haven't seen Montana mentioned very often. So, am going to give the boys something to shoot at.

I have a 1930 seven-tube Victor Model R-15 and an ariel 170 feet long and 60 feet high. My ground is a size 0 copper wire stuck into the ground about 4 feet.

The following stations were received between November 1 and today, February 3, 1934. Every station in the U.S., Canada and Mexico over 100 watts, 80 of 1000 watts, 41 of 500 watts and 73 more down to 30 watts. WMMN, WDMT, WTAX, HWAE, WBL, XEA, XEL, XETA, XEC, XFC and XEY (a ten watt) are some of the small ones. Daytime reception: WCCO, KFI, KSL, KYW, WENR, KVOD, XGA, and several others almost every day. Have received WJZ and WABC from 3:00 pm on local time.

Foreign reception is good from 2:30 to 5:00 am local time. Some examples include: LR4, HIJK, KGU, RW35, 2YA-3YA, 2CO, 2GB, 2BL, 2FC, 3LO, 3AR, 4RK, 4DG, 5CK, 7ZL, JFAK, JFBK, JDAK1, JDAK2, JDDK, JDDK1, JDDK2, JDDK1, JDDK2, JOEK, JOFK, JOHK, JOIK, JOJK, JOKK, JOOK, JOPK, JOGK, JDSK, JOVK, JOAK, XGDA, XGDD, KGBU, and KZRM.

Would like to inform you that the new Crosley transmitter, WBXD, roars in here, louder than any other station except XER. WBXD is also right on his frequency and does not blanket either 690 or 710 kc.

Am going to put new tubes in my receiver some day and get a little DX out of it.

Japan, Australia, New Zealand, Argentina, Dominican Republic, China, Alaska, Hawaii, Russia and the Philippines are certainly nice catches even by today's standards.
