ABOUT THE CHARTS

THE EUROPEAN TOP 100 (SINGLES/ALBUMS): In many European countries one chart is recognised by the music industry as the "OFFICIAL" initiparade and is therefore used for the compilation of the EUROPEANTOP100. However there are other countries where various charts are in existence and often equally important. For these countries we have compiled a number of these charts into one representing the easies in that marker.

and often equally important. For these countries we have compiled a number of these charis into one representing the sales in that market; each chart position for every country then receives, relevant to that position, an equal points rating which is in turn multiplied by a factor determined through the latest known sales percentage of total singles for album sales which that country holds in relation to the rest of Europe. There are different percentages for singles and albums. These figures are kindly provided on a regular basis by the industry-organisations such iFPHEPHER failup-Deutsche Phonoverband etc. A European Chart-Committee, with experts from a number of these industry-organisations will overtook the calculation system and will decide on improvements, changes and updates. For the EUROPEANTOP 100 SINGLES 25 charts are used from 15 countries. Since the sales percentages of a few countries are too small to get their hits into the EUROPEANTOP 100 (provided these records are not charled in any other territory), we are also printing a TOP 3 in EUROPE list each week. The EUROPEAN AIRPLAY TOP 60 is compled through all our correspondents tips received this week. ("Records of the week receive extra points." The airplay lists of the airplay report organisations within some of the European countries are also used in the calculations, as well as playists of major radio stations. ("Please note that in all received this appear in Europsheet but they are all used for the calculation of the

Eurotysheet but they are all used for the calculation of the Airplay Top 60.

THE EUROCLIPS LIST shows the music-videos most aired on relevision throughout Europe in the week prior to publication. It includes weder-tuprograms and other tw.shows partly using video's from 14 European countries.

Oh., yes, radio could have the power to make or break records, but it's never one jock doing it on it's own and in the end it's always the audience that decides".

Apart from his connection with the Tony Blackburn show he also co produces and presents two weekend breakfast programs called "London Today". The music on the show is a mixture of the best of the latest releases and the current BBC Top 40. London Today is broadcast on saturday and sunday mornings at 8 o'clock, and also contains what's on info, sport and competition.

Immediately striking when taking a look at The Scandinavian Charts is the fact that there is amazingly enough no local Scandinavian record that, apart from it's country of origin, also charts in another Scandinavian country. All local hits remain local and do not tend to cross over to the other markets in Scandinavia. The only exception to this rule was last year's European succes Laidback (remember Sunshine Reggae?), this one charted not only in it's original country Denmark but also elsewhere in Scandinavia. But the song had English lyrics and was therefore easier to chart elsewhere.

Most of the singles in the Scandinavian Charts are successes elsewhere in Europe apart from e.g. Slade who are very popular with two singles charted of which Run Runaway is not appearing in the European Top 100 Singles. Mike Oldfield's single Crime Of Passion is srREDII doing well

and not appearing anymore in the Euro charts (used to be big in Germany and Italy). Scandinavia is (together with the French and The Spanish) a bit late in discovering the appeal of Nena, 99 Luftballons is in the lower regions of the Euro charts. The Flying Pickets' Only You is still very popular but for the rest of Europe downgrading the charts. Though there is some consensus in the general single sales pattern for the international releases, Finland clearly stands out as different from the rest of Scandinavia. Not appearing in the above charts and already disappeared from the Euro charts for a few weeks is the McCartney/ Jackson single Say Say Say which is still nr. 1 in Finland and Gazebo's I

Jackson single say say say which is still it. If it mindred and Gazedo still like Chopin is doing well in the Finnish charts while the rest of Europe has nearly forgotten this one.

We must bear in mind, however, that the single market in Scandinavia is different from the rest of Europe. The overall single sales are relatively speaking very low compared to other European markets. In one of the coming issues we will take a closer look at the Scandinavian album parket for which the sales pottom dozen't differ that much as the single. market for which the sales pattern doesn't differ that much as the singles

With regards to the T.V. situation it is rather quiet Up North. The monday show "Mandagsborsen" with it's tradional weekly live broadcast from the beautiful Grand Hotel in Stockholm has had it's last program mid april and will not return untill end ofAugust. The popular show "Nojesmaskinen" with it's growing array of international artists is due to come back after the summer. In Denmark the weekly progam "Eldorado" presented and co-produced by the popular Jorgen Myllus is taking a break till september. Norwegian program "Zikk Zakk" produced by Odd Arvid Stroemstad will be off the air soon. And what about Finland? The monthly pop program "Casino" (producer Heikki Karma) has planned to return after the summer, but when is unknown as of yet. This means that our weekly T.V. section will not feature Scandinavia until the end of the summer period. the end of the summer period.
