BMG dumps regions for functional structure

New York — At a single stroke, BMG's

new worldwide organisational structure, announced on January 23, ends the company's well-established regional setup, in favour of four operational groups.

Under the changes, BMG has replaced the European, Latin and Asia regional offices with four operational divisions—Office of the Chairman, Label Group, Territory Man-

agement, and Corporate Center-all of which directly report to the Office of the Chairman, led by BMG chairman/CEO Rolf Schmidt-Holtz (pictured).

A BMG spokesman in New York tells M&M: "The regional system worked during its time, but we want to take the next step. We are creating smaller regional groups, getting managers with A&R backgrounds and experience." spokesman refused to discuss potential

job losses but confirmed that the new-look BMG would reduce bureaucracy "lighten overheads".

The regional structure which has long-dominated BMG's way of thinking is the former legacy of president/CEO Strauss Zelnick and chairman Michael Dornemann, both of whom left the company in 2000 after

clashing with then-Bertelsmann chairman/CEO Thomas Middelhoff over BMG's strategic direction. The structure is now being swept away in favour of what BMG COO Michael Smellie describes as "an organisation built on records with a global reach. The labels continued on page 21


Berman alarm at Directive retreat

CANNES "alarmed" Jay Berman has urged European Union member states to rapidly implement into their local legislation the EU Copyright Directive without altering the text of the document.

Delivering his Midem keynote speech in Cannes on January 19, the IFPI's chairman/CEO (pictured) said he was concerned about delays in the implementation of what he

described as "an important tool for

In EMI's Robbie Williams the music industry has a new spokesman, although the jury is out as to whether it's a good or bad thing.

Williams, like many of us, went to the French Riviera last week for Midem and delivered one of his trademark snappy one-liners; he found piracy "great". There was "nothing no one can do about it".

That Europe's most popular artist says he finds piracy cool should be no surprise—he is in sync with his fans, even if, luckily for him, many of them continue to buy his records. He might find it less cool, argued a few people in Cannes, when his royalty cheques start shrinking.

By adding that record companies "don't know what to do about [piracy]," Williams asked for a rebuke, which duly came from several sources. IFPI chairman Jay Berman, who delivered Midem's keynote speech the day after Robbie's outburst, easily played "the responsible' figure against Robbie "the irresponsible" (after all, that's what is expected from artists, right?). Berman appeared upset, but secretly could not have wished for a better scenario.

Williams gave him a wonderful platform from which to outline the dangers of physical piracy-linked to organised crime—and online piracy, affecting everyone in the food chain, save for telcos and ISPs.

point—also mentioned by Berman's chairman/CEO Hilary Rosen in her MidemNet keynote speech—was that law enforcement and proper legislation is one thing, but it's by offering proper online alternatives that the industry will win back consumers.

Such views would have carried more weight if indeed consumers, especially in Europe, had seen a difference in 2002, but aside from a few services such as OD2, Vitaminic or Wippit, there's still far more on offer for free. And little can be expected in 2003 from Pressplay and Music-Net, with both services focusing on the US market.

What came across at Midem was the notion that to

woo consumers back, labels must offer something extra. This was exemplified by the presentation of Microsoft's new Windows Media, which allows through DRM systems to select—and limit—which applications consumers can access from a CD. A way forward yes, but not the only way, hopefully; after all, who really wants a Microsoft-dominated market?

Italian radio lobbys against airplay quotas

MILAN — Italy's commercial radio groups have stated their outright opposition to any plans by the Italian gov-

ernment to introduce airplay quotas which would force them to devote 50% of their musical output to local repertoire.

As the Italian parliament's Culture Committee continues to examine assorted legislative proposals in connection with the country's long-awaited Music Bill (M&M, November 16), preliminary drafts

of the Bill-designed to give help to the country's troubled music industryinclude such measures as tax incentives and establishing a French-style export office, as well as the 50% airplay quota proposal. The country's record industry is prepared to accept a 40% quota, according to Enzo Mazza (pictured), director general of local labels' organisa-

tion FIMI, but this must be for new, rather than established, domestic "Established artists. names like Vasco Rossi don't need support, but young artists definitely need more airplay," says Mazza.

The three radio lobby groups-RNA, representing the national networks. and two organisations rep-

resenting local stations, FRT and Aeranti-Corallo-made their cases in a joint presentation to the parliamentary Culture Committee on January 9.

In a document which the lobby groups claim represents the views of Italy's "1200 radio stations and 14 national networks, which serve 36 million daily listeners and employ 15,000 people" it was stated that 15% of Italy's radio stations already play exclusively Italian music, while the national networks play an average of 37.7% Italian music. The report says the average figure for local stations is 44%.

The Culture Committee, under the presidency of Ferdinando Adornato of the ruling Forza Italia party, has yet to draft the final Bill, although Adornato recently assured FIMI representatives that it would be presented "by March." The proposal for a 50% airplay quota forms part of a proposal made by Guglielmo Rositani of the nationalist Alleanza Nazionale party, a partner in the Berlusconi coalition government.

Critics create new 'credible' Danish music award

COPENHAGEN — Describing last year's Danish Music Awards (DMAs), as "commercial, predictable and self-serving," a group of 15 leading Danish music critics collectively known as FDM have bonded together to create a new music award, Steppeulven, as an alternative to the established accolades.

"We don't care if the artist has sold five hundred or five million records," notes Klaus Lynggaard, a music critic at broadsheet newspaper Information. "We have decided to create an award based on credibility and originality."

Industry reaction to the rebel awards has been surprisingly positive. "We welcome it with open arms as another window of opportunity with its own merits," says Ole Mortensen (pictured), international exploitation director at EMI Denmark.

Lynggaard and two other critics

founded the music critics' organisation FDM and came up with the award idea

after last year's DMAs. The new award, for which only home-grown acts will be eligible, is named after a '60s band that pioneered Danish-language pop.

"It won't be a show, but business, serious streamlined affair with music at the core," says Lynggaard. "Instead of the acts doing one song, they will perform a small-er set, live." Outlandish

and Mew are among seven live acts booked so far for the January 31 event at Copenhagen venue Vega.

Urban act Mælk de Kojn (BMG) have received six nominations in the 10 categories, followed by Outlandish (BMG), Saybia (EMI/Medley) and Under Byen (Pladeselskabet).

Umbrella labour organisation LO is helping fund the event, and will give a

grant of euros 6,666 to the winner of the Hopeful of the Year award. The act taking that prize will also be guaranteed a slot at this year's Roskilde Festival.

"It's positive there's even more focus on music, and I like-just as it is in the world of cinema-the idea that there's an alternative to the major awards," says IFPI Den-

mark marketing director Annette Tingstrup, who oversees the DMAs. "One element of the critics awards I really like is the prize for 'best idea' in music. It can pertain to radio, management, the web, a label or anything to do with music. It's an idea that wouldn't fit into the DMA format."




YLE defends new-look stations ON THE BEA

HELSINKI — Finnish public broadcaster YLE has been responding to criticism that its new bouquet of national stations, which debuted on January 13, are too similar to services already provided by its commercial radio rivals.

Pointing out YLE's obligation as a state-funded broadcaster to provide an alternative to commercial radio formats, the commercial stations have been accusing new Hot AC station YLE Q (which has replaced Radio Aino) and CHR station YLE X (which has replaced Radiomafia) of being direct competitors to commercial stations such as AC outlet Radio Nova and CHR stations Kiss FM and NRJ Finland.

YLE dismisses the accusations made by the commercial sector, and is urging critics to listen to its new stations properly for longer periods of time. "Anyone



who takes time to properly listen to our programming will notice that our stations are not clones of Kiss or NRJ," says YLE's director of programming Heikki Peltonen (pictured). "Of course [YLE X and YLE Q] play some of the same music as the commercial stations, but the biggest difference is in how all the other things are done."

Perhaps bearing out Peltonen's theory, Kiss FM's initial views on the new YLE X have softened after a week of intensive listening to the station, according to programming director Pasi Piipponen. "I expected them to move more clearly onto our turf, but YLE X is playing more rock and is primarily targeted both at male and more teen-oriented audiences.

Petri Paarnio, programme director of commercial domestic repertoire station Radio Suomipop, adds: "In commercial radio we're amazed that YLE can afford to just throw away a strong brand like Radiomafia.'

YLE has received an abundance of feedback during the first week of its new services, much of it from listeners who are missing their favourite programmes. "The amount of feedback we've received is positive in that it reveals people really care about what we do," says Peltonen. "Unfortunately spontaneous reactions are often more likely to be negative.

EU boost for music piracy battle

BRUSSELS - The music industry was given a much-needed boost in its fight against piracy last week (January 20) when new rules to tackle the increasing waves of counterfeit goods entering the European Union were unveiled.

Under the proposals, customs officials will be given more power to stop the flow of counterfeit goods, the range of goods that can be seized will be extended, and officials will be given the authority to conduct more extensive searches of travellers' bags.

Procedures will streamlined to make it easier and cheaper for companies to ask customs to seize and destroy counterfeit products, without having to await the outcome of substantive legal proceedings that could take years.

The proposal suggests granting customs officials the right to open investigations and to improve datasharing between industry and governments about the trade in fake products that manufacturers. It also improves the quality of information provided to customs by right holders applying for action. The period of validity and the form of applications for action would also be harmonised, and applicants encouraged to lodge them by computer.

Robert Verrue, the EC's director general for tax and customs matters, admits that counterfeiting has changed much in recent years, both in scale and scope. "Piracy as a phenomenon has been underestimated for years, and enforcement mechanisms been underdeveloped," he says. The trade in pirated CDs alone is estimated at between four and five billion a year, he adds.

The new rules are likely to come into force next year, once approved by the European Parliament and national governments.

LOCAL MUSIC STAGES RECOVERY IN PORTUGAL

LISBON -- Sales of domestic reprtoire in Portugal are showing signs of modest recovery after four years in freefall. According to expected market figures for the final quarter of 2002, local IFPI affiliate AFP reported that sales of Portuguese music had increased, thanks to several quality albums launched in 2002 being well received by the public. Amongst these was Pedro Abrunhosa's platinum album Momento (Universal), which has sold over 50,000 units and topped the album charts for five weeks.

SGAE THANKS PREMIER FOR ANTI-PIRACY MOVE



MADRID — Teddy Bautista (pictured), executive president of Spanish authors' and publishers' society SGAE, has written letters to Spain's prime minister José María Aznar and justice minister José María Michavila expressing "gratitude

and satisfaction" for anti-piracy measures approved on January 17 as part of a wide-ranging law and order campaign. The measures include a toughening of penalties, expulsion of illegal immigrants, and quicker trials. "Violations of intellectual property rights impoverish our economy and weaken our enormous potential in cultural expansion," wrote Bautista.

OD2 unveils Digital Download Day

CANNES — The offensive against illegal P2P services stepped up another gear at the Midem trade fair in Cannes, France, on January 20 when OD2—the online music service provider co-founded by Peter Gabriel—unveiled the launch of Digital Download Day (DDD) Europe.

Supported by international trade group IFPI and the European Parliament, DDD Europe aims to promote awareness of legal online music in the region during the week of March 21-28. The move follows satisfaction with a UK-based pilot last October.

By registering on the digitaldownloadday.com website, consumers will be provided with a credit voucher worth five euros to

download or stream music for free across 16 European retail web sites in six countries (UK, the Netherlands, France, Germany, Spain and Italy).



Once registered, they can choose music from a catalogue of more than 150,000 tracks by 8,500 artists, including Warner Music, EMI, Universal Music and BMG Entertainment acts. The participating online

retailers include Italy's Tiscali Music, hmv.co.uk, Los40.com in Spain and Wanadoo in France.

After spending the free voucher, they can stream and download music at 16 cents per track or two euros per album, provided that the music is played on their PCs. Or they can burn the cuts onto CD for prices varying from euro 0.99 to euro 1.50 per track.

OD2 CEO and co-founder Charles Grimsdale (pictured) argued that this move will prove that virus-free, high-quality legitimate services are better value than the illegal P2P services, which are offering 100 million pirated recordings a day. "Legal sites are the best kept secret at the moment," he said. "We need to get across to people that these services do represent good value."

Growth again for French market in 2002

CANNES — France again bucked the trend in most major markets in 2002 by posting a 4.4% rise in the value of music shipments to 1.3 billion euros, according to figures unveiled at last week's Midem trade fair in Cannes by local trade body SNEP. Unit shipments rose 3.3% from 2001 to 171 million.

"The recovery we enjoyed in 2001 was confirmed in 2002," says SNEP head of economic affairs Antonie Cartier. Results for the first nine months of 2002 showed a 10% growth, although the fourth quarter revealed a decline in sales.

A total of 39.3 million singles (against 38m in 2001), 125 7m albums (against

122.8 m) and 3.8m video music carriers (against 3.0m) were sold in 2002.

According to SNEP, France is expected to replace Germany in 2002 as the world's fourth largest music market. SNEP director general Herve Rony cites the strength of local repertoire, which accounted for 58% of sales last year, as one of the main reasons for the continuing success of the French market.

Seven of the best-selling singles in 2002 were francophone, nine of the 10 best-selling were francophone.

"The figures are good," says Rony, "and France remains an untypical market. However, we do see potential clouds coming our way. There's a tough interna-

tional environment, CDburning is also affecting us and the online piracy cloud has not stopped at the French border."

Another source of satisfaction for the industry in the 2002 figures was the ongoing success of French acts outside France. Statistics for 2001 show that international sales of French and Frenchsigned acts topped close to 40 million units, an increase of over 2000. Eric Morand, founder of electronica label F Communications and president of the French export office, said that "despite a bad international climate, sales by French artists are still on the rise, which is a tribute to the quality of the artists and the teams working with them.'

FRENCH CULTURE MINISTER HONOURS INDUSTRY FIGURES



Three European industry personnalities as well as Brazilian new minister of culture Gilberto Gil, were honoured at Midem by French minister of culture Jean-Jacques Aillagon. Awarded the medal of Officer in the Order of Arts and Letters, one of France's highest accolades, were Gil, Reinhold Kreile, CEO of German

authors' rights society GEMA; Jean-Francois Michel (pictured), managing director of the French Export Office; and Eric Morand, founder of electronica label F Communications. Aillagon said Kreile has been recognised for GEMA's initiatives with French authors' body SACEM, which contributed to the "building of Franco-German relationships." Michel has "been a militant for the cause of export for many years," and his award is for "an action that has delivered so much for French music." Morand, meanwhile, helped to "establish the world-renowned 'French touch' in electronica music."

CHINA READY TO OPEN DOORS TO MUSIC SPECIALISTS

A delegation of Chinese music executives visiting Midem for the first time told delegates that a massive market is open and ready for business. Gary Chen, chairman of Pulay Talent Agency, said: "The music industry is a numbers game and the one thing China has is huge numbers," although he acknowledged the market was missing two vital ingredients: specialist retailers and music publishers. "There are tremendous opportunities for foreign partners in these sectors," he added. Daxin Zhao, GM of the state-owned China Record Corp., said China's joining the World Trade Organisation has led to it strengthening copyright legislation which would make it a more attractive business environment.



ROEDY, RECEIVES MIDEM ACCOLADE

William Roedy (pictured), chief executive of MTV International, received the Midem Nesuhi Ertegun Person of the Year Award at a gala dinner in Cannes on January 21 in the presence of a number of industry personalities, including EMI Group chairman/CEO Eric Nicoli, Sony Music

Europe president Paul Burger and IFPI chairman/CEO Jay Berman. Reed Midem chief executive Paul Zilk described Roedy as a man "passionate about music from all parts of the world" and an "shameless groupie". Performing at the ceremony were Swedish act The Cardigans and Destiny's Child's Kelly Rowland.

FRENCH MUSIC RETAILER CALLS FOR VAT CUT

Leading French music retail chain Fnac ran a five-day campaign in its store in Cannes last week to highlight demands for a cut in VAT on sales of pre-recorded music from the current 19.5% to 5.6%. Speaking at a Midem summit in which industry representatives called for a VAT reduction on recorded music, Christophe Cuvillier, director-general of Fnac, called

on the industry and retailers to sign up to a pledge that it would pass on any savings to the consumer. Arlene McCarthy, a member of the European Parliament, said Europe's politicians recognised that the music industry

"needed a break, [and as] legislators we want to support a VAT reduction campaign, but it's not going to be easy". Despite calls for VAT to be reduced in areas such as music sold online or video, Francois Leotard, the French "envoy" to the EU on the issue of VAT, said his remit was limited to physical CDs and other pre-recorded products. Leotard, who was responsible for lowering VAT in 1987 in France, told attendees that he hopes to convinced all 14 EU member states to the urgency of such measure.

Dance moves for Italia Network

MILAN - Despite the current downturn in the dance music sector, one of the biggest gainers in Italy's Audiradio ratings for the fourth quarter of 2002 was dance station Radio Italia Network, which saw its average daily audience increase by 6.6%, returning it to the two million

"We've maintained our position when many others have lost listeners, which has to be seen as a satisfactory result," says Italia Network managing director Giorgio Bacco. "I think we've achieved results by fine-tuning, rather than changing, our programming, bringing in new DJs like Camilla from MTV and shifting other shows and DJs to more suitable times of the day."

Audiradio's fourth quarter figures, based on telephone interviews conducted between November 2 and December 20, estimated the country's average daily radio audience at 35.26 million. Of the leading 10 national networks, five saw gains and five suffered losses. In addition to Italia Network, the winners included the public stations RAI 1 and RAI 2, CHR outlet Radio 105 and domestic repertoire Radio Italia SMI. Small losses were suffered by the two biggest CHR networks, Radio Deejay and Radio Dimensione Suono, and the two AC-leaning music networks, Radio Montecarlo and RTL 102.5 Hit Radio.

Italia Network's Bacco says of the latest figures: "If there is a general trend, then it's the [audience] flight from generalised networks either to local stations or to more specialised, formatted networks like ours and one or two others, such as Radio Italia SMI."

Morronzoo overtakes P3

STOCKHOLM - For the first time ever in Sweden, a commercial station has more listeners to its breakfast show than that of the breakfast show, on national public CHR sta-

Morronzoo ("Morning Zoo") on MTG Radio's Hot AC network Rix

FM now has a daily reach of 462,500 according to the latest quarterly ratings from RUAB, covering the period September 30 to December 8, 2002. That's a couple of thousand more than P3's Morgonpasset, although

still substantially less than public news/talk station's P1 morning news programme, which reaches more than 600,000 listeners.

"I believe we've made a connection with our listeners," says MTG Radio's group programme director Christer Modig. "The chemistry between three strong personalities [pictured above] is also important, plus the fact that the show is about quite everyday things close to the everyday life of the listeners.'

Rix FM increased its overall daily reach in the RUAB ratings to 10.3%, up from 9.7% a year ago and 10.0% in the previous survey. Main competitor Mix Megapol is still at 6.9%, while NRJ is up 0.2 to 6.8%.

Among the public stations, SR's local network P4 has gained 1.3 to achieve a 36% daily reach, although this is 1.4 below its rating a year ago. Although its breakfast show has been overtaken, P3's recent decline seems to have been halted, with the station increasing its reach by 0.1 to 10.5%, though that's still 2.0 lower than a year ago.

In Stockholm, local public full-service station P5 Radio Stockholm continues to lose listeners, falling to a 13.5% daily reach. Sister channel P4 Radio Stockholm, which targets an older target group, is now almost as

big with a reach of 13%.

MTG Radio's Lugna Favoriter 104.7 (soft AC) and Power Hit Radio (CHR/dance) are still the number one and two commercial stations in Stockholm at, respectively, 9.2% and 7.4%

In Skäne, commercial radio stations broadcasting on low-powered frequencies originally intended for community radio continue to score. Lugna Melodier, run by Bonnier Radio with a Soft AC format, has surpassed both Rix FM and Radio City (Hot AC) less than a year after its launch with a daily reach of 8.8%. This follows the recent success of Bonnier Radio's two Gold-formatted Vinyl stations in the area.

Everyone's a winner in new French figures

PARIS - France's radio market has reached an almost perfect 50-50 equilibrium between national music networks and full-service and news/talk stations.

The combined audience of RTL, France Info, France Inter, Europe 1, RMC Info, BFM and a few others matches that of NRJ (confirmed for a second successive sweep as the leading station in France in terms of reach), Nostalgie, Skyrock (achieving its highest ever audience), Fun Radio (which has gained 200,000 listeners in two months), Europe 2, Cherie FM, RFM, Rire & Chansons, RTL2 and MFM

Overall, however, the speech-led networks have gained two points in audience share at the expense of the music outlets, which could be

explained by important events such as the situation in Iraq and floods in the south of France.

The latest Médiamétrie survey covers the period November-December 2002, and is the second set ratings results Médiamétrie's change in methodology, which has seen the inclusion of the 13-15 year-old audience for the first time.

The major highlight of the figures was the overall increase in reach by almost all stations compared to the previous (September-October 2002) survey. As a whole, radio's total weekly audience jumped from 84.1% in September-October 2002 to 86.5 % in November-December 2002.

Other highlights include the strong performance of Radio France's Radio Bleu (a network of MOR/talk local stations), up to 7.4%.



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Dopp sets trend by bucking it

n 1986 Warner employees were presented with a new act from the UK notorious for playing 20 minute sets, causing riots at their gigs and making feedback an integral part of their songs. The band was the Jesus and Mary Chain, and when the assembled product managers were asked who wanted to take on the project, only one hand was raised. The hand belonged to Bernd Dopp, who went on to break the young Scots in Germany.

Sixteen years later, Seeed, an 11-piece reggae band from Berlin singing in both German and English, collected two Echo awards and stole the show with a blinding performance at the gala. The act are signed to Warner imprint Downbeat, which was launched in 1997 when Dopp offered the owner of one of Germany's leading reggae record shops a label deal.

Both examples highlight some of Dopp's outstanding qualities: a love of music, a determination to break acts and a desire to do the best job with the minimum of fuss.

Despite operating in a declining market, Warner Music Germany reported a 3% increase in turnover for 2002 compared to the previous year. *Olaf Furniss* profiles the company's president Bernd Dopp, a man well-known for bucking the trend In Germany.

A&R focus

At the same time, Warner Music Germany has been moulded into a even more music orientated company since Dopp took the helm, with a strong focus on the core areas of A&R, marketing and promotion.

"We have people who fit into the company culture and are dedicated to music, able to think for themselves, introduce new ideas and have an affinity with the artists," he says.

This is backed up by Wegener. "It is worth looking at who Bernd has put

"Bernd knows what the assets of a record company are—music and artists," says the Oliver Wegener, managing director of Germany's largest music marketing and promotion company, Public Propaganda.

Dopp's former mentor, Gerd Gebhardt, who until last year was president of Warner Northern/ Central Europe, agrees.

Music lover

"He can get on with the most difficult artists," he says. "There are many people who claim to be music lovers, but with Bernd it is actually true."

This becomes evident when talking to Dopp in his office. On the walls hang giant posters of acts he has worked with such as Lou Reed, while even the briefest conversation will see the Warner president namecheck at least half a dozen artists he is currently excited about.

Significantly, he is also one of the few German executives who insists on playing forthcoming releases and new signings to visitors. Moreover, ask some of his competitors what they are most proud of in their careers and they are likely to start boasting about market share or some particularly personal achievement. This is not the case with Dopp.

"I wouldn't consider myself a proud person," he says. "I would describe myself as low key. I'm proud of our artists and proud of my team."

While the global record company culture is increasingly orientated towards immediate success, Dopp further distinguishes himself by sticking by his signings—a policy which has paid dividends with acts such as Seeed,

into senior positions within the company—there are a lot of people with a strong connection to artists," he says. "It's a classic record company structure, but while others are still talking about it, Bernd has already done it."

And it is clear that in a short space of time he has succeeded in establishing Warner as the first port of call for many managers seeking deals for unsigned acts.

"What Bernd has done is great, I would approach Warner with any artist I am working with," says Jens Geisemeier, who manages several songwriters and represents labels for licensing deals.

It is testimony to Dopp's restructuring that his reputation as a music man loyal to his team still remains intact. Few noticed the roster being reduced by some 40 acts and that by moving East West and WEA into a

Media mix-up

Yet while he is admired within the industry and also among retailers, he has sometimes been less successful at communicating his strengths in the German media. In the past editors have complained about strong-arm tactics being used following poor reviews of Warner acts, with threats to withdraw advertising and publications being struck off mailing lists not unheard of.

"He's one of the few executives who I wouldn't address in informal [du] register, I've never got to the point where we have sat down and had a couple of beers," says one veteran music industry journalist, who asked to remain nameless.

"There was a time when we got a

complaint about every three months that we were not writing about enough WEA acts."

When asked about past tiffs with the media, Dopp is keen to point out that his approach was based on fighting his artists' corner. "We expect the same professionalism from others as we demonstrate in our work," he says. "Having said that, you do get older and wiser!"

His media-savvy counterpart at Universal Germany, Tim Renner, acknowledges that his Warner peer is sometimes misunderstood but is quick to point out examples of Dopp's more conciliatory side.

"Bernd is an innovative wolf, who comes across as a conservative sheep," he says. "He's an extreme democrat who can switch off his ego for the greater good."

Radio quotas

This was evident in Dopp seeking to build bridges with commercial radio stations during his time as head of the German industry's chart and marketing committee. Nevertheless, he backs the principal of quotas for newcomer acts being playlisted at public stations, and his reasons are clear.

"We are on the verge of proving there is a very good music scene in Germany, but we need more platforms for local acts," he says. "There is no A&R crisis in Germany. There is lots of talent, but there are very few platforms and radio is the biggest problem. That is why we are pushing for public stations to play more newcomers and new releases."

And while he does not profess to have any long-term aspirations to rise up the international corporate ladder, Dopp remains ambitious for German artists.

"It is still very difficult for German acts internationally. Apart from one-off dance singles, novelty records and Rammstein, we've not managed to establish real stars abroad...more needs to be done!"

If he can repeat his recent trendbucking achievements at home further afield, then the next German band to break internationally could well be a Warner signing.

Career starts and thrives by taking chances

Bernd Dopp's career at Warner began in 1984 following a lunch with Gerd Gebhardt, now president of the German IFPI and industry body the BPW. Gebhardt was marketing manager at WEA at the time and eventually rose to become Warner's president of Northern/Central Europe. At the time Dopp was head buyer for the record department of German retail chain Schauland.

Within a few weeks of the lunch Dopp was working as a junior product manager at the label and hit the ground running. Posts as marketing manager, marketing director and deputy managing director followed until in 1997 he was promoted to managing director of WEA. During Dopp's tenure the label broke a diverse range of acts including German hip hoppers Deichkind, Berlin reggae act Seeed and pop crooner Sascha.

Moreover, he personally signed A-ha, re-launching the Norwegian trio as a platinum selling act after they had spent seven years in the wilderness.

Dopp also headed the BPW's chart and marketing committee from 1999 until last summer, overseeing several key reforms of the sales charts, the introduction of the official dance chart and initiating a close dialogue with radio.

In July 2001 he became president of Warner Germany and deftly brought together East West and WEA, building one of the most promising teams in the local industry in time for the labels moving into new headquarters in Hamburg in June.

"When I appointed him, the job offered less money than he was earning in Schauland, but he took the position anyway, because he saw it as a chance to do what he had always wanted to do," says Gebhardt. "When I asked him about whether he minded, he replied: 'Don't worry, I'll make it up in the future', And he did!"

Malin executes fine art of reinvention

"I'd always been listening to stuff that was about lyrics and emotions and I wanted to be able to tell stories instead of just hitting myself with the microphone."

Making the leap from manic punk rocker to singer-songwriter was no easy task for New Yorker Jesse Malin. But, for the former lead singer of hardcore outfit D Generation, it's one he says was inevitable.

"We did seven years and I was always listening to the sort of music I am now—whether it was The Clash or Bob Dylan it was always about songs," he says. "But

always about songs," he says. "But people always looked at [our] hair and make-up and it was really distracting—the 'read the cover and not the book' syndrome."

The decision made, Malin left the band and began writing for himself, trading lyrics and riffs with Ryan Adams, with whom he'd become friendly after the latter moved to New York following the break-up of Whiskeytown.

"I gave him a demo of some stuff and he really dug it, and he offered to produce [my solo] record," says Malin.

The album—The Fine Art Of Self-Destruction (One Little Indian)—was recorded in a six-day whirlwind six days at the start of 2002, with Adams in overdrive and Malin worrying whether what they were getting was good enough.



"We were doing everything live with me playing guitar and singing at the same time, it was like Johnny Cash's Sun sessions," he laughs. "I figured it'd be better if I took a few more stabs at the vocals, but Ryan was like 'Yeah that's it, that's a take'. I'm really proud of the record now. I think he did a wonderful job—but at the time there was tension!"

Not surprisingly the album is a stripped-back affair, with Malin's introspective tales of love and loss perfectly augmented by Adams' laid-back atmosphere. It's bound to appeal to lovers of alternative country, but there's more to it than that, according to Nick Stewart, who presents UK rock station Virgin Radio's Sunday night American show under the moniker Captain America (Stewart's day-job is as VP, international, A&R for

"Jesse Malin stands out from the current pack of alt. country singer songwriters because of his urban roots," explains Stewart, who recently aired a session by the New Yorker. "His lyrics are incisive, to the point and relevant, backed up by great tunes."


Colin Martin, executive producer (music) at UK public AC/MOR station BBC Radio 2, agrees. "It's an album straight out of the Ryan Adams academy of Americana, with additional vocal coaching from the school of Bruce Springsteen," he says. "There's a lot to commend it with a couple of interesting radiofriendly tracks, but is there room

friendly tracks, but is there room commercially for someone so close to Ryan [Adams]? Time will tell but I think he'll be much appreciated among album buyers."

They'll get the chance to do just that all over Europe, as the album has now been released throughout the region—on One Little Indian in the UK, and through deals with MNW for Scandinavia and Fargo in Italy, France, Spain and Benelux. Zomba is handling distribution in Austria, Switzerland and Germany.

Having opened for Ryan Adams on a series of UK dates at the end of last year, Malin began his own tour in Birmingham on January 14. "I'm gonna jump back and forth between here and the States like some crazy little mouse," he says. "We'll see how [the album] sells and just go with it."

Jaimeson puveys new urban sound

UK urban music is evolving, and one of the artists at the cutting edge of the new sound is 27-year-old producer, DJ, singer and MC, Jamie Williams, aka Jaimeson.

His single *True*, released on January 13 through UK indie V2, is the centre of a unique marketing and re-release effort, as the single was originally mixed over a year and a half ago and has already been a massive club hit. Yet radio has proved that time has not dulled the track's infectious chorus and sweet soulful house stylings. The single is currently being played by all the major UK radio groups, is A-listed at London dance station Kiss 100, and is also on the A list on the BBC's national CHR station, Radio 1.

"Jaimeson is part of the new wave," says Mark Jackson, product manager at V2 UK. "Like Big Brovaz this is new UK urban music. It's not just garage—it's dance, R&B, pop, all mixed into one. So Solid and More Fire Crew are fantastic artists but they are part of the more traditional UK garage sound."

Backing up *True's* bubbly bassline and the sassy vocals of Angel Blue was a marketing strategy which saw V2 team up with Shazam Entertainment, the UK mobile marketing company. Through Shazam's technology, mobile users ring a number, direct their phone at a sound source—a radio or speakers in a bar or club, for example—and get a text back telling them what the track is. Following its club and radio play, *True* reached the top of Shazam's "tagging" chart, where it stayed for four straight weeks in November/December last year.

"People were tagging the track through the amount of Kiss 100 play we were receiving at the start of the campaign," says Jackson. "So we knew that working with Shazam would be a very effective way to reach this target audience."

Vijay Solanki, UK marketing director at Shazam, picks up the story. "On the day of *True's* release, we sent SMS messages to any Shazam user who has tagged the track telling them of its availability in store," he says.

There will be more singles from Jaimeson this year, and an album which will feature urban pop mixed in with underground garage cuts. Internationally, V2 plans to release *True* where it has a presence, although the label says no release dates have yet been set.

DANCE GROOVES

BITTER SWEET

The D-Influence remake of the Gladys Knight classic Taste Of Bitter Love (Dome/UK), featuring Romina Johnson (who appeared on, and co-wrote, the Artful Dodger's Movin' Too Fast) stays close, but not too close, to the original. A fullblooded horn section provides the punctuation on a production that also features strings, chugging wha-wha guitar and a stirling vocal performance by Johnson. The radio edit lopes along at a classic R&B pace while the Messy Boys Mix is an altogether more uptempo affair, clocking in at 135 bpm. This provides a radically different take on the track that, style-wise, lies somewhere between classic house and two-step.

GLOBAL CHICANERY

Chicane's Saltwater (Xtravaganza/UK), featuring the highly-individual voice Clannad's Maire Brennan, has already been used as the backing on the global TV campaign for Tourism Ireland and is consequently enjoying a greater reach than it ever could via radio. The combination of Chicane's hit of this summer and Brennan's vocal makes for a trance-influenced tune that should also have enough melodic content to appeal to a broader audience. Despite the name, the dancefloor-bound *Thrillseekers House Mix*, bangs along at a trance-ish 145 bpm with enough references to the radio edit for mainstream clubs.

FINNISH QUALITY

Across the growing range of music coming out of Finnish label Exogenic Records, whether it be banging techno, minimalist electro, dub reggae or funky jazz, the high quality of the artists is undeniable. Happily, this has never more evident than on the latest label compilation Complications-Exogenic Breaks Volume 1, which features an eclectic and inspired selection of tracks from artists who richly deserve to be better known. Naeae Eletrok by Brothom States is tuff, bleepy and uncompromising while Purnaus by Centro 53 provides a soundtrack that would work well in Bladerunner. Meikku by Uusi Fantasia features a completely different approach, a spacey mix of dub reggae with a sublime horn motif and occasional vocals. Yet more quality Finnish reggae comes from Velours Perfect on Different Passages, while Lada by DJPP is funky, jazzy and soundtrack-worthy. The top track of the album is, however, the brilliantly off-kilter Parasite Of Power by DJ Vahamieli. Altogether, an album of

EDYTA **IMPOSSIBLE**

(Virgin Germany) Release date: February 3 Everything seems to be in place for Polish artist Edyta Gornik to have a major European hit. The artist first came on the scene in

1994 as Poland's entrant for the Eurovision Song Contest. Since then her first, self-titled debut album has sold over a million units—and she has EMI A&R man Chris Briggs (who has worked with Robbie Williams, Joe Cocker and Geri Halliwell) behind her. As well as the good looks, Edyta has the voice, as is apparent here, as she sings soulfully over an electronic dance beat. A catchy slice of classic pop music, Impossible is already making its way slowly onto European programmers' playlists. Although a big name artist in her home country, DJ/producer Darek Turecki at Polish CHR station Radio Lublin, which is playing *Impossible* twice a day, isn't totally positive about the track. "I don't know about her potential outside Poland," he says. "All I know is that it's a shame the single is not in Polish. Our listeners would like the track to be in Polish—not in English." The track is taken from Edyta's forthcoming album, set for release this summer

After having her vocals DB featured on Boulevard's 2001 hit Point

Of View, and following her own debut single Dove (I'll Be Loving You), Moony continues her upward curve with this new single. Written by the artist herself, Acrobats (Looking For Balance) finds the Venetian singer—aka Monica Bragato-in fine vocal form, crooning her way over a jaunty dance soundtrack. Although released internationally from February 17, Acrobats has already been released in Italy. Roberto Gentileschi is head of music at Italian national CHR network Radio Dimensione Suono. "We've been playing it for three months—since 26 September," he says. "Before it was on heavy rotation, and there has been a good reaction to the track. The music is very easy on the ear and so it's perfect for radio. It's the right mix of dance and pop." The single is taken from Moony's debut album Lifestories, which is set for a March 3 release and features both the previous hits Point Of View and Dove (I'll Be Loving You). NCE BEAT

Tomcraft's Loneliness (Kosmo) is sitting pretty on top of the European Dance Traxx chart for a second straight week. The single enjoys both an increase in club play and dance retail sales across Europe and has benefited from debuts on Poland's regional top 30 dance chart, as well as on Spain's monthly chart.

Madonna, meanwhile, stays at number two with Die Another Day (Maverick). The track registers a decline both in terms of club play and at specialist dance retail—those factors make it unlikely it will return to number one.

Jennifer Lopez's Jenny From The Block (Epic) holds its position at number three on the chart for the third week. Although the track is a nonmover, it is enjoying increased support.

There are no new entries into the chart's top 10 this week, but Blank & Jones' The Hardest Heart (Gang Go) returns at number nine (from 12). The resurgence is based on a number 19 entry on the Swedish dance chart.

Meanwhile, UK Asian act Panjabi MC's Mundian To Bach Ke (Superstar) climbs from number nine to four and has recorded the biggest gain in support on the entire chart. The thunderous bhangra tune debuts on regional charts in Italy, Denmark, Belgium, Poland and Hungary.

Set to enter the top 10 is Russian female act T.A.T.U. with their controversial All The Things She Said (Universal), which is all about a lesbian love affair. The track climbs from 14 to number 11 this week, and debuted on the Swedish dance chart. The same applies to Together's So Much Love To Give from France's Roulé label, the company that brought us the Stardust classic Music Sounds Better With You. The single credits Thomas Bangalter (the man behind Stardust) and DJ Falcon, and jumps from 40 to 16, as well as being number one on the dance retail chart.

After last week's low number of entries, there are 14 newcomers and two re-entries to the top 100 this week. They are led by veteran UK trance act Chicane with Love On The Run on the new WEA London-marketed imprint M Records. which goes in at number 37 this week.



M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

Robbie Williams is still the darling of European programmers, as his Feel (Chrysalis) stays at the top of the European Radio Top 50 chart for a second week. Another radio favourite, Jennifer Lopez, is steady at number two with Jenny From The Block (Epic), while Blue and Elton John creep up from five to number three with their new version of John's classic Sorry Seems To Be The Hardest Word (Innocent/Virgin).




Of the other tracks jockeying for position in the top 10, Stronger (Island) by Sugababes continues its steady climb up the chart from 11 to number eight, while T.A.T.U. drop down one place to nine with All The Things She Said (Universal). But the Russian girls need not

worry, as this week sees their new single Not Gonna Get Us enter the chart at number 50.

Just below T.A.T.U. at 10 is Craig David with his Hidden Agenda (Wildstar/Warner), which moves up eight places compared to last week.

A constant problem for radio programmers is how far ahead of release date to playlist a track. Wolfgang Biechele, head of music at Antenne Bayern in Bavaria, says the station has exactly that problem with David's track. "The release is four weeks ahead," he says, "and we always have to be careful. If I play it thirty times a week it might get burned out by the time we have the release date. Often they [the record company] delay the release date and I go crazy, because I started with the company and then they delay the date and I often have to pull things off the playlist when they need my help.'

Mundian To Bach Ke (Superstar) by Panjabi MC moves up an impressive 15 places to number 33 this week. Biechele is playing the track, but only on specialist shows. "It's a bit too spicy for daytime," he says.



Other songs that meet more with his favour include the new single by the Counting featuring Crows Vanessa Carlton-a cover of Joni Mitchell's classic Big Yellow Taxi (Geffen/Polydor) Biechele also likes the current Pink track, Portrait Family (Arista), which moves up four places to num-

ber 28 this week. "It's a great flavour-a new style for her," says Biechele.

Further down the chart, at number 44, are UK hip hop/R&B boy-girl group Big Brovaz with their Nu Flow (Epic). Just below Big Brovaz are another UK outfit, the young rock trio Busted, whose Year 3000 (Universal) sits at number 47.

Tracks that are picking up major airplay and may break into the top 50 next week include Beenie Man's Streetlife (Virgin) and Mel C's Here It Comes Again (Virgin). Biechele says he likes the new Matchbox 20 track Disease (Atlantic) "because it's good rock song and not sequenced rubbish." He also likes the new single by The Bangles. "It's good to see them back again. Again we have to take care because the release date is so far ahead," he notes.

and our creative executives will be able to work even more closely with artists while being able to rely on powerful and effective global marketing capabilities."

Europe, former BMG Europe president Thomas Stein now heads the German-speaking territories as president of BMG GSA, while London-based BMG Europe COO Tim Bowen will be in charge of BMG's operations in the UK, Australia, and South Africa.

Schmidt-Holtz said in a statement that although the regional offices had functioned well over the past years, the changes in market conditions forced the re-jig of the operations with a focus on creative challenges and repertoire, whilst finding a way to reduce overhead costs.

Schmidt-Holtz added that Stein had successfully restructured the European region and his experience will help turn around the fate of the GSA company. Stein refused to comment on the changes as M&M went to press.

The management in the Office of the Chairman division includes Schmidt-Holtz as chairman, Michael Smellie as COO, and the newly-appointed executive VP marketing, Tim Prescott—formerly senior VP of BMG's Asia-Pacific region, who will relocate to New York.

Prescott's new role is to oversee global marketing campaigns for BMG artists. Also reporting to the Office of the Chairman are human resources, strategy and new technology and corporate communications.

The Label Group consists of US-based records

labels including Arista Records, RCA Music Group, Jive/Zomba, and RLG-Nashville, as well as BMG Music Pub-

Territory Management will consist of Stein and Bowen's operations as well as Japan. A number of other territories will report to former senior VP, corporate development-and BMG Nederlands MD-Maarten Steinkamp (pictured) who is appointed to the new position of president, international. Bruno Gerentes (BMG France MD) and Adrian Berwick (BMG Italy MD) will report to Steinkamp, as will senior VP Latin region, Rodolfo Lopez-Negrete.

Nicholas Firth, chairman of BMG Music Publishing, adds to his responsibility that of Corporate Center, a division that includes legal and business affairs, information systems and technology, finance, and coordination for manufacturing and distribution.

According to the company, the changes were originally laid out last spring when Schmidt-Holtz and Smellie did the rounds of BMG's worldwide operations. In a statement, the new structure is described as a way to "focusing on creating global music superstars that reach across geographical boundaries". "This is the latest step in our strategy to make BMG the industry's leading home to world-class artists and top creative executives," said Schmidt-Holtz in a statement. "We place a premium on our relationship with our artists. And so this structure allows our creative executives to be closer to artists while allowing us to better support our creative executives.'

German Cartel office approves | Capital RTL's AVE radio acquisitions

Cologne — Germany's Federal Cartel Office has approved virtually all

of RTL's acquisition of a portfolio of radio shareholdings owned by AVE, a subsidiary of the Holtzbrinck publishing group.

However, RTL has had to withdraw-at least temporarily—from

part of the AVE deal, in order to win the Cartel Office's speedy approval for the rest of its purchase plans.

As a result of the acquisition, RTL becomes the largest radio operator in Germany, with shares in 19 stations across the country.

In most markets, the AVE stations were found not to compete with those already owned by RTL, although the Cartel Office had misgivings in two markets, which has led RTL to withdraw its stakes in the three stations affected.

In Baden-Württemburg, RTL had acquired as part of the AVE deal 28% of AC Radio Regenbogen, which itself owns half of CHR station Big FM. RTL already owned 25% of the three-station AC/Rock network in the state, Hit Radio RTL. Hot AC competitor, Hit Radio Antenne 1, objected to the deal, so RTL has

decided to drop that part of the deal for now and present it to the regulator later, in a separate application.

Berlin/Brandenburg, acquired 40% of regional

market leader BB Radio to add to its 100% holding in 104.6 RTL and its 30% holding in Berliner Rundfunk 91!4 (all AC). The Cartel Office asked RTL to dispose of its

shares in Berliner Rundfunk, which have now been distributed among the other owners, and it approved the remaining shareholdings. But the regional licencing authority, MABB, is still

not happy with the situation.

The MABB's legal officer, Ingeborg Zahrnt, tells M&M that BB Radio was set up as a station for the state of Brandenburg, which surrounds Berlin. The original licence required that none of the owners should be involved in the Berlin radio market. The MABB has told the current shareholders to find a way of conforming to the licence by February, or face their frequency being thrown open to other bidders. The situation has not made easier by statements made against RTL's involvement by Helmut Markwort, CEO of the BB Radio's other 40% shareholder, Burda Media.

finely-balanced piece of legislation," said Berman. "I am alarmed that attempts are now underway at national level to retreat from this

hard-fought compromise.'

He continued: "The music sector needs this Directive to be implemented rapidly and accurately across Europe. We must resist all attempts to re-negotiate this needed Directive urgently national level.'

Berman pointed the finger at France, a country he described as "a strong defender of European culture", where the implementation of the new copyright legislation "is proving problematic". He believes that the draft French proposal to implement the Directive "does not establish a satisfactory judicial framework for the development of such technological measures".

The IFPI, alongside representatives at the French industry, is concerned by the level of exceptions the French text will introduce. The French proposal goes as far as suggesting that technical measures such as encryption or copy protection used to prevent copying could be removed. "It would be a shame if the French government allows serious loopholes to appear in its forthcoming copyright law," said Berman.

Universal Music France chairman/CEO Pascal Negre, who is also president of collecting society SCPP, summed up the industry's view continued from page 1

when he said that "the draft was a piece of junk—copying is not cloning and home taping does not mean having the ability to make 150 copies." Bernard Miyet, president of French authors' rights SACEM, added that "exceptions should be exceptional", and that the implementation of the Copyright Directive should focus first and foremost "on ensuring the protection of all rights owners.

Negre says that the local music industry would be trying to use all possible means to convince the authorities—and parlia-French ment-of its views. A meeting was held in Cannes with industry executives such as IFPI's Berman and French minister of culture Jean-Jacques Aillagon.

Aillagon tells M&M that "there are conflicting views on this question and it is difficult to find a consensus". Aillagon adds that he expected to present a new draft to parliament in March.

One of Aillagon's major problems is that France's copyright law of 1984 established a "right to home copying" that is now strongly embedded in the mentality of users, who see it as a limitation of their rights if home-copying is restricted through technical devices. "Everything must be done to fight against piracy," says Aillagon, "but at the same time, we need to maintain the possibility of home copying."

advertising for Smith's successor, who will have the title head of music, Capital FM Network.

Pringle confirms that, since the new year, the Capital FM Network's playlist—although remaining firmly contemporary—has started to encompass a broader range of music genres, including some crossover rock, and less manufactured pop. "We haven't changed the shape of what we're playing-it's more a genre balance thing than a wholesale change of direction," he explains. "A lot of music today is done to a formula, and people are starting to rebel a bit against that—consumers these days are very savvy, and they don't want to be fed stuff off a production line. I think the need in hit radio in 2003 is for a little bit of variety. That doesn't necessarily mean that the whole thing is going to go off at a tangent, but that is what we're going to concentrate on."

He adds: "When you get a number of different genres that appeal to different age groups, it's important to remember that if you just play the ones that appeal to a singles-buying

public, you may well be turning your back on probably half your audience. I think it's important that the music properly reflects what is still a really broad audience base from 15 up to 40. What we found at the back-end of last year there were some rock acts that came through, such as Avril Lavigne, that really complement the other hits we play."

Pringle and his team are looking at the possibility of introducing a weekly rock show to Capital FM/London—the station already airs specialist urban and dance shows, and also recently introduced a Saturday morning album chart countdown. "With a heritage station [like Capital FM] people have come to expect it to provide for all their music needs—so perhaps it is sensible to provide a bit of variety at the edges," suggests Pringle.

The Capital programmer says he also wants the London outlet to return to its roots as a station known for promoting new music. "When we can break songs that the other stations in the market aren't so interested in, that's great. I think Capital's always had a reputation for leading the music scene, and I think that should continue."
