BERTELSMANN LAUNCHES SYNDICATION SUBSIDIARY

International Partners Sought

Frankfurt- Improved international cooperation with programme suppliers and syndication services is being sought by German media giant Bertelsmann. This is needed for the new syndication subsidiary Deutscherfunk Programme Service (DFS).

The service was launched officially just before last week's Broadcast '86 Trade Fair here by the conglomerate's radio-tv division UFA. Bertelsmann is adopting a cautious approach toward news, sports and networking, due to the cost involved. However, strong interest from potential domestic clients and the launch of the new European direct broadcast satellite next summer could lead to activity in this area, too.

According to head Barbara Dickmann, a former network news anchor, the next nine months will see 100-200 new low power FM stations hitting the air in Germany. Many, perhaps up to half, will broadcast 'round the clock. "After 7 pm, most radio listeners wander off to tv, and ad revenues will dwindle," Dickmann says. "For evenings and overnight, we provide a cost effective service. We are the pioneers, the first in Germany with radio syndication, but we have already had a strong response from prospective licensees."

UFA head Bernd Schiphorst says programme prices will be based on market size and whether or not a programme contains pre-sold advertising. However Bertelsmann is not yet ready to commit himself to starting a radio news or sports operation. The official reason for the dynamic firm's unusual reticence is personnel costs.

ISLAND JOINS RCA/ ARIOLA IN FRANCE

RCA/Ariola have just finalized a deal with Island in France to distribute

their products throughout this territory. RCA/Ariola have had an agreement with Island since 1st May 1971 and over these 15 years Island products have been handled in the GAS countries, Benelux, Spain, Portugal and South America.

Island will next year celebrate its 25th anniversary. Its founder, Chris Blackwell, the son of a plantation owner in Jamaica who saw the potential of ska music, had his first big success with Millie Small ('My Boy Lollipop') whom he took to the UK. His next project was the Spencer Davis group which then included Steve Winwood. The latter is still with associated Island and his new lp was released on 1st July, the same day as the partnership began. Island have a very successful history behind them with such acts as Grace Jones, Bob Marley and B-52's.

Island Products were previously distributed through PolyGram (Phonogram in France). Joe Kiener, international vice president marketing A&R RCA/Ariola, says of the new venture: "Given the long-term historical link we have had with Island, I am thrilled to welcome them as part of the RCA family in France. I am sure we will continue to promote the best acts to the best of our capabilities."

Major releases on Island this year, apart from Steve Winwood, include new albums by Frankie Goes To Hollywood, Marianne Faithful, Tom Waits and Robert Palmer. Another successful UK act, Amazulu, which is expected to reach top 5 UK, is also being marketed through Island and two up and coming new Island acts include Thinkman, a project of Rupert Hine and Bourgeois Tagg, a US product.

Secret Service- Night City (Sonet) Sweden

Swedish pop/rock band Secret Service (who mix so many Exile-ingredients in their repertoire), follow-up their 'When The Night Closes In' single, that achieved quite some success on the Continent. The new single has all the familiar clichés (the 'Oh Woah Oh' vocals, the Eurobeat drive), but cleverly mixed into a mainstream, catchy, if light-weight pop song.

Figo- Maikaefér (Papagayo) Germany

A very cheerful poppy tune, especially the community singing at the end makes the record very 'hitverdächtigt', as the Germans so appropriately say. Six young lads who will be representing West-Germany at the fourth International Music Contest in Cesme, Turkey on the 5th of July. Figo comes from Italian and has the same meaning as the German word 'Geil'. English language version (out very soon) makes this single suitable for crossover, notably GAS countries and Scandinavia.

Easter House- Inspiration (Rough Trade) UK

Already a big favourite on the UK indie scene, this four track EP, out since May. Manchester band couples polemic rock (with echoes of U2 and The Smiths) with politically committed lyrics. Passionate vocals and a guitarist that is regarded by many as the best since The Smiths' Johnny Marr. Album 'Contenders' out next week.

Bo Katzman Gang- Working On The Galley (EMI) Switzerland

Very popular Swiss quartet who are receiving heavy airplay and entered the Swiss charts last week at 25. Hard rock intro moves into an Opus-like pop single with a good timey chorus. Single deserves to be released by EMI all over Europe. Germany has already committed itself to release the single and the upcoming album ('Katz-people') around autumn this year. An instant pop radio add that has huge potential to cross-over.

Rita Mitsouko- Andy/Un Soir, Un Chien (Virgin) France

M&M's long time French favourites finally released the follow-up to the synthesizer dance ditty Marcia Baila with a double A-sided single, already a top add on France radio, both AM and FM. Andy is the most commercial of the two, although not having the same immediate impact as Marcia Baila. This time the avant-garde duo comes up with a funky Tony Visconti produced dance track. A repetitive theme in a rather mutant production.

Curacao-born female singer with an infectious reggae/rock song with lean and modest arrangements. Overall sound (Dutch production) is polished and fresh. Deserves a release outside Germany.

It seems that Andy Taylor is too busy working on his solo projects (including an album with ex-Sex Pistol Steve Jones) to devote 4 months of his life to a mere Duran Duran album!

More News about Wham's farewell. Nick Heyward will now join the boys, Elton John and Paul Young and everybody who couldn't get tickets will just have to be content to stand outside and watch the £60,000 firework display.

And a rival bash will be going on down in south London on the same Saturday with Sting, Boy George, Gary Kemp, Communards and Billy Bragg as some of the Artists Against Apartheid who'll be playing a free open air concert.

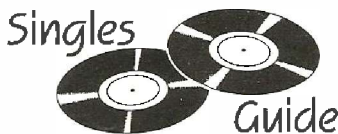

Although **Wham!** are about to split up, the duo is still in the middle of all attention with their latest *The Edge Of Heaven* and a forthcoming farewell album. Last week their single was the highest debuting single in the European 100 Hot singles of this year (with its entry at 12), this week they top the European Airplay in a good move from 4 to 1, breaking the hegemony of the 4-weeks topper Invisible Touch.

A good contender for the top is **Bowie's** *Underground*, moving from 8 to 4. Bowie topped the European Airplay earlier this year with *Absolute Beginners* for 5 consecutive weeks.

The airplay of the **Eurythmics'** single *When Tomorrow Comes* is a bit disappointing although the release of the new album *Revenge* will make up for this. After wandering for 10 weeks in the European Airplay Top 50 there is renewed interest for **Level 42's** single *Lessons In Love*; it moves into Airplay Top 10 (8-11).

As predicted last week, **Madonna's** new single *Papa Don't Preach* has very much improved on the rather low entry in the Airplay Top 50 last week. The single is this week's fastest moving single in a spectacular jump from 39-11, only in its second week.

Another remarkable jump for **Steve Winwood's** *Higher Love* (13-40) and his latest Island album *Back In The High Life* is eagerly anticipated.

Other Airplay gainers for **A-Ha** (17-25), **Bangles** (18-32), **Alphaville** (19-26) and **Dr. & The Medics** (21-29).

The highest debuting single in the Airplay Top 50 this week is for **Owen Paul** with *My Favourite Waste Of Time*. Apart from a hit in the U.K. other European stations are adding this Marshall Crenshaw written single to their playlists.

Watch out for the new single of **Tom Robinson** who continues his politically engaged stance with his anti-cocaine song (*It Ain't Nothing Like The Real Thing*, much in the same vein as Grandmaster Flash's *White Lines*). A very powerful rap dance killer. Other remarkable releases for **Southside Johnny & The Jukes'** *Walk Away Renee* (a return for the Jersey band with their rendition of the Four Tops hit of 1967), **Wax** (joining

the talent of Andrew Gold and Graham Gouldman) with their second single from their splendid album *Magnetic Heaven* and the remarkable *Sweet Bird Of Truth* by **The The**, **Matt Johnson's** hard-hitting noisy funk single.

In the Hot 100 singles **Madonna** keeps on reigning with *Live To Tell* for 6 consecutive weeks at the top. Two new singles in the Top 10, **Bananarama** (7- 15) and **Wham!** (10-12). Other very good moving singles in the Hot 100 for **David Bowie** (12-34), **A-Ha** (13-41), **Sandra Kim**(16-26), **Prince** (17-25) and **Modern Talking** (20-29).

The highest entry in the Hot 100 is, as expect-

ed, for **Madonna's** *Papa Don't Preach*, entering at 24. It is already Madonna's 3rd entry in the Hot 100 this year with *Borderline* entering beginning of this year at 54 and *Live To Tell* at 18. This makes her, when it comes to new entries, the most successful artist in the European Hot 100.

It is striking to see that the next 4 new entries are all disco/dance related products. The second single from five artist **Samantha Fox**, *Do Ya, Do Ya*, enters at 67, the Solar dance ensemble **Midnight Star** come in at 72 with **Headlines**, and **Sly Fox's** *Let's Go All The Way* and **The Real Roxanne's** *Bang Zoom!* enter at 76 and 80 respectively.

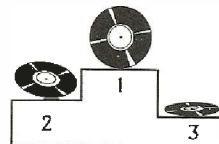

ROD BEATS ON

Good old Rod (Stewart) is back with his 15th album entitled *Every Beat Of My Heart*. Already his 7th album for Warner Brothers, the album contains more rock 'n roll than his latest disco attempts on 'Body Wishes' and 'Camouflage'. Rock 'n Roll is here to stay, and tracks like *Another Heartache* (co-written by o.a. Bryan Adams), *A Night Like This*, *Whose Gonna Take Me Home* and *Red Hot In Black* are perfect examples of his return to the basics. The familiar rasp and the straight forward solid rock approach, make them all single contenders. Side 2 shows Stewart from a more restrained side and especially the title-track *Every Beat Of My Heart* and the striking cover of the Beatles track *In My Life* (is this the first time Stewart has recorded a cover version of a Beatles song?) are recommended. Produced by Bob Ezrin and featuring his old playmates Jim Cregan and Steve Cropper, it is definitely the hottest album around at the moment at Europe.

It is already one and a half years since the German-trio *Alphaville* had worldwide success with singles *Big In Japan*, *Sounds Like A Melody* and *Forever Young*. Over 3 million of these three singles have been sold worldwide and their debut-album also sold over 1 million. For their new album they teamed up with producers Steve Thompson (re-mixer of Elton John, A-Ha etc.), Peter Walsh (Simple Minds, Saga), Wolfgang Loos (producer of the first Alphaville album) and Michael Barbiero. The new album holds the promise for several more singles most notably *Sensations* and *Universal Daddy*, both sparkling synth-dance tracks highly polished and with lots of appeal. The album entered the Hot 100 last week

at 48 and is now already at 39.

Eros Ramazzotti is one of the most successful Italian singers in Europe at the moment. The San Remo winning song *Adesso Tu* is charted in Austria, Switzerland, Belgium and Italy at the moment and picking up good reactions in Germany and France as well. His new album *Nuovi Eroi* features the latter and 8 new songs. The album sports a nice amalgam of ballads (*A Mi Ribello*, *Con Gli Occhi Di Un Bambino*) and more powerful material like *Fuggo Dal Nulla* and *Lacrime Di Gioventu'*.

The highest entry in the European Hot 100 albums is this week **Sting** with his double live set, *Bring On The Night*, entering at 23, followed by the new album by **The Smiths** entitled *The Queen Is Dead* (38). It is their 3rd studio album and it features their 2 hit-singles *The Boy With The Torn In His Side* and *Bigmouth Strikes Again*. Probably their best set so far, it features Morrissey's melancholic vocals on *I Know It's Over*, two more energetic master pieces like *Vicar In A Tutu* and *The Queen Is Dead*.

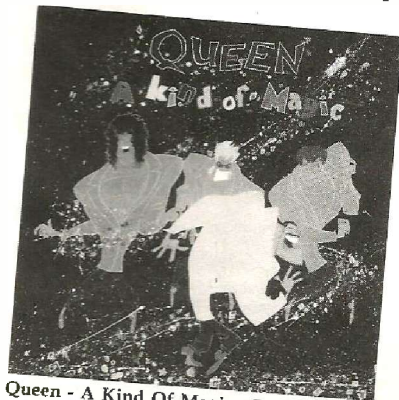
The Housemartins have a top 3 single in the U.K. and the release *over* their auspicious debut-album couldn't be more appropriate. The band already appeared twice in our New Talent column with their charming, simple and innocent pop songs. Four boys from Hull who play dead normal songs with an infectious enthusiasm and conviction. 12 songs (and 13 hits) of which especially *We're Not Deep*, *Freedom*, *Flag Day* (the debut single in a new version) and *Sitting On A Fence* are recommended playing.

After only being charted for 3 weeks, **Queen** reach the no. 1 of the Hot 100, replacing **Peter Gabriel** whose *So* only remained at the top.

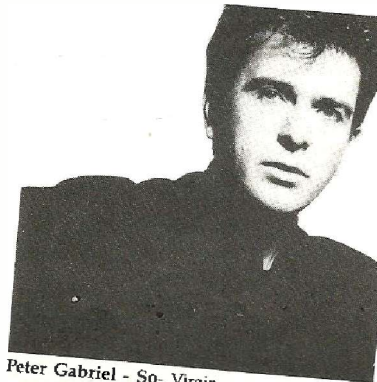

SYNDICATION - PROMISING FIELD FOR EURO RADIO

Despite Negative Connotations, First Signs Of Acceptance

Whereas syndication is a common phenomenon in the US, in Europe there is still much resistance and misunderstanding surrounding this area of programming. One thing that clearly stood out at the IMMC panel in Montreux, is that European programmers fear the domination of American values and the American way of living. In addition language barriers, various local restrictions on advertising and a general fear of losing the station's identity by selling American syndicated programmes, are all hurdles against a successful and fruitful syndication supermarket.

Even the word 'syndication' in itself is very often misunderstood. Basically, syndication means an 'exchange of programmes' and this can be done in 2 ways; the sale or exchange of programmes to overseas buyers, either radio stations or other syndication companies or secondly the distribution of programmes in one territory, creating a 'network' of stations which take certain programmes, not necessarily broadcasting them at the same time, but all agreeing to broadcast them in their original form.

Only recently attitudes have changed drastically. And although syndication in Europe still has a long way to go, the recent relaxation by the I.B.A. (Independent Broadcasting Authority) in the UK to allow sponsorship and bargain deals was a first sign. In a more general sense, European programmers are beginning to understand that by pooling financial resources and by getting more than one station involved in a project, one can create higher quality programmes.

Radio stations in the UK have always looked at overseas markets for their programmes and in fact the BBC Transcription Service was the first to syndicate and to establish success in this area. A few years back UK Independent Radio Stations became interested and some of the larger stations (especially Piccadilly, Capital and Clyde) had some success in finding overseas markets for programmes already broadcast in the UK. According to Simon Cole, chief executive of Piccadilly Productions, the future of syndication in the UK is very healthy. "I sense a change in the British radio industry and people are beginning to understand that syndication is a genuine way of producing quality programmes. Something that happened in tv much earlier, where a lively exchange of programmes is a very

common thing, now seems to be taking place, although very slowly, in the radio field as well."

Piccadilly Productions tries to act as a valuable marketing arm for any UK independent radio station overseas since stations often do not have the time, inclination or contacts to properly represent themselves. "We try to recognise this need," continues Cole, "by not just shipping out already existing material but looking at ways of customising it or even creating entirely new product to suit a particular overseas market."

At present Piccadilly Productions is working with American Public Radio on a series of Classical Concerts to be narrated by Edward Heath and they produce Paul Gambaccini's American chart programme for syndication. Piccadilly is also considering syndicating throughout Europe a show based on the European Hot 100 as compiled by M&M. To achieve these goals explains Cole "we get a sponsor to pay for the costs of the production and

syndicate the series to a number of stations. The sponsor gets the exposure he or she is looking for and the stations get a high quality programme that they would otherwise not have been able to afford."

Several independent producers are also very active in the UK producing special programmes. The most successful one is Rock Over London with its one-hour weekly series produced in London by Steven Saltzman and Paul Sexton, hosted by Graham Dene (the morning dj on Capital Radio) and syndicated to a great number of American and Canadian radio stations.

Not only in the UK but also in France, FM stations are producing programmes that are distributed, mostly within their own territory. Ofredia produces the weekly Kit Parade Societe Generale, a one-hour weekly programme with interviews and hit tracks, syndicated to 180 stations. At the moment producer Christian Savigny is looking for possible syndicators in Canada, Belgium and the Caribbean. Although at the moment Savigny acknowledges that France FM stations do not have the same financial resources as the US and syndication at this stage mainly consists of getting sponsors, with no real possibilities as yet to sell programmes, this will definitely happen within a few years.

Conversely, to syndicate program-

mes from the US into Europe, is a much more tedious task. According to Suzanne Olson, international manager of Westwood One, "We still have a long way to go. We realize Europe is not around the corner, each territory has its own specific needs and its own rules and laws on advertising, but we still see a great future. In the end it will bring more advertising dollars for everybody, it is feasible and adventurous for all and in fact everybody can benefit from this procedure." The US company has most success with its concert series and exclusive radio interviews with the pop and rock stars of today. "There is much more resistance on regular programmes like weekly series and Countdown programmes. Lots of European stations don't broadcast 24 hours a day and it is therefore quite hard to squeeze in blocked programming. For that reason Westwood One tries to develop an individual style for each station and we have had quite some progress in Scandinavia, Italy and Belgium, mostly with the private or pirate stations."

Another US syndicator is Radio Express, the only company in the world who sells American material, exclusively to stations outside the US. The company represents all the ABC and NBC radio shows and is most successful with its American Top 40 with Casey Kasem, a.o. weekly broadcast on German WDR, national Austrian channel ORF and Radio Orwell in Ipswich, UK. Suzanne Barron of Radio Express thinks it is very important to keep on supporting a particular station and "to find ways of helping them in getting sponsors and in this way line up an individual way of programming for each station".

There is tremendous potential for quality programmes in Europe and although the radio system here is not as commercialized as in the US, it is only a matter of time before European programmers really start to open up the dialogue and to come to a successful and fruitful exchange of programming. Radio stations are still not very keen on giving away their airspace to programmes they have not produced themselves and sponsors should be convinced that there are other ways of buying their advertising space.

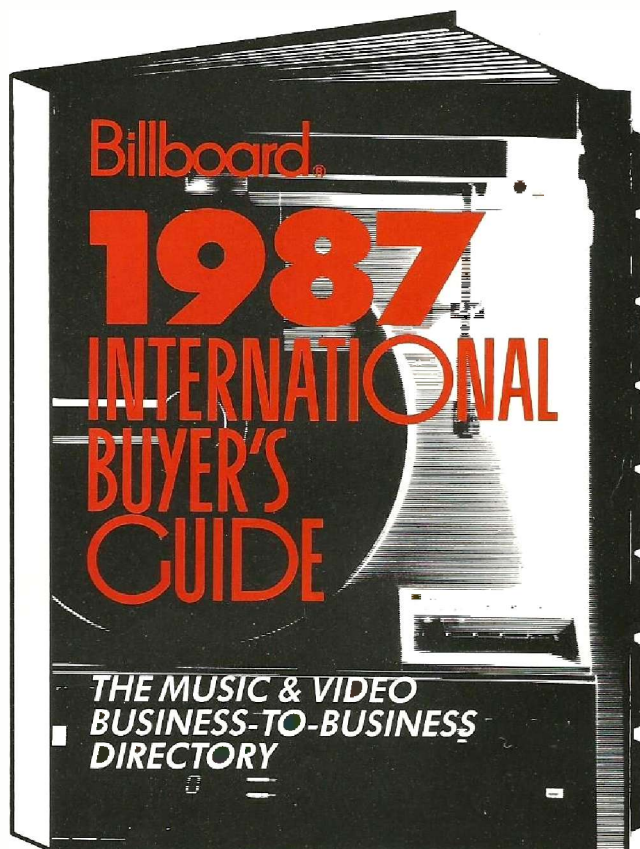

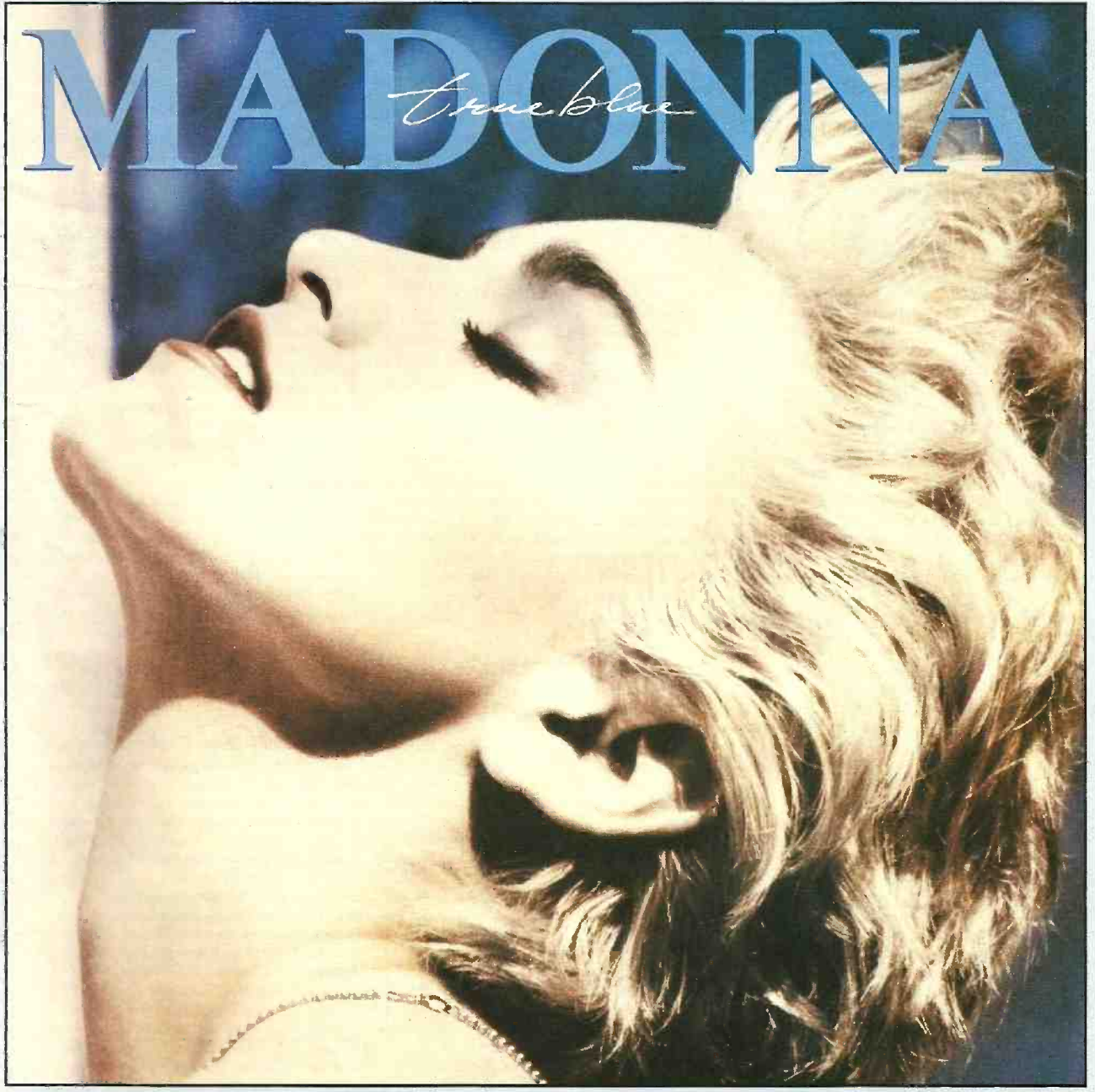

CBS Act Participate In Film Promo

by Peter Jones

"Dirty Work", the Rolling Stones' first album for CBS, has already out-sold its predecessor "Tattoo You", even without that album's advantage of a major European tour in support. That's the claim of CBS International executives, who say over 1.5 million units have been sold worldwide, more than 120,000 in CD format.

The album went platinum fast in Canada and Australia, gold in Britain, West Germany, France, Holland and Switzerland, and has topped charts in a Pan-European sweep which includes

Holland, Belgium, Austria and Switzerland, as well as the Music & Media overall European Hot 100 (album was 3 weeks no. 1), with chart entries in no fewer than 15 European territories.

The first single from the LP, "Harlem Shuffle", is giving way to "One Hit", seen as a further sales boost. Additionally a one-hour documentary special made by BBC-TV is nearing completion and will be available round the world this autumn. The film takes in biographical material, but

DUTCH VERONICA ORGANISES ZOMERDAG

Veronica's Zomerdag will coincide with UK The Tube's exclusive programme, Eurotube, to be transmitted live on July 5th from 19.30 - 0.30 hrs. The Dutch radio/tv channel Veronica will broadcast the first 3 hours of Eurotube and their input for the show says Lex Harding, programme director, will be Simply Red.

Before the show they will feature Miami Vice starring Phil Collins and between 15.00 and 20.00 hrs. from their Countdown studio in Bussum, 5

hours of music will be featured. This includes an entire hour of Wham! videos, Paul McCartney's version of We All Stand Together entitled Rupert & The Frog Choir, Dutch rock artists and OMD.

Veronica are also actively involved in arranging a concert on Scheveningen beach by The Hague for Golden Earring. It is a free concert expected to be attended by over 100,000 people and will be recorded live for radio and broadcast later on television.

transmitted live on Austrian radio and television, was sponsored for nearly \$30,000 by the Coca Cola company with the aim of promoting Austrian youth culture in general.

Every record released in 1985 on which an Austrian made a key contribution - be it as writer, producer, artist or whatever - was eligible for the competition. At the awards ceremony, with more than 250 big name guests, and an audience of 2,000, prominent personalities announced the winners.

Named best composer of the year was Rainhard Fendrich, with Gert X Steinbacher of pop group STS best lyricist. Other major winners: Peter Wolf (arranger), the Dolezal/Rossacher team (best video) and Ina (new-comer). There was a special award for the "Austria For Africa" fund-raising project.

The Pop Amadeus Awards followed the same organizational lines as America's Grammy ceremony, or the annual German Record Awards. A media jury picked the winners.

Stephan von Friedberg, president of the Austrian branch of IFPI, was on the jury but without voting powers. He is fully in favour of the newly-created awards, though some record industry heads are saying that it would be better, more prestigious, if there were official IFPI prizes instead.

Though it is not certain the Pop Amadeus Awards will continue next

year, there are already strong negotiations over possible sponsorship. The 1986 event was organized by Herbert Fechter and his company Profil Promotions. Says Fechter: "It is possible IFPI could be involved, but I have registered the trademark 'Austrian Record Prize' and I'm the only one who can use it."

But the German Federal Post Office monopoly is the most likely villain. The post office charges exorbitant prices for a stereo broadcast line, and one from New York to Washington would cost about \$70,000 per day. A live network alternative would be cooperation with Radio Luxembourg and use of a current RTL tv satellite subcarrier. Technically, this would make networking possible right now. But effectively, the German post office could veto the project. So UFA and DFS must wait for the new European DBS with broadcasting starting in late '87. DFS could then feed local stations directly with live programming.

State-chartered giants (BR in Munich and SWF in Baden Baden) have hinted they would let private stations carry some of their shows during off hours. DFS could soonface not only private but also public radio competition. (see also page 18)

RCA/Ariola Records - International is one of three new independent operating units established by Elliot Goldman, president and chief executive officer of RCA/Ariola, as part of the recently announced restructuring of RCA/Ariola.

Prior to joining RCA/Ariola, Mr. Fischbach was president of Activision International and senior vice president of Activision, Inc., the Mountain View, California computer software and video game concern.

QUEEN GIG ON UK NATIONAL STEREO SIMULCAST

Unless there are any unforeseen problems, Queen's July 12 Wembley Stadium concert in North London will be not only a memorable sell-out gig but also a unique broadcast event.

Plans have been completed to link UK independent radio and television in a national stereo simulcast.

With the television pictures carried on Channel Four, and stereo radio carried via satellite to the Independent Radio network, the broadcast will create several firsts for the UK media industry.

Apart from being the first-ever nationwide stereo simulcast on the independent networks, the concert will also be the first time satellite distribution has been used for a network independent radio broadcast in the UK.

The concert, promoted by Harvey Goldsmith, is to be filmed by Tyne Tees Television's "Tube" team, directed by Gavin Taylor and will be recorded in digital stereo. It is said that the sound quality of the satellite distribution system will thus be equal to that of the digital stereo master tape

and will allow the listener to experience the full impact of the original recording.

Participating UK independent radio stations will be equipped with satellite dishes and the visual signal from Channel Four will be electronically "locked" to the sound signal, broadcast over the ECS2 satellite just a fraction of a second ahead of the pictures, this to cut out satellite delay.

The scheme was initiated by Queen, living up to their reputation as one of the world's most innovative bands. It's recalled that their film, produced to accompany the 1975 smash "Bohemian Rhapsody" was an important landmark in the development of the pop video. Now, 11 years on, they are pioneering commercial broadcasting's big moment in terms of the UK's first national stereo link.

The event has been coordinated by Queen, manager Jim Beach, the promotions agency Creative Planners and the AIRC programming committee, in consultation with Channel Four.

UNITED KINGDOM

Wham! have their fourth no. 1 hit in the UK as their festive *The Edge Of Heaven* moves from 2 (new entry last week) to the no. 1 spot this week. The three weeks chart topper *Spirit In The Sky* has therefore been put back to no. 4. At 2 M&M's Disco/Dance tip **Nu Shooz** and Hull based band **The Housemartins** (yet another M&M New Talent tip) move from 12 to no. 3! (the band just released their debut album, *Hull 0* London 4, this week). **Amazulu** move into Top 10 (5-9) and the Mar-^{Canada}shall Crenshaw written *My Favourite Waste Of Time* by **Owen Paul** streaks into Top 10 as well (7-14). **Madonna** enters straight in at 13 with *Papa Don't Preach*. In terms of chart entries, this is her 4th best entry in the UK charts after the entries of 'Groove' (last year straight in at 4), 'Live To Tell' (this year in at 10) and 'Dress You Up' (last year; 12). Good moves for **Queen** (14-21; in its 2nd week), **Bananarama** (15-22), **Big Country** (28-34) and **Art Of Noise** (38-46). Second best entry for **Samantha Fox's** latest *Do Ya, Do Ya*, entering at 24. Other entries for **Midnight Starr** (Headlines in at 29) and **The Real Roxanne** (*Let's Go Go*) entering at 31.

The **Smiths'** new LP *The Queen Is Dead* makes an enormous entry straight in at 2, even surpassing **Sting's** entry at 16 (the live double *Bring On The Night*).

GERMANY

Modern Talking again top both the single and album charts this week. The duo's *Atlantis Is Calling* is followed by **Sam Cooke** who moves up one notch and by **Chris Norman**. **Level 42** move up to 4 after only being charted for 3 weeks and 2 incredible jumps into top 10 include **Nu Shooz's** *I Can't Wait* (7-53) and **Bananarama's** version of *Venus* (9-65). Also climbing steadily are **Sandra** with *Innocent Love* (14-48), **The Cure's** *Boys Don't Cry* (19-28) and the **P4F** medley of *P.Machinery* with *Relax*. **A-Ha** have highest new entry with *Hunting High And Low* (25) and **Bowie's** *Underground* also enters the German charts along with **Marvin Gaye**, **Draft Deutscher** (*Sensuality*) and **Wham!**

FRANCE

Jeanne Mas has not succeeded in replacing **Stephanie** from the top where she remains for the

9th week. The only addition to the top 10 is **Madonna's** *Live To Tell* (at 7, up from 12) and other good moves for **Alphaville** with *Dance With Me* (23-38), **Nicole** (*Don't You Want My Love*: 31-43) and **Prince** with *Kiss*. Only 2 new entries this week: **Images** with *Les Demons De La Nuit* and local trio **Niagara** with their follow-up to Tchiki Boum, entitled *L'Amour A La Plage*. (The group took their name from a Henry Hathaway film starring **Marilyn Monroe**).

It is with regret that we learned of the death of **Coluche** who recently featured highly in the French pop scene thanks to his active participation in **Les Restos Du Coeur**, the charity single for French homeless.

HOLLAND

Already for 2 weeks at no. 1 **Janet Jackson** with the Jam/Lewis produced *What Have You Done For Me Lately*. **Labelle & McDonald** creep up one notch (2-3) and **Level 42**, last week in Holland for promotion, streak into top 10 (6-16). **Jermaine Stewart's** *We Don't Have To Take Our Clothes Off* is new in the top 10 (8-12) and a contender for next week top 10 entry is **Wham!** with *The Edge Of Heaven* (an enormous jump from 26 to 11). Other good moves for **Samantha Fox** (14-17), **Bowie** (15-22), **Whitney Houston** (27-20) and **Bananarama** (25-35).

Holland is probably the only country where **Sheila E.'s** *Holly Rock* is charted. The single enters at 29 and comes from the OST *Krush-groove*. Second best entry for the new **Madonna** single and other entries for **Queen**, E.G. Daily (*Say It Say It*), **Muenchener Freiheit** with *Tausendmal Du* and **Stephanie**.

ITALY

For the 4th week **Madonna** tops the Italian charts whose top 10 remains pretty static this week with only one addition: **Peter Gabriel's** *Sledgehammer* (at 10 from 13). **Level 42's** *Lessons In Love* is climbing well (13-25) as is Spanish singer **Miguel Bose** with his English-sung *Heaven* (15-26). **David Bowie** with *Underground* is the highest of numerous new entries including **Valerie Dore** (*Lancelot*), **Tom Hooker** (*Looking For Love*), **The Blow Monkeys** and **Samantha Fox**.

SPAIN

Modern Talking sticks at 1 for the 4th consecutive week and is again followed by **SSS's** *Love Missile* and popular Spanish duo **Victor Manuel & Ana Belen** (an M&M New Talent tip). At 4 comes **Stephanie** who has zoomed up from 14 and other fast climbers for **Angel** with *Dancing In The Street*. Local quintet **Ole Ole** are currently doing well in the Spanish charts since the addition of new female vocalist, **Marta**. Their *Lili Marlene* is still charted and the follow-up *Bailando Sin Salir De Casa* is rising steadily. Only one new entry for **Jose Luis Perales** with *La Primera Vez* (The First Time).

GREECE

Although single sales are relatively low in the Greek market, **Madonna** has best selling single with *Live To Tell* followed by **Modern Talking** (*Brother Louie*) and **Sandra's** *Little Girl*. Best selling international albums for **Prince**, **Stones**, **Whitney Houston**, **Sandra**, **Jean-Michel Jarre** and **A-Ha**.

FINLAND

Most popular single is **AC/DC's** *Who Made Who*, making a big jump from 10 to the no. 1 spot this week. At 2 local artist **Juce Leskinen**. **Samantha Fox** has been put back to 3 and new entries for **Eurythmics**, **Genesis**, **Dr & The Medics** and **Level 42**.

DENMARK

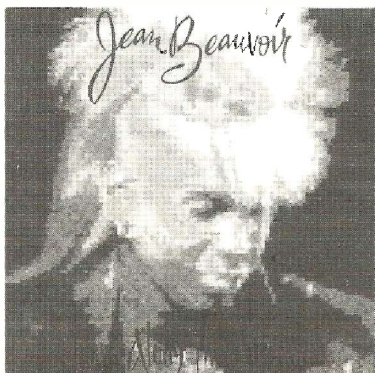
Two national products remain on top, **VM-Holdet** and **Dansk Holdet**, but **Wham!** is new at 3 with *Edge Of Heaven*. **Alphaville** drops one place to 4 and new in the top 10 is **Prince** with *Mountains* (9-19). Best moving single has **Peter Gabriel** (18-26) and **Genesis** enters at 25).

PORTUGAL

Jennifer Rush is still no. 1 with *The Power Of Love* and the highest jump has **George Michael** with *A Different Corner* (2-21). 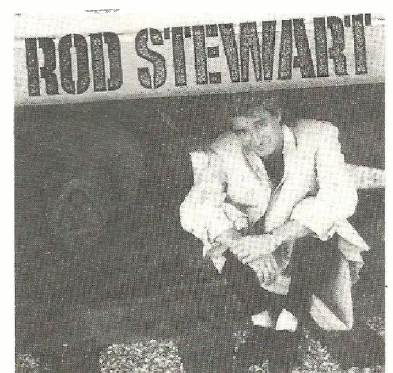

EURO CABLE PENETRATION ON THE INCREASE UK Lags Behind

by Peter Jones

While the number of homes linked to cable television networks in western Europe generally grew by 4% last year to around 11 million, so creating a mood of high optimism, the British cable-tv industry, worried by its snail-space progress, is looking for an urgent injection of financial aid from the government.

In the UK, only seven of the first 11 franchises granted in 1983 are in operation, whereas all should have been in action by now. And of the additional 10 granted by the new Cable Authority, only one (in East London) looks likely to be operating this year or next.

Operators say one reason only 150,000 British homes are cabled thus far is the lack of material fed into them by satellite. But the Dutch satellite service Europea will feed Britain from mid-summer and others will follow.

Operators say demand is similar to that, say, in West Germany where, in Frankfurt and Hamburg, the cable

penetration was around 15%, but where there has been immense government subsidies. The cable companies have 15-year franchises, but the financial problems all come in the early years, hence the demand for government help.

But a new report covering the whole western Europe region suggest that about 16% of European homes, or 21 million, will be linked to cable systems within the next 10 years. About 3% of homes are now on sophisticated cable networks capable of two-way communication, and this sector is expected to rise to 12% by 1995.

The report, from CIT, London-based communications consultancy, its fourth annual survey, says that if the UK had been excluded from the reckoning, the western European growth would have been 8% last year, not just 4%. Without the inclusion of slow-moving British cable, Europe would have seen record cable growth last year, says the report.

DUTCH VCR'S UP TO 23%

Amsterdam- According to a recent survey organized by NOS, the Dutch state-owned broadcasting organization, a total of 1.2 million Dutch households had a videorecorder at the end of 1985. The VCR penetration grade was therefore up to 23%, a six-fold rise since 1981.

According to the NOS research, the VCR penetration was up to 30% in February this year and is expected to increase to 50% before 1990.

In recent years the number of rented pre-recorded video cassettes in

Holland has also grown considerably. 70% of VCR owners now rent these cassettes on a regular basis.

Last year Dutch households with a VCR played an average number of 15 videotapes per month, 68% of which included taped television programmes and 14% of which were pre-recorded cassettes. Of the taped programmes drama represents some 50%, entertainment 18%, youth programmes 15% and information and sports the least of all. Of the pre-recorded video cassettes 56% were action films.

UK SALES BOOM FOR VIDEO CASSETTES

Blank and pre-recorded videocassette sales worldwide will reach 2.5 billion a year by 1989, according to a new report from Benn Electronics in London. In 1984, some 600 million two-hour equivalents were sold.

The report predicts a major sales

boom as unit prices fall and video music starts making real movement into the mainstream audio-based music business. Videocassette purchases per VCR owner will rise from 15 hours per year in 1984 to over 25 hours per year in 1989 as a result, says

SKY EXPANDS TO AMSTERDAM

Amsterdam- At a press conference held here last week Sky Channel announced the signing of contracts with Caransa B.V. and the Escape management for the transfer of a major part of its production activities to the Escape Theatre complex in Amsterdam.

The Escape Theatre, formerly a cinema on the Rembrandtsplein in Amsterdam, will be totally redesigned to contain Europe's largest discotheque The Escape and Sky will also install a second studio available for local productions as well as Sky activities. The Eurochart Top 50 show, produced by John De Mol Productions will be produced directly at the Escape (the only discotheque in Europe designed exclusively with television in mind), as well as the Pop Formula shows which are to be co-produced by Dutch TROS and Sky Channel from October 1986.

On average a total of 10 hours a week of programming will be produced in Holland. To confirm their commitment to moving to the Continent Sky will have an office in the Escape Theatre accommodating around 15 Sky staff. This is just the beginning of the addition to the Continent and Sky executives say they hope to produce regular programmes from Scandinavia in the near future as well as entering into Flanders in Belgium this autumn where they hope to produce directly from Brussels.

Patrick (Cokes) managing director of Sky Channel said: "Sky Channel is making a major investment in the Netherlands based on the success of our production activities there over the last year."

centers on the new album, including its videos, and is produced by Mike Appleton.

Bunny Friedus, CBS International vice president of creative operations, says: "What really impressed us was the band's willingness to get involved in promotional work. Over the same period, VCR ownership will increase from the 1984 figure of 65 million to some 140 million machines, VHS and Beta combined. And it says the manufacturing dominance of Japan will shift. Production of video hardware in Japan is expected to fall 10% this year, a further 13% in 1987 and 15.5% in 1988.
