GLORY DAYS

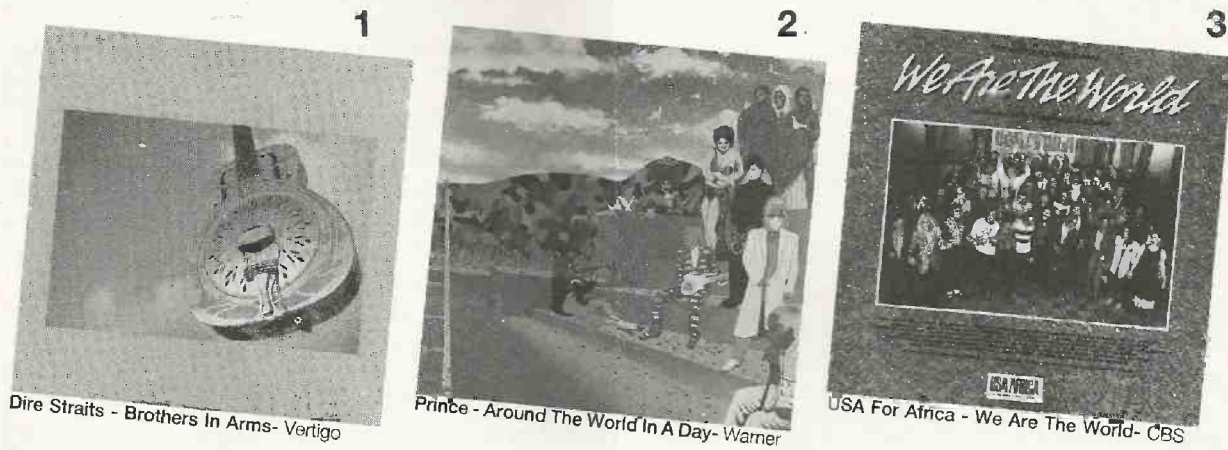
The Dire Straits album is happening and the overall European response is enormous! 73 % of our correspondents added the album this week! Their first studio album since Love Over Gold (1982) is loaded with airplay favourites. Real consensus is hard to find, although the rockers like *Money For Nothing*, *Walk Of Life* (with its funny Sir Douglas Quintet-like type of organ part) and *One World* seem to fit best for rock radio. The title track may not be the most logical choice for rockradio but is one of our favourites (very suitable for nighttime play!) On first hearing you may have decided that Robert Plant hasn't made one of his easiest albums for programming. This should not be the reason for not playing it!! Preceded by the single *Pink And Black* (although we are more in favour of the American single *Little By Little*) this album should get a fair chance and needs collective album radio support. Try *Sixes and Sevens* and *Trouble Your Money* 24

Although the USA For Africa supersession continues to be one of Europe's hottest played albums, Supertramp's new album *Brother Where You Bound* is shooting up as prime contender for next week's Euroradio Albumsmash. It will be interesting to see if Euro Radio is willing to play the sixteen minutes long 'Brother' track in its full length (that radio can work with extended tracks has been proven earlier with the success of Private Investigation by Dire Straits). With the upcoming European Tour in mind, Bruce Springsteen still gets heavy coverage on album-programs. Some deejays are even playing the *Glory Days* track in celebration of Bruce' new bride! Now... deejays are always accused of never attending Rock concerts. It will be interesting to know who of you out there are going to see the Boss on his European tour. We anxiously await your reports on his performance. *u8*

MAI TAI MAKING HISTORY

The Dutch three girl band Mai Tai is slowly making inroads on the European market and are at the moment one of Europe's hottest Crossover acts. Their new single *History* (Injection/CNR Holland) is moving up the European Airplay Top 50 due to heavy airplay in England, the Benelux and some parts of Italy and the latest news (very hot- just in time to make the deadline) is that the single is new entry in the UK at 47!

For Holland, though, it is not their first single. Their debut *Keep On Dancin'* was released in October '83 and was a club favourite although chart action did not follow. Their follow-up *What Goes On* was a modest success in Holland in April '84. But real acclaim came with their 3rd single *Body And Soul*, a very swinging up-tempo dance track where the vocals of the three ladies came to full power. And their next one *Am I Losing You Forever* only confirmed their status as one of Holland's best vocal bands at the moment; the ballad was for weeks and weeks a favourite on the Dutch channels.

They all were born in Dutch overseas countries (two come from Curacao and one from Surinam) but came at an early age to Holland. All have back grounds in the music field, but this is their first real successful band. Special mention should be made to *Eric Van Tijn* and *Jochem Fluitsma*, who wrote, arranged and produced all the songs. Their recently released self-titled album contains all the above mentioned singles with the exception of *Keep On Dancing*. From this debut album we further recommend you to check *The Rules Of Love*, a delightful piece of funky action. Comparisons with the American Pointer Sisters are constantly made and we think that this unique talent needs to be nurtured for a very long time to come!

INTER-BEAR DIALOGUE

We are now used to African, Cuban, South American and recently Mexican (Los Lobos etc.) influences in today's pop music. But who would have thought that music from the Balkan could mix with pop? The **Three Mustaphas Three** make it happen! Their mini album *Bam! Mustaphas Play Stereo* (Globe Style Records) is a very peculiar and unusual combination of ethnic Balkan music with 'modern' Western rhythms.

The Three Mustaphas Three are six family members from a place called Szegereli, the heart of the Balkan. The music they play is

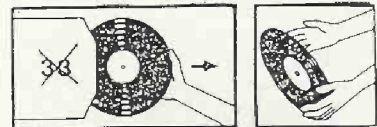


traditional cheerful folk music, however, with some very strong leanings on Western music. Somehow, they seem to be able to place their music into a very accessible (and almost commercial) frame. With instruments like cymbals, cello, violin, accordion and various percussion instruments, the Three Mustaphas Three create a very hypnotizing atmosphere and one only wonders where they picked up such influences.

In the moody track *A Chilling Tale Pt. 4/Betz*, Uncle Patrell Mustapha tells us about the importance that the bear has for the people living in Szegereli; a story 'about the day Szegereli lost it's memory': imagine yourself to be amongst the people of this little town for a gathering for the annual bear seminar, set up for the promotion of inter-bear dialog. The bottles are many, the glasses full, the food hot, the speeches short... and the young Mustapha's are starting to play this very same bear-dance music. And all the people and all the bears started to move to the delicate rhythms. Soon however, it is noticed that the friendliness of the bears exceeds all expectations... The day Szegereli lost its memory.

A charming and beautiful little story accompanied by an accordeon and a must for those programmers always on the look out for something new and exciting. Be careful and play this mini album at 45

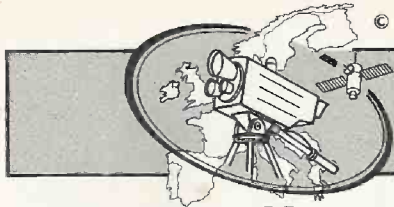

Big news this week comes from France where from June 1st videos will again be allowed on the French national TV channels. Negotiations between all interested parties were dramatic, as the SNEP (the French organization of record companies) needed to beat a deadline. As we reported earlier the SNEP had already an agreement with the Canal Plus pay channel which was already paying for video rights for the last 6 months. However, the agreement with Canal Plus specifically mentioned that they would not have to pay any rights anymore if the SNEP would not have reached an agreement with the national channels before June 1st 1985!?! Because of budget reasons the French channels will not have to pay for the video rights in the first month and this caused a last minute major problem. Although the record companies agreed to provide the videos free of charge for this first month only, the French musicians union demanded payment for this first month too. This would have meant that record companies would have had to pay the musicians union on videos that they deliver free of charge to French TV. Anyway, a little more than 1500 FF. will be paid for each clip to be shown on French TV. This will help the declined sales on international repertoire. ★ Talking about payment for video rights; it looks like this issue is now also be under heavy negotiation in the USA. Major labels CBS and WEA are expected to be charging the MTV's soon, which is a great turnaround. ★ The US First Lady Nancy Reagan is an active campaigner against drug use in the USA. One of the initiatives from her organization is a 3 1/2 minute video entitled "Just Say No" which has a strong anti-drug message. The video will be aired by all national and regional music channels including MTV and will be pushed strongly in clubs, schools and movie theatres too. ★ It looks like in spite of the bad results of last year, the second St. Tropez Video Music Festival will still be held. It will most probably take place the first week in October, probably just before the Vidcom festival in Cannes. ★

DAVID BOWIE's new clip Loving The Alien should get enormous showing all around Europe now that the single is added to a lot of European radio stations. ★ ERIC CARMEN has a new clip for his single I'm Through With Love from his debut Geffen album. ★ And also NINA HAGEN is back again, striking with a video for Universal Radio from her new album Extasy, which is available in German and English. She'll be out touring Europe in July. ★ Tight Connection To My Heart is the title to the new BOB DYLAN video. It's been a while since he has been in the spotlights. ★ The new MEN AT WORK video for Everything I Need is very nice, but so is the song. ★ HONEYMOON SUITE are currently working on their promo-clip to their upcoming new single Wave Babies. A great song, actually the whole album is very good. I wonder what happened to Europe? Unfortunately they didn't get the attention that they deserve over here, while the lp went Gold in the States and Canada. Is there a possibility to still pick up on this? ★ BRYAN FERRY's latest clip to Slave To Love is quite a sophisticated masterpiece, just like the song. So we are all looking forward to lay our hands on his new album. ★ Old mates PHIL LYNOIT & GARY MOORE teamed up to make a real good record Out In The Field. The video accompanying that is also just released. Both should do well! ★

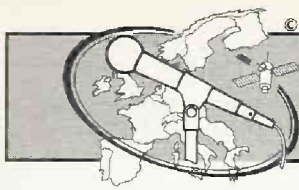

Singles Guide

The season of hot releases is continuing, and the record companies are releasing one good record after the other. While Miles Davis' version of *Time After Time* is just out on the market, Cyndi Lauper continues to 'have fun' on the first release from Steven Spielberg's new film, *Goonies 'r' Good Enough*. A lot of fun also for Italian shoe manufacturers with Mink De Ville's special shoe tribute. With the upcoming Bruce Springsteen tour, Nils Lofgren's single *Secrets In The Street* (Towerbell) will certainly arouse a lot of radio action (Nils, as you know, is a new member of the E Street gang). It is a rather simple, but effective rocky tune, with some beautiful guitar licks in the middle (check the 12" version). The hottest producer in town, Nile Rodgers, is the driving force behind the surprisingly tame new single of Sister Sledge (from the forthcoming album *When The Boys Meet The Girls*). An early Sixties Doo-Wop style enwrapped in an almost Euro-sounding production. 35

We are very proud of one of our correspondents: Claudio Cecchetto, program director of the Italian cable Deejay Television has co-produced the new single by Sandy Marton, *Camel By Camel*. A poppy song with good chances to repeat the Euro success of 1984 (*People From Ibiza*). 33

BATTLEFIELD

The Star Sisters, whose Broadway and Hollywood repertoire charted in various European countries, come up with a new sound and image. The single *Danger* is produced by the same team behind Mai Tai (see separate section) and deserves to chart outside of Holland. Our last recommendation for Euro-Crossover is the new single by the Dutch band Time Bandits, who were very popular last year in Australasia. *Endless Road* has a very commercial feel that sometimes comes very near to the sounds of Modern Talking.

The European Top 100 Singles is a battlefield this week with many records shooting up the charts; Paul Hardcastle jumps right into the top 10 (7-29), Duran Duran's Bond theme hits Top 10 (10-48), very closely followed by Eurythmics (11-

24). The sunny Motown sounds of Katrina & The Waves moves up to 20 (from 42) and the original version of *Around My Dreams* by Silver Pozzoli, charted in France, Germany and Denmark and currently at 22 (from 54), is suddenly picking up more sales than the cover version by Kasino (30-37).

BODY-STOCKINGS

The Eurovision Song Contest winners Bobbysocks are picking up a lot of radio airplay and we expect the single to come in the European Top 100 Singles next week (presently 104). The European Airwaves show strong movement as well this week. The greatest number of adds are for Hardcastle, Duran Duran (see above) and Supertramp's Cannonball. This slow rocky tune gets heavy radio coverage mainly in France and Holland but a chart position hasn't materialised yet (though the album comes in at 23 this week). Anticipating the release of the new Bryan Ferry album, the single *Slave To Love* jumps to no 9 in our Airplay Top 50 and you are obviously all dying to hear his new album *Boys And Girls*. It should arrive on your desk any day now.

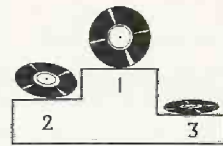

GERMANY CALLING

Let's start with good news: record buyers will be delighted to hear that Cologne based **Saturn**, known as the biggest record shop of the world, announced the opening of a second store in Frankfurt, Berger Str. 125, where they'll offer more than one million records ★ An example which deserves strong following was launched by **FAZ**, one of Germany's leading newspapers. Financed through adverts they not only started a TV service broadcast in three of Frankfurt's major hotels to inform visitors about sightseeing facilities, cultural events etc. but also introduced a city-tv which goes out via monitor systems in the centre of Frankfurt ★ **BR 3** announced the start of a new programme in fall 1985. The daily programme will go out from 14 to 18 o'clock. Between 14 and 15:30 it's **Thomas Gottschalk**, between 16:30 and 18:00 it's **Guenter Jauch** to entertain the listeners. Program makers are still undecided about the female jock to take over the middle section ★ The situation of the private radio stations in Munich is nothing but a mess. From May on 20 stations have to share three frequencies which will as insiders say cause a chaotic 'wave salad'. Nevertheless private radio come up as mushrooms in the south. In Aschaffenburg, a city in the outer north of Bavaria a new station called **Neue Welle-Antenne Aschaffenburg** was founded ★

SAT 1, the satellite TV station which started its programme on the 1st of January this year, is the first choice for the 500.000 households and already has a higher acceptance than ARD and ZDF ★ By far worse is the situation of the German concert promoters. They complain of a recession of concerts up to 20 percent. In the first half of the running season there've been 250 concerts less than last year. While expenses and ticket prices steadily increase the takings go down. Feature length concert films and videoclips are said to be poison for the concert business ★

Personal news: After eight years working for K-Tel as head of marketing **Frank Pietzsch** left the Frankfurt based company to establish his own Phono- and Video firm. German singer/songwriter **Joachim Witt**, up to now with WEA, signed a three year contract with Deutsche Grammophon. His debut album for the company is expected for September. **Manfred Wodora**, till now working for Warner Home Video, took over responsibilities as head of product in WEA domestic department. From January 1986 on **Ulrike Wolf** who worked as an editor for NDR will co-host the daily ARD-news magazine "Tagesthemen" together with **Hans-Joachim Friedrichs**, who until now worked as a ZDF correspondent in the United States.

PARIS CALLING

Good old **Vogue Records**, the famous French record company, has been sold by owner **Leon Cabac** to **Jean Luis Detry** who was formerly general manager of **Carrere Records**. Many industry experts believe that Detry is financially backed by **Claude Carrere** himself but at press time there was no proof of that. In any case Detry also arranged a major loan from the banks. But apart from this major sale, there are many other changes in the French record industry which attract attention. Former WEA general manager **Marc Exiga** has gone to **Trema** where he is hired to make it a successful company in international repertoire. So far **Trema** has been extremely successful with French artists but wants a base in international as well. **Exiga's** former position at **WEA** has been filled by 2 ex-CBS executives, **Philippe Duwat** and **Jean Jacques Gozlan**. **CBS Records** has already seen many changes during the last few months, but has also just appointed a successor to managing director **Alain Levy** (who went to **Polygram**). This time they took someone from outside the record industry. At **Polygram** **Alain Levy** has appointed **Luigi Calabresi** to head **Polydor Records** while **Jean Paul Commin** is named managing director at **Phonogram**.

It seems fashionable for international record labels to sign French artists. Latest proof is very promising young act **Axel Bauer** who has just been signed to **A&M Records** Los Angeles. Total sales of records in France have dropped considerably during the first quarter of 1985. Compared to the 1984 first quarter figures, the drop is most significant for albums. During the 1985 first quarter total units on albums reached 7,45 million (compared to 9,70 million a year earlier), while cassettes went down to 4,79 million (was 5,17 million). The upsurge of CD was good but does not make up the difference. Total value of record sales came down to 531 million french francs (compared to 559 million francs in 1984). The decline of sales on international repertoire was partly due to the non-broadcast of video clips on the national television channels, however, big news this week as from June 1st videos will again be allowed on the French national TV channels. (see our Video News section). All French radiostations were anxiously awaiting the new ratings figures this week. Early reports indicate that especially the **NRJ FM** chain went up again and ranks very high, especially in the Paris region. But more on this next time. Au revoir!
