EMI starts to make cuts across Europe

LONDON — Country by country, EMI is rolling out its new management and operational plan outlined on February 7, leaving hundreds of employees in doubt about their futures.

The restructuring (M&M, February 16) will mean the loss of "a fair amount" of jobs according to EMI Recorded Music vice-chairman David Munns, although he could not name a figure: "It's not just jobs, it's offices, systems. Virgin and EMI had a separate royalty accounting system. There's unnecessary clutter on the systems side."


Munns acknowledges the risk of destabilising EMI's staff worldwide and says this consideration to act as swiftly as possible has been taken on board by the company's top management. "We want everything done quickly," Munns told M&M's sister publication Billboard. "We know this is painful; we know people are worried."

After the UK and Germany, details of the new structures have emerged for Spain and France. In the latter country, M&M has learned that Marc Lumbroso, president of Capitol France (formerly EMI Music France) was asked to leave the company following a February 12 visit to Paris by the division's chairman Alain Levy.

At time of going to press, no formal announcement has been made by EMI continued on page 21

Morissette and MTV join hands

LONDON — Alanis Morissette's third studio album, Under Rug Swept, is shaping up to be another big seller for Warner Music Europe.

Described by the label's Londonbased marketing director for US repertoire Paul McGhie as "a return to form," its first cut, Hands Clean, spent two weeks at number one on M&M's European Radio Top 50 prior to its February 11 release. Importantly, Warner has enjoyed good access to the artist in Europe since the start of the year and has enlisted MTV as a key ally.

Brent Hansen, president and chief executive of MTV Networks Europe, tells M&M: "MTV Europe certainly considers Alanis Morissette to be a core artist. This week we taped an continued on page 21


Albarn launches **Honest Jon label**


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
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Upfront

With Ken Berry having more time to go hiking and a new, down-to-earth management team of Alain Levy and David Munns installed at EMI Recorded Music, it was obvious to most observers that the venerable old British lady that was EMI was in line for a major wakeup call. And by the sound of it, that call is exceeding all previous expectations.

The harsh medicine that doctor Levy and professor Munns are administering to the body of EMI will undoubtedly leave some scarring, but is viewed by many, not least in the company itself, as emergency treatment that should have been carried out before.

But the point is that it hadn't-and it couldn't have-been done.

There are at least two reasons. One was the presence of a Virgin man, Ken Berry, at the top of the company. The other was the painful process the company went through with its unsuccessful proposed merger with first Warner and then BMG, which froze any changes for over two years.

As long as Berry was there, Virgin's status as a stand-alone label within the EMI empire was not likely to be tampered with. First because it would have undermined the free spirit of the company Richard Branson built (and which persisted after he sold it): both labels never really mingled, and EMI was perceived by the Virgin team as a gentrified, uncool company. Secondly, it was Berry's back-up plan and insurance policy that if things went wrong at EMI, Virgin could have been sold and he could have moved on.

When all the merger options had been explored and abandoned, Berry's position became untenable and there was an urgency to slice into the fat of the company and look at Virgin and EMI from a structural point of view.

For Levy and Munns, that was the only way forward. The dynamic duo's rush to get things done before the closure of its financial year (in order to start with a clean balance sheet) is understandable. They reckon that they can trim down the size of the company without affecting

massively its ability to deliver music. That was broadly what they did at PolyGram, and it didn't do too badly for them

There is a human cost, however, as well as the risk of losing some of the free spirit that made Virgin a different record company. Once they have put the new structure and management in place, all they need is hits. That's the hardest part!

UK follows France in bucking

LONDON - Following in the footsteps of France, the UK's recorded

music market bucked the global trend by registering an increase in sales for 2001, largely thanks to the performance of local repertoire.

Figures released by UK labels' body the BPI show sales of pre-recorded music in the UK rose by 5.3% in 2001 to £1.23 billion (euros 2.02bn), an

increase the organisation describes as "impressive"

Album shipments grew by 4.4% in volume, with the top seven of the best-selling albums all coming from

British artists. The best-selling album of the year was Dido's No Angel (Cheeky/BMG), which sold over two million copies in the UK

alone. Other top-selling albums came from EMI's Robbie Williams, Telstar's Craig David and Gorillaz (Parlophone).

"Too much is made of the importance of economic factors in the music market place, says chairman and CEO of EMI Recorded Music & Ireland Tony Wadsworth.

"And it's often overlooked, that when you have great music-guess what?-the market increases. It's no coincidence that this comes at a time when UK music is doing better overseas than for many years."

A further feature of album sales in 2001 was the impact of greatest hits collections, which accounted for 23.5% of top 100 album sales. This was an increase on 17.9% in 2000, despite the fact that a similar number of "best of" titles were released in both years.

On the downside, singles shipments fell below the 60 million unit mark for the first time since 1993, although singles sold in the UK still account for around a third of total European sales. And two releases achieved sales of over one million units: It Wasn't Me (Universal) by Shaggy and TV "Popstars" group Hear'Say's Pure and Simple (Polydor), which was also the fastest-selling debut single.

McGee's Poptones joins forces with Telstar

LONDON - Poptones, the UK indie label set up by ex-Creation boss Alan McGee, is to set up a joint venture imprint with the UK's largest independent label, Telstar Records.

Under the terms of the agreement, key acts signed to McGee's label will be provided with funding and marketing resources by Telstar, whose roster includes Craig David, Mis-Teeg and De Nada.

Negotiations between the two companies began in November when Poptones was forced to lay off its workforce due to "streamlining in line with current circumstances in the music industry."

At the time, the company's share price had dropped from a first day trading high of 2.75 pence (euros 0,04) to 0.4 pence.

Following the Telstar news, and with Swedish rock band The Hives (licensed to Poptones in the UK) cur-

rently at number seven in the UK album charts with Your New Favourite Band (Burning Heart), Poptones the share price rose to 1.36 pence.

The Hives. whose new single Hate To Say I

Told You So also looks set to enter high in the UK charts, are the only Poptones act confirmed for the new imprint

In a statement, Poptones chairman Mike Blackburn said the move represented "an attractive way of funding Poptones into the future."

McGee, who discovered Oasis, was unavailable for comment, but told M&M last month: "Poptones

now has no staff and has become a virtual office-my couch, my mobile and my laptop.

M&M understands the label still retains press officer Susie Ember, and A&R scouts Ian Johnsen and Alan Hake on a consultancy basis.

Telstar Music Group managing director Jeremy

Marsh, and A&R director Pete Hadfield, who negotiated the deal on behalf of Telstar, said in a joint statement: "Alan McGee is one of the great music industry visionaries with a track record second to none. This new joint venture adds real muscle to our A&R efforts."







Emap moves to improve Performance

LONDON — The Emap Performance Network (EPN)part of UK media giant Emap—has announced an April 1 shake-up of its radio operations which will see Mark Story appointed to the new position of man-

aging director, radio and Andy Roberts (pictured) taking the group programme director's role.

Story's new job him take sees responsibility for all of EPN's radio

interests, including the development of new digital radio brands. Previously, as MD of Kiss 100 (dance) and Magic 105.4 (soft AC), his remit was confined to the company's flagship London stations. He reports to EPN managing director Dee Ford.

In addition to Story's MD positions at Kiss and Magic, he had also been head of dance music for EPN. Story denies that his appointment as radio managing director marks a return to platform-specific management at EPN, following a content-specific

approach introduced in 2000. He tells M&M that he sees his new post of radio MD in terms of "widening my brief," and adds that he will still have responsibilities related to

Kiss TV and Emap's dance magazines.

Kiss 100 programme director Andy Roberts has been promoted to group programme director in place of Phil Roberts, who is in discussions about a new role within the company. Andy Roberts-who with Story was responsible for the highly-successful relaunch three years ago of Kiss FM as the more mainstream Kiss 100-will oversee Kiss 100 and Emap's eight "Big City" local FM stations. The Magic network will remain in the hands of programme director Trevor White.

The change in Emap's top programmer follows a decline in audience for the Big City network in recent times—its 16.1% share of listening in the fourth quarter of 2001 is sharply down on the 20.2% share it enjoyed in the same quarter two years previously.

Story says the appointment of Andy Roberts as group PD is a logical one given the rapport they enjoyed together at Kiss, where he says Roberts' record "speaks for itself."

BETHELL, BLAXHILL JOIN CAPITAL RADIO



LONDON — Former head of media at Ministry of Sound, James Bethell, has joined the UK's Capital Radio group as a strategy consultant. Bethell will advise Capital on, among other things, the forthcoming consolidation of the UK

radio sector. Bethell quit Ministry last October, following the arrival of former Virgin Radio managing director David Campbell. Meanwhile, Ric Blaxill (pictured), a former producer of BBC TV show Top Of The Pops, has been named deputy programme controller at the group's flagship London CHR station, 95.8 Capital FM.

LOCAL REPERTOIRE LIFTS FINNISH SALES

HELSINKI — The value of music sales in Finland rose 1.4% in 2001 to euros 68.1 million, partly thanks to a 7.2% increase in the sales of local repertoire, according to local IFPI affiliate ÄKT. Sales of foreign repertoire fell by 3.3%. Local repertoire in Finland now accounts for 47.8% of total value and 53.2% of units. Unit sales in 2001 dropped by 1.4% to 9.5 million, mainly due to a 48.6% dip in cassette unit sales. CD sales were up 2.6% to euros 65.6 million, with domestic CD sales gaining 9.6% in value.


NRJ GROUP BUCKS THE RADIO DOWNTURN

- France's NRJ Group has announced revenues of euros 86.82 million for the first quarter of its new financial year (October to December 2001). The figure, representing a 4.1% rise in turnover compared to the same period in 2000, has been put down to an increase in national advertising. The company's international revenues, however, dropped dramatically by 23% from euros 11.8 million to euros 9.1 m in the same period. In a statement, NRJ attributes this figure to poor performances by its stations in Germany and Sweden.

FLAT FIGURES FOR UNIVERSAL MUSIC

PARIS — Vivendi Universal (VU)'s media and communications businesses posted revenue of euros 28.9 billion for the year ended December 31, 2001,

a growth of 9% compared to the same period of 2000. The group reports that its music revenues of euros 6.56 bn "were essentially flat in 2001, representing a strong performance in a down market." The company claims to have grown its market share during 2001. It suffered from declines in Latin America (down over 20%) and a flat North American business, while revenues were up in Europe (+ 3%)

second-city Norway's currently has two commercially-operated frequencies: FM 105.8, which is exclusively held by the local hot AC-formatted station Radio 1: and FM 104.1, which is shared among five licensees, but is dominated Radio 1-owned the Melodi FM, which broadcasts for 18 hours a day.

NRJ applied last year to media authority Statens Medieforvaltning (SMF) for frequency-share with Radio 1 in Bergen, but was unsuccessful.

"We have built our frequency gradually over several years, says Radio 1 Bergen's station manager Fred

Olav Johannessen, "but I understand why NRJ wanted to share the frequency with us. It's because we have four or five times as many listeners as the other frequency. They just want a portion of our advertising money."



Red FM targets youth market ON THE BEAT

DUBLIN — Ireland's newest commercial radio station, Red FM 104-106, is using dance as a major weapon to target the youth market in the south of the Republic.

Launched last month,

Red FM is aiming its mix of dance, R&B, rock, pop and contemporary Irish music at 15-34year-olds in Cork city and county.

'We are geared towards giving something

completely new and exciting, and look forward to having a huge presence in the lives of young people in the city and county," says Henry Condon (pictured), chief executive of Red FM who, in his previous role as

programme director at UK rock station Virgin Radio, was known by his on-air name of Henry Owens.

Every weekday evening the station is airing a dance show, Dance Your Pants Off, from 18.00-22.00. Pete Tong's Wise Buddah-pro-

duced syndicated dance show, Essential Selection, will be broadcast on Friday nights. That will be followed by another Wise Buddah dance show, Roger Sanchez's Release Yourself.

DJ Stevie G presents a three-hour R&B show on Saturdays, while Pink On Red, features club music and a guide to Cork's gay

A total of euros 3.5 million has been invested in Red FM, which is hoping to lure listeners away from the well-established Cork AC station County Sound 96 FM. The most recent radio listening figures, released by ratings body JNLR, show County Sound attracted 59% of the audience in Red FM's target market. Red FM aims to win over 20-25% of that market in its first year.

Condon is confident the goal can be achieved. "Our market research highlights very clearly the hunger for change among Cork's young people in particular," he says. "It also brings into focus the appetite for a fresh, music-driven, radio alternative in Cork. Red FM will offer Cork's youth a radio station designed to meet their needs for the very first time."

French focus for Norway's By:Larm

Oslo — The Norwegian music industry conference By:Larm is expanding, with some 40% of the 800 delegates expected to come from

the rest of Scandinavia and Europe.

In this its fifth year, By:Larm, to be held from March 7-10 in Kristiansand on the southern coast of Norway, will focus on

Scandinavia and France. There will be performances by a number of French acts, including Bertrand Burgalat, Fugu, Infused, and DJs from the F Communications label. There will also be a seminar dedicated to the French mar-

"The reason for selecting France this year is that the Norwegian music scene is where France historically was-and I believe that Norway will reach the same status France currently enjoys," says By:Larm founder Erlend Mogård Larsen (pictured).

Other seminars this year include sessions on radio (moderated by Music & Media), artist management (led by the Cardigans manager

Petri Lunden), touring, government funding, artist promotion, music publishing and sponsorship.

There will also be performances by artists from Sweden such as Bad Cash Quartet and multiple Grammis-nominated rap act Fattaru, and from Denmark including Envelope and Baby Woodrose.

In its first five years, By:Larm has established itself as a significant event in Norway, both in terms of helping raise the general level of self-confidence within the industry and identifying the next wave of local talent. Several internationally-known Norwegian artists-including Briskeby, Röyksopp, Sondre Lerche, Big Bang, Cato Salsa Experience and St Thomasplayed By:Larm before breaking through commercially.

Says Larsen: "I think we've been good at helping to lift several artists one step further by never exceeding 100 performing artists per year. Other similar shows in Europe usually book up to 500 bands, but there just aren't 500 notable new artists from the UK, the Netherlands or Germany every year."

FONKY FAMILY SIGNS DEAL WITH BMG



PARIS - French hip hop collective Fonky Family (pictured) have signed a longterm publishing deal with BMG Music Publishing France. The deal covers records to be released by

Fonky Family, as well as by its individual members Le Rat Luciano, Sat, Don Choa, Menzo and Feló, and the works composed and produced by members Pone and Djel. The collective was previously signed to EMI Music Publishing France/Cotê Obscur, which retains the publishing rights to their previous works. Fonky Family have a label deal with Sony Music France's urban imprint SMALL. Several projects are due for release in 2002 and 2003.

IFPI GREECE NAMES STAMBOULIS GM

ATHENS - Warner Music Greece veteran Ion Stamboulis has been named general manager of local labels' body IFPI Greece. Panos Maravelias, managing director of independent Greek label Lyra, takes over as chairman. In his newly-created post, Stamboulis, who most recently served as IFPI Greece president and is managing director of Warner Music Greece, will be responsible for implementing IFPI's strategies on a local level. "Our main goals are to fight piracy, protect copyright and foster respect for the industry," he tells M&M. Stamboulis says he is especially concerned with the issue of CD piracy ahead of the 2004 Olympic Games in Athens.

P4 INCREASES ITS AUDIENCE

Oslo — P4 Radio Hele Norge, the national commercial AC station in Norway which last year sacked its president/CEO Cecilie Norland, has increased its daily reach to 29%, up from last year's 25%, according to official ratings figures from Gallup. The station still ranks second behind public national AC station NRK P1 but is ahead of public national CHR station NRK Petre. P4 recently launched a new morning show, hosted by P4 veteran Tor Andersen and Bjørn Faarlund, who joined P4 after a 15 year stint with Radio 1 Oslo.

BRITS FINALISE LINE-UP

LONDON — The final line-up of artists to perform at the Brit Awards 2002 has been confirmed. Among the artists to play at London's Earls Court on February 20 are Jamiroquai's Jay Kay, who is to perform a duet with fellow Sony act Anastacia, while Shaggy and Ali G will perform their new single collaboration Me Julie. Other performers include The Strokes, Kylie, Gorillaz, So Solid Crew and Sting, who will receive the Outstanding Contribution award on the night.





The Official UK Charts Company, previously known as the Chart Information Network, has timed the launch of its website to co-incide with the 50th Anniversary of the Official UK Singles Chart. A brief history of the charts makes for interesting reading, as do the charts themselves. Also on offer is a question and answer area, chats, competitions, polls and more. A timeline and a clickable map of the United Kingdom disclose an eccentric selection of trivia, but the invitation for users to submit entries will undoubtedly fill in the gaps of this ambitious and promising concept. The company plans to expand the site further and use elements of it as the basis for a TV show, a radio programme, a CD and a book.

Homework pays for air talent

For even the most naturally gifted radio presenters, some form of show prep—no matter how informal—is an essential ingredient for creating a winning show. In an extract from her book The Powerful Radio Workbook, radio consultant *Valerie Geller*, who has coached presenters involved in both talk radio and personality-based music radio, gives some advice on programme planning.

general would never go into battle without a plan. A surgeon would never go into the operating room without a preliminary work-up. Yet it is surprising how many air personalities show up for work and just wait to see what happens. Some days you might get lucky, but for succeeding over the long haul, show prep is essential. If a talent is prepared, it does not matter if he or she slides in at 11:59. The host can still do a great show.

It is very easy to do radio on a busy day when many interesting things are happening. The art of the job is to be fantastic on air and create powerful radio when there is very little going on. These are the days when show prep is key.

It also helps the show if the pre-

senter, programmer and producer all understand clearly who the target audience is. Show prep is a process that does not begin when you get into the station in the morning, but rather involves observing life all throughout the day, week and year in order to find subjects.

The best personalities and show producers compile their material from various sources in addition to life experience: articles from magazines or the newspaper, written ideas, and items discovered from the Internet.

Everyone has his or her own way of organising show prep materials, but if a host or presenter sounds consistently disorganised on the air, try coming up with another system. If a host is prepared but cannot access an item

during the on-air performance, all that prep is wasted and the show can wander.

Creative talent, 24 hours a day, seven days a week, are constantly engaged in show prep. Everything in their lives, what they read, eat, feel, experience and even dream, all this goes into their shows. A top professional can talk about anything, but it helps if there is some genuine interest or the presenter can find a personal connection to the topic.

Good talent utilises everything including their personal experi-

ting boring or too private.

You can go personal, even discuss people you know or have come into contact with. The only rule is that no one should be allowed to hurt others or endanger them in any way. Not only can there be legal consequences to giving specific information about people's private lives, but there can be security issues as well.

Often a little camouflage enables more creative and dramatic storytelling without risking someone physical harm or emotional embarrassment. What is your

ences and relationships.

So how personal can you get? This is a huge question. No one wants to hear the boring minutia of your life, but the more personal you go, the more universal the subject becomes. There is a big difference between personal and private. The answer is as personal as you can without get-

point? If entertaining your audience is the goal, then does it really matter if something happened to your wife or "a woman I know..."? Try the approach: "The story you are about to hear is true, but the names have been changed to protect the innocent." Tell the truth. Never be boring.

Rules for powerful show prep

1. Go with the moment

If something spontaneous happens on the air that is better than what you have prepared, go with it! You would happily take a detour to see something interesting while travelling. The magic moments on radio—a breaking news story or a fabulous caller—happen when you least expect them, and when they occur it is wonderful. Although there is no substitute for walking into the station thoroughly prepared, you must also be willing to throw that stack of stuff out of the window when something irresistible turns up.

2. Why are we doing this?

What is your purpose for today's topics? Always have a specific reason for wanting a guest. Avoid "guest-omania." If a guest has been booked for you, know the reason. Ask the producer, "What has this person done? Why is he or she special?"

Never promise a guest a set amount of time on the air. Give yourself an "out" in case the person is dull. Instead, when you prearrange the interview, just ask for "a few minutes" of his or her time.

that a guest may be pre-empted by a
breaking story. You have now protected yourself from the potentially
embarrassing situation of having to

dump a guest if he or she is boring or if a bigger opportunity arises.

I am frequently asked for a rule about guests. Unless you are doing an interview-based show, I advise using guests as spice. Like great the show and justify their salaries. They like to see bodies at desks for eight hours a day.

Many broadcast managers do not come from creative backgrounds. Because of this, often



seasoning in a bland meal, guests can be wonderful. Good guests can make a show, but they must be gifted communicators with passion and something relevant to say.

The best guests are people who have some kind of unique personal experience, with a story to tell, rather than just being experts in their field.

3. Warning to managers

Managers, particularly those oriented to sales or goals and results, like to hear guests on the air in order to feel that the host and producer have done some work to book

managers feel most comfortable seeing people working.

We are accustomed to believing what we see. Management have a hard time accepting that a talent fighting with his or her mechanic is actually doing show prep, but it can be true. A manager may not understand that if you are having the tyre changed on your car, you can actually be doing show prep for your airshift.

Broadcasting is not school, or a factory job where we punch in our eight hours a day. Radio work is different, more like art than manufacturing. A gallery owner would not call an artist at 8:45 in the morning

and ask, "Are you at your easel yet? How many brushes have you used?" The only hard rule is: be prepared and on time for your show.

What listeners respond to is the finished product. Radio people work very differently. Our product is on the radio. Our preparation is real but invisible.

4. Be prepared

Ideas come at anytime, anywhere. Always be prepared. Carry a tape recorder or note pad at all times. Don't forget spare batteries for that tape recorder. If we were working as photographers, we would always have a camera ready. But we work in radio and our medium is sound. When was the last time you thought to yourself, "I wish I had a tape recorder right now?" They are small and inexpensive. Get one. Carry it. If you are not comfortable carrying a tape recorder, at least keep paper and pen handy so that you can jot down a great idea before it is gone. Great ideas come in the shower, the car, wake you up at night. Write them down.

5. Make friends outside the business Hang out with normal people. If you only associate with other broadcasters, you limit your vision. Expand your horizons. Talk to everyone. Your inner circle should contain people



who do other work and have a variety of interests and experiences. Listen to them. Find out what they are thinking, worrying about, and talking about. It will help your show tremendously. Read everything. Watch everything. Hang out with creative people, and learn from them. Study creative performers outside of radio.

6. Know your target

Know your audience. Do the listeners have a lifestyle that is different from the presenter's? Probably so. Perhaps a host lives in a busy urban centre, whereas the bulk of the station's listeners are in the suburbs or rural areas. You need to know what goes on where they live too. Read the local newspapers, and drive around to get a feeling for the area. Attend functions. Meet people. Get to know your city. Eat where your listeners eat: shop where they shop. Stay curious, alive, and interested. Check out the Internet.

7. Take a test drive

Discuss show ideas with somebody else. Prep is much easier when you have the luxury of working with a talented producer. He or she can help form questions you will ask on air and points you will make to engage your audience. Try bouncing the ideas off anyone around you: the call screener, the programme director, someone in news, or the station's security guard. It may help you focus on what is really interesting about the topic, or take it in a different direction.

8. Prep warning

Do not do your show before the show. Testing out an idea should not be confused with rehearsing a monologue. Save your actual performance for the live microphone. It won't sound as good the second time around.

9. Be generous with others

If you have found a topic that would be perfect for somebody else at the station, pass it along. Leave the article, book, note, etc in that person's mailbox, or give him or her a call. The success of a station depends on the efforts of all its creative members.

10. Experiment


Break rules if you can come up with a more successful method. Take what works for you, and leave the rest.

- Is it relevant?
- Does it matter?
- Do you care?
- Do the listeners care?
- What will I do if this topic gets boring?
- Do I have a fall-back plan?

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2001: A global sales odyssey

global pie of legitimate record sales may be shrinking, but it was still a multi-platinum meal for many in 2001. In fact, for a pair of acts—the UK's Dido and the US's Linkin Park-it was a proper banquet, as their debut releases became the biggest albums in the world last year, at 8.6 million and 8.5 million copies shipped, respectively. A third newcomer, Alicia Keys, also saw her opening effort rate as one of the top titles of the year.

The Global 20 represents the first time that Billboard has ranked the world's biggest albums of a calendar year, based on figures supplied by record companies. These figuresshipments to the trade-largely represent the only globally consistent information available, and are also the basis on which the International Federation of the Phonographic Industry (IFPI) annually calculates the volume and value of the worldwide recorded music business.

Health warning

For their part, the five multinational record companies track and report sales in various ways, as do the world's independent labels. The data behind The Global 20 may be subject to this "health warning" but is arguably a good indicator of the year's top albums.

Dido earned her global crown a full 30 months after No Angel was issued by Arista Records in the US, and 14 months after its UK release in the UK. The album shipped 1.7 million

copies in 2000-almost entirely in the US-and then rolled around the world. Its cumulative shipments since release now exceed 10.5 million, according to Arista VP of international marketing Frances Georgeson.

In the "open big, burn fast" environment that the global music business has become, the 2001 achievement of No Angel may be a record not soon broken. En route to becoming the top album in the world last year, it spent a remarkable 33 weeks lodged simultaneously inside the top 10 of three or more of the 10 leading music markets. No other release matched that status or longevity during the calendar year. Only three other albums-by Shaggy, Enya, and Destiny's Child—sustained three or more simultaneous top 10 occupancies for half as long as Dido.

Warner Bros. released Linkin Park's Hybrid Theory considerably later than Arista issued No Angel, but it swiftly took the album-and the band-to the Between January September last year, the six-piece spent 12 weeks outside the US on promotion chores. The result: Hybrid Theory shipped 3.7 million copies outside the US in 2001, complementing its domestic tally of 4.8 million. The performance includes almost one million units moved in the UK. Warner Bros. senior VP of international Steve Margo asks, "When was the last time a rock record sold that many [copies] in England?"

Seasoned stars

The Global 20 features its share of seasoned campaigners-Madonna (with two albums), Michael and Janet Jackson, Pink Floyd-but the bulk of slots were taken by artists who were unknown 10 years ago. As for repertoire source, the US is home to 13 of the 18 acts, the UK to three, and Ireland and Jamaica to one apiece.

To qualify for inclusion in The Global 20, an album must first have figured on the Billboard Common Currency, the weekly scorecard of albums that simultaneously attain top 10 chart status in three or more markets from the following list: the US, Japan, the UK, Germany, France, Canada, Spain, Australia, Italy, and the Netherlands. According to the most recent data available from the IFPI, these countries account for 82% of global prerecorded music sales.


To produce The Global 20, total worldwide sales of the qualifying albums were requested from the record companies and results ranked accordingly. The figures were taken

as the companies' gross shipments to the trade during the calendar year.

For most of the titles shown, the repertoire-owning company is the source of the sales information. But in some markets, an album may have been released through different outlets. For example, the total figure for Moulin Rouge combines shipments

from Universal Music Group affiliates and from independent Mushroom Records, which released the album in Australia and New Zealand.

The breakdown by corporate group (see chart, top), shows the top albums from each of the five majors and from independents. As with The Global 20, the albums listed met the Billboard Common Currency criteria. Each of the majors' top three titles graduated to The Global 20, with the exception of Warner (all five of its titles did so) and Universal. The latter placed Hotshot in the upper reaches of the worldwide ranking, as well as Moulin Rouge.

But the world's largest record company did not have any shortage of border breakers, including albums by Enrique Iglesias and Nickelback (4

million apiece); Andrea Bocelli, Limp Bizkit, D12, Blink-182, and Bridget Jones's Diary soundtrack (all at over 3 million, with Limp Bizkit's cumulative total now at 11 million); Bee Gees and Mary J. Blige (2.7 million each); U2 (2.5 million, for a cumulative 10 million); and Bob Marley and the Wailers' One Love—The Very Best of Bob Marley and the Wailers at 2.4 million.

The impact of the Marley compilation reiterates the value of hits packages. In 2001, at least a half-dozen such releases performed strongly worldwide, including Madonna's GHV2. Backstreet Boys' The Hits-Chapter One, and Bee Gees' Their Greatest Hits—The Record.

Global winner

Another worldwide winner, Robbie Williams' Swing When You're Winning, was not issued by EMI in the US, but its shipments in Europe, Australia and elsewhere were sufficiently robust to lift the album into The Global 20, with 4.4 million units.

Among the live albums that circumnavigated the globe were those by Sting (2.3 million), Bon Jovi (2.1 million), and Radiohead (2 million). Meanwhile, Sony Music shipped 925,000 pieces of Bruce Springsteen and the E Street Band's Live in New York City, a two-disc set.

Regarding music trends, 2001 was clearly a year in which pop, rock, and R&B took the big numbers. American rap and hip-hop does travel, yet seldom to multi-platinum levels outside the US But the recent exception was Eminem's The Marshall Mathers LP (a cumulative 16 million units worldwide, including 2.3 million last year) and his D12 combo, whose Devil's Night shipped 3.3 million units in 2001.

As for the record industry's global pie, the data in The Global 20 underlines that-despite the popularity of all these artists—there is a problem. Consider that No Angel, the No. 1 album worldwide in 2001, shipped fewer copies than the No. 1 album in the US alone in 2000: No Strings Attached by 'N Sync. Clearly, the angel's needed in the kitchen.

Silver turns to gold for Nickelback in Europe



Three million albums and counting has produced a return of much more than nickels and dimes in the US for Roadrunner's Canadian rockers Nickelback.

The band's sophomore album, and first European release, Silver Side Up, came out on the Continent in October, selling half a million units to peak at number six on M&M's European Top 100 Albums chart. The record is certified gold in Germany, Denmark, Switzerland, Austria and the UK, where the first single—How You Remind Me—is yet to be released, on February 25. Chart success elsewhere gave the single a number 12 position on the M&M Eurochart Hot 100 Singles.

On February 12 Nickelback kicked off a European tour in London—where it winds up on March 16 which is "a combination of touring and promo," according to Roadrunner VP international marketing Paolo D'Alessandro. In addition to the live dates, the four-piece are to perform on the UK's Top Of The Pops and CD:UK television shows, while in Italy their concert will be filmed and broadcast on MTV Supersonic. The footage will then be repackaged and serviced to all European feeds under the MTV Total Request Live banner. The multi-purpose tour also takes in an appearance at the Echo awards in Germany.

Formed in 1996, Nickelback comprises brothers Chad and Mike Kroeger, their cousin Brandon and friend Ryan Vikedal. The band released their debut album, *The State*, on their own label in 1999, before signing a contract with Roadrunner after the single, *Leader Of*



Men, went Top 20 in Canada. On Silver Side Up production duties are shared by Pearl Jam producer Rick Parashar and Randy Staub, who has previously worked with Metallica and U2.

As in the US, Nickelback have benefited from radio support in Europe. "We had some resistance from radio to start with, because of the formats, but they have completely opened up now," says D'Alessandro. How You Remind Me sits at number 11 in the European Radio Top 50 chart. One mainstream station that never had doubts about playing the track is CHR station NRJ Stockholm in Sweden which playlisted it as early as November 13.

"We were one of the first stations in Europe to play it," confirms head of music Frederik Severin. "We think the tune is fantastic. It's one of our most-played songs—it's on the A-list and gets 82 spins a week, it's an incredibly popular tune." He adds, "I believe there are a few more hits on the album." Other important radio support comes from BBC Radio 1 (CHR) in the UK, Eins Live (CHR) in Germany and Radio 3 FM (CHR) in the Netherlands.

D'Alessandro continues, "I don't think this album has any limits. It's impossible to say how much it can sell. We like the fact that it has been a slow seller. There are so many one-hit wonders around—two months and they are out. That's not what Roadrunner is about, we are a rock label. Rock is here to stay and to create careers, not to produce one-hit wonders."

Forthcoming single *Too Bad* comes out in April, followed by a third single—"depending on how long the first two last," says D'Alessandro. "That's the great thing about working for a rock label, you can always count on people liking it."

Jovanotti preaches salvation

Even if he claims he was only trying to get people to discuss the war in Afghanistan, 35-year-old Italian singer Jovanotti has shown an enviable flair for promoting his current single, Salvami (Soleluna/Mercury). The song, which was written in the wake of 11 September and was released on January 18, has a clear pacifist message and, in order to get this across, the artist appeared on no less than 38 TV shows in one week in January. Cleverly, he then proceeded to use a collage of these appearances as the video to the single.

TV marathon Jovanotti's kicked up quite a media storm as he was attacked by pro-war guests on some of the shows, but the result is a hit single and proof that all publicity is good publicity. More importantly perhaps, the artist succeeded in bringing attention to a musical product in a country where industry executives constantly complain about the lack of TV openings for their artists. Unsurprisingly, expectations are high for the Jovanotti's tenth album, Il Quinto Mondo, which was released on February 1 and went straight to No.1 in the Italian sales charts.

Jovanotti's career began at the

age of 19 in the mid-1980s as a DJ on the CHR network Radio Deejay. Now, as a performer, he has topped Italy's airplay charts with Salvami, and admits that "radio has been very important". Betty Senatore is a presenter on (RAI) Radio 2, where Salvami enjoys "high rotation status". "Salvami currently occupies the number one [airplay] spot," she tells Music & Media. "Jovanotti has done something that is both original and marvellous. He got to play on chat shows that don't normally have music, although I think he genuinely wanted to promote the anti-

One of the most controversial elements of Salvami is the refer-Jovanotti's fellow ence to Tuscan, the New York-based writer Oriana Fallaci, who caused offence by claiming Muslims were inferior and that no mercy should be shown in Afghanistan. She also expressed admiration for the individual courage of the September 11 hijackers. In Salvami, Jovanotti refers to her as, "The journalist and writer who loves war because it reminds her of when she was young and beautiful." As a result he was mauled on one TV show by the Berlusconi government's assistant minister of culture, Vittorio Sgarbi, but Jovanotti seems to have taken it in his stride.

"Music is very compartmentalised, with protected zones and this is something that the industry encourages. Yet the artists I admire are groups like the Beatles who broke this mould by bringing music out to society as a whole. This is what I tried to do, a little naively perhaps, but I knew I would come under attack," Jovanotti says.

Jovanotti's much talked about hit single has also helped detract attention from the fact that his previous album, *Lorenzo Live* (2000), was a flop at retail. Stefano Zappaterra, who recently succeeded Claudio Buja as head of A&R at Universal Music Italy, comments: "We're not remotely worried about this album. We've given it a double platinum shipment."

Similarly, Universal hopes that *Il Quinto Mondo* could be a Universal hopes border breaker. Says Zappaterra, "It's getting a simultaneous release in Switzerland and the GSA countries, while most of the rest of Europe will be releasing it from March onwards. Holland and Belgium have traditionally been good markets for him and we've recorded at least six of the album's songs in Spanish." As for sales predictions, Zappaterra considers "a total of a million units in Europe would be a great result for this album."



An unlikely popstar, moustachioed 53-year old jazz singer John Larkin, aka Scatman John, shot to fame in early 1995 with novelty dance record Scatman (Iceberg Records/RCA). Originating from LA, Larkin's material was signed to Iceberg Records in Denmark and licenced to RCA Germany for the rest of the world. "It was huge in Denmark because it was signed to a local label," says programme director at Radio ABC (CHR) in Randers, Denmark Morten Bach. "It exploded back then. We were on it right from the start." For a novelty track, which often is rigidly tied to a certain period in time, Scatman has survived well as a one-hit wonder. Seven years on, Bach keeps the track on the station's recurrent rotation. "But the question is for how long, because it is a novelty number after all," he adds.

DANCE BEAT

The weekly dance chart comment by Harald Roth

The 50th number one in the history of the Dance Traxx chart still awaits its coronation, as the 49th is heading toward a new longevity record. iiO's Rapture (Tastes So Sweet) (Made/Ministry of Sound) continues to rule the chart for an unbelievable 12th week on the trot. Only Daft Punk's One More Time (Labels), and Roger Sanchez's Another Chance (R-Senal/Defected & Sony) have enjoyed more time at the top; Daft Punk topping the charts for 13 straight weeks a year ago, and Sanchez staying number one last summer for a recordbreaking 14 weeks in a row.

This week's number two is ATB's *Hold You* (Kontor), up two notches from last week's number four. It's the German act's highest charting dancefloor hit to date, with a real chance of going all the way to the top next week. If it makes it, it'll be the first Dance Traxx number one for the successful German dance label Kontor Records.

Indeed, the race for next week's top spot should be pretty interesting, since Belgian-signed Junior Jack is also in contention with *Thrill Me* (PIAS). Rocketing from 20 to number three over the past fortnight, it would be the second track from that particular artist to reach the top.

Two tracks come into the top 10 for the first time. Jamiroquai's Love Foolosophy (Soho Square/Sony, last week's number two on the Movers listing, has zipped up to number eight on the overall chart. It's a dance-floor burner in the UK, Germany, and the Netherlands, as well as a hit on a European radio—it debuted at 29 on last week's European Radio Top 50. Meanwhile, German duo Blank and Jones are the second new entry to the top 10, climbing from number 11 to nine with their latest tune, Desire (Gang Go).

Further down the chart, ATFC's Sleep Talk, (Defected) featuring Lisa Millett, climbs from 148 to number 30, making it this week's number one on the Movers chart.

Finally, Shakira is looking to become a contender for the Dance Traxx top 40 with her single Whenever, Wherever (Epic), also known by its Spanish title, Suerte. Both the Spanish and English versions have been rapidly climbing M&M's pan-European radio and sales charts.

Also on Uptown and big hit all over Denmark at the moment, Vent På Mig is taken from the Danish blockbuster movie En Kort En Lang. Actor Peter Frödin, who has a part in the film, performs the track. "It's a monster hit," says Brodde. "It sounds a bit like Ricky Martin's She Bangs. Some people are tired of the song, but when it's played in clubs, the dance floor explodes. It has the same effect as Kylie's Can't Get You Out Of My Head. Everyone's wild about it."

Sophie Ellis-Bextor's Murder On The Dancefloor (Polydor) is inching its way up the airplay chart, up to 17 from last week's 19. The dance track is just starting to take off in Denmark. "It's going to be big," predicts Brodde. "We played Take Me Home as well, but that didn't really take off here. Everybody plays Murder On The Dancefloor now, it's really growing in Denmark."

In the coming weeks, the Pet Shop Boys' new offering *Home And Dry* (Chrysalis) looks set to make a big impact at European radio. And Travis' *Flowers In The Window* (Independiente) is likely to be the latest in a long line of radio hits from the Scottish act.

MTV Live one-hour concert with Alanis in Milan, which will be seen across MTV's network in more than 100 million European homes."

The show was recorded in Milan before 1,600 invited guests, and saw the Canadian singer showcase tracks off her new record as well as from her 1995 debut Jagged Little Pill and 1998's Supposed Former Infatuation Junkie, which together have sold over 40 million copies.

"With re-establishing her it could have gone either way-VH1 and AOR, or the other way," says McGhie of MTV's continued support for the Maverick/Warner-signed artist. "We're lucky to have MTV's involvement with the project."

broadcaster's association with Morissette dates back seven years to when it aired her first video, You Oughta Know. The following year she won Best Female at the MTV Europe Music Awards, and she has three MTV Video Music Awards. More recently, she released an MTV Unplugged album in 1999. Hansen continues: "Her video, Hands Clean, is receiving acrossthe-board playlist rotation. We've supported Alanis since 1995 and will continue to do so because she delivers intelligent, well-crafted music."

Access to the artist has been possible because, says McGhie "the single is not going to be commercially released in the US. America went to radio on January 21, so we were fortunate to go before then."

There was a webcast broadcast by MSN on February 8 from the Whiskey A-Go-Go venue in Los Angeles, which is exclusive to MSN until the end of March. Meanwhile, UK rock station Virgin Radio has been recording some of Morissette's London showcases.

The second single off Under Rug Swept is expected to be Precious Illusions, scheduled for the beginning of April by which time, McGhie says, "summer [tour] dates will have been announced"

EMI makes cuts across Europe

Group about Lumbroso's departure or his replacement. M&M understands that the position of general manager of Capitol France has been handed to Alain Artaud, current GM of Virgin France's imprints Source and Labels.

The new line of reporting in France remains unclear, since EMI Recorded Music Continental Europe chairman and CEO Emmanuel de Buretel, who is still president of Virgin France, has not yet appointed a chief executive for EMI in the country. Lumbroso did not return calls, de Buretel was unavailable and a spokeswoman for EMI Group in London declined to comment.

The changes in France follows the announcement at the beginning of last week of changes in Spain, which see the departure of Miguel Angel Gómez, president of the Iberian regional division of Capitol Records. Gómez, who joined Capitol Records Spain in 1995, also exits as president of Spanish labels' body AFYVE.

In the wake of Gómez's departure. EMI veteran Chacho Ruiz has been appointed president of EMI Recorded Music Spain. Ruiz was president of EMI Recorded Music Argentina (formerly EMI Odeon), a company he joined in 1972, and is relocating to Madrid with immediate effect. He assumes responsibility for both Capitol Records Spain and Virgin Records Spain, whose managing director Lydia Fernández has been confirmed in her role and will now report to Ruiz. This is the first time in Spain the the two label groups, Capitol and Virgin, have come under a single management. In a statement, EMI says that "both labels will continue to maintain their own separate identities in this new structure."

David Ferreira, managing director

of EMI Recorded Music Portugal, will report directly to de Buretel, "for the time being", according to a company statement

Although nothing is certain in the Italian music industry at the moment, insiders expect that fall-out from the EMI restructuring will be relatively minor. EMI Music Italy's president and chief executive, Riccardo Clary, is already head of both divisions, and Virgin's GM, Marco Alboni, reports to him.

Many back office operations in Italy, such as legal affairs, IT and personnel, are already run jointly. Capitol and Virgin do, however, operate from separate buildings in downtown Milan and this is therefore likely to change. EMI Italy is generally considered one of the group's most successful operations in Europe-last year it produced Italy's top-selling album (Stupido Hotel by Vasco Rossi) and single (Can't Get You Out of My Head by Kylie Minogue), while it also uncovered one of the country's most promising new artists in Tiziano Ferro.

In Scandinavia, Capitol Records MDs Stefan Gullberg in Sweden, Nils Heldal in Norway, Wemppa Koivumäki in Finland and Mik Christensen and Nikolaj Foss in Denmark report to EMI Music Scandinavia & Finland president & CEO Michael Ritto in Copenhagen, while all Virgin MDs in Scandinavia-Åsa Törneryd in Sweden, Per Eirik Johansen in Norway, and Henriette Blix in Denmark—report directly to de Buretel. One key question is whether the regional structure for EMI in Scandinavia will be retained, and what role Ritto will have in the new set-up.

One former EMI executive notes

that "the integration has already taken place in some of the Scandinavian countries. In Finland, Virgin was only an imprint, but in Denmark there has historically been two separate offices and set-ups, the same in Sweden. In Norway, Virgin and EMI have signed and marketed artists separately, but with a shared financial controller, sales staff and administrative sup-

One Nordic EMI executive-who asked not to be identified—comments: "The process with Levy and Munns coming in has provided a breath of fresh air and given a sense that something is finally happening in the company. Finally, we've got the right people at the top.

port."

He adds: "It's a very intelligent and way overdue plan. It's totally free of internal politics, and it's been a long time since we saw something like that. [One MD per country] is something which no-one has dared to think of before, mostly because of legacy, politics, and a few personal preferences. Ever since the EMI-Virgin deal in 1992 there have been, and there still are, managing directors with EMI and Virgin in various countries who don't know how to collaborate with each other and maximise common goals.'

He concludes: "With the psychological, almost military order-This applies to everyone, period!'-Levy and Munns have been able to neutralise 10 years of infected, internal problems in one second. Politically, it's brilliant-let's just hope the results will be the same.'

'The idea is that it's any kind of music we want, however disparate it might seem. Because it's all coming from the same attitude it'll fit together on the label," Albarn tells Music &

The Blur singer is an equal partner in the new venture with Alan Scholefield and Mark Ainley, the shop's coowners. Albarn, a longtime customer, says he intends to be a fully active partner and will be keenly involved in A&R-ing the label.

"We'd been thinking about a label

will release Mali Music on April 1 on for ages and Damon's enthusiasm was the catalyst," reveals Ainley, while Scholefield adds:

Working in his London studio with Gorillaz bass player Junior Dan, the Blur frontman set about looping, sampling and dubbing the tapes. He added elements of reggae, house, rock and ragga, although other pieces of music were left virtually

untouched. The tapes then went back to Mali, where Bocoum worked further on them.

Albarn will appear with the African musicians in a concert to launch the album at London's Barbican Centre on March 26. Prior to the release of Mali Music, a 12-inch remix by house DJ Phil Asher will be sent to club DJs. Albarn also says he plans summer festival appearances with the hand

Meanwhile, Gorillaz are to make a full-length cartoon film later this year, and Blur have started work on the group's next album. Albarn says he has written "15 or 16 songs" for the still-untitled record and estimates it will take a further eight months in the studio to complete.

The album will be released in 2003 and will be Blur's first since 1999

Universal Music International has acquired the European recorded music and music publishing operations of the Koch Group, the independent German-language repertoire label based in Austria and Bavaria. The acquisition excludes the US-based Koch operations and its Austrian distribution centre. The company will continue to operate under the Koch name, and the majority of the members of staff are expected to stay with the company. The acquisition is subject to regulatory approval.

The Isle of Man Communications Commission has finally granted a 10-year licence to the long-running MusicMann 279 radio project. The long-wave service is expected to launch towards the end of 2003 with an adultoriented music policy targeted at listeners in the UK and Ireland.

An appeal court has confirmed a judgement made five years ago in which French Hot AC network Europe 2 was found guilty of breach of intellectual property law by broadcasting "virtual duets" which combine the recordings of two artists without the consent of the right owners. Following the use of recordings from its catalogue, Universal Music France pressed charges and the court ordered Europe 2 to pay euros 15,000 to the record company.

Rob Markus, who left digital distributor DX3 last December, where he was managing director, is establishing the international office of US online music company ARTISTdirect Records. Based in London, Markus has been appointed VP of international, while former Play It Again Sam international manager in Brussels, Dave Cronen, becomes director of international.

Emap has advertised the Kiss 100/London programme director's position externally as it seeks to replace Andy Roberts (see story, page 4), although the company is also understood to be considering internal candidates. And expect Christian Smith-who recently departed his position as head of music for Chrysalis Radio's dance network Galaxy (M&M, February 16)-to be appointed to the new position of Kiss 100 music co-ordinator.

Universal Music Norway managing director Petter Singsaas has been elected the new chairman of the Norwegian affiliate of the IFPI. Singsaas takes over the position from Rune Hagberg, who was recently promoted to deputy managing director of Sony Music Nordic and general manager of Sony Music Norway. Meanwhile, Universal Norway is to launch Sonet Distribution, an in-house distributor for up-andcoming local indie labels, at the By:Larm industry conference March 7-10, an event at which Malcolm McLaren will be intrerviewed on stage by rock journalist Arvid Skancke-Knutsen.

And finally, it appears that Polydor/Universal Music UK are about to bring Lene Nystrøm (pictured) in from the cold. The former Aqua lead singer is understood to be embarking on a solo career, with an upcoming album project reportedly being handled by Polydor's A&R wizard Colin Barlow. A source says Nystrøm is to be positioned as "a female version

of Robbie Williams."
