UK Yorkshire's All **Night Programming** Successful

After its first pioneering week of all- Irish national broadcasting organisanight rock music programming, UK commercial broadcaster Yorkshire TV reports "a very good reaction". Says a spokesperson: "We've had lots of calls about the experiment, and for every call that's critical we've had ten in favour."

The transmissions, for a three month trial period, began Friday August 8th after a month's delay while Superchannel/Music Box, which is providing the programming, negotiated rights clearances with the British Phonographic Industry. They run from the closedown of normal programmes to the start of breakfast ty at 6.15 a.m., and consist of Music Box's continued on page 3

Such a prospect will dismay the Independent Local Radio network in the UK, which faces an uphill struggle to draw national advertisers because of its regional structure, and has seen proposals for a national ILR network shelved pending a government Green Paper on the future of British radio.

However, the launch of Radio Tara is at least two years off and details remain vague, with Luxembourg staff in London tight-lipped about the project. Some reports say Luxembourg will handle advertising, others that a joint company will be set up for the

Wavelength is expected to be a longwave frequency recently allocated to RTE, and the station would be based outside Dublin, broadcasting 12 daytime hours per day.

Rocketing CD's Spur German Industry

West German record industry chiefs are hoping for a turnover increase of at least 5% this year, fuelled by rising CD sales and strong cassette performance. Figures for the first six months are on course for such an increase, with many of the year's strongest releases still to come.

Says Dieter Ohms, head of Poly-Gram joint distribution company PMV: "Over the whole year I think we shall see a plus of up to 7%, because most of the CD supply problems will have been resolved. So far we have had strong growth in the first three months of 1986 followed by a very noticeable lull, but the trends should stabilize."

RCA managing director Michael Anders adds: "The growth is mainly caused by CD, which is compensating for the decline in conventional album sales. We are not euphoric, but we see no reason for gloom either." WEA continued on page 3

Major Boost For Euro CD Facilities

New Plants Lined Up In Four Countries

Furopean CD manufacturing capacity is set for a major increase over the next six months with the launch of new plants in Holland and the UK Companies in Italy and Norway have also announced plans for new CD fa-

cilities to be on stream by 1988. In Holland, Dureco will become the first Dutch record company to embark on CD production when it opens a new plant alongside its existing tecord pressing division in January next year. Initial output of the \$2.8 million plant will be between 500,000 and 800,000 units in 1987, rising to as many as two million in 1988. Dureco

says it will supply throughout Europe and not just for the domestic market.

The country's first CD plant, however, is expected to be DOCdisc, a division of computer firm DOCdata. which plans to be fully operational by October this year and aims to produce 500,000 CDs by the end of 1986. The plant is notable for its unconventional manufacturing process, which managing director Joseph Beaujean describes as "unique anywhere in the world." Based on a DOCdata rotary machine, it does not require a dust-free environment, and is said to produce one CD

Scandi Indie Forges Ahead

The future of Danish indie, Mega Records looks bright and it has already secured itself a sizeable market share in Scandinavia, where the company is widely regarded as one of the leading ones of the mid-eighties, as exemplified by its constant chart presence in Scandinavia.

Mega Records began its operations as a spin-off to the Wennick Bros. Management Co., which was achieving promising results with 'Sunshine Reggae' and 'White Horse'. Manager of the band, Kield Wennick, was offered masters and he said yes to 'Guardian Angel', collaborating with Intersong Hamburg on getting the project placed in territories outside the GAS countries. This venture was very successful, leading to releases in many countries of the original Masquerade version, as well as versions by Nino de Angelo and Vicki Leandros, a.o. Other masters followed and Mega was soon in operation as a fullfledged EMI-distributed Scandinavian label, vielding hits with Modern Talking, Falco, Bad Boys Blue, Bruce & Bongo, Silver Pozzoli, Matia Bazar, Laban. Euro-contest winners Bobbysocks, and more.

What worries label chiefs most is the growing concentration of retail sales through fewer and fewer outlets. Clip Deal Puts UK's Chart FUGITIVE'S Show Back On Air

UK tv company Channel Four's "The Chart Show" is back on the air following a deal in principle with the British Phonographic Industry/Video Performance Limited over payments for the clips used in the all-video programme.

Launched in April this year, the series ran into difficulties when the BPI implemented its threat to stop supplying music videos to UK broadcasters pending agreement to the principle of payment. It was eventually taken off air in late June, after struggling on for several weeks using old and non-RPI material, and has missed six weeks. The remaining 12 programmes in the series will now be seen

weekly until October

"The Chart Show" is produced for Channel Four by Keith MacMillan's Video Visuals and runs 24 minutes each Friday evening with the latest video clips. The new agreement covers the remainder of the series plus a Christmas special still in the planning

No details of the agreement, the first for an all-video show on British television, have been released, but the BPI is now understood to be negotiating a blanket three-year deal covering the whole of Channel Four's pop music output.

NEW TALENT UPDATE

This column will give a weekly update on the progression of M&M New Talent Tips In Europe

Alpha Records in Sweden are going through a very successful period with lots of their acts charting and selling quite an excessive amount of records. M&M's New Talent tip Paradise by Pernilla Wahlgren & Emilio Ingrosso (see M&M issue 32) is currently no. 20 in the Swedish national charts. During one of her recent shows in Stockholm she drew some 20,000 people and everywhere she goes she was welcomed by big

Another Alpha release, M&M's New Talent tip Sound Of Musik (see last week's issue for single and album review) have their album at 20 in the Swedish chart and the band is in the middle of a very successful Swedish tour. Check them out!

M&M's New Talent tip Trio Rio made a very impressive jump in the German hitparade this week with their single New York-Rio-Tokyo zooming into top 10 (8-58!). The album stuck at 33 and the band is still picking favourable reactions outside their home country.

German session musician Alex Merck whose 'Shadow Dance' Ip we discussed in issue 14 of this year, recently concluded a sub-publishing deal in Italy with Channel 5's publishing arm Milano.

The impact of the Italian formation Matia Bazar is slowly but steadily increasing over Europe. Their superb disco single Ti Sento has very good positions in the Benelux (2 in Holland and 33 in Belgium) and gets good airplay reports in Germany as well. For those of you who still haven't heard their album 'Melancholia', please ask your local Ariola representative for a copy and enjoy it ...

As the New Talent page went to press, M&M New Talent tip, M.C. Miker & D.J. Sven shot up after only 3 weeks to the top of the German charts. Their rap version of Madonna's 'Holiday', Holiday Rap, has sold around 150,000 copies in Germany and sales are expected to rise to 200,000 the coming 2 days. The song also topped the Dutch charts for 4 weeks and is currently no. 1 in Belgium, as well as receiving very good airplay in France.

Following his no. 1 hit in the UK and Ireland. Chris De Burgh's single The Lady In Red is rapidly gaining in impact all over Europe. This week the single dethrones Madonna from the no. I spot of the European Airplay Top 50 where she stayed for 5 consecutive weeks. This sultry love ballad, an ode to his wife, is currently a hit in 6 European countries and saleswise it pushes through in the Hot 100 as well with its move from

23 to 14 A substantial boost in Airplay points for Peter Cetera's Glory Of Love, shooting up from 13 to 4 in the European Airplay. A no. I hit in the US, it is the first European solo hit for Cetera, the former Chicago vocalist. Cetera was responsible for a couple of chart topping singles for Chicago including 'If You Leave Me Now' and 'Hard To Say I'm

Sorry' (the latter co-written with David Foster). Lots of airplay action as well for the cheerful Stuck With You that brings Huev Lewis & The News after only three weeks up to no. 9 in the Eu-

ropean Airplay Top 50 (coming from 23). Tina Turner hits the grooves again with her new single Typical Male, where she rejoins the successful writers duo Terry Britten and Graham Lyle (responsible for a.o. 'What's Love Got To Do With It'). With Phil Collins on drums, Tina delivers the usual passionate vocals over a solid mid-tempo pop-rock track. Virtually all our correspondents are reporting their enthousiasm for the single and it zooms right into the European Airplay Top 50 at no. 10, making it the highest Airplay entry of this year. Several other artists have however improved on this position in 1984 and 1985, although Tina Turner is the first female solo artist to reach such a position. In fairness, a female group, the Pointer Sisters beat Tina Turner in 1984 with their single Automatic entering at 9 in the Airplay Top 50.

The highest entry ever in the Airplay Top 50 is due to Bronski Beat who crashed the Airplay Top 50 in 1984 when their second single 'Why' entered straight in at 4. Other very high Airplay entries in M&M's chart history include David Bowie ('Blue Jean' in at 5 in 1984 and 'This Is Not America' entering at 9 last year). UB 40 (last year's 'I Got You Babe' coming in on 5), Bruce Springsteen ('Glory Days' entered at 9) and finally Simple Minds'

'Alive And Kicking' who entered at 9 last year. While Prince is taking Europe by storm with his sold out concerts his new Girls & Boys single is a heavy favourite on Euro radio and jumps from 26 to 14 in its second week. Other Airplay movers for Human League (17-32). Boris Gardiner (22-45). Stan Ridgway (29-43) and Rod

Stewart (31-44). Lots of Airplay action to be expected next week when most of the European stations will have added the new Frankie Goes To Hollywood single, Rage Hard. The band premiered the single on the Montreux Rock Gala this year, shocking the audiences by crashing the stage completely (taking the lyrics a bit too seriously we presume). Watch out for the 12" version of this song where FGTH do a cover of Bowie's Suffragette City.

Easy Lady by female singer Spagna has nearly become the most successful Italian production of this year, as it moves this week from 16 to 12 with a bullet in the Hot 100. The single is charted in France, Spain, Italy and Belgium and equals the success of Den Harrow's Bad Boy earlier this year.


