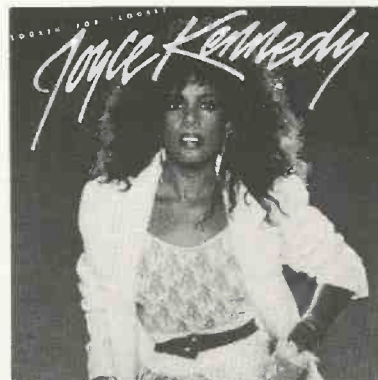
#### Honeymoon Suite - Honeymoon Suite- Warner

#### Joyce Kennedy - Lookin' For Trouble- A&M

The first album for Joyce Kennedy the ex singer of Mother's Finest. Joyce makes a move towards (adult) pop orientated material (produced by labelmate Jeffrey Osborne), while the other half of the album leans more towards funk and is produced by Solar architect Leon Sylvers. Recommended tracks in the first category are Watch My Body and a duet with Jeffrey Osborne The Last Time I Make Love, while songs like Tailor Made and Different Now (with a hard rock solo of Steve Lukather) are more fitted for club play.

# Publication Lists Europe's Hits

LONDON—A new Europe-wide Top 100 chart that combines the results of more than 80 local hit parades is proving a popular industry tool here, following its introduction by Dutch independent promoter Theo Roos in the spring.

The chart is contained in Eurotipsheet, a weekly publication put out by Roos' European Media Report organization and distributed to some 2,000 radio/tv producers, DJs and program directors in 17 countries for an annual subscription fee of \$98. It is carried by 34 major radio stations in Europe, including Radio City and BMRB in Britain, RTL and NRJ in France, SWF Baden Baden, HR Frankfurt, BR Munchen and RTL in West Germany, SER in Spain, Radio Veronica in Holland and ERT I in Greece.

Satellite tv broadcaster Sky Channel bases a weekly program slot on Eurotipsheet, which is also used in programming put out by Britain's Music Box cable/satellite service and in a new weekly tv show for France, Germany and Belgium launched by RTL (Radio Tele Luxembourg). An increasing number of trade and consumer print publications throughout Europe also carry the Eurotipsheet chart, according to Roos.

Compilation involves a series of statistical manipulations. In countries such as Britain, Holland and West Germany where a single, authoritative national chart exists, that list is employed. In other territories the results of a variety of charts may be combined, as in France, where six are used: two from RTL, one from

Europe No. 1 and three from leading rackjobbers.

The results from individual countries are then multiplied by a percentage figure reflecting the relative sizes of different sales markets, based on quarterly sales figures supplied by national and international groups such as the British Phonographic Industry, Deutsche Phonoverband and IFPI. The calculation is made separately for single and album sales.

Since unit sales in minor territories like Finland and Portugal may be so small that a No. 1 record there will make little or no impact on the overall European chart, Eurotipsheet carries an additional Top Three In Europe list giving chart-toppers by territory.

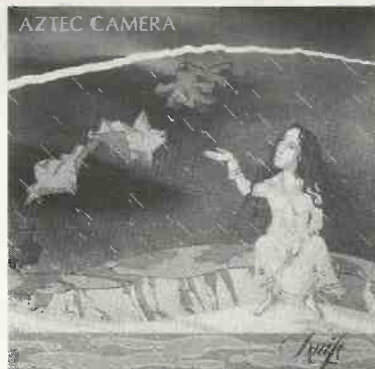

**Kiss - Animalize-** Casablanca With throwing their make up overboard, many people thought they've given themselves the Kiss of death. But all of their old fans remained faithful to them and with this new album they may even enchant new ones too. It has been produced by Paul Stanley and shows a fully grown-up HM/Rock Band who certainly have to be taken seriously. No commitments towards commerciality, nor did the band hand in its original power & force. After their last gold status for *Lick It Up*, this one deserves a kiss for a kiss!

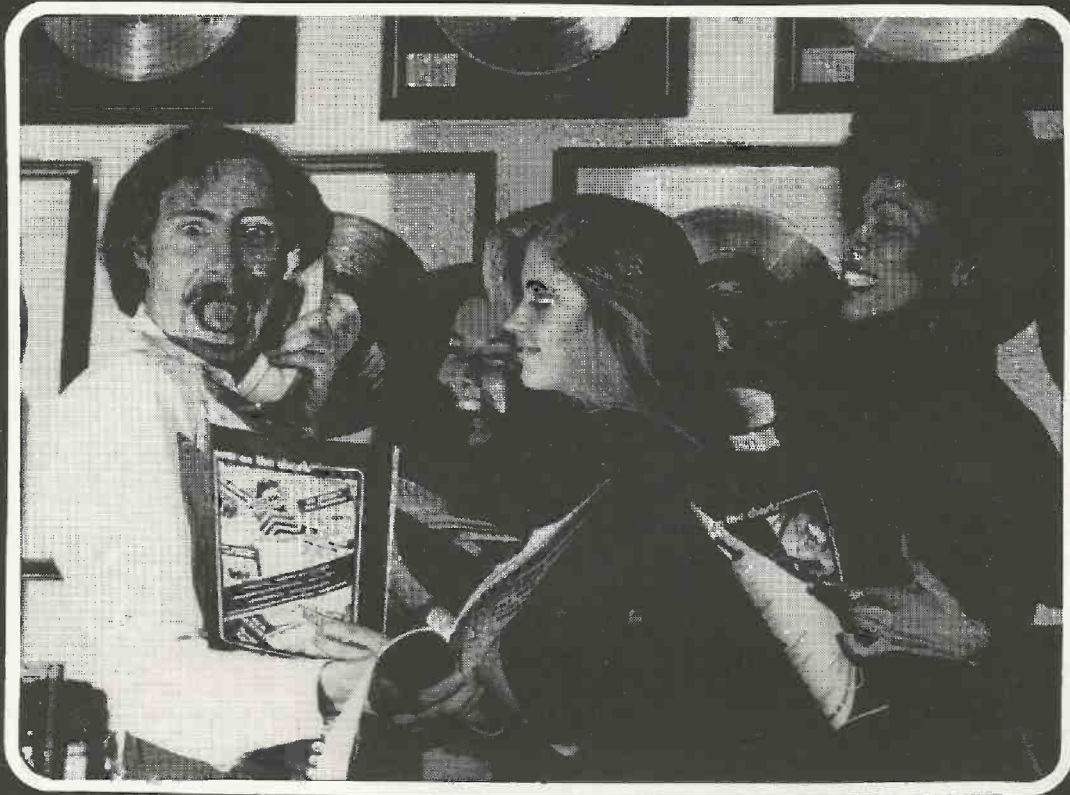

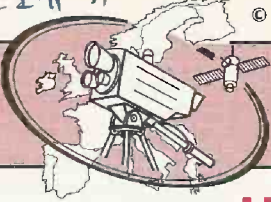

## ABOUT THE CHARTS....

### THE EUROPEAN TOP 100 (SINGLES/ALBUMS):

In many European countries one chart is recognised by the music industry as the "OFFICIAL" hit parade and is therefore used for the compilation of the EUROPEAN TOP 100. However there are other countries where various charts are in existence and often equally important. For these countries we have compiled a number of these charts into one representing the sales in that market.

Each chart position for every country then receives, relevant to that position, an equal points rating which is in turn multiplied by a factor determined through the latest known sales percentage of total singles (or album) sales which that country holds in relation to the rest of Europe. There are different percentages for singles and albums. These figures are kindly provided on a regular basis by the industry-organisations such as IFPI-EPH- Gallup-Deutsche Phonoverband etc.A European Chart-Committee, with experts from a number of these industry-organisations will overlook the calculation system and will decide on improvements, changes and updates.

For the EUROPEAN TOP 100 SINGLES 25 charts are used from 16 countries, for the EUROPEAN TOP 100 ALBUMS 20 charts are used from 15 countries. Since the sales percentages of a few countries are too small to get their hits into the EUROPEAN TOP 100 (provided these records are not charted in any other territory), we are also printing a TOP 3 IN EUROPE list each week.

The EUROPEAN AIRPLAY TOP 50 is compiled through all our correspondents tips received this week. (\*)Records of the week receive extra points. The airplay lists of the airplay report organizations within some of the European countries are also used in the calculations, as well as playlists of major radio stations. (\*)Please note that not all received tips appear in Eurotipsheet but they are all used for the calculation of the Airplay Top 50.

The EUROCLIPS LIST shows the music-videos most aired on television throughout Europe in the week prior to publication. It includes video-t.v. programs and other t.v.shows partly using video's from 14 European countries.

## RADIO GUIDE

Wham! Here we are again with the hot radio additions in Europe with the single of *Wham! Freedom* the major climber on Eurochart entering the Airplay Top 50 at nr. 13. In the meantime their former hit *Wake Me Up* re-enters the Airplay chart due to good airplay in France, Austria and Spain. Hottest airplay furthermore for *Culture Club* - (straight at nr.3 in the U.K.) *Paul Mc Cartney* - and *Julian Lennon* -'s debut *Too Late For Goodbyes* which has already charted in the U.K. and is record of the week on Dutch radio. *Duran Duran* - finally scoring enormously in France with their *Reflex* which is creeping up all Eurocharts because of activities in Southern Europe.

We are glad to see *Bruce Springsteen* - coming up with *Cover Me*, which was already tipped by the team of Eurotipsheet Correspondents as strongest out on the album some months ago; the single has now entered in England and is getting good airplay in the other countries. This will keep Bruce going until a possible European tour in 1985. His American tour has brought him new acclaim and is a terrific commercial success, but with the unbelievable figures earned by *The Jacksons* (see Alex's News section this week) the Springsteen tour gets less attention in the trades.

After her European smash *Self Control*, *Laura Branigan* -'s *The Lucky One* seemed to have a

lot more difficulties to break, but slowly she seems to come through with a chart entry in England and improved airplay in most countries.

Another sleeper is *Drive* by *The Cars* - . Although already their fourth hit of the *Heartbeat City* Album, it was going slower than most of us expected but is now surely coming up in most territories. England is leading the way this week with the single jumping from 37 to 15. And then we have ex- *Fleetwood Mac* -'s *Lindsey Buckingham* - (no Kees, we know he is not a lady) whose *Go Insane* should get your plays as it is a great inventive production.

### EMOTIONS IN FRANCE

Please pay attention to *Chris De Burgh* -'s ballad single *The Head And The Heart*, which could be hugh (Germany!?) if it gets enough airplay. After initial hearing you may find it difficult to program but give it a few spins and you'll hear the power of the song. In any case it's the follow- up to *High On Emotion* which stays high in the airplay reports mainly due to French plays.

Speaking about (To) France, *Mike Oldfield* -'s latest entered the European Top 10 (from 12) this week and is receiving continuous airplay all over the continent. Because of high percentages for general sales on singles in the U.K. (see Chartsystems on page 23) it doesn't happen often that a single makes it to the European Top 10 without any chartplacing in Britain, but Oldfield reaches it with the help of top ten positions in France, Spain, Italy and Austria.

### ALBUM MOVERS

Oldfield's album is now nr.1 on the European Album Top 100 while last weeks frontrunner *The Jacksons* -' *Victory* falls down to nr.6. The top of the Euro Album chart has never shown stronger movements than this week, with albums by *Iron Maiden* - , *Bob Marley* - and *Stevie Wonder* - making good progress as they are now highly charted across Europe. Also in many other respects it is a delightful week for album programmers with the new *Bowie* - album *Tonight* (Nr.1 in UK) as album of the week, closely followed by Mute act *Depeche Mode* - , *Kiss* - for the hardrock fans (see our review section) and *Heaven 17* - , all entering on good positions in the European Top 100 Albums. And watch out for *Paul McCartney* - (Soundtrack *Give My Regards To Broad Street*), *Joan Jett & The Blackhearts* - (Glorious Results Of A Misspent Youth), *Big Country* -'s *Steeltown*, *Madonna* -'s *Like A Virgin*, *Toto* - (Isolation), *Pat Benatar* - (Tropico), *Barbra Streisand* -'s *Emotion* all released in the very near future as is *Culture Club* - (Waking Up With The House On Fire). By the way, their hitsingle is available in different languages. Apart from the English one there will be Spanish and French versions on 7 and shriekmixes on 12 inch. There will also be very interesting album releases later with *Meatloaf* - coming back strongly (The single *Modern Girls* on Arista is already a hit in England but still needs more airplay) and the debut album of *Julian Lennon* - to be scheduled. Eurotipsheet already heard this lp some months ago and we guarantee you some great music!!

New singles and albums from all the big names are being released within the next couple of days. Hot From The Heels from **Culture Club**, and the **War Song**, comes a new single from **Wham!** The title of the single is **Freedom** and the album will be called **Make It Big**. The band are also going to be touring the UK to support the album promotion. **Kim Wilde** returned to recording, with a new record deal and a new single for MCA Records. The single is entitled **The Second Time**. **Heaven 17** has their new single and album released soon too, the single is called **This Is Mine**, and the album title is **How Men Are**. **Paul Young** returned too, with his first single since having trouble with his throat. The single is called **I'm Gonna Tear Your Playhouse Down**. Once again Paul has chosen an old song, this one having been covered several times before.

In my opinion, two of the best new singles out at the moment, are released on labels licensed to or distributed through Virgin Records. The first is on **Charisma/Virgin**, **Julian Lennon**, makes his debut with his song entitled **Too Late For Goodbyes**. The record is picking up strong airplay from Radio One and should do well chart wise during the coming weeks. The other single via Virgin is on the new label formed by **Madness**, after 5 years with Stiff, they have formed **Zarjazz** and the first single to be released strangely enough, is not by them, but by ex-**Undertones**, ex-**Assembly** and now solo **Fergal Sharkey**. The song is written by **Carl Foreman** of **Madness**, and is entitled **Listen To Your Father**. A really excellent single, and already picking up strong airplay. **Capital Radio** man about town and friend of the stars, **Gary Crowley** was recently struck by a bug, which kept him away from the radio for a week. The wonderful **Wham!** boys sat in as dj's for one of his shows and **Culture Club's** **John Moss** sat in for another. Gary is now back in his chair for his regular "Red Hot Club Show". Illness has also taken **Radio One** new dj **Bruno Brooks** off the air for a week, **Richard Skinner** has been sitting in. New dj for **Radio One** taking over the Saturday evening slot which **Janice Long** vacates, is a gentleman named **Ian Brass**, also known as "Brasso", a dj who used to work for **Radio Luxembourg** in the past.

After 17 years with **Radio One**, **Tony Blackburn**, has officially left the station. He will continue with his daily **Radio London Soul Music Show**, and also his **Sky** channel cable music TV show.

Former **Capital Radio** dj **Peter Young**, can now be found at the new commercial radio station which will open soon named **Mercury Radio**. I wish him lots of luck, apart from being a good mate, he has great taste in music, and a great knowledge of **Sixties'** records. Also joining **Peter** at **Mercury** will be former **Radio Two** jock **Ed Stewart**, and former **Radio One** jock **Pat Sharp**. It has also rumoured that former **Capital** man **Tony Myatt** will join too, but I have not had that confirmed yet.

**Michael Aspel** re-joins **Capital** on Sunday mornings with a new show, and was actually interviewed on air by **David Jensen**. **Aspel** said he found it very strange sitting in the guest seat, as he has never ever sat on the other side of the cancel before.

Talking of **David Jensen**, he started a new Sunday afternoon show in addition to his Monday to Friday morning **Capital** show. This show will be the first ever official commercial radio chart, which most of the stations will broadcast. The chart will be based on sales and radio play, and should be an interesting alternative.

I spent some time talking to **Ian Gillan** recently, he has been very busy during the past few months, putting an album together with the newly reformed **Deep Purple**. The album is out in October, and the band are on tour as well. Ian tells me the band are in fine form and glad to be working together again.

You can always tell when autumn is to descend in England, not necessarily by reading the weather reports, but by watching the tv shows. They are all with us again, evoking images of winter nights watching tv, rather than going to clubs and gigs. Coming back are **The Tube**, **Hearty**, the **Old Grey Whistle Test**, **Cracker Jack**, **Showerstore**, and **Sunday Sunday**. Great exposure for live bands and the showing of video promoclips.

Finally a word from **Boy George**, when asked recently on **BBC** television breakfast time program what he thought of the **Frank Sinatra** concert. **George** told **Mike Smith**, "I thought that the Jewish housewives in the audience with their sparkling dresses were much more interesting".

# euROPEAN DANCE report

Welcome to our first European Dance Report! During the next few months we will expand this regular disco-dance section and we will highlight danceable records and disco campaigns from the different European countries. This marks a strong expansion for EUROTIPSHEET as we will be servicing to the elite of the European clubs.

To let you fully understand what this section means, we should immediately point at the diversity of danceable records as they appear on different European Disco charts. This is mainly due to the variety of clubs existing in the major countries. In general the U.K. is the dance scene with the most progressive records while e.g. in Germany disco sounds are for a good part conservative because of the majority of "conservative" clubs in that country. France gives a mix of these two, good disco hits can however continue to be played for a long time in that country. In France as well as in the southern countries Italy and Spain disco lists change drastically during the summer period when millions of Central and North Europeans are spending their holidays in this region. We will spotlight specific countries and trendsetting clubs on a regular basis. We will also start to select correspondents amongst the deejays from the Euro topclubs.

## THE CHARTS

We will print highlights from the major disco/dance charts from England (with thanks to MRIB), Germany (DDO), France (RTL Clubs) and Holland (Stichting Nederlandse Top 40). There will be special features on personalities as well as local disco artists. Dance records are dominating most of the sales charts around Europe and although a lot of radio deejays are seldom visiting discos, they realise that many hits are born in these clubs and therefore more and more major record companies are finding the disco circuit a healthy ground for breaking new talent. They have disco promotion teams, but as there are more than 6500 clubs in Europe and it is almost impossible to put them in categories, the labels find it hard to select and prepare valuable lists. They often change their way of club-promotion. This is also a result of the frequent changing of deejays. In general clubs in big cities are much more progressive than the discos in the smaller villages although the latter are often attended by high number of youngsters during the weekends. EUROTIPSHEET will point at these differences and we hope to be able to fastly expand the space given to the European Disco Scene.

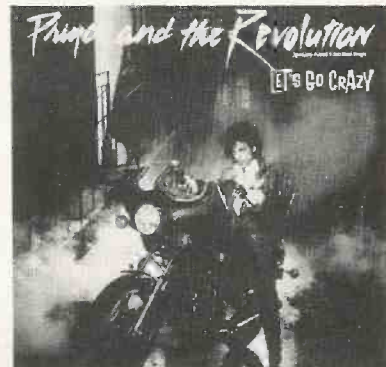
