PROGRESS MADE BY CBC IN 1958:

... A Year of Many Changes

It has been an eventful year for the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, as, it seems, every year is. In August, the Canadian Parliament passed a broadcasting act which resulted in overall changes in Canada's broadcasting system. Since 1936 the CBC had been responsible for providing a national radio and television program service, and for regulating all broadcasting of publicly-owned and privately-owned stations in Canada. On Nov. 10 when the new Act was proclaimed, a Board of Broadcast Governors, a Board independent of either the CBC or the private stations, assumed the latter responsibility. At that time too, a new Board of Directors for the CBC was appointed.

Since July 1, our microwave television network (the longest in the world) has extended from Sydney, Nova Scotia, on the east coast to Victoria, British Columbia, on the west coast. The continent-spanning network, built and operated by the Trans-Canada Telephone System, and the CNR and CPR, provides simultaneous television to three million homes through French and English stations. It links both CBC and private stations across the country, in every province except Newfoundland. In a few months Newfoundland too, will be connected.

Video tape came into use by the CBC on July 1. At the relay center in Calgary, Alberta, television network programs are recorded on video tape for retelecast at more appropriate

times over stations in the western time zones.

A plan to develop CBC northern broadcasting service went into operation on Nov. 10. At that time the CBC assumed control of radio station CFWH at Whitehorse, the capital of the Yukon. This means that our radio programs are now being broadcast in seven time zones. CFWH was operated for the past 12 years by Canadian Army and Air Force volunteers.

An FM radio network has been planned between Toronto, Ottawa and Montreal, and will soon go into operation.

This Fall we entered the television network market in the United States. Five of our dramas appeared simultaneously on the CBC network in Canada in the "General Motors Presents" series, and on the ABC network in the United States under the series title "Encounter."

The CBC, in 1958, won seven first awards and seven honorable mention awards at the 22nd Annual American Exhibition of Educational Radio and Television Programs at Ohio State University. No other network in North America received as many awards.

The CBC, during 1958, provided several special broadcasts that made extraordinary demands — the March 31 Federal Election (a record audience of 7,860,000 persons witnessed the live CBC television and radio, French and English coverage of the election results), the Springhill, Nova Scotia mining disaster, and Princess Margaret's tour in Canada.

CANADA'S PRIVATE BROADCASTERS

... See A Better Outlook For Regulation

THE high point of 1958 for Canadian private broadcasters was the late-in-the-year appointment of a 15-member Board of Broadcast Governors, under the leadership of Dr. Andrew Stewart, an economist and President of the University of Alberta.

Private broadcasters had pressed for the appointment of such a board before two royal commissions and several parliamentary radio committees. Establishment of the BBG (the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, Canada's government-owned broadcasting system, now has its own separate board) takes the private stations out of the former situation in which they were regulated by, at the same time that they were competing with the CBC.

The new Board of Broadcast Governors will be concerned only with regulation, and private broadcasters are now hoping for action on two more of their requests before the royal commissions: (1) the immediate licensing of non-government television stations in main metropolitan centres which are now reserved exclusively for government-owned television and, (2) permission to form private networks.

Four new private radio stations and four new TV stations came on the air last year and at year's end there were 30 applications in the hands of the Department of Transport awaiting reference to the new Board of Broadcast Governors in 1959. As soon as applications for second TV stations are accepted there will be a flood of new applications. Second station applications have not been accepted in order to prevent applicants assuming

a favoured position by filing an application on an if as and when basis.

The membership of the Canadian Association of Broadcasters now stands at 149 radio members, 37 television members and 59 associates. Both the Radio and Television Sales and Research offices in Toronto expanded the research and statistical studies supplied to agencies, advertisers, reps and stations this year. Separate radio and television weeks were held (radio week in the spring and TV week in the fall) to inform the public on the informative and entertaining qualities of the media.

The Toronto offices sent out promotion kits featuring spots; fact sheets; idea books; dramatized announcements (including a series of announcements by top Canadian sports stars); display promotional material, etc.

The Canadian Association of Broadcasters annual meeting (held in May this year because of the federal election in March) again featured separate radio and TV workshops.

Radio stations have been encouraged this year by the fact that radio sales have led TV set sales (446,417 radio sets were sold compared to 273,765 TV sets as of September 30).

Most of these new radio sales seem to have gone to multiple radio homes, and car radio sales have also boomed. This has meant an increasing emphasis of diversified radio programs, especially for night time radio.

The trend in television has been toward still more daytime television since network option time swallows much of the Class "A", 8 to 11 p.m. period.

"CUSTOMER-SLANTING" The Television Buy

... New Dimensions in Buying Time, Programs, Films

THE demand for qualitative information about audiences literally put us into the ratings business as our most conspicuous product, market by market and network. Yet, twenty years ago if I had been shown the crystal ball, no one would have been more surprised. For, engrossed in consumer-attitude studies for governmental agencies, and some ten years with a foremost group of psychologists, my work revolved around special surveying.

Today while we meet the keen competition of ratings-only firms established after ours in 1941, we have kept our qualitative perspective uppermost. And through mass subscription for our data, servicing the most markets and the most subscribers, we have been able to reduce subscription costs materially.

So, briefly, using face-to-face interviewing in the homes of the nation, our trained interview specialists visit an entirely new sample of 100,000 different families monthly. Five thousand different families are interviewed for each once-a-week television program, and the particular characteristics and purchases of each are recorded. Twenty thousand different families are similarly interviewed for multi-broadcast programs, and spectaculars and specials are duly entered. Each month a new category is analyzed. We are now interviewing in all our major markets 365 days of the year. And for all other markets interviewed less than monthly we also use daily interviewing instituted several years ago for the smaller markets.

The value of this information be-

comes obvious when we look at situations such as illustrated in typical situations. Interpreting the percentages in terms of the industry's figure of 45,000,000 television homes for Spring, 1959, the differences are impressive. Let us take just one category:

The above are norms for each kind of program. The individual program, therefore, can be measured against the norm, and its value appraised accordingly. Our data in this and other categories indicate that certain advertisers' programs attract millions of customers and prospects above the norm, or millions below the norm. It behooves an advertiser of a low-customer's show to know when a competitor is out-hitting him with a program attracting more customers and prospects. Plainly the conventional focus on big ratings becomes questionable.

It is our belief that this new concept of customer-slanting (from samples so large that quibbling is impossible), will become a widely recognized and positive contribution to the mechanics of today's demands for lower-cost, more effective product-selling.
