Sabot goes local with Louvain

PARIS — Former NRJ group programme director Christophe Sabot is returning to an active role in the radio industry with an ambition to create France's fourth largest radio group through developing local sta-

Sabot recently joined entertainment group LV&Co, founded by TV and concert producer Gérard Louvain, as its managing director and partner. Sabot says he received several offers but chose LV&Co because of Louvain and because, after 10 years working for France's

largest commercial radio group, the move would be a real challeng,.

"I have no ego problems and it doesn't bother me at all to start all over again from scratch," Sabot tells M&M. "I had a great time at NRJ but it was time to move on."

Sabot says his ambition is to build a community of local radio stations in France, through partnerships or acquisitions,

LV&Co providing the knowhow. "I've been impressed by the development of independent local or regional stations over the past years," explains Sabot. "Year after year, their overall audience has grown. In each main city there is a

Viva Radio to become reality

COLOGNE - German music TV channel Viva has succeeded in winning a terrestrial radio licence in Germany's most populated state of North Rhine-Westphalia.

Viva's holding company Viva Media has won the licence, for two AM frequencies, in a joint venture with local commercial broadcaster NRW. The licence was awarded by the state's broadcasting authority LfR, which favoured the Viva-NRW bid over six competitors.

Viva Radio—as the station will known—will target the same 14-29 year-old demographic which the main Viva TV service aims at with a contemporary

hits format. It will broadcast via the Internet and

satellite in addition to its two medium-wave frequencies of 885 kHz (in Nordkirchen) and 702 kHz (in Jülich). A Viva source says the station will effectively act as a terrestrial support for Viva's Internet radio channel, as well as being a precursor for a future FM licence



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
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Upfront

Think local, act local.

It could be the new motto of the times, a response to the globalisation of the world and its effects on people and on mass media.

It's certainly a recipe that a few broadcasters are starting to look at seriously. Take Christophe Sabot for a start. This man has worked for 10 years in the most centralised radio group of them all—NRJ—overseeing the programming of several national networks.

As exciting as his job was, Sabot says that he has missed the local component of radio, for this is where he came from. Now, as we report in our front page story this week, Sabot is trying to reinvent himself, thinking locally, acting locally. He'll probably ultimately succeed locally as well, because he has the skills and because it may well be the right time.

With the amount of consolidation taking place in recent times on both sides of the Atlantic, radio has

had a tendency to become bland, swapping its local roots for a more secure road driven by research, costcutting and rationalisation—with the current trend for voice tracked shows at the big US groups arguably demonstrating the worst aspects of this.

In Europe, the trend has been for the increasing proliferation of national networks or, in countries where regulators won't permit that, through groups developing national "brands" which are locally implemented, such as Chrysalis Radio's chain of Galaxy dance stations in the UK.

The world may well have become a global village, but as a reaction to that, the search for local roots is becoming increasingly important. And no medium is

better positioned than radio to satisfy this need—it's close to the people, is in a position to react instantly to events affecting local communities and is capable of catering for the tastes and interests of its local audience.

Going back to its own roots could actually be one of the routes to radio's future.

Davis, BMG in record deal

NEW YORK — Former Arista president Clive Davis has formed with BMG a new label, J Records, in the biggest ever joint deal in the history of the record business.

Valued by an industry source at around \$170 and named after Davis' middle initial, J Records is a 50/50 private joint venture between the legendary executive and BMG Entertainment. BMG president/CEO Strauss Zelnick says: "We're not disclosing terms, but the figure rep-

resents the largest commitment ever made to a joint venture in the record business."

Davis, who founded Arista and headed it for 25 years, says: "BMG and Strauss made it abundantly clear from the beginning that we would create something unprecedented—an instant major company. Any new artist being competed for or important artists wanting to make a new association will want to compete in the finals with us."

The first acts on the label will be boy band O-Town, along with debut artists Olivia, Alicia Keys and Jimmy Cozier, with initial releases due in October.

Zelnick stresses he will play no active role in running the label. "BMG's role is as financier and worldwide distributor," he says. "We will have zero management involvement, except to the extent that we can be supportive," adding:

"Clive will make his own decisions about management and management succession."

Davis has established a team of executive players including former executive vice president at Arista,

Charles Golstuck, who takes up the role of chief operations officer.

Goldstuck confirmed that a publishing venture will be developed "in the next few months," and "we expect that it will be associated with BMG." Other future ventures include divisions for soundtracks and for motion picture and TV opportunities for artists.

Meanwhile, Davis will continue hands-on production involvement in future projects by Arista artists, such as Whitney Houston and Carlos Santana.

Cheiron closes after eight years

STOCKHOLM — Cheiron, the Swedish production company behind the music of Britney Spears, the Backstreet Boys and 'N Sync, will be closing its doors at the end of the year.

The news follows the death of Cheiron's co-founder Denniz Pop, who died of cancer in 1998. In a statement the company said: "We feel that the hype of Cheiron has become bigger than [the business] itself and it's time to quit while we're ahead. We want Cheiron to be remembered as it is today."

The Cheiron studio in Stockholm was formed in 1993 by Pop and Tom Talomaa, who had begun their collaboration at SweMix Records in 1989, spawning hits with artists such as Dr Alban, Kayo and DaYeene.

Cheiron widened the duo's musical repertoire beyond dance, producing Swedish artists Ace Of Base, Leila K and Jessica, and international acts Westlife, Five, Boyzone, 3T, Bryan Adams and Céline Dion.

But it was the enormous successes of Zomba artists Britney Spears and the Backstreet Boys that was a major factor in putting the Stockholm studio on the map.

Zomba's Stockholm office opened in June 1997 next door to Cheiron, after an agreement was signed between the two companies. Zomba Sweden MD Magnus Bohman says: "The Cheiron producers played an enormous part in the successful launches of new artists, and I think we will work a lot with them in the future as well. But now, we'll have to compete with the other record companies in getting new artists produced by them."

It is understood that Cheiron's best known producer Max Martin will continue to work with studio founder Tom Talomaa.



Record Austrian sales up 10% ON THE BEAT

VIENNA — Austrian record sales jumped 10% in the first half of the year—the highest growth rate of any European country, according to figures released by IFPI Austria.

About Sch2 billion (€133 million) was spent on singles and albums between January and June in a country of eight million inhabitants. And, although 1999 was a weak year for general European sales with few notable new releases, the first half of 2000 brought a "boom throughout Austria," in the words of IFPL spokesman Thomas Boehm.

Despite international acts scoring well, particu-

larly Santana and Eiffel 65, about 15% of the singles and albums purchased during the first half of the year were produced domestically. Compilations produced specifically for the Austrian market, such as Wickie, Slime and Piper, Ö3 Great-

est Hits and Bravo performed particularly well.

Industry sources suggest that the growth may have been partly fuelled by a new Saturday afternoon Austria

Top 40 TV programme, aired by public broadcaster ORF, and the increasing number of music stations on the airwaves since Austrian commercial radio finally debuted in 1998.

Singer Anton aus Tirolalias Gerry Friedle—is also being held responsible for the boom. Despite receiving virtually no airplay, his self-titled novelty single sold more than 140,000 copies domestically, while

the album has sold about 40,000 copies. "It's one of the most successful, if not the most successful single in Austria, ever, says EMI Austria managing director

Erich Krapfenbacher.

Although it's too early to predict sales figures for the second half of the year, IFPI Austria expects sales will be up 5-10% on last year.

West Midlands licence battle underway

LONDON — An AC/talk mix is the most popular format among applicants hoping to win the biggest commercial radio licence to be advertised in the UK for two years.

UK regulator the Radio Authority (RA) has received 12 applications for the West Midlands licence, which covers around 2.3 million adults in central England, taking in Birmingham, Wolverhampton and Walsall.

One of the most high-profile applications comes from the GWR Group, which is proposing an AC/Rock format with The Storm. Chairman of the Storm is promilocal businessman John Towers, chairman of the Rover car group. Also going for the "adult" music market but with a greater amount of news and talk are Today FM (under former

BRMB/Birmingham David Bagley); Big FM (backed by The Wireless Group); Central Radio (with former CLT-UFA UK boss Travis Baxter on board) and Variety FM (The Guardian Media Group, GMG).

The Variety FM application is headed up by GMG's John Myers, who has a



track-record at winning licences for stations which blend AC music with locally-relevant speech. He has previously won key regional licences for Border TV (Century Radio) and for GMG with Real Radio.

applicant The only proposing a mainly new

music format is N-Joy Radio, which promises to mix "credible" chart music with more specialist alternative rock and dance for a 15-34-year-old audience. At the other end of the age spectrum, Saga Radio is proposing a MOR/talk station to appeal to the over 50s.

Three applicants are proposing specialist music formats—country music station Route 105, Jazz FM and Christian music service Voice FM. Meanwhile, the multi-ethnic Radio Minar and Asian service Spice FM aim to cater for sections of the West Midlands' large ethnic population.

proposing Applicants mixed music and speech services have their sights set on the audience of local public full-service station BBC Radio WM, which currently attracts a 12.1% share in the region.

SPANISH SPENDING HABITS REVEALED

MADRID — Last year, Spaniards spent an average of Pta2,446 (€14.70) each on CDs and cassettes, compared to Pta2,006 on the cinema, according to a report on cultural spending habits compiled by the Spanish authors' and publishers' society SGAE. Spending on sound carriers fell slightly from the 1998 average of Pta2,511, but the report said this could be put down to an increase in piracy. The average entry price for poprock concerts was Pta1,843, but the report points out that a surprising 74.4% of all pop concerts were free events staged by local authorities or other institutions, especially during Spain's summer "fiesta" season. The report stresses that the actual amount spent per head by music lovers is much higher than the average figures indicate, since 44.2% of Spaniards never buy recorded music carriers, 76.7% never go to pop concerts and 90.5% never attend classical music concerts.

STOCKHOLM — MTV is moving its Nordic division from London to Sweden as part of the network's stratof regionalisation across Europe.

From November 1, the Scandinavian office-located in Stockholm but up to now used only for sales and marketing-will also house a production team headed up by programme and production manager Mats Jankell, formerly project leader for entertainment at Swedish national channel

In addition to providing

home-grown output for MTV Nordic in Sweden, Denmark, Norway and Finland, the Stockholm production unit is also expected to produce programmes that will be taken by other MTV European regions.

Jankell explains: "My ambition is to create an exclusive Nordic programme format to attract

young listeners not only in the Nordic countries but also in the rest of Europe."

As with the recent launch of MTV France (M&M, July 1), English is will be used as the main language on MTV Nordic, mainly because of

the different languages spoken in the various Nordic territories.

Jankell will have four senior people working with him. Anna Marselius will be responsible for talent and artist relations; Cathrin

Whyrén, formerly music programmer at Stockholm Modern AC Wow!105.5, will have the same

role at MTV Nordic; Kjetil Njoten will be on-air producer responsible for graphics and programme promotion; and Marit Kringstad, who has been recruited from Sweden's TV3, will be the programme scheduler.

Young gun forces industry to grow up

an Clarke is only 23 years old. He looks even younger. But with his Freenet software system, he's about to unleash a file-swapping mechanism that will make Napster's controversial system look like child's play.

The goal is to apply the Internetdistributed Freenet, currently undergoing tests, to digitally delivered music, other entertainment content and information, and make them all freely available to anyone. The move is likely to force recording industry executives to do some grown-up reevaluation of their business.

At least, that's what London-based Clarke, now dubbed a "Web anarchist" by the media, says, and it's difficult to argue with him. US-based lobby group Business Software Alliance, is forced to agree. In Time magazine he said: "The problem [with going after Freenet] is there is no there there."

Clarke, who's set up a company called Uprizer with venture capital cash, will be based in Los Angeles but still wants to establish where he's coming from. He agrees that file sharing systems, such as Napster, are illegal. As a software producer himself, he believes that all creative people should be rewarded.

But piracy isn't the problem, he argues. The predicament lies with copyright legislation. "The music industry claims that piracy is hurting the artist," he says. "The reality, however, is that the vast majority of people who produce music don't benefit from copyright." Clarke maintains that record companies represented by organisations such as the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA) and international labels federation IFPI operate a cartel: "If they don't give you a recording contract, you can't distribute your music."

Unlike operations such as Napster,

Clarke insists that Freenet isn't breaking any law. And here comes the clincher. "We're just ignoring the law," he says. "We start with the assumption that the copyright law doesn't exist."


So how does Freenet (freenet. sourceforge.net) actually work? The concept came to him while studying Artificial Intelligence and Computer Science at university. The third beta test for the technology kicked off last month.

Volunteers

Tried and tested by more than 25 highly supportive volunteers world-wide, Freenet stores any type of online content, including music. Still in the early stages of development,

the system is known mostly to a handful of interested parties—online aficionados and anti-piracy detectives. Clarke is adamant that once high-speed broadband Internet connection becomes widespread, there'll be no stopping it.

The core Freenet software is never in one place or server that can be located. Other file-swapping technology such as MP3.com, Napster and Gnutella (developed by America Online staff) originate from one particular place, which lawenforcement officials can close down to prevent illegal trading of copyright material.

"There's no way of telling who's placed information on the system because it's constantly moving around," Clarke explains. "Even if I was brainwashed by aliens who demanded I shut down Freenet, it couldn't be done either by me or appeare else."

by me or anyone else."

Although the RIAA and other music industry trade bodies have not been in touch, Clarke is aware that they're keeping a close eye on him. "[The RIAA's] Hilary Rosen did suggest that Freenet might be subject to the next legal action [after Napster]," he says.

Cyber-buccaneer

So what prompted him to take on the role of cyber-buccaneer? While at Edinburgh University, Irish-born Clarke was intrigued by the idea of a system that promoted total free speech. He wanted to develop a platform that censored nothing and provided anonymity to the information's distributor. "If there's a piece of information on there that you don't like, there's nothing you can do to remove it," he says.

That's when he became intrigued about the Internet and copyright. "Any system that promotes total freedom of communication is inevitably going to make it impossible to enforce copyright law. Because copyright is censorship of sorts and I'm challenging that."

Clarke proposes that copyright, as it exists today, is effectively failing to protect the very rights that it's designed to safeguard. Artists should receive remuneration for their work, but he believes that today's concept of copyright protection is going about it the wrong way.

Floodgates

"If you made a living selling water in a desert and suddenly it started to rain, do you protest to your government to force people to buy your water from you, or do you start selling umbrellas?" Clarke argued on online financial news service CNNfn. He believes the 'Net has opened the floodgates for freely distributed music, but people will always pay for good creative work—it just depends on how you market it.

Clarke is also a big advocate of free speech, and while he admits that Freenet could potentially allow racist and bigoted views to thrive online, he maintains that history's most evil tyrants censored information to suppress free speech. The anonymity allowed by Freenet also means the tyrants won't be able to identify their critics.

It's another interesting point conjured up by the rapid development of the 'Net, and another example of how the sexy, fun-loving music industry, constantly targeting the world's youth, is being forced to confront a variety of grown-up ideas simply to protect the status quo.

The 'devil' who wants to be seen as a good guy

or a man under siege, Michael Robertson sounds rather cheerful. Bombarded by US lawsuits filed by the five multinational record companies, the CEO of MP3.com, the online music provider, has watched his company's status slump from being pioneers to violators of artists' rights.

In fact, the major labels' complaints have been so vociferous that MP3.com might as well be renamed 666.com, symbolising the devil's infiltration into the holy sanctum of all things good and sacred in the music business.

But while clarifying the company's philosophy and objectives during a Music & Media interview, a sanguine Robertson sounded positive about the legal disputes. "We're in the middle of a war today. But you've got to approach it with a smile," he says.

How long he maintains that smile will depend on his nemesis: the major record companies. His company began in 1997 as a form of online record label that encouraged

artists of all calibres to post their music on the MP3.com site and allows fans to listen to free music via streaming audio, downloading or ordering a physical CD via the Web.

In April this year, however, a New York federal judge ruled that the advertising and subscription funded MP3.com infringed the major labels' copyrights. The clincher rested on My.MP3.com, which allows MP3.com users to upload their CD collections on to the Web so they can listen to them anywhere in the world via any Internet-access device.

Following out-of-court discussions, MP3.com reached settlements with EMI, BMG Entertainment and Warner Music Group in June. They have agreed to license their music to MP3.com in return for a reported \$20 million compensation each. But there's no time for celebrations.

As of last month, Universal Music Group was still suing MP3.com, while Sony Music reached an agreement with Robertson's company. The online company's MP3Board search engine is also subject to another dispute. The My.MP3.com system has now been switched off, with digital padlocks preventing users from accessing tracks belonging to the majors. The company is waiting for agreements with all five multinationals before unlocking the system.

Moreover, the publicly quoted MP3.com's deep coffers of \$400 million in cash could soon be depleted. The company's estimated legal costs could be \$150 million-plus. In the

second quarter to June 2000, it reported a net loss of \$117 million compared with net loss of only \$18 million in the first quarter.

So why doesn't Robertson just give up? Simple: he's totally convinced that MP3.com can boost today's stagnant \$40 billion international music business. In his view, traditional record companies have two options: to allow digital delivery to render their existing main income source—the CD format—obsolete, or use MP3.com to encourage consumers to spend more on CDs.

"It's a natural progression; people want more free music," he says.

He's also quick—and proud— to list MP3.com's achievements to date. More than 80,000 artists are featured, with more than 200 artists worldwide joining daily. There are more than 500,000 songs and audio files on the system. There is also an on-demand classical music channel, a kids' music channel, and more genrebased on-demand channels will follow. MP3radio.com syndicates music by the unsigned acts on MP3.com to traditional radio stations.

Robertson supports his argument by identifying one of MP3.com's unique selling points—

you can order CDs via My.MP3 and start listening online while waiting for your order to arrive by mail.

"If you move the CD into the digital world, you'll destroy \$40 billion in revenue. But if you create a system that still depends on the physical CD, then what you're doing is holding on to the \$40 billion, while creating extra [revenue] via the digital world," he says. "We want the industry to grow to \$100 billion by rolling out new ways for people to buy and listen to music."

Complements

My.MP3.com, he stipulates, does precisely that. In order for consumers to use the system, they have to go out and buy the CDs they want to listen to online. And they can't send what they've uploaded on My.MP3 to friends. "My.MP3.com doesn't cannibalise, it complements," Robertson declares.

And unlike Napster, MP3.com compensates artists, depending on their popularity among online audiences. Its Payback for Playback program kicked off last November, using about \$1 million each month (raised from advertising revenues), to reward artists whose tracks prove popular with online fans.

Robertson believes future consumption of music online will be similar to cable-delivered pay-TV, where viewers pay a monthly subscription fee for uncontrolled access to free basic programming, paying extra for fewer ads and premium programmes.

In all, Robertson argues that the service provides new avenues for promoting artists to maintain a healthy music industry. Yet, despite reaching amicable but costly agreements with the majors, he can't hide his anger and frustration. "If you look at the big brouhaha about tape recorders when they first came out, they said this was killing the music industry. Instead, it grew the industry," he says. "There's a history of new technology being considered a threat, but as it develops, it turns out to be a boon."

He's also suspicious of the motives behind the Secure Digital Music Initiative, which brought together record companies, electronic goods manufacturers and technology specialists to digitally distribute music securely.

"People don't want to be told how they can use the music they have paid for," he says. "If someone buys a CD, you need to give them more ways to listen to that music. SDMI is about fewer ways."

Robertson believes that when a person buys a CD, he or she is acquiring a personal licence to listen to the music, even if they want to copy it on to cassette tape. "Our system allows consumers to copy music they've purchased online. But the music industry is saying we've created a database without a licence," he says.

But he remains confident that the agreements with the majors will enable them to see the benefits of MP3.com and realise that he's actually one of the good guys and not the devil they've made him out to be.

Dance grooves

NORWEGIAN MAGIC

Kicking off with a sweeter than sugar cello refrain The One



by Voodoobeats (BMG/Norway) also has several other highly attractive aspects. Singer Ani has a magnificently syrupy voice, the song features some sublime, dark chord sequences and...the cello's keep coming back. That aside it is a fine, if mildly unconventional, pop tune. While the radio edit is mellow

and eminently programmable the Club Mix is sufficiently trancy to create complimentary dancefloor momentum.

RIGHT ON

Rightly tipped as the next "bomb" from German production powerhouse Peppermint Jam Records Her Song by MKL vs. Soy Sos has an engaging lead vocal that recalls the dulcet tones of Eddie Grant. Happily it also has something of the hook-laden nature of Grant's most successful work wrapped up in a warm, brass heavy production. This is topped off with a sensual sax solo plus a Mariachi-trumpet break that Herp Albert would be proud to claim. House music at its sexy best with, thanks to the full-blooded vocal, has every chance of seeing broadcast action.

A mean and moody house tune with a pop refrain, Demon vs. Heartbreaker's You Are My High (SMALL/France), is a bit of a mixed bag. The music is really quite adventurous, being dominated by a genteely scything post-industrial syncopation while the vocal and upper register instruments are swathed in enough echo to drown a cat. Although this could easily be a pop song with a cleaner, less troubling production it remains an intriguing deep house track-albeit one with a diva's voice floating around the mix like a balloon without a string.

WELL PHAT

Featuring a phenomenally crunchy, upfront synth bass sound the aptly named Phat & Phunky by The Phunky-Tec Brothers (Mo'Bizz/Netherlands) is second generation hard house at its best. The total absence of vocals precludes the chance of any serious crossover action but this is, by any standards, a classic floorfiller. Dramatic, highly effective drops and big, spacy instrumental interludes are interspersed with some standard riffing which in turn piles on the excitement for the return of the hook. One of the better tunes of this year from the currently somewhat confused Dutch underground scene.

Although it obeys few of the genre rules that inform contemporary ideas of dance music Afrobeat certainly has a similar effect. On The Shrine-Afrobeat(Ocho/UK) the name of Fela Kuti's legendary Lagos club is evoked as an umbrella for a style of music born in the '60s that is again proving to be both relevant, fresh and increasingly influential to a new generation of musicians.

The artists here, King Sunny Ade, Fela Kuti, Tony Allen + Africa 2000 and Manu Dibango amongst them, mix sublime beats with soul jazz, hi-life, ju ju even electro on Captain Yabba's juddering Yaba Funk—and, on Bantous Jazz Watchi Wara, a very African take on bossa nova. The inscrutable King Sunny Ade is at his sinuous best on Synchro System while N.E.P.A. Dance Dub sees Fela's former drummer Tony Allen being characteristically ahead of his time. Living history.

Ween's recipe for acceptance

As marketing strategies go, sending the gentlemen, and ladies, of the press the new Ween record White Pepper accompanied by a cook book could be said to take the biscuit. Or to be more precise, the pepper; for it was recipes for this most versatile of green, red and yellow vegetables that the band's UK label Mushroom included in their promotional mailout earlier this summer, as Ween product manager Nigel Adams explains. "They're very different to a lot of the bands on the label,'

Adams says, "so any marketing tries to be as imaginative as the band [and they] really liked the White Pepper cook book. So it's more difficult [with Ween] but also a lot of

A traditional guitar band Ween are not. Now on their seventh album, the US five-

piece are legendary among their fanbase for three-hour live shows reminiscent of the Grateful Dead and for a slightly off-kilter, lighthearted approach to their music demonstrated in songtitles like Bananas And Blow.

They're also not afraid to slam their US label, Elektra, for what guitarist Mickey Melchiondo sees as negligence. "The record company here really don't support us very much," he says after lamenting the departure of their A&R man to RCA. "Even If You Don't was the first single [off White Pepper] in the States," he continues, "it was getting airplay but I don't know what's happened to it." But criticism of the label is a little harsh given that the guitarist concedes, "in the big cities like Chicago or New York we play to 2,000 people per night," and that "we're playing on Letterman for the first time two nights from now then we go to Japan."

In the UK and Europe, the band are happier with the attitude of Mushroom. "They're a great record company," stresses Melchiondo.
"They exploded Ween in Australia and did a great job with Push The Little Daisies and made it a hit." What has helped relations with Mushroom is the success of the band's last single Stay Forever in the UK, which was Single Of The Week on BBC Radio 1's (CHR) midmorning Simon Mayo show and C-listed on the BBC's national AC/MOR Radio 2 station.

Despite having what Mushroom's Nigel Adams describes as "such a strong fan base,"

Ween were still surprised at how the British media recently warmed to the band. "They've never been particularly kind to Ween," admits the guitarist. "I've seen the press and only one country is remarkably cruel to Ween and it's England."

Adams thinks the change in

attitudes is because "the current album is a lot more of a commercial cross-over. The next single, Even If You Don't, is the big single [with] the video made by the directors of South Park." But it's not just the creators of Kenny who are famous fans, reveals Adams. "They have very high profile fans [including] the guitarist from Limp Bizkit, Queens Of The Stoneage, David Duchovny, Beastie Boys, and Spike Jonze was going to make the last video."

But the important factor for Mushroom with the new single is not celebrity endorsements but having Ween in the country to help with promotion. "It's [been] difficult not having the band over [previously]," continues Adams, explaining that "they've been touring the States for the past three months." Last weekend the band played the Reading and Leeds Festivals and headline at the London Astoria on September 7.

Nothing less than No.1 for Krezip

The combination of teenage performers and the music industry almost automatically evokes images of sugar-coated pop songs.

But in recent weeks, poppy Dutch punk rock band Krezip have been busy distorting that notion with their edgy debut album

Nothing Less (WEA). Topping Holland's Mega Top 100 Albums chart on July 1, it has remained there selling over 150,000 copies and is now heading towards double platinum status in the Netherlands.

"When I first saw them in January 1999, I was completely won over," recalls Warner A&R manager Menno Timmerman. "[But] as they A&R were only schoolkids, I wasn't

prepared to join in a crazy and irresponsible bidding war, which would be counterproductive for a band that young.

Through the grapevine, Timmerman found out the band, fronted by enigmatic 17-year old lead singer Jacqueline Govaert, wanted to do everything themselves-even their management is handled by two of their fathers. "I only got in touch with Krezip when they independently released a CD demo dubbed Run Around," continues

Timmerman. Shortly after its autumn '99 release, the band broke its own "do-it-yourself" credo, by closing a distribution deal with PIAS. "Then I thought, 'now is the time to take action'," says Timmerman. "They told me that they could no longer do it on their own terms completely. That's where Warner got aboard."

On May 5, Warner released second single Nothing Less, shortly before the quintet prestigious played the Festival Pinkpop Landgraaf on June 11. For Jacqueline Govaert, that was a key event in the band's career to date. "Performing at that festival was the highest achievement ever," she says.

Five days after Pinkpop, I Would Stay was commercially released on June 16. It peaked

at number two in the Dutch Mega Top 100 singles chart, where it has remained selling over 80,000 copies along the way. That success kept up public interest in the parent album-which had already been certified gold for selling in excess of 40,000 copies and rose to the number one slot. Although currently Krezip's success is confined to the Benelux region, Warner is expected to confirm international release dates shortly.





The weekly dance chart comment by Harald Roth

The story of the week is the performance of Madonna's Music (Maverick/Warner).

Although radio intstantly took the track to its heart, rendering it a radio hit, clubland has taken a while to catch the bug. This week, however, the cut debuts on club charts in Germany, Sweden, Finland

and the Czech Republic enough to send La M storming into our chart at number 12.



a couple of weeks what she did with Frozen in 1998—take over the number one spot without even breaking sweat.

While no single record moves in or out of this week's top ten, there are some significant moves inside. Wink feat. Lil' Louis' How's Your Evening So Far? (French Kiss) (Ovum) makes the biggest jump, from ten to four, due to club chart debuts in Germany, The Netherlands and Poland, as well as an increase in sales.

Baby D's Let Me Be Your Fantasy (Production House/Systematic) debuted at 38 four weeks ago because of its success in the UK. It now returns to the chart at 14, a resurgence that's based on club chart debuts in Germany and Belgium.

Also a slow starter, Delano's I Want You (Subliminal) now appears on new EMI U.K. dance label Credence and currently sits proud at the top of the UK club chart. It finally debuts at on the Dance Traxx at 24, having failed to enter under its previous stewardship. Another top 40 debut comes from Kontor Records staffer and deejay/producer Markus Gardeweg, who debuts straight at 37 with Push (Kontor).

Darude's Sandstorm is the undisputed track of the summer. At the corresponding stage last year, Eiffel 65's Blue (Da Ba Dee) (Skooby/Bliss Co.) was the number one track and 1998's summer hit was Stardust's Music Sounds Better With You (Roulé).



Beware, the American pop/rap-crossover dragon has returned to breathe fire into the European Radio Top 50.

The catchy title track of Sisqo's Unleash The Dragon (Def Soul/Mercury) album is this



week's only new entry at 47. The former Dru Hill member has already sold five million albums in the US, while the fourth single from the album, Incomplete, has just hit number one in the Billboard Hot 100.

In Europe, it was Thong Song, accompanied by that imfamous beach which broke him. The track peaked at number 14 in June in M&M's European airplay chart.

German urban station Jam FM in Berlin has already been playing Incomplete, but has now decided to switch back to the Oliver Silk remix of Unleash the Dragon. Frank Nordmann, programme director at Jam FM, explains: "The normal radio mix sounds too European for our station!" The enormous success in the US for Sisqo is, according to Nordmann, "due to the status of Dru Hill, and the fact Sisqo is offering credible rap with huge crossover potential.'

Nordmann is also involved in marketing the station by, in his words, "tearing down some walls on advertisement agency's heads." One high-profile feature he has been heavily involved in was the station's live broadcasts from Popkomm. Popkomm 2000 was Jam's fourth consecutive year at the event and, as well as offering his listeners a look into what is happening in the music industry, Nordmann interviewed guests such as Dough E. Fresh.

The station is currently pushing The Next Episode by Dr. Dre and Snoop Dogg (Interscope) with over 100 plays a month. Nordmann's tips for the future are German signing Four Colourz with Dog Me Out (Ariola) and Things I've Seen by Spooks (Epic), a Fugees-like tune.

Jam FM reaches an average of 61,000 listeners an hour, mainly via cable transmission, says Nordmann. "That might increase with a surprise move later this year," he adds, intriguingly.

On top of the Top 50, Robbie Williams has secured his position with Rock DJ (Chrysalis) by gaining increased airplay in Scandinavia and Holland. Meanwhile, more support from stations in Scandinavia and Germany has enabled Madonna's *Music* (Maverick/Warner) to be this week's greatest chart points gainer.

Four re-entries emerge: Red Hot Chili Peppers with Californication (Warner Bros.) at 36-thanks to the impact of the video; Raemonn flies back in with Supergirl (Virgin) at 44; Corazon Espinado by Santana (Arista) returns due to increased A-list plays at 49; and Take A Look Around by Limp Bizkit (Interscope), one place lower, is profiting from the band's extensive touring and performances at outdoor festivals.

Finally, bubbling under and likely to enter the next few weeks are Black Coffee by All Saints (London), Babylon by David Gray (IHT/East West), Spanish Guitar by Toni Braxton (LaFace/Arista), You See The Trouble With Me by Black Legend (Rise), and In Demand by Texas (Mercury).

is signed to Virgin world music imprint Yerbabuena and in France, as leader of the group El Cuarteto Patria, who were responsible for last year's Sublime Ilusion LP.

El Cuarteto Patria celebrates its 60th anniversary this year, and Ochoa-who has been its leader since 1978—decided to honour the occasion by choosing 13 songs that he felt best represented the quartet's history. Building on the momentum generated by this album and the success of the Wenders movie, Ochoa releases Tributo Al Cuarteto Patria on September 25.

Underlining the importance of the release to Virgin/Yerbabuena, the label is running a marketing campaign unprecedented for a Virgin Spain artist. Virgin Spain label manager, Fernando Martinez, says that the company is attempting to develop an Eliades Ochoa trademark and that "the best way to do this is by natural process, for the message to seep through to the public that Eliades is formidable in his own right and dominates the full spectrum of traditional Cuban music."

Tributo is consequently a mix of traditional Latin musical styles son, bolero and guaracha, all played with an effervescence reminiscent of the group's on-stage celebrations. Martinez reveals: "He [Onchoal is also a monster on stage...and is now our most important international artist.

The promotional campaign will include a tie-in with French-owned record and book retailer FNAC. He added: "The Buena Vista experience was sensational, but El Cuarteto Patria will shine on long after that light has dimmed."

GetMusic partners with BOL for Europe

LONDON — GetMusic, the US online music store jointly owned by BMG Entertainment and the Universal Music Group, has finalrevealed its international expansion plans.

They will see Bertelsmann's BOL.com, which is already present in 14 countries in Europe and Asia, handle all physical sales and fulfilment for GetMusic's localised sites outside the US.

GetMusic's sites (including its soon-to-be-launched local Euro-

pean sites) currently feature e-commerce facilities plus exclusive entertainment content such as superstar interviews, breaking news stories and interactive games. These items will also now be available on BOL's sites. "BOL doesn't produce a lot of content itself," explains GetMusic's

president and CEO in New York, Andrew Nibley. "So we shall be providing that.

Meanwhile, visitors to GetMusic's existing sites from outside the US looking to purchase physical sound recordings will be directed to the co-branded BOL pages, which will effectively act as Get-Music's non-US stores.

The co-operation is starting on

BOL's sites in the UK, Germany, Switzerland, the Netherlands and France, where BOL's arch rival Amazon.com has just launched a French site.

After Europe, GetMusic will roll out to other regions, with plans to be in Japan before the year ends. But Nibley emphasises that, outside Europe, his company will consider other content partners for other markets. "In each place, we shall see who's the best content partner," he says.

Heinz Wermelinger, BOL.com's president and CEO, says: "This

deal creates a clear win-win situation for both [BOL and GetMusic], allowing each of us to capitalise on the strength of the other."

The link-up also hints at the continuing trend of consolidation within the Internet sector, according to Simon Dyson, music analyst at UK research compa-

ny Market Tracking International. "There seems to be consolidation everywhere," he notes. "More than just sharing resources, Get-Music and BOL seem to be limiting and streamlining the different companies and outlets for their music." Dyson believes that, in Europe, GetMusic will benefit hugely from BOL's more established brand name.

major local station on a par with national networks or even outperforming them. It's where I want to go. Besides, I started my career in local stations and it's really the nuts and bolts of radio.

LV&Co operates Paris-based Dance station Voltage FM and the small Gold network MFM. Sabot's first priority is the reformatting of Voltage as a Paris city station with an upbeat Urban format catering for the 15-34-year-old age group.

MFM will also be reformatted, as an AC station targeting an over-40 female audience with popular French music from the '70s and the '80s featuring strong local content.

At LV&Co, Sabot will have full licence develop the group's strategy, alongside deputy managing director Jean-Marc Morandini. Last June, Louvain acquired Morandini's Internet company Tout Est Net, which will provide the foundation for the group's Internet development. A music portal is currently under construction, and sites for both MFM and Voltage will be launched by the end of the year.

As part of a major management shake up, Telefonica has appointed Juan José Nieto president of Telefonica Media, its affiliate comprising all the media assets of the Spanish telecoms giant, including Onda Cero Radio. Nieto replaces Manuel Garcia Duran, who fell from grace after Telefonica chief executive Juan Villalonga resigned in July.

The new managing director of French radio group LV&Co, Christophe Sabot, tells Hotline that a major financial organisation is set to become a partner in the company. Expect an announcement by mid-September.

And talking about new shareholders, French indie label Naïve, launched three years ago by former Virgin France chairman Patrick Zelnik, has a new financial backer in the shape of state-owned financial group Caisse des Depots. The amount of investment has not been disclosed.

Michael Guldhammer has left his A&R post at Universal Denmark to start a new management company, to be called Goldmind. At Universal, Guldhammer worked with acts such as Aqua, Hampenberg, Freya and Christina.

The world's biggest radio merger is finally official-US-based Clear Channel Communications has completed its \$23.8 billion buyout of its former US rival AMFM. However, under antitrust regulation the newly-merged company is being forced to sell off 108 of its radio stations, leaving it with a mere 900 radio stations and 19 TV stations...

Stockholm-based indie label group Music Network is laying off 13 of its 85 employees, and will scale down its international licensing deals from 300 labels to 100 by the end of the year. CEO Peter Yngen tells Hotline that the Swedish offices-in Stockholm, Malmö, Umeå and Gothenburg—are all likely to be affected; affiliates in Oslo, Copenhagen and Tampere, Finland, will remain intact.

Finally, Hotline has learned that American producer, composer, and executive David Foster will be the Midem 2001 Personality of the Year at the annual music trade show, to be held January 21-25 in Cannes. Foster has penned songs for Whitney Houston, Celine Dion, and Barbra Streisand, and operates the 143 Records label.
