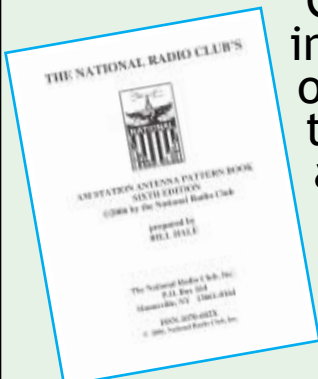

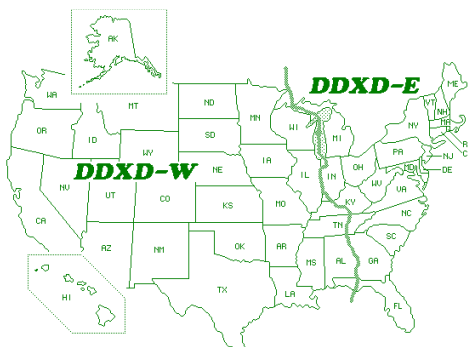

## DDXD-West

FROM THE VAST WESTLAND

- ▲ There is sad news to report on the Super Bowl front this week, and not just because your editor's beloved Packers were eliminated from their quest for it. Long-time readers of this column will recall how for the past few years we have detailed the futility of **Vast Westland** teams to win championships in two sports: NFL football and NCAA basketball. On Sunday 1/20, Eastern Time teams New England and the New York Giants beat **Vast Westland** teams San Diego and Green Bay, setting up an all-ELT Super Bowl match-up. No suspense this time around-- an Eastern Time team will win the Super Bowl for the *eighth* consecutive year! (By the time you read this, which one it is may have already been decided.) We will have to wait until March Madness to see if this is the year the other string (ELT teams have won *ten* straight NCAA basketball championships!) will end.
- ▲ Thanks to our great group of Denver area reporters, DDXD-W readers have been kept up-to-speed on the Denver IBOC situation, quite possibly the most challenging one in all of North America for DXers. This week **Chris Knight** sends along these observations: "I did a daytime IBOC scan here

in metro Denver and noted 16 stations carrying IBOC.... As a result, there is noise all over the AM band on all unoccupied frequencies during daylight hours. The Denver dial sounds "third world." For example: the Denver Airport TIS is overcome with 560 KLZ IBOC (which is particularly sloppy); 850 KOA's IBOC is audible under 870 KJMP within 10 miles of KJMP's transmitter; 1490 KCFC's IBOC is audible on 1510 KCKK within 10 miles west of KCKK's transmitter and when driving through underpasses at closer distances." And Chris adds: "It seems to me the FCC set up the Denver metro area as their showcase. The FCC granted power increases to stations within 20 kHz of semi-locals running IBOC: 1360 KHNC (1340 KCFR runs IBOC), 1060 KRCN (1040 KCBR runs IBOC), 1510 KCKK (1490 KCFC runs IBOC) plus others. KCKK was also granted a transmitter site move from south of Littleton to Thornton 20 miles to the north. This puts their transmitter site 25 miles away from KCFC 1490 in Boulder, but they still suffer IBOC interference from KCFC outside of their lobes."

▲ **Steve Sprague** reports he is "...getting some new ones on a CCRadio-SW with Select-a-Tenna." Chris Knight tells us that he has started experimenting with some backyard antennas. Says Chris, "So far just one antenna is up, the terminated loop. One end is fixed, but the other end is portable 90 degrees from SE to SW. The terminated end has a variable resistor. I use wireless headphones and listen while making adjustments to the variable resistor, then come inside where it's warm... hi." Steve and Chris are part of a double-digit turnout of reporters this week, together using a wide variety of receivers and antennas to pull in those logs. And of course, doing their listening inside where it is warm! Thank you all. 73 **Bill**

**1560 WMBH MO Joplin.** (John Tudenham has kept us posted on this often-silent station in past DDXD-W columns, and updates us on the situation in this one. **Ed.-WI**) Now running the transmitter off a generator as power company shut the station off for non-payment. No regular hours-- usually on from about 8 AM to shortly after sunset, sometimes off in middle of the day if out of gas. Just urban music from CDs with few adds or voice IDs. Noticed lately on 1560 we get strong signals by skywave from 50-kw KGOW 1560 in Bellaire TX before and after sunset and sunrise. A friend in Carthage MO 15 miles from Joplin tells me KGOW often takes out WMBH when WMBH is on its 250-watt day power. (**JRT-MO**)

**960 CFFX- ON Kingston.** 1/15 0000. I listened from 0000 until 0115 and couldn't pull it out. The frequency was congested with SS here, with KGWA and then KGKL also in. (**FO-OK**)

**590 KSUBp UT Cedar City.** 1/20 2235-2242. End of Southern Utah/South Dakota State basketball game (So. Utah lost 66-62), ads for Smith Diesel, a construction re-mod company (867-1777) and a concrete company (867-0165) all in Cedar City. KOGO 600 IBOCrud nulled, semi-local KTIE 590 in a deep fade. (**DS-CA**)

600 KROD El Paso," into CBS news. Semi-local KCOL totally nulled by terminated loop antenna. **(CK-CO)**

- 610 KVNU UT Logan. 1/18 0907. News, weather, typical wake-up fare, area ads. Good on peaks, mixing with others. **(JW-CO)**
- 620 WJHX AL Lexington. 1/18 0002. SS music, "La Doble X" slogan, ID in EE: "WJHX Alabama-Tennessee-Mississippi." Completely dominated the frequency in WTMJ null, doing quite well for a nominal 99 watts night power (day power is 5 kw). Needed call change, last logged as WKNI (but had calls WZNN in between). **(Ed.-WI)**
- 750 KAMA TX El Paso. 1/20 0113. Spanish. Good signal, romantic vocals, ID: "Estas escuchando KAMA El Paso." **(CK-CO)**
- 770 CHQR AB Calgary. 1/19 2352. Poor signal under KKOB with call letter ID by a man into talk program. **(CK-CO)**
- 870 WINU IL Shelbyville. 1/23 2259. Religious programming just ending. Mention of New Life Evangelistic Center (the station's owner), then a multi-station legal ID, including for WINU. Below but almost equal to WWL. This station is a 500w daytimer obviously on late this night. **(Ed.-WI)**
- 930 KCCC NM Carlsbad. 1/19 0754. Carlsbad spot, then gal with call letter ID. Briefly fair before fading. **(JW-CO)**
- 980 KDSJ SD Deadwood. 1/16 2239. Good signal with sports announcement, ID: "...right here on KDSJ." **(CK-CO)**
- 1000 KTOK OK Oklahoma City. 1/21 0033. Poor signal over/under XEFV with ad, ID: "...1000 KTOK" into political interview; several mentions of "Oklahoma." **(CK-CO)**
- 1140 KCLE TX Cleburne. 1/10 2215. Country music, IDs as "Classic Country." **(SS-KS)**
- 1140 KCLE TX Cleburne. 1/20 2358. Good peak with country-western music, legal ID: "...KCLE Cleburne-Burleson-Crowley." **(CK-CO)**
- 1160 KSL UT Salt Lake City. 1/13 2059. "End of CBS TV program "60 Minutes" ID, local weather, then program "Meet the Press." Then the signal was gone. **(GH-KS)**
- 1240 KRDO CO Colorado Springs. 1/20 1257. Poor but clear signal with Sporting News Radio, several call letter IDs, ad for AutoZone, promo for "Dr. Laura," legal ID mentioning FM, into ABC news. Usually dominant KFBC in Cheyenne totally nulled by the terminated loop antenna. IBOC hiss from 1220 KLDC. **(CK-CO)**
- 1240 KCCR SD Pierre. 1/21 1959. Out of Dr. Laura with legal ID at 1959:54 "KCCR Pierre, Capital City Radio for central South Dakota," followed by CBS news. Fair-to-good signal atop the pile. **(JW-CO)**
- 1240 KDGO CO Durango. 1/22 2229. Fair signal over mess with ID by a man: "Newstalk 12-40 KDGO Durango," into weather forecast. **(CK-CO)**
- 1240 KIUL KS Garden City. 1/22 2238. Poor signal, man with ID: "...program right here on KIUL." **(CK-CO)**
- 1290 WHKY NC Hickory. 1/5 1657. Call ID, news. Good, well above mess. **(DB-IA)**
- 1290 WCBL KY Benton. 1/7 1753. Country music, ID "Here in Benton." New. **(SS-KS)**
- 1300 KKML CO Colorado Springs. 1/20 1459. Poor (S-2) signal with legal ID: "KKML, Colorado Springs," "ESPN 1300 Sports Animal" slogan, sports news, ad. **(CK-CO)**
- 1370 KWTL ND Grand Forks. 1/19 1758. Poor, alone with Bishop's Masses in North Dakota-Minnesota area, legal ID; power drop yields WSPD. Rare! **(JJR-WI)**
- 1390 KENN NM Farmington. 1/20 1959. Poor signal with legal ID by a man. **(CK-CO)**
- 1390 KCRC OK Enid. 1/20 2122. Fair peak, ID: "ESPN radio....KCRC," into ESPN sports. **(CK-CO)**
- 1400 KREF OK Norman. 1/19 2207-2209. Fair peak over jumble with ID: "...right here on KREF," into sports commentary. **(CK-CO)**
- 1410 KNTX TX Bowie. 1/20 2155-2158. Good peak with '70s rock/pop music, call letter ID. **(CK-CO)**
- 1440 WJLJ NY Niagara Falls. 1/19 0719. Poor; calls over unID Gospel station, other. **(JJR-WI)**
- 1450 KSIW OK Woodward. 1/22 1057. Fair signal on top with "WWLS" call letter ID, ad for a truck dealer. Local KGRE nulled by terminated loop antenna. **(CK-CO)**
- 1510 WWHN IL Joliet. 1/19 1300-1730. Local noted silent this afternoon. No idea why, didn't care. DXed 1500-1520 kHz during this rare silent period, both on the Sangean Sonido and my car radio. Got an ID on 1500 WAKE once, got two stations

on 1520 in mid-afternoon but no solid IDs; presume WKVI /WLUV. Really frustrating. Clear weather, around 0 degrees with snow cover. Station back on the next day. Have a pesky electrical QRN problem nearly everywhere in this duplex. **(KO-IL)**

- 1540 WECZ PA **Punxsutawney. 1/20 1730.** "Polka Mike on WECZ" and "The Groundhog" IDs. Briefly very strong, running over KXEL, then faded. New. **(GH-IL)**
- 1570 KZLI OK **Pryor. 1/8 1735.** Oldies music. "Thank you for listening to KZLI." New. **(SS-KS)**
- 1570 KYCR MN **Golden Valley. 1/10 1650.** Local NFL talk about Minnesota Vikings. ID as "the Patriot." **(SS-KS)**
- 1590 KELP TX **El Paso. 1/8 1903.** Good ID, local weather with high of 65, windy, into religious program. **(FO-OK)**
- 1590 WVNA AL **Tuscumbia. 1/19 0658.** Poor; calls, weather with "North of I-20" calling for snow. Rare! **(JJR-WI)**
- 1590 KDAV TX **Lubbock. 1/19 2102-2104.** Good signal; legal ID, into oldies music over a sports station. **(CK-CO)**
- 1630 KKGM TX **Fort Worth. 1/19 2059-2102.** Good signal; legal ID into country music. **(CK-CO)**
- 1640 WTNI MS **Biloxi. 1/8 1854.** On top of frequency, with sports talk about SEC football, ad for American Wholesale Furniture at 1855, call letter ID at 1857, ad for Turbo Tax at 1858. **(FO-OK)**
- 1700 KVNS TX **Brownsville. 1/20 2224.** Oldies, ID as "Oldies radio" at 2233, AutoZone ad at 2239, talk about "oldiesradioonline.com" at 2251. New. **(FO-OK)**

TIS, HAR, Etc.

- 1680 WQHC967 IA **Oakdale. 1/21 1445-1455.** "This is the Iowa Department of Transportation's Highway Advisory Radio System, transmitting at a frequency of sixteen-eighty kilohertz AM. This is a test." No ID. Transmitter location is the IDOT Oakdale Maintenance Garage near Iowa City: 41-42-28.3 N 91-36-32.4 W. Phone call revealed the test loop will run for a month, then regular broadcasts will begin. Fair at 26 miles. Don't confuse with two similar IDOT stations on 1680 in the Quad Cities. **(DB-IA)**

- 1440 WDCO GA **Cochran – Per Premiere Radio, stn flipped 1/21 to Fox Sports Radio almost 24/7, with exception of 1200-1500 weekdays (presumably Jim Rome) and partly on weekends. (DP-HI)**
- 1490 WBAE ME **Portland (also 1400 WVAE Biddeford, ME) – Per Portland Press-Herald,**

stations added Don Imus 1/21 at 0600-1000. Imus was previously on sister station WZON-970 before being replaced by "Bob and Tom" from WFBQ-FM Indianapolis. **(DP-HI)**

1500 **WWWT DC Washington** – Per its website, stn adds Glenn Beck, drops "Larry King Live" and discontinues Randi Rhodes, though she still continues on normal simul-caster WWWB-820 weekdays 1606-1900; WWWT does add a "Best Of Randi Rhodes" Sunday afternoons. **(DP-HI)**

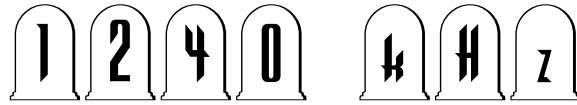
