Since we have some extra room this week due to a very short supply of information we will review several recent FCC actions that have a bearing on our field of interest.

On January 17, 1984 the bi-lateral agreement between Canada and the United States was formally signed. This agreement made possible the PSSA operations of many daytime stations and will also open up further applications for new stations on the 1-A clear frequencies. However both countries need time to make further adjustments on some allocations. Accordingly the freeze on new applications for "new unlimited-time stations on the 1-A frequencies announced 11/18/83 will remain in effect for another six months" in the words of the FCC. The commission release defines the 1-A channels as: 640, 650, 660, 670, 700, 720, 760, 770, 780, 820, 830, 840, 880, 890, 1020, 1030, 1040, 1100, 1120, 1160, 1180, 1200 and 1210. Note that despite the breakdown of the "clear" channels, the FCC designation of these frequencies remains "1-A."

The FCC has issued a notice of proposed rulemaking on compensating U.S. broadcasters for expenses they incur in mitigating effects of Cuban interference to their service area. Areas to be defined and explored in the rulemaking include: defining interference, establishing level of interference that will constitute precondition for compensation, determining the qualifying interference periods and specifying the types of expenses that are compensable.

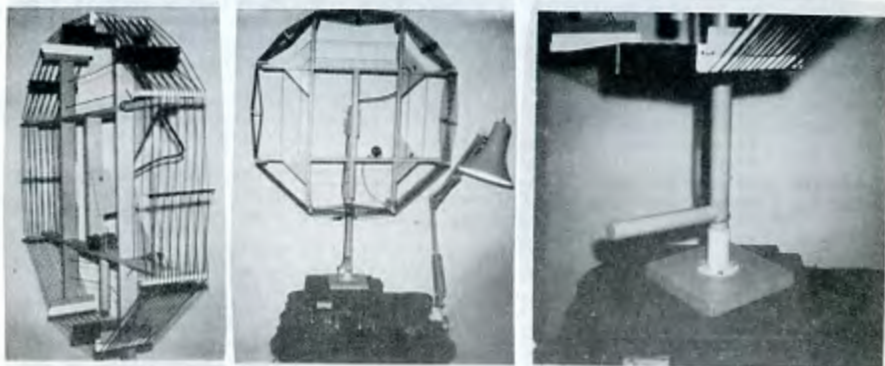

Ernest Cooper - 5 Anthony Street - Provincetown, MA 02657 (pm 1-24; rec'd 1-27; two Muses combined) (617) 487-9337 Remember, no early-morning phone calls after Feb. 27, when I go into Mass. General Hospital for my double bypass operation. Thanks to Mike Knitter who sent me the list of new members over the past two months. All you have to do to get this info is to write him and request it, he says. If there are any new members in my area, please communicate with me. Here's the DX of the week, written while it was still fresh: Tues. 1-10: 900 was an interesting frequency, but I didn't fathom out anything new from among the many signals between 1 and 3 am like Barbados (giving AST timechecks), in/out with an SS, an FF, an EE, and a TT of unknown origin! It'll take a few tries to figure out who all these are. Wed. 1-11: Back on 980; at 1 am an EE announced, "It is now 2 o'clock", but the ID was missed, if given. That eve, CBGY-750 was in with a CBC news broadcast similar to "All Things Considered", way o/WSB; WHEB was already off; 5:49-6:11 pm when WSB took over. Friday the 13th (Jan.): UNID TT on 1410, 12:57 and gone by 12:59. WPTR-1540 was on OC this morning, KXEL under it, no splatter onto 1550 therefore, but nothing there but the usual two SS's. SM 1-15: WBGW-1580 test showed up after WLIM-NY finished testing at 1:08 and CHJ ended "O Canada" at 1:09, and then went into its eternal, infernal all-night TT, but WBGW peaked out from under it. The P. O. Box number was also wrong on Page 1 of DX News (should have been 194), and two of us, at least, got the wrong number when calling the station; those tiny 8's and 0's look alike under a small desk light - in fact, out in the open, too! Why that silly slash through a zero - can't a person tell which it's supposed to be without it? (Welcome to the computer age, hi! -pls) MM 1-16: TT'er on 1290 12:46-12:49 gone, then unn WGLI popped up top. Unn WNYR-990 very loud, c&w mx, all AM. Unn CKCY-920 saying it was being relayed by CJWA-1240, Wawa. To John Buehler of Toled, indeed WMER-1440, Westbrook/Portland, ME, is now fulltime - NSP, in fact, and all-news/talk. Alphonse Tobia, your TT on 660 is undoubtedly the new CFFR, Calgary, now on RS. No, I haven't heard him here, hi, only read about him in IRCA. Ken Onyschuk, who is WBCE-1570, your all-jazz pest? I don't find a listing of this one in the NRC Log. Did I miss a call change? Neal Perdue, on phases of the moon affecting BCB DX, it was the late Dick Cooper's belief that the best conditions prevailed when the moon was full (and the DX'er, also, hi.). Another unproductive week here. I find when conditions are very good, DX is more difficult - there are just too many signals on every frequency for anything to be logged! Give me the weirder reception of a good Aurora any day! WNYR-990, after not being heard for a few weeks here, is now booming in every morning; they must be on their new higher power, right, Jerry Bond? Back to MM 1-16: UNID TT on 810 at 1:56 am; this might have been only WGY, but it wasn't very loud. WBAL-1090 has closed up its silent period now and carries an all-nx format on MM's, presumably trying for WTOP-1500's audience, which station is still off Mondays. Off today were WHUE-1150 (but TT'ing much of the AM), WBSM-1420, WKBW-1520, CKLM-1570. On this latter spot, I had XERP with Guatemalan-style marimba mx at 2:30 am, plus CHLO "playing more of your favorite music". Somebody TT'ing on 1550 2:55-3:03, rather weak. Tues. 1-17: EZL-style mx on 1610a at 1:30, UNID'ed, very weak. On 1380, amidst others, an PFC with rock mx noted at 1:53, but gone by 2. Thur. 1-19: I heard Larry King's guest say KOFY will carry San Francisco Giants' games in SS this season, but they're only a San Mateo daytimer on 1050. Semi-local WSAR was on with mx this AM at 2 am; and there seemed to be two SS'es on 900. Sat. 1-21: A phony on 1615a today at 1:09 playing "good Night, Irene" and then off. No WSAR-1480 today; musta been a test on 1-19. And someone u/WJJD faded up over him at 2:40 am, and it turned out to be KSL. I had hopes for WKCM! SM 1-22: At 2:30 I found 880 completely clear - no WCBG, no Cuban, and none of the new WC fulltimers either - nothing! Forward - March!

(808) 965-9885 NOT collect A belated "Seasons Greetings". It didn't look at Christmas here at all - even Mauna Kea didn't have any snow until just after New Year's. 1983 was the driest year on record for the Big Island; normal is around 115 inches, and we only got 65 all year. Since 1 Jan, however, we've had quite a bit more; naturally, I decided to do some antenna work just when it changed. Built a 40-foot wooden mast out of 2x3's to hold my wire antennas - it's half-way erected and will probably sit there until the rain stops (that may take a while, too). Have two dipoles hanging on it, for 41 and 90 meters, each with separate openline download for broad-banded response. The

90m wire works as a 20-foot vertical with a 150-foot top-hat for BCB DX, and seems to work quite well. Reports out to KDAC-1230, KRE-1400, KRED-1480, 200-1575, KUBA-1600, and the Caribbean Beacon-1610 (good catch, John -pls). KRE used my stamp and label to send me two KBLX stickers, but no verie, so I'm not closing the log on it yet. A recent morning scan revealed KXL-750 way o/KFOD (must be full power now) and KDLG-670 l&c w/NPR. Also heard KVI-570, Bankok-891, and my old buddy Gene Nelson on KSFO-560 (first time for them here) - it's been too long since I heard his voice. Have also hrd and reported to Top End several beacons and two CH language stns, on 1690 and 1700 kHz, apparently from different sites, as propagation is different. Any ideas? Anyone coming to Hawaii should plan to call and/or visit; NRC'ers are especially welcome. 73, jta.

PLT. Mon. 12-12 was the final night on the AM band for long-time San Francisco rocker, KYA-1260. KYA owner King Broadcasting bought KSFO-560, and in turn sold KYA to Bonneville Broadcasting of beautiful mx fame owner of KOIT-FM 96.5. KYA-AM became KOIT-1260. KYA wanted to keep the historic KSFO callsign on 560. Some people lament the "melting down" of a three-letter callsign, yet King Broadcasting wisely decided to keep the KYA callsign alive by moving it to the FM band. KYA-FM, which has been KLHT-93.3 for the past few years, is once again KYA-FM and has KYA's recent rock oldies format. For those who don't know, 1950's and 1960's rock oldies constitute my favorite radio format, and Nancy's, too. KOIT-1260 is BPL mx NSP, dropping the MM midnight-5 am SP KYA has had in recent years. One lost, one gained, as KSFO-560 now has an MM SP those hours. Most recently KSFO was big bands, and while local QRM keeps me from hearing KSFO well enough to define their revised format, they seem to be keeping a lot of the Sinatra mx while including more current artists and even some jazz. But it's definitely not a rock-based format like the old KYA. In fact, Rich Segalas told me it's a lot like the old KSFO when it was a personality-MOR station, and several former KSFO jocks are back! KYA-1260 had a fascinating final hour, including playing every KYA jingle they'd ever used, for posterity! Right at midnight, during the switchover, an engineer let a KSFO ID slip through on 1260 before pulling the plug! That means KYA, KSFO, and KOIT ID's went out over 1260 in less than 25 minutes. Since KSFO is not an approved callsign on 1260 I'm not counting it as an official logging (maybe there are those who would!) (Good grief! -pls) but the nice KOIT-1260 ID at 12:17 am 12-13 is station #826 here. For the third straight month, Nancy and I spent the third Sunday night and Monday morning at Ocean City State Park, about 14 miles west of here. Sunday morning 12-18 we woke up with 1/4 inch of snow on the ground in Aberdeen. Weather fronts and cold weather always affect DX'ing here, so we expected interesting conditions, and we were right! If you're asking why two people would head out in a soft-sided tent trailer in December, well, first, we love camping, second, we love DX'ing, and this is a great location, and third DX'ers aren't normal, are we?? Finally s/off 6:04 pm (7:04 pm Navolato time); this must be the Mexican equivalent of post-sunset authority. 6:29 pm sporting event on 850 which I expected to be KOA, but the ID was for "KGOE, Radio 85." Turns out the sporting event was L. A. Kings hockey! KTAC nulled, which also nulled KOA which was running Denver basketball. 7 pm KPAK-1230 Redding, CA, ex-KRGG, weak but definite legal ID over c&w song amid the mess. 8 pm clear ID from KSMA-1240 Santa Maria, CA during break in L. A. Lakers phone-in talk show, so the sports network lists do help. Also mentioned Music of Your Life. Atop KNRY briefly. 11:04 pm KNUI-900 good ending KNUI mx, CJVI nulled, XEW partly nulled, first logging since move from 1310. Tried for KBYE-890 test but not heard, just a het possibly from Fiji? Now new logging MM 12-19 was the tentative on WMOB-1360 mentioned a few weeks back. It rained on our campsite, but five miles east it had snowed! 73 and good DX.

Hello; I'm not a new Muser but am getting back into the fold. I first joined the NRC back in 1964 and was a member of the NRC for 8 years. I lost interest in DX because of time, getting married, building a house, and starting a family. I caught the DX bug again in 1981 and it seems I rejoined the NRC just in time. Got my first issue back in September (v. 50/30) to find Ron Schatz's excellent Cuban listing and the new CP's for the FCC deregulation of clear channel stations.
