



WAVE ARTISTS IN CONCERT

he lineup of WAVE artists performing around Southern California this Summer is spectacular! The caliber of musicianship of these players speaks for itself when you hear them live...let's take a look at the backgrounds and influences that make them all "hot tickets" this Summer:

This year's Long Beach Jazz Festival, August 11th through the 13th, features a choice collection of WAVE artists. Included in the lineup are: Dave Koz, Hiroshima, Alphonze Mouzon with Dan Siegel, Brandon Fields and Grant Geissman, Najee, Richard Elliot, Carl Anderson, The Jazz Crusaders featuring Randy Crawford and Bobby Caldwell, Pieces Of A Dream and Fattburger.

Dave Koz is a busy guy. He bears the distinction of being the only WAVE artist that is also a member of the WAVE air staff. Koz's nationally syndicated radio show, Personal Notès can be heard Sunday evenings on The WAVE. The multi-media performer's unmistakable saxophone signature sound graces the soap opera General Hospital. This September he will be appearing and performing as himself on Beverly Hills 90210. The sales of his latest album "Lucky Man" have just achieved gold certification and show no signs of letting up. The San Fernando Valley native has recently re-located to the San Francisco Bay area and is currently preparing for his next release. One of the most sought after session players in the business, he spends entirely too much time lockedup in recording studios. When he does émerge from the confines of soundproof rooms, you owe it to yourself to see this dynamic performer in a rare live appearance. Dave brings to the stage an abundance of good old fashioned showmanship and fun. He is continued on page 3...

also bringing to the Long Beach show a sneak peak at some of the new songs he is working on for his next album due out around March of next year.

The weekend of August 18th

through the 20th is so packed with WAVE artist performances, you may want to just call in sick the following Monday. The Gas Company's LA a la Carte is returning to its location in Westwood this year. Some of the acts appearing on The WAVE Stage at Los Angeles' premier food and music festival are: Michael Paulo, Tom Scott, Chaquico, Jeff Craig Lorber, Rick Braun and Peter White. On August 20th, the Jine-up at JVC Jazz At The

Bowl includes Larry Carlton and Lee Ritenour together, George Duke, David Benoit and Norman Brown.

The Hollywood Bowl will be one of the hottest spots on the planet when Lee Ritenour and Larry Carlton take the stage

August 20th for the JVC Jazz At The Bowl festival. The pair of heralded guitarists have followed similar paths in their careers, but it wasn't until this year that the two collaborated. They recorded an album together called Larry & Lee.

"I'd heard about Larry ever since I was 14," Ritenour recalled. "I always admired his playing, but there was always a little wariness. Because he was the young hotshot and I was the kid on his tail." Both began doing studio dates while still in their teens. By the time they were in their

twenties they were playing three sessions a day and commanding triple-scale rates. (For the record, the only album they both remember playing on at the same time was Paul Anka's otherwise forgotten 1976 release, "The Painter.")

Last year LA a la Carte, a long standing summer tradition in Santa Monica, moved the festival to Westwood. The new location was given the unofficial name of Westwoodstock by guitarist Grant Geissman. Once again this year, the festival is at the corner of Wilshire and Veteran. The WAVE Stage will be providing music the entire weekend of August 18th through the 20th.

Returning this year for the food and music is saxophonist Tom Scott. He is performing Friday night, August 18th. Ask anyone making a living playing saxophone today who their influences are, and Tom Scott is likely to show up on their list somewhere near the top. Tom's first solo record was released in 1968, and he has 23 albums to date. If you try to count his appearances on other people's albums you would probably

lose count somewhere over 500. The Los Angeles native is an institution. You don't get much more local than the guy who

formed The L.A. Express back in 1974. In fact, his connection to the L.A. music scene is part of his heritage. His father, Nathan Scott, is a respected film composer who wrote music for the original *Dragnet*, as well as My Three Sons, Lassie, and The Twilight Zone.

Among those in the line-up on Saturday, August 19th at L.A. a la Carte are: Veteran guitarist Craig Chaquico, who after years of playing in band Jefferson **Starship** has released two critically acclaimed solo

Paul Taylor albums. Jeff Lorber, the renowned keyboardist and producer who has shaped the sound and careers of many in the world of contemporary jazz. Also on The WAVE Stage will be newcomer Paul Taylor. The saxophonist has been a performing member of **Keiko Matsui's** acclaimed band. We think you will be hearing a lot more from this rising star in the future.

On Sunday, August 20th guitarist

extraordinaire -White is scheduled at L.A. a la Carte. Two things you can count on when Peter takes the stage are; incredible feats of guitar-string gymnastics and a conga-line forming in the audience. Trumpeter and flugelhornist Rick Braun will likewise be-on The WAVE Stage Sunday. With the recent release of "Beat Street," his fourth album, Rick has established himself as a formidable force on the jazz charts. Braun is currently on tour with rocker Rod Stewart, and thanks to a break in the schedule, is able to

do some laundry and squeeze in an appearance on The WAVE Stage. He has proven himself not only as an incredible player, touring with such acts as Sade, Tina Turner, War and Natalie Cole, he is an innovative composer and producer. His production credits include the critically acclaimed self-entitled album by Avenue Blue. About his song writing, he once told a journalist, "I'm a jazz player, but coming from a pop background helps keep my music accessible." His music is accessible, but you may want to throw in captivating and evocative if you are going to begin to describe it.

WAVE Music is about quality musicianship by top notch players. This is a particularly busy summer for WAVE artists in terms of touring. Take advantage of the opportunity to catch some of this music live, and experience some musical magic this summer. Remember, If you don't get a chance to see WAVE artists live, you can always find them where they live, on 94.7FM.


