Here at last: Universal, Sony debut music downloads service Pressplay

NEW YORK — Pressplay, the longawaited music downloads platform jointly owned by Sony Music Entertainment and Universal Music

Group, started trading in the US on December 19, three months behind schedule.

The service is available through MSN Music, Roxio and Yahoo!, and will soon be

offered through MP3.com and other affiliates. Limited to a small number of platforms in its first few weeks, the service plans to broaden its reach after the New Year.

Pressplay will offer access to an unspecified number of tracks from the catalogues of Sony Music, Universal Music and EMI Music, as well as many independents.

When discussing the service at Popkomm in August, Jean-Marie Messier, chairman/CEO of Universal Music's parent company Vivendi

Universal promised Pressplay would have an attractive pricing structure and would allow consumers to stream audio, download tracks and burn tracks onto CSD.

Four specific monthly offers are currently available to US consumers:

14-day Free Trial: 200 streams, 20

- downloads (for a limited time only);

 Basic Plan \$9.95: 300 streams,
- Basic Plan \$9.95: 300 streams,
 30 downloads;
- Silver Plan \$14.95: 500 streams, 50 downloads, 10 burns;
- Gold Plan \$19.95: 750 streams, 75 downloads, 15 burns;

● Platinum Plan — \$24.95: 1000 streams, 100 downloads, 20 burns.

As a special limited offer at launch, Pressplay will offer the Silver Plan at the Basic Plan price of \$9.95, but the offer will be limited to the first 90 days of the member's paid subscription.

"For people passionate about music, today marks a new way to experience the world's most popular music that is easy-to-use, reliable, and secure," commented Pressplay president and CEO Andy Schuon in a statement. "We have worked hard to create a compelling online music experience, with unique programming, a broad selection of the world's most popular music and the freedom of portability."

No details were unveiled about the service's availability in Europe, although initial plans call for a rollout during the first half of 2002.

Parlophone open up Finn's crowded house

LONDON — Sometimes you can't look a gift horse in the mouth.

Last April, on the eve of the release of his second solo album *One Nil*, former Crowded House leader Neil Finn again found himself "interested in collaborating, as I was no longer in a band."


Rather than go through the process of auditioning new faces, he came upon the idea of recruiting an all-star cast of performers to join him in a residency at St James' Theatre in his hometown of Auckland, New Zealand from April 2-6.

"I'd run into [Radiohead's] Ed O'Brien a number of times and similarly [Pearl Jam's] Ed Vedder, and I met [The Smiths'] Johnny Marr last year at the Linda McCartney tribute show," he told M&M at the time. Several phone calls later, Finn had assembled his dream team with the additional help of his brother Tim, Lisa Germano and Phil Selway from Radiohead.

Quick to spot a great opportunity, Finn's record label Parlophone decided to record the shows and compile a live album and concert performance DVD entitled 7 Worlds Collide, which was released worldwide on November 26. At the request of the artists, all profits from the recordings are going to the charity Medecins Sans Frontieres to assist with its work in Afghanistan.

Although the album has yet to enter M&M's European Top 100 Albums chart, according to EMI International

Radio France makes Le Mouv' into Paris

Paris — Public broadcaster Radio France's alternative rock station Le Mouv' has finally secured an FM frequency in Paris, in addition to another new frequency in Clermont-Ferrand in central France.

In Paris, the Toulouse-based network takes over a frequency formerly used by another Radio France network, classical and jazz station France Musiques, which had previously been operating on two frequencies in order to cover the city adequately. "Work carried out by [telecommunications companyl TDF on the Eiffel Tower this summer allowed France Musiques to be transmitted on just one frequency, therefore freeing up the second," explains Le Mouv' managing director Marc Garcia.

SRN, the trade group representing national commercial broadcasters, has been quick to criticise the decision made by French regulator the CSA to approve Le Mouv's new fre-



quency. "Radio France should not have the monopoly of access to these reserved frequencies," said SRN president Marc Pallain in a statement.

But, counters Garcia, "Radio France has given back 200 unused frequencies in numerous regions since the arrival of [Radio France president] Jean-Marie Cavada. In

Clermont-Ferrand, for example, we gained one frequency, but have already given back two. The situation in Paris is the same—France Culture returned its dual frequency. Given that Radio France predates commercial radio, it is true that it has a large number of frequencies. But we give them back."

With these two latest frequencies, Le Mouv' will go from covering five million to 16 million people by the end of the year, says Garcia, who expects Le Mouv' to eventually expand even further.

Garcia emphasises that the station can play an important role in the development of new talent. "It's a public service radio. As it is not commercial, it has a lot of freedom... as a result, the space left to new talent is slightly larger."

Absolute Radio reveals its UK partners

LONDON - What do a trendy dance brand, a Northern lrish TV broadcast-

er and a German radio group all have in common?

The answer is that Ulster TV, Cream and German radio grouping Eurocast are all partnering with Absolute Radio International (ARI) to develop radio interests in the UK.

Pan-European radio group ARI was founded last year by former Capital Radio group head of programmes Clive Dickens and Capital's former head of international development Donnach O'Driscoll (M&M, August 11, 2001).

The Absolute Radio UK (ARUK) affiliate has been set up specifically to make applications or new radio licences in Britain advertised by the Radio Authority (RA).

The first major licence to be con-

tested by ARUK will be the East Midlands regional licence next year. ARUK is proposing a new-music station Jump FM, which will blend modern rock and dance.

Jump FM's format has been designed to compete

directly with UK public CHR station BBC Radio 1, and Dickens claims that research conducted in the

region shows a desire for a station that combines both rock and dance. "The revival in rock and the arrival of nu metal has been significant," he says. "If you're going to target 30-somethings, then you'll play dance; but if you want to target teenagers and

20-somethings, dance music is only one of the music genres they want to listen to."

Dickens says that the link-up with Cream represents a new way for radio companies to work with major consumer brands. "We're bringing brands into ownership, rather than just advertising or sponsorship." He also notes that Cream is interested in diversifying its brand and developing other brands.

Of ARUK's other partners, Ulster TV (UTV) is one of the two remaining independent commercial terrestrial TV operators in the UK (Virgin Radio's owners SMG being the other). O'Driscoll says that UTV has made "a

strategic decision to get into radio," also confirmed by its recent purchase of County Media in Ireland (M&M, November 3).

Eurocast, a radio investment house which is owned by German stations Hit Radio FFH, Radio SAW, 94.3

RS.2, Radio PSR and RSH, previously applied for the Radio Authority's regional South Wales licence that was subsequently awarded to the Guardian Media Group.



Bavarian stations boosted in independence battle

MUNICH — A group of small independent radio broadcasters in Bavaria have won a legal victory over the state's licensing authority the BLM as they attempt to avoid being bounced into unwanted mergers.

When commercial radio began in Bavaria, the BLM licensed a number of stations on shared frequencies (all broadcasting for only part of the day) in order to encourage variety. However, such frequency-sharing arrangements have confused listeners, and the BLM subsequently changed its policy, licensing no new shared frequencies and putting pressure on existing operators to merge, in order to provide a greater consistency of output on their frequencies.

Many did come together, but a few refused. Most prominent was Gerhard Prokscha of Extra Radio in Hof,

which broadcasts four hours a day on a frequency that is otherwise dominated by Radio Euroherz. Says Prokscha: "Euroherz is owned by newspaper publishers and by [Bavarian radio entrepreneur Gunther] Oschmann. They've offered us minority shareholding in a new operating company, but, against such powerful interests, we might as well give up."

The state's constitutional court last month confirmed a previous lower court decision that the BLM could not force the small stations into agreements with other operators on their frequencies.

Prokscha says Extra sees no reason to sign an agreement with Euroherz, particularly as Extra's format broadly fits with the former's output. "One of our four hours," he boasts, "has a higher percentage listenership than any other hour in Bavaria."

To fight what he sees as the domi-

nance of big operators, Prokscha has set up an association of independent stations with six others. Three of them-Extra, Aladin in Nuremburg and Radio 2Day in Munich-were involved in the court action. The latest ruling gives them legal security after a legal battle lasting nine years.

The court ruling said the independence of individual operators was paramount—and if "rock, Richard Wagner, and folk music" were all broadcast in blocs on the same frequency, the market would ultimately ensure more co-ordination.

Roland Bornemann, the BLM's legal expert, describes the court's ruling as "astonishing" and accuses the judges of "going back to their youthful experiences of steam radio."

Bornemann contends the findings contradict practical experience, and that the BLM has a responsibility to licence financially viable operations.








Some of the acts who made the industry groove in 2001. From left: U2. Kylie, Linkin Park and Gorillaz.


1) For me, challenging as usual! For Naïve, a pretty good year—we expect an increase in turnover of at least 35% over last year.

To quote Fred, their lead singer: "This time with the Naïve team, we are living a great love period". Also, as vice-president of Impala, the increasing strength of the body was illustrated by the growth of its membership—from 400 to 1,500 members all over Europe in one year.

3) Records becoming the number one TV advertised products in the country. It is very sad to see how the industry is turning records into normal consumer goods. It is also sad to listen to the same titles turning the knob of the radio. More than 10 spins a day, it's a nightmare... Needless to say that the concentration is increasing despite UPFI and Impala's actions.

4) Shakedown. An electro-funk duo we signed last summer. Their second single At Night already appears in the specialised charts in France and the UK, and radio stations such as FG are already playing the title. Naïve and I did groove Shakedown in 2001, everybody will in 2002.

5) More diversity in the charts and in the music industry. The artistic thing is more exciting than ever, and music is more and more important in people's lives. Curiously the record industry is not fully benefiting from these positive trends but I am still optimistic because I think that we have reached the bottom of a cycle. In Europe, a consumer buys an average of three CDs per year. If we could increase this figure to four it would represent a 33% increase of the record industry turnover. Needless to say that if this fourth CD was a Naïve one it would be brilliant!

Jazz 2001: How was it for you?

hat jazz artists as distinct as Diana Krall and St. Germain are selling millions of albums around the world may be a sign that jazz is recovering from a decade of eroding sales. The 14-episode Ken Burns "Jazz" documentary, aired by the BBC in June, also raised the genre's profile and spurred both renewed interest in classic jazz and sales of repertoire by iconic figures such as Louis Armstrong, Billie Holiday and Charlie Parker. The spark also saw a revival in the fortunes of jazz on the air, as programmers picked up on vocal and electronica vibes.

An important year for the genre then, and one reflected in the thoughts and opinions of leading jazz radio producers and presenters.

Frédéric Charbaut, programme manager, Paris Jazz/Paris

Artists such as St. Germain, Erik Truffaz, Laurent de Wilde, and Nils Peter Molvaer have created a new sound. Electronic jazz is a new break which we programme on Paris Jazz—I think Miles Davis would have liked and played this music. I think that vocal jazz is the best way to discover [the genre]. When you talk about voices, you immediately think of Billie Holiday, Sarah Vaughan or Ella Fitzgerald. It's very hard and courageous today to be a jazz singer—people like Kurt Elling, Diana Krall, Rene Marie and David Linx represent the future.

When re-issues of Miles Davis, John Coltrane or Duke Ellington are proposed, it's always a pleasure and an event. We programme these CDs, but new productions are more important for us. Today Europe has an important place in jazz. Many artists from France, Italy or the north of Europe can easily rival American artists. About 25 per cent of Paris Jazz programming is dedicated to European jazz.


Pino Saulo, producer, Radio RAI Suite/Rai 3/Rome

The most popular artists [of 2001] were possibly Brad Mehldau or Keith Jarrett. Also the concert of Enrico Rava and Paolo Fresu was very popular. Many listeners loved two concerts which could have been judged as difficult: "Mondo Ra"—an orchestra of young musicians devoted to the music of Sun Ra—and Annie Whitehead's "Soupsong" concert dedicated to the music of Robert Wyatt.

As for electronica, I like some stuff, such as Us 3, St.Germain. I enjoyed the Llorca album and I listen to things like the Red, Hot & Cool double CD [GRP] with Franti, MC Solaar, Lester Bowie, Ron Carter, etc. The reissue of classic albums like Coltrane's Ascension, releases by ESP or Byg Actuel, or Blue Note's Rudy Van Gelder Edition are very good because they allows listeners the chance to discover pearls and jewels.

This year we seem to have experi-

enced a northern explosion, with Swedish, Norwegian and Finnish musicians in festivals and polls. Electronic jazz seems to be the new trend, although musicians have been working in [this area] for years.

Matthias Kirsch, head of music, Jazz Radio 101.9/Berlin

The most popular new artist has to be vocalist Jane Monheit. We're always looking for new quality voices, and we have lots of young vocalists on the playlist, including Melissa Walker, Rene Marie and Carla Cook.

We've recently started a new programme called "The White Room," which features jazz electronica. Core artists would be St. Germain or

Ronnie Jordan. We also launched a Latin jazz show in March. Now that we have definitely established our main format—which is mainstream jazz—we thought we could open up on the weekends.

For major re-issues we usually mention them when playing a track by the artist, or by finding a place on our web site. Some, like the recent Miles Davis albums In A Silent Way or Bitches Brew were hard to programme simply because of the length of the tracks. France, Scandinavia and Germany are the three most important and challenging areas producing jazz right now, developing the music further but also keeping mainstream jazz alive.

David Fishel – jazz producer, NRK 2/ Oslo (Alltid Jazz:(www.nrk.no), Jazz Scene (http://jazzscene.no)

NRK is developing Alltid Jazz (Always Jazz), a 24-hour digital jazz station, and has decided to skip FM altogether. Alltid's internet launch will take place this month. The programme will be a constant loop lasting about 30 minutes, with new items inserted as needed. Depending on the success of the show, other Scandinavian services will be invited to join, making it a truly pan-Scandinavian project. Meanwhile, Jazz Scene—now internet only—is about to celebrate its 10th anniversary.

Joe Lovano is on his way to legendary status. He has a phenomenal free-flowing creativity and improvising quality that hasn't been seen since Sonny Rollins. At First Light from Silje Nergaard is an excellent album [to be released internationally on Emarcy in February]. The fact that pop, R&B, or hip-hop singers might include their interpretation of a standard on an album will help insure the popularity of jazz vocals. The mixture of DJs and live music, a really fresh jazz experience, I believe is a style pioneered in Norway and especially Oslo, at clubs like Blå (Blue).

Marco Fullone – artistic director, Monte Carlo Nights, Radio Monte Carlo/Milan

Monte Carlo Nights airs every night from 21.00–2.00 and is a mix of all styles from classic to mainstream to dance and electronica. St. Germain was one of the biggest hits this year. Also popular is Gotham Project (Ya Basta), which is a very sophisticated mix of Piazzolla, club music and jazz. We also had a big response from our audience for vocalist Rachelle Farrell. We played the 10 minute-long *I Can Explain* from the album *Individuality* (Blue Note) every night and received numerous calls and e-mails asking about this incredible voice.

In France there are many artists who take older jazz from the 50s and 60s and transform it into a new style of club music. The clubs are the centre of this evolution. It's music of the past fused with music of the future, creating a new sound but with the same mood. One of the most beautiful compilations of the year is *Trip Do Brasil*, 2 [Sony Music France].

David Carr – genre channel manager, Jazz, Blues, World Music, Music Choice/UK/Europe

We have three full time jazz channels: mainstream, which covers acoustic jazz from early through bebop to cool; modern which takes in funk, fusion, electric and avant-garde to contemporary jazz; and big bands from their beginnings to the present. This year has seen a special push for UK artists on the mainstream channel. We've had lots of good feedback on artists like vocalist Stacy Kent and Alex Wilson, winner of the BBC jazz award continued on page 8

for best newcomer. For modern jazz we did an extensive interview with Joe Zawinul.

Jazz vocals have seen a major comeback over the last few years with labels signing singers such as Sandra Wilson, Claire Martin, Nicki Leighton-Thomas and Clare Teal. Many contemporary pop artists, from Sting to Joni Mitchell have picked up on jazz and are incorporating into their music.

Because we're a pan-European service it's very important for us not to become London-centric. Sweden is very fertile ground for really good contemporary jazz. We'll soon launch a new programme featuring jazz blended with world rhythms and voices.

Roger Wright - controller, BBC Radio 3/UK

We've become known for more cutting edge jazz. As media partner for the London Jazz Festival we'll be programming 40 hours of jazz from the event. When we talk about jazz it's a much broader umbrella than before. Jazz, world music and classical no longer have the currency as categories that listeners want to put them in. There's a greater sense and embracing of many more styles and traditions, and there are many less niches to fragment the market. More kinds of music are available, so it's more easily assimilated, and the result is more styles being developed more quickly.

One of the trends which we reflect and try to contribute to is the collaboration of artists, like Courtney Pine working with Bobby Watson, or Andy Sheppard with Annie Whitehead. The station's on-line activity is driven almost exclusively by our jazz output. We have three artist presenters now: pianist Julian Joseph, and singers Stacy Kent and Claire Martin.

Steve Quirk - head of music, Jazz FM/London/Manchester

An artist who has gone from strength to strength and has huge crossover appeal is Diana Krall. In conjunction with the release of The Look Of Love [Verve] earlier this year, Jazz FM did a huge poster campaign in London with her picture and the Jazz FM logo which was quite effective. Her popularity has helped the format considerably and given it more mass appeal. George Benson's return to his jazz roots with the Absolute Benson album also pulled people in toward the genre. We generally work on a 50-50 split between vocals and instrumentals. The consensus is that people prefer vocals.

Specialist presenters definitely picked up on St. Germain, but it's not really for Jazz FM daytime airplay. The Ken Burns documentary was featured heavily by specialist presenters on the station. The smooth jazz format is particularly strong right now. Ride by Boney James (Warner) is about to go Gold after just three weeks. A new show, "Late Lounge," plays ambient jazz sounds from 22.00-1.00 weeknights.

Cream of the current crop

Pieranunzi/Johnson/Baron Play Morricone (CAM Jazz)

Pianist and 1997 Django d'Or winner Enrico Pieranunzi reveals himself as a consummate keyboard impressionist on this tribute to Ennio Morricone. Accompanied by bassist Marc Johnson and drummer Joey Baron, the album moves from the delicate Addio Fratello Crudele to the sizzling swing of La Volglia Matta. Pieranunzi's uncanny lyricism and sense of detail, welded to the beautiful and evocative melodies of Morricone's Italian songbook, place him among the most accomplished European pianists of his generation. Once again Rome's Sonic studios deliver the richest sound imaginable.


Clare Teal That's The Way It Is (Candid)

Not since the 40s have there been so many fine jazz vocalists recording and performing, making it all the more difficult to stand out from the crowd. What distinguishes Clare Teal's warm and soulful voice is her ability to turn a simple lyric like that of Harold Arlen's Ill Wind into a bluesy lament full of drama. Her own compositions, like opener Messin' With Fire, are lyrically and musically sophisticated, and her singing exudes both discipline and spontaneity. Ably aided by pianist Martin Litton and reedman Trevor Whiting, this poised CD puts Teal near the top.

Clare Teal

Salvatore Bonafede Ortodoxa (Red Records)

Lively straight-ahead session of originals by pianist Bonafede and an exceptional quintet featuring the resourceful Rosario Giuliani on alto and soprano saxes and Fabrizio Bosso on trumpet and flugelhorn. Post-bop energy melded to hints of southern European popular songmade explicit in Pasion and the pretty Federico Fellini—lend the music a festive air. On If I Were A Ball the piano, bass and drums interact marvellously, captured to perfection by Goffredo Gibellini, who ought to garner attention for his recent recordings.

Trilok Gurtu The Beat Of Love (Blue Thumb)

Produced by Wally Badarou and recorded in Bombay, Johannesburg, New York and the UK, this is perhaps the percussionist's most varied album. Featuring a handful of worldbeat stars, including Angelique Kidjo and Salif Keita, it is also his most commercial. Bottom-heavy grooves, sumptuous electronic arrangements and layered vocal choruses see this pioneer of ethno-jazz fashioning a forceful, driving collection. Its cosmopolitan ambitions are best heard on the indo-electronica of Maya and Tuhe.

Luis Bacalov Quartet Tango And Around (CAM Jazz)

An excellent addition to the growing catalogue of contemporary approaches to the venerable tango form first proposed by Astor Piazzolla. His countryman, pianist Bacalov, successfully fuses tango's dramatic and emotional language with the more anarchic jazz idiom. More meditative than rousing, these mostly original tunes approach the tango as though it were unknown territory ripe for exploration. On bandoneon, Ulises Passarella matches the leader's tone and style beautifully.

Jasper van 't Hof Un Incontro Illusorio (Challenge)

A follow-up to the wonderful Un Mondo Illusorio (1998), which featured van 't Hof improvising on the Baroque organ of the Santa Maria delle Rosa church in Bonefro, Italy. This time out, Joey Baron's drums nicely punctuate the Dutchman's Satie-like miniatures, and on *The Ultimate* the two duel in a steadily building crescendo. Slow and incantatory, this intriguing music steadily seduces the listener with its strange sounds and other-worldly invention.

Bush-the UK rock band the US loves

If Bush had a crisp green English "fiver", or an even ten bucks, for every story about their modest British profile compared to their international stardom, especially in America, they'd probably never need to record again.

Instead, the rock quartet from west London are wisely focusing on the music, touring behind their new, fourth studio album, Golden State (East West/Elektra), in a career that now embraces seven years of success and worldwide album sales of 14 million. Golden State has enjoyed healthy initial sales in such territories as Germany, Austria and Holland, while their extensive European tour continues until December 7. They resume shows in America, where lead track The People That We Love was a top ten airplay hit at both modern rock and mainstream rock formats, just two nights later.

The discrepancy in Bush's domestic and foreign standings is undeniable, but lead singer Gavin Rossdale is encouraged by the response to *Golden State*. "The reaction's been amazing, we've had excellent support from [London alternative station] Xfm, and Kerrang! and the whole metal press," he says. "We've always had



excellent support from the rock press [and] MTV's been amazing, they always have." MTV and Xfm presenter Zane Lowe describes *Golden State* as "Bush's finest album, a great rock record. They tour relentlessly, they're of the old school where you make a record and tour it really hard. And *The People That You Love* sounds great on the radio. I saw them live recently and I saw a band that had the bit between their teeth again."

Warner Music Europe marketing manager, US labels, Jacob Harregard says that Germany remains Bush's best European territory. "We're only one single in, and already past sales of 60,000 with the album there," he notes, adding that its predecessor, 1999's The Science Of Things, has sold 88,000 in Germany. "I'm pretty confident we'll pass that one," he says. "The band have done a lot of promo, and we have a second single, Headful Of Ghosts, early next year."

Rossdale maintains a healthy perspective on the fact that some members of the British media have almost made Bush-bashing a national sport. "I don't actually read anything individually, but sod's law has it that the only one I read, my mum gets upset by something, and she makes me read something really hideous. I'm going, 'Mum, I'm avoiding everything, what are you doing?" People always want to bang on about other things about our lives, but they don't quite appreciate-that's 7-8,000 people [at a gigl in London that have gone berserk. We had the influx of the nu-metal stuff [in the UK], so it's going to be really interesting to me to see whether kids say 'Hold on, we've got one of those ourselves'.'

Brothers Keepers sing out against racism

The German music industry's determination to combat racism in its country has resulted in a new initiative—Lightkultur. Released December 3 through Warner Music Germany, the album is a compilation of tracks recorded by the leading lights of Afro-German hip-hop, soul and reggae, along-side colleagues from the UK and Jamaica. All proceeds from the record and live performances will go to victims of race crimes.



The collective, known as Brothers Keepers, features artists such as Xavier Naidoo, Samy de Luxe, Brooke Russell, and Nadja from No Angels. The UK contingent is represented by Roots Manuva, Blak Twang, Creamo, among others. After the success of the first single, Adriano, which was released on July 5, 2001 and sold over 210,000 copies, the plan for an album was formulated and up and running in two months. "It is amazing how quickly

everything was produced," says Norbert Rudnitzky, head of Warner subsidiary Downbeat Records, which is co-ordinating the project. "And the artists came [in] on their own with the songs," he adds.

The original idea for the charity record came from the singer Adou and his small Cologne-based label Nitty Gritty Records. "When Adou came to us with the idea, we really wanted to do this," continues Rudnitzky. "Everyone from Bernd Dopp (Warner Music Germany president) down to the secretaries favoured this project. Even in hard times like these WEA saw that something had to be done and so we did it." Over 40 artists wrote 17 exclusive songs, and there are more on the way. "We already have enough material to fill a second album which is scheduled for release in spring 2002. The cooperation with the artists from other labels was not at all problematic. Every afro-German artist understands the importance of the topic," explains Rudnitzky.

The styles of music on the album are very diverse. While the first single Adriano was a hard rap song, on the album hiphop, soul and reggae are equally represented. As Adriano just featured male artists, their female counterparts come in the form of Sisters Keepers whose first single Liebe und Verstand (release date: January 3) is enjoying "powerplay" status on MTV. The charity performers are expected Germany tour around February/March time.

DANCE GROOVES

JAZZ SPACE ODYSSEY

Aliftree's January 2002 released album Spaced (Verve/France) contains a multiplicity of influences and ethnic references across its 10 tracks alongside excellent vocal contributions from Helen Merrill and the extraordinary Rona Hartner. fragile tones on Solitude's Song mark her out as an unusual talent in that her penchant for jazz takes the form of a delicate, naïve approach. Her voice, couched in a swirling blend of Arabic and electronic tones, comes across somewhat like the Swedish singer Tina Nordenstam. The album's other guest vocalist, Rona Hartner, is the antithesis of Merrill. Hartner's voice is pure Romanian gypsy complete with melodramatic turns of phrase and a cracked, "stagey" laugh; pure camp in other words. Anapoda, the song she is featured on, would be, thanks to its wheezing harmoniums and splendid melody, one of the album's standout moments with or without vocals. But her throaty, dynamic voice has rendered it a classic of the ethno/chill/jazz sub-genre.

CAMDEN UNDERGROUND

Despite the fact that the dance compilation business has been undeniably revived by the chill-out/lounge phenomenon, selling 25,000 copies in six weeks of an album of underground music that mixes Rai with phat beats is still quite a result. Arabesque Zoudge (React Music/UK), put together

by Momo owner Mourad Mazuz with resident DJs Boris and Stephane, comes beautifully packaged and bearing the undeniably powerful stamp of Londonbased Momo restaurant. "French compilations such as Hotel Costes have been as skilful at offering an attractive artefact as they have in compiling exceptional music," says React Music director Thomas Foley. "Packaging is important for the mature demographic." The music, happily, is just as good the cover. Kicking off with Yalili Va Aini by Jah Wobble's Invaders Of The Heart, the album takes in Rachid Taha's excellent Nokta, the sublime, flute-heavy Jonon by Stephane Malca, Raba Raba—one of Khaled's best moments, alongside contributions from Natacha Atlas, Djamel Ben Yelles and the extraordinary instrumental track Khalliouni Khalliouni by 1,2,3 Soleils. The story goes that Steve Hillage (Rachid Taha's longtime producer) found the track on an old cassette in Camden Market in London.

F COM TRIUMPH

Even by its own very high standards, it has been an exceptional year for F Communications. Llorca's debut album Newcomer has sold over 120.000 units and is now taking off in Australia just as summer breaks. Alongside that a raft of acts including The Youngsters, Readymade and Alex Kid have turned in formidable albums. 2002 looks set to be equally fruitful with albums by Soul Designer and Frederic Galliano in the first quarter.

This double A-sided single the first cut from Cypress Hill's new album Stoned Raiders, which

was released on December 3, 2001. One of the pioneers of the hip-hop rock/metal fusion, the band from LA are now on their ninth album since their self-titled debut in 1991. Trouble is a pulsating and energetic tune, juxtaposing crisp rapping and scratching with raging rock interludes, and is characterised by a catchy and haunting bass line. Meanwhile, Lowrider is a well-crafted, chilled-out hip-hop track with a slight Latin flavour to it. The title means love and intelligence in German and the song appeals for racial tolerance. The track features on the album Lightkultur by Brothers Keepers, which came out on December 3. Stephan Oettel, head of music at Urban station Jam FM in Germany, says: "It is a very ambitious project just like Brothers Keepers. Sisters Keepers have already been our guests in the studio and the Brothers Keepers/Sisters Keepers tour through Germany was a huge success—they always played sold-out venues. Musically the members of Sisters Keepers come from all different directions but they have one common goal, to be the mouthpiece for ethnic minorities in Germany.'

The weekly dance chart comment by Harald Roth

iiO's Rapture (Tastes So Sweet) (Made/Ministry Of Sound) stays at number one on the chart for the fourth consecutive week, way ahead of its closest competitor, one-time chart-topper Kylie Minogue's Can't Get You Out Of My Head (Parlophone).

Roger Sanchez feat. Armand van Helden & N'Dea Davenport's You Can't Change Me (R-Senal/Defected & Sony) is closing in on the top, up to three from last week's four. Now that Sanchez's record-setting Another Chance (R-Senal/Defected & Sony) has dropped out of the top 100, You Can't Change Me is coming into its own.

Germany's Andre Tanneberger—ATB—jumps from 11 to five this week with Hold You (Kontor). The track is toping charts at home in Germany, while debuting on charts in The Netherlands, Italy, Denmark and Norway. Meanwhile, Russia's PPK becomes the first act from eastern Europe to reach the top 10 of the Dance Traxx chart. ResuRection (Perfecto) climbs 15-10 this week, thanks to chart entries in The Netherlands, Norway and Finland and clubplay on import in Germany.

Originally from The Netherlands' United Recordings, RIVA feat. Dannii Minogue's Stringer (Who Do You Love Me Now) has now crossed over to other territories and shoots up from last week's 25 to this week's 12. Building on steady chart runs in the UK and Germany, it debuts on the dance charts in Scandinavia and Belgium this week.

Dance Street-signed Supa Dupa Fly from 666 (House Nation/Dance Street), an act that once topped Dance Traxx chart for five (non-consecutive) weeks with Alarma! at the beginning of 1998, enters the top 40 at 30 this week, with support from charts in Germany, France, Italy, Norway and Poland.

A possible contender for next week's Dance Traxx top 40, Simple Minds' classic Belfast Child (Virgin) gets a trance treatment by Britain's John "00" Fleming. The latter normally is on indie dance label React, but the new incarnation is credited to John "00" Fleming Vs. Simple Minds and titled Belfast Trance, appearing on Virgin dance label Nebula.

Also coming up, a fine track from Dutch label Combined Forces, Juno's Breathless. Packed with excellent Fragma-esque vocals the trancey track seems to perfectly fit on radio playlists, and should visit the Dance Traxx chart early in 2002



M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

It has been a month now since US artist Cher climbed the hill of M&M's European Radio Top 50, and she is still siting pretty at the top with Music's No Good Without You (WEA).



The other positions in the top five are occupied by artists which have all made their mark in 2001. With Paid My Dues, Epic's Anastasia is at number two for the second week, Robbie Williams & Nicole Kidman (pictured) move up from number four to number three Somethin' with Stupid (Chrysalis/EMI), and

Jennifer Lopez's I'm Real (Epic) follows at four. At five is Destiny's Child with Emotion (Columbia), which has been in the Top 50 now for eleven consecutive weeks.

The highest new entry this week is Garbage with the band's new track Cherry Lips on indie label Mushroom. The single has been picked up by radio stations over the whole of Europe, from VRT Studio Brussel in Belgium and Radio Riume Ticino in Switzerland to stations in France, Italy, Latvia, Sweden and Russia. In Denmark four stations have added the track.

Jan Brodde, head of music at Radio Uptown in Copenhagen, says Cherry Lips may take time to make its mark. "Our listeners still consider the previous single, Androgyny, as the new Garbage single. It's still much more popular than Cherry Lips," he says. "I think that the general radio audience is much slower moving concerning new releases than people in the radio and music industry."

He continues: "There are a lot of new releases now in the pre-Christmas season and it's hard for people to keep up. Therefore Cherry Lips might be more successful after Christmas than now in this busy time."

Brodde reckons the same scenario will be true for the new Lenny Kravitz single Stillness Of Heart (Virgin), which entered the European Radio Top 50 at number 45 this week. won't playlist Stillness Of Heart yet because Dig In is still hugely popular," says Brodde.



Another product of the German version of the Popstars TV show is Bros'Sis (pictured). The four boys and two girls have leapt into the Top 50 with their debut single I Believe (Polydor). At more than 800,000 units shifted, the ballad has notched up the highest first week

sales of any single ever released in Germany. It may only be rock'n'roll, but there is no

stopping pop veteran Mick Jagger. The 58-year-old is back at number 45 with God Gave Me Everything (Virgin), taken from his latest album Goddess In The Doorway.

Candidates for entering the charts next week are US college rockers Sum 41 with In Too Deep (Island), Belgium dance artist Ian Van Dahl with Will I (Nulife/Arista) and Swedish disco pop act Alcazar with Sexual Guarantee (RCA).

project manager Bea. Goedhuys sales are "going as expected". She adds: "Belgium, Holland, Spain, France, New Zealand and Australia are the major territories. In New Zealand it shipped gold straight away and went to number five in the charts.'

As for the additional DVD format. Goedhuys explains "music DVDs are still a small niche". The overall marketing campaign has "been especially press-driven and about getting good reviews and reaching not just Neil Finn and Crowded House fans, but also Johnny Marr fans and Radiohead fans," she continues.

To do this, Parlophone has also serviced stations across Europe with a radio-only edit of The Smiths' song There Is A Light That Will Never Go Out, which Neil Finn performs on the album. But, as it is not a commercial release, many stations are not programming the track.

We're not playing the single I'm afraid," says Alan Carruthers, programme director at AC station Heart FM in Birmingham, UK, "-it's not for release, is it?"

At Spanish AC network M-80, however, programmer Jesus Portela has added the track to the station's playlist. "Crowded House were an important group for our audience," he says. "We're an adult contemporary station so we play lots of '80s and '90s pop. When Neil went solo we still considered him a major artist for us. His new single is very good. It's not for sale, but we received it from the record company. If someone wants it, they only have to buy the album.

The album and DVD 7 Worlds Collide features 17 tracks comprising favourites from Finn's Crowded House days (Weather With You, Don't Dream It's Over) as well as songs from One Nil (Anytime, The Climber) interspersed with guest contributions (Paper Doll/Lisa Germano, Take A Walk/Eddie Vedder, Down On The Corner/Johnny Marr).

According to Neil Finn, it was The Smiths' numbers he was most excited about doing. When the residency was still at the planning stage he remembered "trying to steer conversations with Johnny Marr to some of my favourite Smiths tracks." He adds: "I might be attacked by a deranged Morrissey fan. I have a notion they're not a particularly muscly bunch!"

The resultant DVD has now been edited for television and Parlophone is trying to place it on TV internationally early next year. Bea Goedhuys believes the decision to make a DVD of the shows was a no-brainer. "You want to watch it as much as hear it," she states. "An amazing moment in the DVD was when Neil Finn's son and his band [Betchadupa] play a version of I See Red—an old Split Enz song-and Eddie Vedder performed it with them and they're looking at [him] with a look of 'I can't believe it's Eddie Vedder!' in their eyes." Goedhuys says these are the "special moments you don't get with [just] the live album."

Sony Europe restructures Three music international marketing

LONDON - Sony Music Europe is reorganising its international marketing team following the departure of Frank

Stroebele, VP marketing, Epic and continental repertoire, on December 14.

To replace him, Sony Music Europe's president Paul Burger and senior VP marketing Julie Borchard are splitting Stroebele's duties. Jeroen van der Meer, who was formerly marketing director, Epic will now

be handling the label's international

An appointment is expected imminently for European continental repertoire. M&M understands that the job has been offered to Mark Bond, currently GM of licensed repertoire at indie label V2 in London. Both would report to Borchard. Although Burger declines to comment on Bond's possible appointment, he does tell M&M that splitting the two functions will provide an opportunity to concentrate on continental repertoire, which has been identified as a major area for development by Sony Music.

"Jeroen has worked closely with Frank over the past years and we are giving him a chance to prove himself,' comments Burger. "In addition, by separating Epic's repertoire and continental Europe's repertoire, it will help provide a greater focus on this repertoire that we want to build upon.'

Stroebele, who joined Sony Music Europe in March 1998 from Universal Music Germany, will relocate in the new year to Berlin where, on January 1, he will launch his new management company, Eye Sound Management.

Of Stroebele's departure, Burger says: "We are sorry that Frank is leaving. He's done an excellent job over the three years he has been in London. We

hope we will work with him in his new capacity.'

With offices in London and Berlin, Eye Sound Management will focus on European artists with international potential. Stroebele says it is too soon to name acts signed to his new company, but he is already working on a couple of deals.

Stroebele says his experience over the past years with artists such as Anastacia and Macy Gray—as well as Germany's Sarah Connor, Belgium's Hooverphonic and Finland's Bomfunk MCs—has convinced him that there is a need for professional artist management structures with pan-European expertise. "The international experience gained in my London time is invaluable for Eye Sound," he says.

"These days, success can come from anywhere, but organising pan-European success is not an easy task," continues Stroebele, who adds that he doesn't rule out managing US acts for Europe "if I think they are the right artists for Europe." He also believes his advice could benefit labels in search of pan-European strategies.

"People in Europe are no longer as Americanised as they used to be," Stroebele reflects. "Radio stations in European countries still play international repertoire but they also support domestic acts and, at the same time, they can play artists from virtually anywhere. We are seeing the rise of a European culture."

greats pass away

LONDON — Three personalities who made their mark on contemporary popular music passed away last week.

Gilbert Bécaud (pictured), described by French president Jacques Chirac as "one of France's most talented ambassadors," died of

a lung cancer in Paris on December 18 at the age of 74.

Bécaud, whose real name was Gilbert François Silly, was born in Toulon in 1927. He learned the piano in Nice and began his career in music in the early 1950s



when he was discovered by performer Jacques Pills, who was at that time married to Edith Piaf. He quickly earned the nickname of 'Mister One Hundred Thousand Volts," reflecting his energy on

A talented melodist and pianist, Bécaud wrote over 400 songs, including 1961's Et Maintenant, known in its English version as What Now My Love-which has been sung by the likes of Frank Sinatra, Sarah Vaughan, Shirley Bassey and Barbra Streisand—and 1955's Je T'Appartiens, covered as Let It Be Me by the Everly Brothers, Frank Sinatra, Bob Dylan, and Elvis Presley, among others.

Bécaud was recording a new album for EMI, Most of his recordings have been with EMI, with a stint at BMG's label RCA in the late

Scottish guitarist/singer/songwriter Stuart Adamson was found dead on December 16 in a Hawaii hotel room in the US. He was 43.

Adamson, who fought a long battle with alcoholism, had been missing from his Nashville home since November 7. He is best known as lead singer of Big Country, who notched up 17 UK top 30 singles and seven top 30 albums from 1983-93. The band split up in 1999 and Adamson subsequently formed the Raphaels with Nashville songwriter Marcus Hummon. They released the album Supernatural in May on UK manager Ian Grant's Track Records.

R&B entertainer Thomas died on December 15 in a Memphis hospital after a short illness. He was 84. Thomas was an on-air personality at WDIA/Memphis, the first all-black radio station in the south of the US, in the early '50s. He scored his early hits on Sam Phillips' Sun Records, including Bear Cat and Tiger Man (later covered by Elvis Presley). In the '60s, Thomas recorded both solo and with his daughter Carla for Stax Records, and became famous for dance craze tunes such as Walking The Dog (covered by Aerosmith), Do The Funky Chicken and (Do The) Push And Pull.

Publishing move for Buja

MILAN - Following weeks of speculation, Universal Music Italy has officially announced a series of changes to its management struc-

The main move sees the promotion of director A&R Claudio Buja to the post of managing director of Universal Music Italy Publishing.

"After 10 years in A&R this presents a great challenge," says Buja. "Too many people consider [publishing] to be a purely administrative

branch of the music industry. We have to restore it to its traditional role, which was more central and more creative."

Buja replaces Michele Del Vecchio, who has left the company to take up the post of head of light music at another publishing house, Curci Edizioni. Buja's post of director A&R is taken over by current director of marketing Stefano Zappaterra, with Zappaterra's old role being taken by new media director Carlo Galassi. His position is, in turn, filled by Fabio Riveruzzi.

President and managing director of Universal Music Italy Piero La

Falce tells M&M: "These changes are brought about by a desire to promote talented individuals within the company as we endeavour to meet the challenges of today's market."

Buja says of his task ahead: "We will try and make our publishing division more research-oriented, discovering and develop-

ing new writers and artists. We're also going to be working hard on music's new media applications."

• Universal has applied to join the new Italian publishers association FEM, which was formed at the beginning of December. By joining, FEM Universal is following in the footsteps of BMG Ricordi, Sugar, Sonzogno, Cam, Sony Music and EMI. Of the Warner Chappell majors, only remains outside the new grouping.

The reorganisation of Vivendi Universal (VU)'s activities in the US following its acquisition of USA Networks is not expected to affect the group's music division. Universal Music Group (UMG) chairman/CEO Doug Morris will continue to report to VU executive vice chairman Edgar Bronfman until the

latter steps down at the end of the first quarter. After that, Morris will report directly to VU chairman/CEO Jean-Marie Messier (pictured). Morris will be part of a new group's committee of the entertainment CEOs, who will gather monthly to manage the integration of

the company's music, film, TV, games and education assets in order to develop synergies among them.

While rumours circulate that Chris Evans could be making a shock return to the UK's airwaves via public AC station BBC Radio 2 in 2002, the man himself is suing his most recent employers Virgin Radio, claiming a breach of an agreement over share options. Evans was sacked by the station for being photographed out drinking after having phoned in sick.

Hotline hears that all the breakfast show staff at national commercial station P4 in Norway are to be made redundant in January, following extensive cost-cutting measures at the Hot AC broadcaster. It is unclear what will happen with the morning programming in the new year.

Kenneth Bager, the Copenhagen-based A&R director for EMI Music Denmark imprints Flex and Music For Dreams, is taking on an additional job as assistant music programmer at Copenhagen's new urbanformatted station Kiss FM. Meanwhile, Kiss FM's owner SBS is to cut staff at its four stations in neighbouring Sweden. Some kind of programming co-operation is likely between its Hot AC-formatted Radio City stations in Stockholm, Göthenberg and Malmö, which until now have been operated separately.

It is understood that heritage BBC TV music show Top Of The Pops will get a radical new look sometime next year under new producer Michael Kelpie. The programme is set to include interviews and comedy, and one-hour specials could also be introduced.

Following the expiration of his contract with Virgin Records, David Bowie has set up his own imprint, ISO, which has been in development over the year. With offices in New York and London, ISO has still to finalise distribution plans for its releases, which will include a new album from Bowie himself.

Warner Music International's Londonbased VP international marketing Andy Murray left the company mid-December in order to develop projects through his multimedia production company Handyman. Murray, who joined WMI in 2001, will not be replaced.

Finally, head of music at CHR station Radio FFH in Frankfurt, Ralf Blasburg, is leaving to take the position of managing director at the ZYX Music label in Merenberg. Presenter Roel Oosthout will step into Blasenburg's shoes at FFH.






