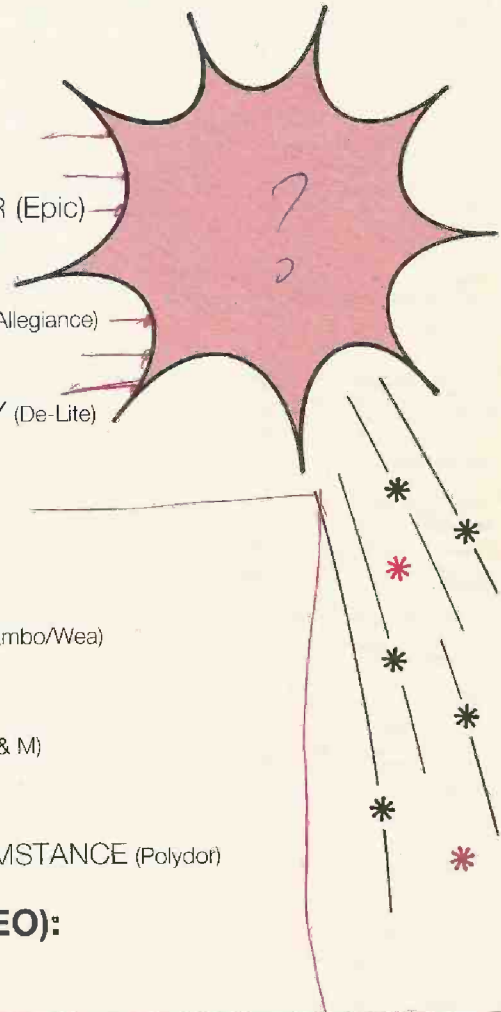

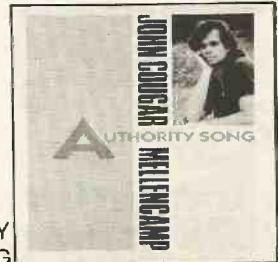

In our Spotlight we'll feature important radio or television personalities and their stations. One by one this will become a book of the top media people in Europe.



**NOS - HOLLAND - FRITS SPITS**

Without any doubt the most influential deejay in Holland, Frits Spits has a daily show on NOS radio called the "Avondspits" which means

"Rushhour" but also has an obvious connection with his name Spits.

That name only is a pseudonym as his real familyname is Ritmeester.

Frits' show is daily between 18.00 and 19.00 and attracts a good 3

million pop- listeners. Therefore the industry regards him as a very

powerful person, a power that he likes to play down: "My influence? My

power to break or kill records? That's nonsense. There are enough

proofs during the last few years that there is no truth in that statement. A

record is a hit, when it is a hit. When a record is not a hit I cannot change

that no matter how often I play it. Sometimes you can feel a hit coming

but fortunately I have been wrong too."

Every saturday Frits chooses his record of the week called the

Steunplaat and he plays that favourite once every day. That record has to

be selected from amongst appr. 70 new releases presented to him in an

average week. To obtain a Steunplaat is extremely important for the

industry as it definitely means that record will be profitable and with a bit

of luck becomes a major hit. Frits has been criticised of not playing

typical Dutch songs in his program, songs he calls "Empty". But he does

push the newer breed of Dutch language popacts which he likes for their

quality music and lyrics.

Originally studying economics Frits later changed to Dutch which study

he finished with success and became a teacher in Eindhoven. At that

stage of his life Frits (Now 35) started to do some radio programs and

soon didn't find time to teach anymore. Later he joined the famous Joost

den Draayer, Hollands leading deejay of that period and together they

made the most popular radioprogram which was listened to during

dinnertime by a major part of the Dutch population.

The Avondspits is daily except on sundays when Frits presents the

Nationale Hitparade as compiled by Buma/Stemra. In the crazy structure

of Dutch National Radio not one broadcasting company has been given

daily time on the popchannel Hilversum 3 and so Frits is the only deejay

to be heard every day. He strongly criticises the freelance contracts of

Dutch Deejays. "You're never sure of your own future. One day a new

management arrives and you can be on the streets instantly".

Frits is very interested in the International Development of pop music and

frequently listens to BBC 1 to hear the new English music.

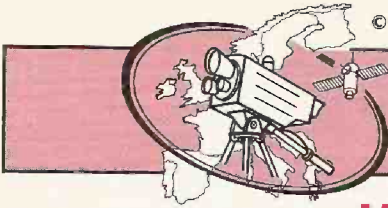

As you may have noticed the titles appearing in our **AIRPLAY TOP 60** last week had labels mentioned for the first time. Due to a computer failure you were reading "Unknown" in the label section while the various labels are in fact known to us. This slight mistake has been repaired this week and you can now find all relevant labels mentioned in the Airplay charts. In the near future we hope to add the publishers too.

There is a major change in the **EUROPEAN TOP 100 ALBUMS** as from this week. You'll be able to see that we are not using the compilation-albums in our calculations anymore. This is due to two factors. Firstly there are a number of charts in Europe, which mention compilation albums such as the U.K.charts. But others do not take these type of albums in their listings (Germany). We will therefore omit these albums from now on, but as a consolidation to the successful Compilation companies we will from time to time print a European Bestsellers List on compilations.

A special salute should however be given to the joint EMI/Virgin initiative for their enormously successful "Various-Now" hit-compilations which are selling high numbers in the U.K.

## THE SOLOCAREERS

A few years ago A&R departments of major record companies didn't particularly like it when members of big groups wanted to start solo-careers. Solo records didn't sell! But during the last few years this has changed drastically, with many bandmembers becoming super solo artists. In this weeks European charts we find **Phil Collins** (also nr.1 in the U.S.A.) and **Lionel Richie** doing extremely well.... should we count **Michael** as an ex-Jackson Five?

## PROSIT GERMANY

German talent is continuing to make waves in many international markets and after the fantastic breakthrough of **Nena** on both sides of the Atlantic and also the strong continental sales for **Masquerade**, there are already newer upcoming names that will storm various charts in Europe: **Alphaville** (action in Benelux-Switzerland and Italy) and **Juliane Werding**(Benelux).

## VARIOUS

A surprise to see that lovely **Mel Brooks** hit "To Be Or Not To Be" breaking in so many countries....who said the Europeans have no sense of humour? The **Julio Iglesias & Willie Nelson** smash will continue to chart for a long time, It's one of those records that will move slowly but in all territories. Not surprising the renewed interest for the late **Marvin Gaye** in the Albumcharts. We mourn the death of this fantastic artist.

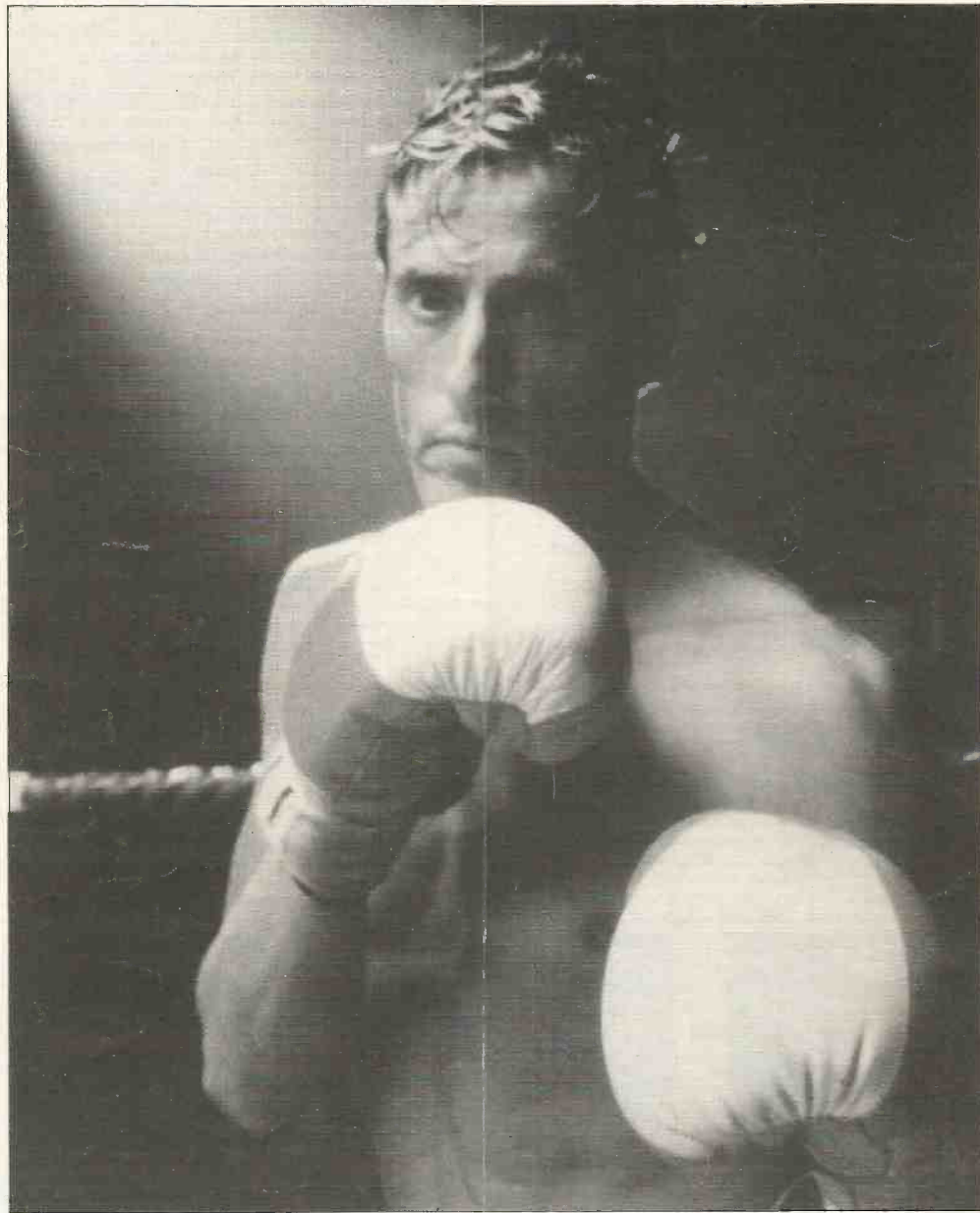
**Pallas - The Sentinel - Harvest**

**Soft Cell-This Last Night In Sodom-Some Biz.**  
 So they did fall apart after all. What once started as a synthipop hit act, developed more and more into a cult band with complex arranged melodramatic songs. And this LP is definitely the apocalypse of all preceding. Though the album as a whole tends a bit to overproduction, the end is fascinating enough. DON'T THINK LOCAL IN THE MUSIC WORLD !!

When you meet a gathering of Music Industry Experts anywhere in the world it is always easy to enter into a big discussion when you start talking about geographics in relation to hitrecords.

Are British talents dominating the charts? Is the percentage of American Hits going up or down? Are Swedish records in fashion? Is there a New German Music wave? We could all continue this list with our own questions. Is it wise to "Label" records that way or is it plain stupid that in a time of Satellite- Programs and all the other ultra-modern ways of programming there are still many of us that "Think Local"?

Of course it's true that British talent has a very strong impact on the International Hitworld and there are various reasons why. England has always been a very creative soil for upcoming talents largely due to its cultural history, determination and last but not least the simple fact that English is the language understood in many many countries. The worldwide success of such a lot of English acts have inspired the young to fight for their own musical chances too and so the successes of the sixties brought a new wave in the seventies and the last year everyone (especially in the U.S.) spoke once again of a new British invasion.

Over the years we have also spoken about a Swedish wave (Abba - Blue Swede etc.) a Dutch wave (George Baker Selection, Shocking Blue, Pussycat and Focus, a German "Krautrock" wave (Kraftwerk, Triumvirat, DAF), and lately a German "New Music" wave (see our Chart Chat section). Whilst it's interesting to point at the specific success of one country's talent at any given moment, one should beware of "Thinking Local". Basically the average listener is not really interested whether his favourite record originates in Liverpool, Los Angeles, Hamburg, Paris or any other place.

So let's have an open ear for each others talent. Stop thinking the (Musical) world ends at Harwich, Lille or Milano. Listen to the music first without asking the obvious question.

ACROSS THE BORDER...

And just to add to the confusion (or prove our point) we will have a regular feature on international successes of "Local" talents under the heading "Across The Border". It will follow the careers of artists outside their homemarket and will include all kinds of music.

AMERICAN ARTISTS THINK LOCAL

The same message should also be much better understood by many American Superstars. Too often do they ignore Europe as an important market. They either plainly refuse to cross the Atlantic for tours or t.v. performances or are just willing to squeeze some days into their schedule... in most cases at the worst possible times. (When the hit is forgotten) With a well planned promotion and or concert tour success in Europe can be equally big as in the U.S.

MEDIA TALK

Every few weeks we'll talk about major changes in radio and t.v. programs and or new jobs for deejays. We will also mention special radio campaigns in our Media Talk column. So Radio and t.v. programmers, send us your news.... Patrick Allenbach, producer of various t.v. shows in Switzerland reports that he is using EUROTIPSHEET in his programs. One of his latest shows "Jukebox-Heroes" featured all of the video's as listed in EUROCLIPS, our weekly chart of most broadcasted European music-video's. Reactions from many Swiss independent radiostations who are sometimes working together with Patrick's program were very strong. They asked to be able to use the EUROPEAN TOP100 charts for their programming.

Honey Bee Benson, the popular evening deejay at RTL Germany will soon be moving to SWF. Honey was presenting her own youth program mostly playing rock and with many good interviews.

Radio Veronica Holland organised a big party in Hilversum to celebrate the 1000th Top 40. This charts, which in Holland is being regarded as the most important one (Recordshops buy in their stock based on the chartpositions appearing in this Top 40.

Veronica started this while they were still a pirate offshore Radiostation. Since that time a lot has changed. Radio Veronica has become a major Dutch station reaching the A-Status, while the responsibility for the charts has been put in the hand of a new organisation the Stichting (Foundation) Top 40, run by Miss Frances Bouwman. Each Friday-afternoon Program Director Lex Harding presents the Top 40 on Dutch Radio Hilversum 3.

Swiss Independent Radio giant Radio 24 reports good use of the EUROPEAN TOP 100 in their programs, so tells us Klem Dalton.

There's also interest from the U.S. to base programs around our charts...news to follow.

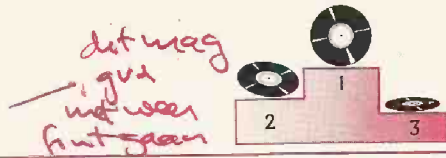
