The Crosley 50 Portable is a remarkable radio. It is a genuine Armstrong regenerative set, using but one tube and operating very successfully with dry cell "A" and "B" batteries. Any Crosley dealer will install batteries, tube and headphones, while you wait. Take it home,

connect the ground and aerial and you are ready to hear all the air offers. When vacation time comes put it with your luggage and "take your entertainment with you." With the 50 Portable you use headphones only. The cabinet is black leatherette with nickel trimmings.

TWO STAGE AUDIO FREQUENCY AMPLIFIER

This is the Crosley Model 50-A, a two-stage audio frequency amplifier. It was designed for addition to the Crosley Model 50 receiver, but can be used in conjunction with any tube detector on the market. The 50-A does not produce volume; it amplifies it. In fact,

the unit amplifies the volume of the Model 50, for instance, approximately 100 times. When the Model 50-A is added to the Model 50 the combined units consist of an Armstrong detector and two stages of audio frequency amplification. On such a set, far away stations will be received on a loud speaker.

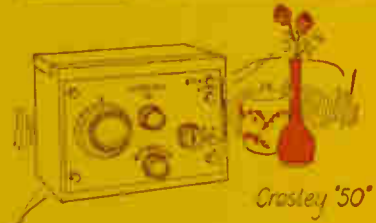

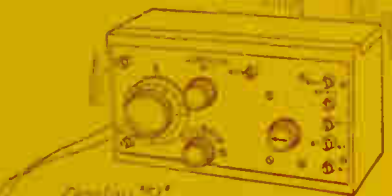

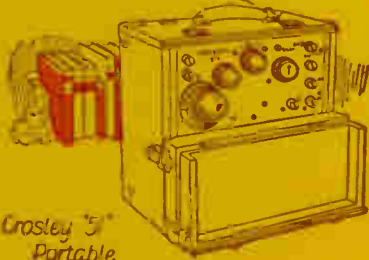

The Crosley 51-A is a One-Stage Audio Frequency Amplifier to match the Crosley 51 receiver. When used in connection with the Crosley 51, it gives the equivalent of a three-tube

regenerative set. A Crosley multistat and standard socket permit the use of any make of amplifier tube. The cabinet of the Crosley 51-A matches the cabinet of the Crosley 51 perfectly.
