## DX Time Machine From the Pages of DX News

50 years ago ... from the March 8, 1941 DXN; WBRW-1310, Welch, WV conducted a test Feb. 15, and the farthest listener was from Waterville, ME (approx 325 air miles). The listener won a six-month membership in the NRC. Next farthest listener was from Canton, MN at 700 air miles ... J. B. "Pat" Resilley, Jamestown, NY, recounted his DX experiences since Dec. 7, 1929, when he heard his first DX program from WNRC, Greensboro, NC.

25 years ago ... Frank Mersill recalled March 14, 1966, when a tremendous aurora affected DX ing conditions, with WMMB-1240 blanketing the eastern half of the U. S., and Cuban stations all over the dial.

840	WKTR	VA	cancellation of the CP or any move to sell it. Earlysville: new station is ON THE AIR with REL format, address given as Box 309, Quinque, VA 22965
910	WOMG	TN	Columbia: station is SILENT, plans to return in April following their move from Lawrenceburg, TN
1080	KRPX	UT	Price: silent station is back ON THE AIR
1090	WKII	FL	Port Charlotte: although they are licensed for fulltime operation (4800/2500 U2) they have never built their night directional antenna system and are presently operating D1 (daytime only)
1150	WMET	MD	Gaithersburg: station is now simulcasting WPGC-1580 under a one-year lease arrangement, they must carry WPGC programming at least from 1700 to 0500 and may carry WPGC up to 100 percent of the time if they wish. WMET gets to sell two local spots per hour during the simulcast, all this in part to bolster WPGC's rather enemic nighttime signal on 1580 kHz which, by the way, is now ON THE AIR.
1230	WIGS	NY	Gouveneur: station is SILENT, has released their entire staff. Indications are that WSLB-1400 is considering purchase of the station and will begin a simulcast operation in both Gouveneur and Ogdensburg.
1260	KICN	ID	Idaho Falls: silent as KTEE, is back ON THE AIR simulcasting KECN-690 (ex-KBL!) Blackfoot, ID
1290	WOOC	СТ	Hartford: station went SILENT in February, land where transmitter is located will become a housing development. The AM transmitter will eventually be moved to their FM site on Avon Mountain (also the site of WTIC's impressive two-tower system) and will then return to the air.
1400	KHCB	TX	Galveston: silent station is back ON THE AIR
1460	WPRW	VA	Manassas: station has been silent, then returned to the air for a few weeks, only to go SILENT again. Owner Bob McKee claims he is taking it off the air for "45 days and I'll be back with a new format."

American region. Diens in those regions could be thrown off by this stuff and think it's something considerably more exotic. [MC-MA]






