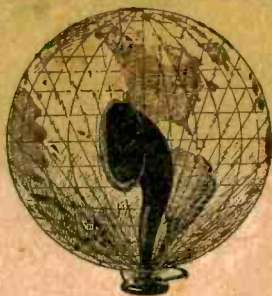

BROADCASTING STATION REGULATIONS

There are two classes of broadcasting stations, A and B. The regulations governing each, follow:

CLASS A.—"Class A broadcasting station licenses will be issued to stations equipped to use power not exceeding 500 watts in the antenna. When more than one station of this class is licensed in the same city or locality, a division of time will be required if necessary."

CLASS B.—"The power supply must be dependable and non-fluctuating. The minimum required will be 500 watts in the antenna. The system must be so arranged as to cause the generated radio frequency current to vary accurately according to the sound impressed upon the microphone system. Sufficient tubes and other material must be readily available to insure continuity and reliability of the announced schedule of service. The antenna must be so constructed as to prevent swinging. The radio equipment in the studio must be limited to that essential for use in the room. The room shall be so arranged as to avoid sound reverberation and to exclude external and unnecessary noises.

"The programs must be carefully supervised and maintained to insure satisfactory service to the public. The use of mechanically operated musical instruments is prohibited.

"Licenses issued for the use of Class B stations shall specifically provide that any failure to maintain the standards prescribed for such stations may result in the forfeiture of the Class B privilege."

Every effort has been made to prevent errors in this list of stations and it is believed it is absolutely accurate at the time of publication. However, if errors are detected, we should like to know of them.

BETTER MUSIC THIS WINTER FORECAST

Winter May Bring Birth of a Great New Art—The Radio Play.
Classical Music and Operas to Replace Jazz.

By THOMAS STEVENSON

Less jazz and more classical music and plays will probably feature the programs of many of the leading stations this winter, according to A. C. Grangeck, of RADIO INDUSTRY, who has made a survey of winter broadcasting plans. Many station directors seem to have reached the conclusion that the public taste for music is much better than previously recognized and an effort will be made to satisfy the demand for newness both in entertainment and education.

Here are some of the principal program features which will be broadcast by leading stations this winter:

WOR, Newark—A series of weekly plays by the Newark Theatre Guild, an organization of splendid actresses and actors. Dinner banquets of the better kind. Spiritual talks by Houdini. Demonstrations in mental telepathy over radio by Kaldah, an Egyptian mind reader.

WEAF, New York—Gradual elimination of jazz, and more classical music. Each week or perhaps oftener, the broadcasting of opera will be continued. A number of vaudeville headliners of the highest type. WEAF proposes to shorten speeches, provide a greater variety and have music between them.

WJZ, New York—Chief emphasis will be on educational features. College courses and other instructive material will be broadcast regularly.

WGBS, New York—Operas and plays will be featured.

WMCA, New York—Christian Science Services. Hardman hour of music. Many important scenes from Broadway productions. Ernie Golden and the Hotel McAlpine Orchestra.

WEEL, Boston—Orchestral concerts and better type of symphony dance music. Lectures occasionally. World Series baseball games and the important college football games of the Big Four. The "Punkinville Program" will be broadcast regularly, consisting of a combination of old time rural comedy and burlesque vaudeville.

NEW DIXIE BROADCASTER

WSM, at Nashville, Tenn., to Add Her Voice to Southern Broadcasters on October 5. Miss Bonnie Barnhardt to Direct Programs Which Will Include Famous Fisk Jubilee Singers.

A new Dixie broadcaster will make its debut to the radio audience on Monday night, October 5. WSM, the new station, located at Nashville, Tenn., and owned by the National Life and Accident Insurance Company will operate on 282.8 meters with 1,000 watts power.

Jack Keefe, said to be the only living personification of Ring Lardner's famous character, will do the announcing at WSM. Mr. Keefe is a graduate of Harvard; has held the position of Professor of Science and Coach of the Athletic teams of the Eastern Oregon State Normal School; has directed Elk minstrel shows over the country; was chief chemist of a large alcohol plant in Tennessee during the war, and graduated in law at Vanderbilt University in 1925.

A unique feature of the station will be that it will have in active charge of its programs one of the few women program directors in the radio world. Miss Bonnie Barnhardt, for more than three years staff artist, program director, radio editor and bedtime story teller of WSM, Atlanta, will be program director and radio editor of the Nashville station. Miss Bonnie is beloved of countless thousands of little folks and grownups for her southern lullabies and bedtime stories and in her WSM has one of the most capable and brilliant personalities in radio.

WSM will give Nashville a mouthpiece by which the world will learn of the city often referred to as "The Athens of the South" because of its great educational institutions. Nashville is a center of culture in Dixie. It is a great educational city and is the seat of the famous Vanderbilt University, Ward-Belmont, Peabody College, Fisk University, the home of the celebrated Fisk Jubilee Singers, and other educational, religious and civic institutions of which the South is justly proud.

WSM will be the third class B broadcaster in Tennessee. The State already has two class B stations in WOAN, at Lawrenceburg and WMC at Memphis.

The slogan of WSM is "We Shield Millions."

BROADCASTING STATION NOTES

An S. O. S. sent out by WGBU, at Fulford, Fla., on the evening of the 22nd, prevented considerable property loss and perhaps loss of lives. The Richmond Hotel was destroyed by fire and the only telephone in Fulford was enveloped in the flames. A messenger rushed word to WGBU where Announcer Harold McCray sent out four appeals to radio fans to phone the fire department at Miami. The fire apparatus arrived in less than seventeen minutes and prevented the spread of the blaze.

Leo Fitzpatrick, "The Merry Old Chief" has left KSD, St. Louis, to join the staff of WJR, Pontiac.

Jacksonville, Fla., WJAX, City of Jacksonville, 336.9 meters, 1,000 watts.

Miami, Fla., Miami Shores, 1,000 watts.

Miami Beach, Fla., Carl G. Fisher Properties, 1,000 watts.

Miami, Fla., The Daily Tab, 210 meters, 20 watts.

KFXF enjoys the distinction of being the highest station in the United States. It is located at the foot of Pike's Peak, in Colorado.

Towers rising 125 feet high are being placed on top of the Hotel Alms new building for WKRC, the Kodel station at Cincinnati. For several months the new hotel, which is now completed, has risen above the old antenna, cutting a wide swath in the range of the station, because the steel of the new building absorbed the radio waves.

NEW STATIONS LICENSED

Nineteen new broadcasting stations were licensed by the Department of Commerce during the past month, while nine stations were discontinued. Two of the new stations are Class B and seventeen Class A.

There is now a total of 583 broadcasting stations in the United States, which is very near a record. The stations are classified as follows: Class A, 467; Class B, 113; Class C, 1; Class D, 2.

WHAS, Louisville—This station will continue its policy of variety in its programs, featuring classical music, dance orchestras, excerpts from operas, vocal choruses, sports, novelties, etc. Speakers will be permitted only 100 words before the microphone.

WGR, Buffalo—Programs will be kept as varied as possible. Afternoon programs and noon recitals by the concert ensemble of the Vincent Lopez Hotel Statler organization.

WMAQ, Chicago—A series of weekly radio photologues. The WMAQ players will continue their presentations. Three lectures a week from the University of Chicago. Football games from Stagg Field. Series of musical lectures, dinner hour organ recitals, instrumental trio concerts and weekly musical revues.

WTIC, Hartford—Light opera selections. Music of representative American composers. Readings and musical settings of representative poets.

WAHG, Richmond Hill—Every first Monday of the month an entire evening of old-time music in the form of male and mixed quartet selections, vocal solos and duets and instrumental combinations.

WOAN, Lawrenceburg—Male quartets will be the main feature. A male quartet will have a place on the program every evening. An orchestra of the Vaughan Conservatory of Music will be featured in addition to various instrumental and vocal soloists.

WOAW, Omaha—Morning and afternoons will be devoted chiefly to the reading of stock quotations. Two musical periods during the day, one at noon, and the other at four o'clock each afternoon. Press news items are read each afternoon.

KDKA, Pittsburgh—As in the past, the programs of KDKA will contain little if any jazz. A number of new features will be introduced this winter.

WBZ, Springfield, Mass.—Jazz will not be used except as a means of affording an occasional change from other types of entertainment. Educational features will be used more widely than heretofore, also instrumental and vocal music, symphonic and band concerts. Speeches, lectures and sports will be included together with occasional novelties.
