WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission has notified Alexander Mitchell Communications Corp., licensee of WSKS-FM, Milledgeville, GA, of an apparent liability for forfeiture of \$20,000 for failure to light an antenna tower, and then neglecting to notify the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) that the tower lights malfunctioned. An inspection on August 13, 1991 indicated all the lights were out on the structure. The Commission said there appeared to be no factors which would warrant an adjustment in this case.

The Commission has notified Ellwood Beach Broadcasting, an applicant for 92.9 MHz in Montecito, Calif., of an apparent liability for a forfeiture of \$25,000 concerning enlarged misrepresentation/lack-of-candor issues. ALJ Walter C. Miller enlarged these issues in the March 16-19 FM proceeding that dismissed the application of Spirit Broadcasting with prejudice after the approval of a partial settlement agreement between Spirit and James Evans. Issues were also added against Ellwood to determine its financial qualifications to become a Commission licensee.

ELSEWHERE

In traditional form, April Fools Day, 1992, proved to be eventful. WNOR-FM, Norfolk, has suspended its general manager and several staffers after the station reported a potential explosion that panicked listeners Wednesday. A spokesperson for the Norfolk FCC field office stated in a release, "The Commission may consider several actions against any station that transmits hoax messages." The Commission continues to receive complaint letters, and is investigating the incident.

ELSEWHERE (CONT'D)

The Arbitron Company and VNU Business Information Services, Inc. have formed a joint venture that will provide a unified database of competitive advertising and public relations traffic information. Terry Kent, the newly appointed president of the venture, said, "The joint venture is really combining Arbitron's broadcast experience. . .with VNU's print media experience." The joint venture will combine Arbitron's MediaWatch and Radio/TV Reports services with VNU's Leading National Advertisers and Radio Expenditure Reports services.

Metro Traffic is testing its Metro News Service this week on WCDJ-FM, Boston, Mass. The complete newscast service is an extension of its weather and news actuality service. If the test is successful, the company plans to expand delivery of the service.

Local radio revenues uptrended in February, while national dropped by just over 17 percent. According to the RAB, total radio revenue for February was off slightly--0.6 percent. Network radio dropped by 4.4 percent. The RAB monthly indicators are compiled from over 100 surveyed markets by Miller, Kaplan, Arase & Co. and Hungerford, Aldrin, Nichols & Carter.

Barrett Associates, Inc. (BAI), an audio and R.F. broadcast equipment supplier, has been purchased by D.J. Nelson of Oceanside, Calif. W. Barrett Mayer, the founder of the company, has retired to travel the U.S.A. Nelson also owns Vision Communications, a publishing and production company.

A total of \$200,000 in prizes will be awarded at the Radio Advertising Bureau's first annual Radio Creative Fund "Mercury Awards" presentation to be held June 4 at the New York Hilton Grand Ballroom in New York City. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Dockets Branch (Room 230) and the Dockets Public Reference Room (239) at the FCC will be closed April 30 and May 1, for reorganization. Both sections of the Dockets Branch will reopen at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, May 4. The Mass Media section of the Public Reference Room will remain open.

The Commission has adopted new groundwave propagation curves to superseded the set of curves currently in use under 47 C.F.R. Section 73.184. The curves are now available through the Commission's contractor for public records duplication on hardcopy or 5 1/4" floppy discs. Contact Thomas Lucey at (202) 254-3394 for more information.

The Commission, through docket 91-67, will now require FM translator and FM booster operators to inform the public in the required newspaper notice and on the air announcements that it may participate in the renewal process. This new requirement is part of the Revision of License Renewal Announcement Requirements for Low Power Television, Television Translator, Television Booster, FM Translator and FM Booster Stations Report and Order adopted March 26. The amendments will take effect on May 26.

Great American Television and Radio, Inc. has been granted a waiver of the one-to-a-market rule with the purchase of KOPA/KSLX, Scottsdale, AZ from Cook Inlet Radio Partners, L.P. Great American also owns KTSP television in Phoenix. The waiver was granted based on the Commission's "Top 25 Markets/30 Voices" standard, which "looks favorably" on waivers of the rule when radio and television stations involved are located in the top 25 television markets and where, following the proposed combination, there will be at least 30 separately owned stations or "voices."

WJLY, Ramsey, IL, has been granted a modification of license to change status as an FM station from commercial to non-commercial. WJLY is at 93.3 MHz.

ELSEWHERE

The National Association of Broadcaster's Convention in Las Vegas took place this past week. Almost 800 exhibitors covered 465,000 square feet. General reaction from radio exhibitors was that traffic was about the same this year as it was last year, although there were fewer hospitality suites. FCC Chairman Al Sikes was the keynote speaker at Tuesday's luncheon. Sikes was expected to comment on radio ownership rules, but only brushed the subject.

During an acceptance speech of the NAB's Distinguished Service Award, former President Ronald Reagan was slightly shaken after an anti-nuclear protestor shattered the glass award and approached the podium. Richard Paul Springer, who had press credentials for the convention, walked past security on to the stage. Secret Service agents forcibly removed Springer, and Reagan finished the speech. The NAB doubled security after the disruption.

Local Marketing Agreements (LMA's) was a hot topic at the convention. There were several standing-room-only panel sessions on the legal, sales and marketing, and potential ownership aspects of the subject, as well as a breakfast discussion hosted by Satellite Music Network.

Veteran broadcaster Larry King was inducted into the Radio Hall of Fame on Tuesday. The award was presented by NAB Radio Board Chairman Dick Novik. The television series "Star Trek" and "Star Trek, The Next Generation" were inducted into the Television Hall of Fame. On hand for the event were former NBC Television President Brandon Tartikoff, William Shatner, Leonard Nimoy, and De Forest Kelley. The award was presented by NAB Television Board Chairman Ron Townsend.

San Diego's Z-90 FM exhibited the "mother of all station vehicles" at the convention's outdoor exhibit area. The bus, made by Unicoach of Chula Vista, CA has two lounges (including a conference room), galley, completely enclosed driver area, satellite uplink, and fold-out broadcast console. The mobile studio is being offered on a market-exclusive basis to the top 75 radio markets, and can be designed and customized by the radio station. The Radio Advertising Bureau's Radio Creative Fund has launched a seminar series designed to teach university students the art and craft of radio advertising. Students at New York City's Fordham University are getting a first-hand look at the radio advertising world in the series of four weekly seminars. Bob Sarlin, Senior Vice President/Group Creative Director at McCann Erickson, is moderating the "Ad Lab" seminars. Students attend four weeks of classes, and are able to write and produce their own radio commercials. The commercials will be judged, and one student will be chosen to receive a \$10,000 stipend and a six month work fellowship. RAB president Gary Fries hopes to expand "Ad Lab" to colleges in other cities, as well. For more information, contact Amy Krakow at (212) 307-3000.

Pacific Bell, the company that supplies telephone service to the Los Angeles area, is investigating complaints that several dozen employees used knowledge about the company's phone systems to attempt to win a KRTH cash giveaway promotion. A spokesperson for Pacific Bell said none of the workers under investigation received any money from the station, although some were the seventh caller--the correct caller in the contest that pays \$1,000 after a promotional phrase is aired. The station is aiding Pacific Bell's investigation, and employees could be suspended or fired if found in violation of company policy.

Rubin Rodriguez, Jr. former operations manager of KTKK Salt Lake City and its parent company, D&B Broadcasting, have been charged with racketeering and communications fraud for selling bogus travel packages to listeners. The proceeds were then funnelled to the black market jean trade in Europe. The travel company purchasing the time on the station--Premiere International Travel--has been charged with over 50 counts of theft.

The CHUM Group may soon own two AM's and two FM's in the Detroit market. The CHUM group, who currently owns CKWW/CIMX has filed with the CRTC to purchase CKLW/CKMR. Although the CRTC policy forbids owning more than one AM and one FM in a market, a company may own more than one AM or FM if they broadcast their programming in different languages.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Federal Communications Commission has affirmed a review board decision upholding the ALJ's dismissal of Ingram and Scott Communications Limited Partnership's application for failure to timely amend to demonstrate its financial qualifications. Ingram and Scott was an applicant in the proceeding for a new FM station at 97.3 MHz in Longview, TX. Through a letter dated November 26, 1990 from the First National Bank in Marshall, TX, Ingram & Scott contended that it had demonstrated that it had take immediate steps to obtain new financing once its financing with the National Bank of Washington fell through. The Commission stated that the letter was of no value because therewere no corroborating statements and that Ingram and Scott did not report the loss of its original financing to the Commission.

The Commission admonished North American Broadcasting Co., Inc., licensee of WALE in Providence, RI, for "broadcasting the type of false and misleading information which violates the Commission's general policy requiring licensees to program their stations in the public interest." On July 9, 1991, WALE broadcast a dramatization that one of its on-air personalities, Steve White, had been shot in the head while outside the station on a break. In a letter to Frank Battaglia, President of North American, the Commission found that the licensee neither knew, approved, nor ratified the broadcast; the episode seemed to be a spontaneous event; and North American effected prompt disciplinary action. The matter has been made part of WALE's permanent record. (More recently, the Commission is investigating an incident on April 1, 1992, in which WNOR-FM, Norfolk, VA, reported a potential explosion which was also a hoax.)

The Commission has amended its rules to delegate to the Chiefs, Mass Media Bureau, Common Carrier Bureau, Private Radio Bureau and Field Operations Bureau, and Chief Engineer, authority to act in forfeiture proceedings involving \$20,000 or less. The previous limits had been between \$2,000 and \$10,000. This action follows a 1989 amendment of the Communications Act in which Congress substantially increased the maximum amounts of forfeiture the Commission could impose.

The Commission inadvertently left off the filing window regarding a new allotment of 93.9 MHz to Andover, KS. The window opens May 18 and closes June 18, 1992. The Commission has dismissed the competing application of Philip Y. Hahn for 105.5 MHz in Brockport, NY. After the application was inadvertently accepted for filing, an engineering review revealed that the application is affected and does not comply with the Canadian-U.S.A. FM Broadcasting Agreement of 1947. Hahn's application of 3.6 kW exceeds the maximum effective radiated power (ERP) of 3 kW for a domestic FM station within 320 kilometers (200 miles) of the Canadian border.

ELSEWHERE

The results of the first round of judging for the Radio Advertising Bureau's first annual Mercury Awards for excellence in radio advertising were announced at a VIP gathering at New York's "21 Club" last Monday. Dick Clark, who will be master of ceremonies for the awards dinner and presentation at the New York Hilton on June 4, took part in the session attended by leaders in the radio and advertising fields. RAB President Gary Fries and Group W Radio President Jim Thompson, co-chairmen of the Mercury Awards, presented an overview of the \$200,000 Mercury Awards program. Unistar Radio Networks Chairman and CEO Nick Verbitsky was introduced as the first Mercury Awards event chairman. Those in attendance also heard a series of humorous spots promoting the Mercury Awards ceremony. The spots will begin airing next week in major markets across the country. For more information about the event, call Laura Morandin at the RAB at (212) 254-4800.

KLOL, Houston, TX listeners have chosen to run a campaign of television commercials featuring the late comedian Sam Kinison. The station opened voting lines this week to tabulate the responses to the question of the television campaign's future. KLOL decided it would air the campaign if responses were 70 percent favorable. According to a station spokesperson, the vote was approximately 75 percent positive. Kinison was hired last fall by the station to appear as a spokesperson for a station promotion. KLOL was re-editing the spots for use this spring when Kinison was killed in a collision with a teenage motorist. For several years, Kinison had maintained a special relationship with the station, serving as a frequent on-air guest as well as a host/entertainer at a number of charity events and parties.

Communication Graphics, a Tulsa-based promotional materials company, has launched a marketing and promotions division in Florida. Dick Downes, CRMC, will oversee its operation. "Communication Concepts will provide advertising, marketing, and promotional products and services to the radio industry," said Rick Lawrence, President. "This . . . enables us to grow horizontally with radio." Downes was most recently Sr. VP/Sales and Marketing for The Pulse of Radio. Rick can be reached at (800) 331-4438.

Jones Satellite Audio (JSA) and Radio Programming and Management (RPM) announced that RPM will develop and distribute JSA's libraries and library updates for its adult contemporary and country formats on compact disc. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Federal Communications Commission has notified Radio Chattanooga, licensee of WGOW and WSKZ, Chattanooga, TN, apparently liable for a forfeiture of \$11,000 for violations of Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) rules, and has renewed the licenses of the combo subject to EEO reporting conditions. The Commission determined there was no evidence of discrimination. It did find, however, a record of inadequate efforts to recruit and employ minorities, especially Blacks. In addition, the Commission noted that the licensee did not maintain adequate records for meaningful self-assessment and hired only one Black applicant during the four-year subject period and that person was hired within the last four months of the license term.

The broadcast industry, as well as other FCC users will be hit with annual fees to cover the costs of policy and rulemaking, enforcement, and user information services in accordance with President Bush's budget for FY 1993. None of the fees will be retained by the FCC, but instead would be deposited into the General Fund of the U.S. Treasury. The expected revenue from the Commission's proposed new user fees is approximately 71.9 million, and increase of 9.2 percent over the last year. Class A AM's fee is \$550 per year, all other AM classes are \$125. FM classes C, C1, C2, or B fee is \$550 per year, classes A, B1, C3, or D are \$125.

Two stations have been granted non-commercial status this week. Gospel Opportunities, Inc., licensee of WHWL at 95.7 MHz in Marquette, MI, and WEUL at 98.1 MHz in Kingsford, MI, have switched from commercial to non-commercial.

The Commission is attempting to clarify the applicability of the Administrative Dispute Resolution Act (ADRA) for all proceedings before the Commission, including those proceedings to which the Commission itself is not a party. It has also asked for comments on whether it should maintain its own roster of neutrals -- persons who perform mediation and conciliation functions -- for parties interested in using ADR techniques. The ADRA, passed in 1990, authorizes administrative agencies to use mediation and arbitration to resolve disputed matters before the FCC. The FCC said they are seeking to eliminate the confusion regarding the applicability of the procedures, particularly its confidentiality protections.

The Commission has ordered Springtown Educational Broadcasting Foundation, licensee of KYQX, Weatherford, TX, for a forfeiture of \$5,000 for repeated violation of Section 399B of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Section 73.503(d) of the Commission's rules, which prohibit noncommercial stations from airing advertisements. Springtown's president, Wesley Yeager, stated he was unaware of the provisions and asked that the forfeiture be reduced to \$2,500 because of financial hardship at the station. The Commission said that no reduction was warranted because the station had not submitted profit and loss statements. The Commission, however, agreed not to increase the forfeiture for the advertisements aired after the notice of apparent liability was issued.

The Commission has notified Donald W. Bishop that he is apparently liable for a forfeiture of \$10,000 for operating an unlicensed station. On October 6, 1991, the Commission's long range, High Frequency, radio Direction-Finding Network (HFDF) detected the unauthorized transmission of 7420 kHz, 7417.9 kHz, and 15050.2 kHz from a mobile transmission source near Limon, Colorado. Mr. Bishop is a contributor or editor of several land mobile trade publications and has written several articles on pirate radio. The base forfeiture amount for this violation is \$8,000. Because of the intentional nature of the violation, the forfeiture was raised to \$10,000.

A second shortwave forfeiture of \$8,000 was assessed against Roberto Pizano for broadcasting anti-Castro propaganda on 7080.8 kHz. On November 18, 1991, the Commission's Field Operations Bureau traced the signal to RA Auto Wholesale in Tampa, FL. It is alleged that Mr. Pizano is a former political prisoner who spent 18 years in a Cuban prison.

The United Talk Radio network went silent last Monday, April 27. Ed Graham, President of U-Talk, stressed in a release that the outage is only temporary, and tried to quell speculation that they have merged with another network. Sonny Bloch's Independent Broadcaster's Network (IBN) is currently being heard on U-Talk's old channel. In January, Graham had worked out a programming deal that allowed IBN to broadcast most of the day on the American Radio Network (ARN), of which he owned fifty percent.

The United Talk Network was borne out of the subsequent breakup of ARN. Graham's partner, Don Emmanuel, joined the Business Radio Network to launch the American Forum Network. Graham further stated that U-Talk is in the process of making some unspecified changes that are "new and exciting."

United Press International (UPI) has asked a federal bankruptcy judge in New York to schedule and auction the sale of the 84-year-old news wire service. The company said that U.S. Bankruptcy Judge Francis Conrad is considering its request for the "accelerated" auction. Pieter VanBennekom, President and Chief Executive Officer said in a statement, "This will determine, once and for all, who will own UPI." UPI filed for bankruptcy protection in August 1991 for the second time in six years as it searched for a buyer.

WDIZ-FM, Orlando morning team Baxter and Mark are out after CBS announced plans to syndicate WYNF, Tampa's "Ron and Ron Morning Show" to WDIZ-FM. Following the lead of other morning show syndication efforts, CBS will be syndicating the show in other markets, if results are good in Orlando.

XETRA-FM, San Diego has suspended their morning team after airing portions of the latest Andrew Dice Clay album last week. Mike Berger, Jeff Prescott, and Russ T. Nailz were replaced last Monday by Station Manager Mike Glickenhau and Program Director Kevin Stapleford. The station aired apologies every hour on Thursday, April 23--the day of the incident. The suspension is "indefinite."

Financial talk show host Sonny Bloch and C.D. Media, Inc. have inked a co-venture pact to distribute Bloch's programming. Bloch's daily "Business Journal" and "The Sonny Bloch Show" will be digitally distributed on Satcom C-5, Transponder 15 (DATS), beginning May 4. C. D. Media CEO Rick Dees said the move is part of a long term plan to develop his network. C.D. Media also distributes "Rick Dees Weekly Top 40" and "The Satellite Comedy Network."

Arbitron announced that the Tyler, TX metro has added two counties and will jump from market number 205 to 138. The metro will be renamed as "Tyler-Longview, TX" after adding Gregg and Cherokee counties. A spokesperson for Arbitron said the counties were added after proposals were considered from KNUE and KTBB/KTYL in Tyler, and KOOI in Jacksonville, TX.

The Associated Press has released a new version of its AP NewsDesk software that allows users to track school closings and other cancellations electronically through an enhanced phonebook tool. Version 1.2 allows reports to remain active for on-air updates indefinitely during bad weather. Users can also enter the reason for the closing or delay. For more information, call Evelyn Cassidy at (202) 736-1152.

The first Canadian Content CD library for radio stations, "Gold Canada," will be released June 1 by Seattle-based Broadcast Programming, Inc. The 20-disc CD library will feature nearly 400 Canadian titles from the 50's to the early 80's. Supplemental CD's will be issued on a regular basis. All of the titles meet CANCON (Canadian Content) radio requirements. The library was purchased by Broadcast Programming from Ken Singer Broadcast Services and are being manufactured in Toronto.
