

broadcast from a tiny structure at its transmitter site, in a field off Bloomfield Avenue, in the northern part of Windsor. The original format was mix of country and western music and ethnic (primarily Polish) programming. Bloomfield Avenue, originally signed on the air as WSOR, from a small studio bu-eld Avenue, in 1961. The 500 watt daytime directional station from a small studio building

The tiny station was sold in 1964 and the new owners changed the call to WEHW - for Rast Hartford - Mindsor. The country / ethnic format stayed, but again failed to build an audiance or attract sponsors. The station was again sold in 1969, to a group headed by Kenneth Dawson. The call sign was changed to MKND for its new owner, and he replaced the faltering country music format with rhythm and blues, which quickly appealed to the region's previously untapped black community. In the early 1970's, the present studios and offices were built in rooms in the rear of the Windsor Shopping Center, and WKND added a full time news department.

Through its almost quarter century as a Black - oriented station, WKND has offered a variety of urban contemporary, rhythm and blues, gospel, jazz, reggae, and rap music. In 1990, as the station's marketing atrategy targets 25-54 year olds, the rap was dropped. The station presently airs news from the Sheridan - Urban America network. Additionally, realizing that WKND's audience wants more than music, General Manager Marion Anderson has added many programs on community issues, local news and topics of concern to the area's Black community. "Urban Agenda" is aired on Saturdays, and is hosted by the local League Director

WKND's information commitment includes morning announcer Eddie Jordan's show with traffic, and sports. Power 1480's news staff includes News Director Lloyd Wimbish, and four full and part time news reporters, who aggressively cover events of interest to throughout Hartford and the surrounding area.

WKND carries many remote broadcasts, and offers a "power Card" promotion. Holders of WKND "Power Cards" can receive discounts from area merchants.



In her role as traffic department secretary, she organized a fairly loosely run section, and progressed through increasing responsibilities in sales, production, and public marvice. In 1989, she was promoted to General Manager, and developed WKND's full service approach for its audience. She manages a staff of 23 full time employees.

WKND's transmitter is still at the original site, off a dirt road south of Bloomfield Avenue. The original building houses the transmitter, a control booth, and espace for the attendant. The 500 watt daytime signal, with no presunrise or post sunset authorizations, originating from two very short towers, 33 town area, populated by over 630,000 people.


