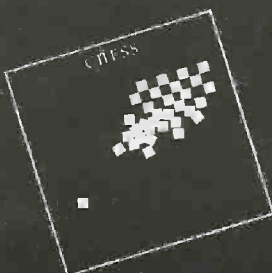

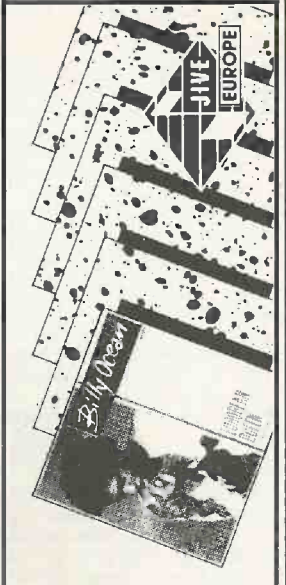

 them on their UK tour, during November when they are around your area.  
 20th October Radio One will broadcast them in their series 'In Concert'  
 at 6.30 p.m. After all this excitement, the band will be going into the  
 studio to record their debut album which is slated for an early '85  
 release. Just to make things clear, they are going to be huge as they've  
 just won the coveted Hot Press (Ireland's leading music paper), best  
 newcomers award and I quote: "For bringing a breath of fresh air, colour  
 and excitement to Irish music). Now how's that for a starter? ★  
 September 28th saw the release of a new ICICLE WORKS single, entitled  
 Hollow Horse. In September they played a European and Scandinavian  
 tour, followed by a UK tour in October ★ And if you are going to gigs,  
 don't miss THE ADVENTURES on their UK dates, nor BILLY BRAGG,  
 FRANK 'N' HANKS go mad on the Contraflows, the show will last at least  
 3 hours, and Billy Bragg will be the first on stage ★

Another artist (no, not Prince) who is marvellous is HUEY LEWIS & THE  
 NEWS. They will be in Amsterdam 24th of October. On 28th he'll play the  
 Dominion London. I think I announced that before already, well, just to  
 make sure you don't miss it! ★ Just about now, there'll be a release of  
 the RAIDERS OF THE LOST CORVETTE, debut single entitled My Way  
 Home. It has been recorded in Munich's Music Land Studio under  
 supervision of Queen's engineer HANS MENZEL and produced by  
 MACK (Queen) in Sevilla (Spain) on the set of Sergio Leone's Once Upon  
 A Time In The West, the band shot a mini film (video) around their single  
 ★ W.A.S.P. changed their drummer TONY RICHARDS, the new Stixs  
 Beast is STEVE RILEY ★ ALPHAVILLE, who's not only Big in Japan, but  
 is breaking everywhere, released their first album, entitled Forever Young.  
 Having already 3 hits (all their released singles so far). This is another  
 band to watch closely. Their album was produced by COLIN PEARSON  
 & WOLFGANG LOOS ★ In September a new all Spanish language LP  
 from MENUDO was released. Currently the boys are on a '6 dates US  
 tour. On this tour they'll introduce a new Menudo member, RICKY  
 MARTIN and farewell RICKY MELENDEZ (he turned 16!) ★ JUICE  
 NEWTON has a new album out, entitled Can't Wait All Night, which has  
 been produced by RICHARD LANDIS with OTHA YOUNG as an  
 associate. Young is also a guitar player in Juice's Road Band ★ Finally  
 something new about RICK SPRINGFIELD. His new video to Bop Till  
 You Drop was shot in San Francisco last month and was directed by  
 DAVID FINCH and produced by JOHN VOIGT ★  
 MEATLOAF is back again, with a few pounds of meat less and a new  
 album and single. His lp is called Bad Attitude, he's going on a major UK  
 tour from Nov. 10 - Dec. 10th, after that quickly to Germany, France,  
 Holland and Belgium for one show each. A video for his current single  
 Modern Girl is available ★ JOAN JETT & THE BLACKHEARTS are  
 touring end of October in Germany, Spain, Switzerland, Holland and  
 Scandinavia. I hope we'll all meet her in Holland! ★  
 NAZARETH is back with a new album and tour. The tour kicked off on  
 October 2nd and culminates with a gig at the Dominion Theatre London  
 October 29th. Support act on their UK tour is Swiss band BLACK  
 ANGEL. The new album is entitled The Catch and was released end of  
 September, produced by JOHN EDEN And now for something  
 completely different, good for a laugh though. Quote of the month by  
 LARRY LE BLANC: "For those who recall the wonderful MONTY  
 PYTHON Parrot sketch, this following story in the UK press recently  
 might bring forth a chuckle. The owner of a London pet shop was

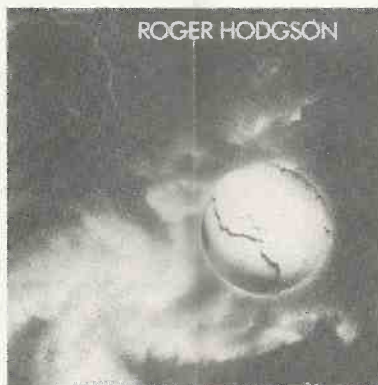

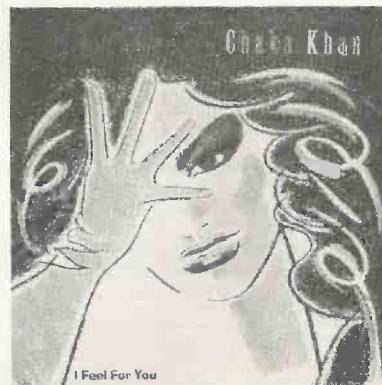
## TURNTABLE TIPS



**David Bowie - Tonight** - EMI America  
Where the Let's Dance album signalled a commercial return for Bowie, Tonight is a natural follow-up to the last one and will further broaden his audiences. Though the album relies heavily on 'dated' material there is still enough to enjoy. While side 1 is more moody and restrained (i.e. *Loving The Alien*, the best track on the album and Brian Wilson's *God Only Knows*), the second side is reserved for dance-rock orientated material (*Blue Jean*, the Lieber & Stoller cover *I Keep Forgetting* and the heavy arranged *Dancing With The Big Boys* - the track most in line with the material on Let's Dance). Enough anyway to keep the Duke dancing for a long time.



**Roger Hodgson - In The Eye Of The Storm**- A&M  
Written, arranged and produced by former Supertramp frontman Roger Hodgson, the album continues in much the same vein as that bands successful melodic pop and rock style, a style that delivered more than 30 million albums worldwide. Tracks like *Had A Dream*, *In Jeopardy*, *Hooked On A Problem* all contain that unique combination of sparkling keyboards, strong catchy hooks and the typical voice of Hodgson, ingredients that make this album a noteworthy and commercial venture. Album comes in this week at nr. 70 in the European Album charts (due to Germany, Uk and Holland) and is about to break all over.



**Chaka Khan - I Feel For You** - Warner  
Chaka is one of those performers able to shine in an astonishing range of musical moods and styles. From the Bacharach/Bayer Sager composition *Stronger Than Before*, to the novelty of *La Flamme*, to the funky *I Feel For You*, to the catchy *Hold Her*, the album is probably her best effort to date. The sleeve credits a long list of different producers (9 in total), each one on a different task; Afrika Bambaataa/Freeze producer John Robie taking the electrofunk cuts; Russ Titelman producing the mainstream cut *Eye To Eye* and Arif Mardin doing the jazzy cuts. Again Chaka establishes herself as a world-class vocalist.

Although the major releases of some weeks ago continue to fill a lot of your airplay time (Culture Club, Paul McCartney, Hall & Oates, Wham! and Prince) there are some good new releases deserving your full attention. Biggest name this week is Lionel Richie with his 5th hit from his Can't Slow Down album, Penny Lover. Most European countries are now concentrating on Tina Turner's Private Dancer track (except the UK) with hit positions in Holland and Germany. Meatloaf is back (on Arista) with Modern Girl while Spandau Ballet's Highly Strung is getting heavy radio backing from England this week. And Euro radio darling Elton John should jump in all our charts next week with his new one Who Wears These Shoes. This week's duet comes from Jermaine Jackson and Pia Zadora. With lots of t.v. shows around Europe this single will go sky high.

France could be providing some surprise hits in the coming months with Euro Crossover singles by Cookie Dingler (Femme Liberee), sounding like a Susanne-type poppy tune; Laroché Valmont (T'as Le Look Coco) which you'll be able to sing-a-long with after only one play and a new release by the old King Johnny Halliday (Ne Tuez Pas La Liberte which means Don't Kill The Freedom). Other high entries produced on the continent are the Dutch Videokids (Woodpeckers From Space) produced by a small independent label and

Jennifer Rush, who although a real born American lady, is living in Germany and was produced by CBS in that country. Stevie Wonder holds nr. 1 on all 3 European Charts!! with his single holding the highest chart points recorded in our Top 100 during the 30 weeks string of Eurotipsheets.

### GREAT LADIES

Three well-known Ladies of Rock enjoy a good week with new entries in our Top 100. Chaka Kahn holds the highest single position with I Feel For You entering at nr. 34 (and her album at 72- see our Review section); Kim Wilde gives her new label MCA a good start with The Second Time emerging at nr 37 while French first lady France Gall adds another big hit to her already very impressive list with Hong Kong Star.

Boney M seems to have won the Kalimba contest from Pepe and Tony... Paul Young will have a huge success again with his I'm Gonna Tear Your Playhouse Down. Don't you all remember Graham Parker's R&B interpretation from 1977 (and the original by Ann Peebles)... John Waite never enjoyed a major European single hit with his Baby's, but his solo effort Missing You makes it big and goes to 17 from 35 in Europe with strong positions in the UK, Germany, Belgium and Ireland.

In the midst of split-up rumours between Chrysalis founders Terry Ellis and Chris Wright, the label is doing extremely well with high new entries for the Ultravox (59) and Spandau Ballet (63) singles and the Billy Bragg Album (60). Billy Ocean scores with his Caribbean Queen which in some countries has names like

European Queen and African Queen. A record suitable for play on both Rock and Pop radio is Jim Capaldi's new one I'll Keep Holding On. Jim had an airplay hit last year with That's Love, but this new one will sell. It's already happening in Holland in its first week of release.

### HONEYDRIPPERS KWISS?

Album wise it is CBS' big week with enormous sales reported for Julio Iglesias, Sade and Toto (pre-orders) all over the continent. And to add to their sales success they also have the Metropolis Soundtrack, going from 90 to 31 in the European Album Top 100. No doubt it will deliver more singlehits after Freddy Mercury's Love Kills with Bonnie Tyler and Jon Anderson amongst others.

Another soundtrack doing very well is Ghostbusters, mainly due to high placings in the UK and Germany it jumps to 32 from 86. Highest album entry this week is Bronski Beat crashing in on 21 which is a remarkable feat for such a new band who everyone expected to be just single sellers. Another "new" name on the album front will come soon; The Honeydrippers. Our quizz of the week! Who's producing? Who's Singing? Name 2 of the guitarists featured? Who plays bass? For the first 3 good solutions Ahmed Ertegun undoubtedly will take you on a free ride back to the sixties.

The program will be broadcast around America Two and various European countries will take programs from the BBC transcription unit.

Even more names have announced their tour dates in the press recently. David Essex will be doing around 40 during the next couple of months. Gary Numan, who has formed his own label recently, will be releasing a single and album and also embarks for a nationwide tour during November. Wham! have added extra dates to their tour, which was announced recently. Nik Kershaw has also announced extra dates to his tour, with special tours planned for Christmas in London. Spandau Ballet are out and about touring and have also added some extra dates to their current tour.

Leading High Energy exponent, Sylvester, has just signed to Chrysalis Records, and released his first single this week entitled *Rock The Box*. Radio London jock Tony Blackburn's Thursday "Soul Night Out" is packing in so many people that the club has to turn people away at the door. Many big names are lined up to do p.a.'s with Tony. Some good soul records around at the moment by Simplicious, <sup>Fonda Rae</sup> and Eugene Wilde <sup>under Gary Rae</sup>. One course of Bucks Fizz Bobby J., releases his first solo single this week. The record is taken for the new BBC Television Series and entitled *Big Deal*.

Former Radio One and Radio Two jock Paul Burnett, has just written and appeared on a single by a young lady called Julie. The record is entitled *I'm In Love With Michael Jackson's Answerphone*. The record is produced by Biddu. The last time Paul appeared on a record was with his pal Dave Lee Travis of Radio One, and that was a hit! Also talking about Paul, could he be heading in the direction of a commercial radio station? All will be revealed at a later date. It is now confirmed that former Capital Radio jock Tony Myatt will be presenting the Breakfast Show on Mercury Radio. The test transmissions for the new station are coming into London loud and clear. Once again, Capital Radio jock Gary Crowley has been taken ill. On another evening Philip Sallon who is a friend of Boy George and also runs various nightclubs in London, was found to be a rather unsuitable substitute for Gary Crowley and taken off the air only after a short while. <sup>Crowley</sup> Kid Creole & The Coconuts are in the UK at the moment to record a television special for Granada television to be shown around Christmas time. Eddy Grant has teamed up with Musical Youth to produce their new single which will be released soon, and he had his own single out this week entitled *Boys In The Street*. Seventeen years after it was a number one record for them, the Tremoloes have re-recorded *Silent* as their new single.

In our second European Dance Report we have this week 5 National Dance charts coming from the UK, France, Germany, Italy and Holland .... crazy Club record from Holland: **Video Kids- Woodpeckers** From Space, doing extremely well in Holland and now starting to break in Germany, a real kiddies computer break record .... Although **Sandy Marton** is already going down in Italy, his **People From Ibiza** is now doing well in the clubs in Germany, Switzerland and Holland .... **Stevie Wonder** is still doing well across the board, single must be best sold record in '84 so far .... Good to see **Billy Ocean** breaking finally with his former no. 1 American R&B hit **Caribbean Queen**. The record is breaking out of France and Holland .... From France comes **Jeanne Mas**, who had an enormous club success in France with **Toute Premiere Fois**, now looking at the German market with the translated **Into The Night** .... Is **Art Company's Susanna** finally breaking the last major market in Europe (Germany) through club play? .... Holland's **Roberto Jacketti** is still **Saving The Day**, but now in Southern Europe especially Italy! .... Surprising to see how slow **Bowie's Blue Jean** is moving in the Euroclubs .... **Chaka Khan's I Feel For You**, undoubtedly is the best sounding club record at this moment, a steamy piece of danceable funk which incorporates catchy hints of rap and scratch in its hooks. Record is moving up tremendously in the UK and Central Europe .... **Prince** tracks being played include almost every song of his album (even the one that's not on the **Ip Erotic City**); **Let's Go Crazy** doing great in clubs, although not released as single in Europe yet and **Purple Rain** moving up strongly .... His proteges **Appolonia 6** and **Sheila E.** are starting to break out of the Benelux with **Sex Shooter** and **The Bell Of St. Mark** while the rest of Europe still has to follow .... Have you heard the **Staple Singers' Flippery People**? These pop-gospel singers cover a very recent **Talking Heads** track with glorious results. It is breaker of the week in the UK and should go big all around .... 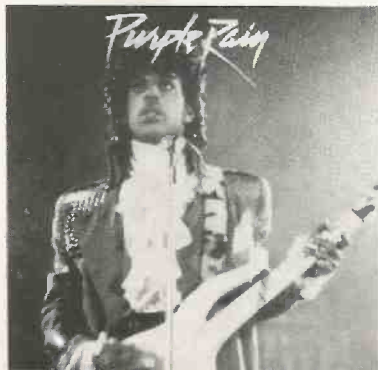
