Bertelsmann \$450 Million Bid For RCA Further Big US Investments Planned

In a move that ended speculation about the future of the RCA Music Division, Bertelsmann, the West German multi-media conglomerate, announced a \$450 million bid for the acquisition of the RCA music operation.

Bertelsmann, a \$3.7 billion concern, would thus obtain total control of RCA/Ariola International, which turns over around \$1 billion annually. The deal is expected to be completed by the end of this year and would be the biggest in the 151-year history of the Bertelsmann group.

Commenting on the deal announcement, a spokesman for the West German economic minister, Martin Bangemann, expressed satisfaction at an acquisition which would give West Germany a very substantial stake in the international music market.

The acquisition of RCA from General Electric, the \$6.3 billion parent company, which has long indicated its inclination to dispose of the music group, would mean that in a Bertelsmann set-up the multi-video

division would be second only to the printing and publishing arm, Gruner Jahr, which turns over \$1.2 billion annually.

Dr. Mark Woessner, head of Ber-

telsmann, said he saw no problems in RCA/Ariola being managed from Gutersloh, particularly with the experience gained over the last three years. ■ continued on page 22

French Gov'n Blasts Anglo Pop Foreign Videos To Be Subtitled

The French government has come up with a new scheme to protect local songsters and stop France's hit parades being taken over by Anglophone material.

It is an idea put forward by junior minister Philippe de Villiers because, they Videos of all foreign songs broadcast on tv will have to carry French sub-titles. De Villiers, who aims to shield 12-million French school children from an endless stream of English-language pop, calculates that once viewers realize how banal the lyrics really are they will turn with relief to the more sensible domestic

compositions.

French newspapers have already published satirical cartoons showing translators giving the local equivalent of 'Shaky Baby, Shaky' and 'Oo-top-a-loo-ha'. The expense of providing translations and subtitles may in itself be enough to discourage French tv stations from broadcasting as much foreign language material as before.

It isn't De Villiers is also introducing a quota system which would require them to have a minimum 52% of local recordings in their overall music output.

The struggle to preserve 'la chanson française' against the Anglo-Saxon invasion has been going on for many years, but has proved an uphill struggle, just as the struggle to maintain the purity of the French language has failed to prevent an ever-increasing number of 'franglais' hybrids like 'le clip', 'le club' and 'le weekend' becoming part of everyday speech.

The French record market is currently split around 50/50 between domestic and foreign product. Earlier this year authors' society SACEM called for the introduction of a quota system governing radio airplays, complaining of the adverse balance of payments on performing rights.



RCA/Ariola Confab Draws 100 Int. Executives

London - Senior Management and marketing executives representing RCA/Ariola, its label organizations, and its licensees from Europe, North and South America and the Pacific region gathered last week in London for a two day conference focused on fourth quarter marketing strategy. The conference was chaired by RCA/Ariola Records-International vice president and A&E, Joe Kiener.

Conferees exchanged information on successful marketing launches for key international acts, as well as new artists whose first product will reach the marketplace during the quarter.

Marketing discussions for RCA label artists focused on the current worldwide marketing campaigns for Eurythmics, Daryl Hall, Bruce Hornsby and Five Star, Blow Monkeys, Tom Robinson and Wax. New release announcements highlighted included forthcoming albums from Pointer Sisters later this year, and Mister Blue of the first quarter of 1987.

Campaigns from Arista U.S. artists included discussions of Air Supply, Dionne Warwick, Aretha Franklin and Carly Simon, as well as strategy to expand worldwide the current U.S. success of GTR, the Monkeys and of Kenny G in the U.K.

Arista U.K. artists releases discussed included Meatloaf and Nick Heyward, as well as promising new acts Sia and Helena. Conferees also began early marketing strategy for

Whitney Houston's first quarter 1987 album release.

Conferees reviewed the Aretha Franklin / Keith Richard video and new single 'Jumpin' Jack Flash', the title track of the new movie starring Whoopi Goldberg, which is to be included on Aretha's forthcoming album. This enthusiastically received preview was one of the convention's highlights.

Conferees were joined at a conference dinner by artists including Tom Bailey of the Thompson Twins, Steve Hackert and Steve Howe of GTR, the Blow Monkeys, Nick Heyward, Graham Gouldman of Wax and management staff representing Eurythmics and Daryl Hall. Arista UK presented new artist Helena to an enthusiastic response from the conferees.

Rick Blaskey, RCA/Ariola vice president, European marketing said, "This was without doubt the most productive and exciting international get-together we have ever had. We are blessed with acts that cross all barriers of language and nationality. The meeting produced an atmosphere of real unanimity among the almost 100 worldwide executives involved."

Conference host Joe Kiener said, "This meeting has demonstrated unequivocally how well RCA/Ariola has come together as an international family within one year following formation of the joint venture. This is the place to be for artists."

Ellis To Organize BPI Awards

Don Ellis, former managing director of RCA and MCA Records in the UK, has been appointed to co-ordinate next year's British Record Industry Awards, set for February 9th in London's Grosvenor House Hotel.

Regarded as one of the UK industry's most successful innovators, the Awards show was produced in its first two years by artist manager and record producer Deke Arlon. Broadcast live in Britain, the 1986 event was seen by an estimated 100 million to viewers worldwide, and has since been shown

in the US, Australia and elsewhere. 1986 award winners included Tears For Fears, Annie Lennox, Dire Straits, Huey Lewis and Go West, and in the week after the show sales of key albums like Phil Collins' 'No Jacket Required', Dire Straits' 'Brothers In Arms' and Nigel Kennedy's recording of Elgar violin concertos received a 100,000 unit boost.

Borvo Leads RMC Into Privatization

The Sofiraad, the French state society for broadcasting, has announced the appointment of a new 'director general', (station director) for the Monte Carlo (RMC), Pierrick Borvo. Borvo has taken over from Jean Pierre

Hoss, the previous station director as appointed by Fabius' government in January '85. Borvo will lead RMC into privatization within the next 6 months. This transition period is needed as Sofiraad, the majority owners of the radio stations (83% of the capital) stated that a timetable was a technical and political necessity.

Pierrick Borvo's mission, says a Sofiraad spokesman, will be "to increase the potential and the chances of development of the station, whilst laying out new conditions of management." One of Borvo's priorities will be the sale of Tele Monte Carlo which is currently losing 3 million francs a month.

As for the sale of Radio Monte Carlo, this will be a long and delicate process. The disengagement of the Sofiraad needs the initial consent of the Monaco state, co-shareholders of RMC. However, negotiations have not yet begun between the French and Monaco states beyond the meeting between Francois Leonard, cabinet minister, and Prince Ranier of Monaco. This will be followed with a visit by the French prime minister Chirac

Dire Straits & A-Ha Winning MTV Award's Animation Comes Up Trumps

The 1986 MTV Video Music Awards gala was telecast live from the Palladium in New York and the Universal Studio in Hollywood on September 5th. During the presentation there were additional satellite pick-ups from various locations around the world including a London and Rotterdam, thereby enabling Rod Stewart to announce several of the finalists from the stadium in Rotterdam.

The Norwegian band A-Ha received most nominations, collecting seven awards for their clip to "Take On Me," for "best editing," "best director" and "most experimental video." The man winner was Dire Straits whose "Money For Nothing" received the prize for "best video of the year," whilst the group was nominated as "best band." Significantly both clips used modern computer animation techniques and both were directed by Steve Barron.

Whitney Houston was voted "best

female artist", Robert Palmer "best male artist", and Tina Turner and Bryan Adams received the prize for "best stage performance" for their clip to "It's Only Love." David Bowie and Mick Jagger were named "best over all performers" for "Dance In The Street". Prince was given the prize for "best choreographer" for "Raspberry Beret", and Madonna received a special prize of honour.

Numerous artists performed live at the spectacular gala including a Phil Collins, Madonna, Talking Heads, Tina Turner, Sting, Billie Jean King and Grace Jones. The performance of The Monkeys, who reached considerable fame in the 60s, was memorable when for the occasion they sang a selection of their old songs such as "I'm A Believer". The only video clip to be screened on the night was the world premiere of "Psychedelic Furs' "Pretty In Pink" and Motley Crew's "Home Sweet Home".

Picture Music Int. have released a 90-minute video entitled "The Real Buddy Holly Story", an expanded version of a documentary shown on BBC 2 last year. It now includes commentaries by Paul McCartney and are footage of Holly. The package is embellished with two audio cassettes featuring 28 of Buddy's best known songs as well as an American style car numberplate to commemorate what would have been Buddy's 50th birthday, September 7th 1986. The video contains shots of Keith Richards & The Everly Brothers speaking of their affection for Buddy's music, original Crickets Sony Curtis, Jerry Allison and Joe Mauldin plus the earliest known footage of Elvis Presley, on and off stage in Lubbock Texas in 1955.

Wayne Isham of video production Company, The Company, has just directed the clip to Bon Jovi's "You Give Love A Bad Name". Isham was previously responsible for "Psychedelic Furs' "Pretty In Pink" and Motley Crew's "Home Sweet Home". He has just completed post production on Howard Jones' longform "Last World I Dream" and is currently in post production on Journey's "Girl Can't Help It". Jay Rooney produced these last two clips.

At N. Lee Lacy Associates Ed Grills has just wrapped up the video to Huey Lewis & The News' "Stuck With You". Grills has directed clips for Sheena Easton and several for Cyndi Lauper, a.o. "She Boy", "True Colours" and "Time After Time" for which she won a MTV award for best director. * Peter Christopherson of Aubri Powell Productions has directed the clip to The "The's "Heartland". This is his second clip for The "The's. He previously directed the "infected" song and he has also worked for ELO, Gemini and The Firm as well as directing commercials. The "The's Matt Johnson is currently in Bolivia and Peru shooting a video album.

CLT Bids For La 5

Claude Lemoine, former director general of FR3, has been given the responsibility for pushing forward the Compagnie Luxembourgeoise de Television (CLT) as a prime candidate for the private French TV channel, La

Cinq. In order to comply with the French law which stipulates that foreigners may not possess more than 20% of the capital of the French channel, Lemoine stressed that the company would be a 'French company'.

Austrians In Favour Of Private TV

Following a survey conducted by the opinion research institute IMAS, 59% of the Austrians are in favour of private TV existing alongside the national channel ORF. Only 17% were against. Especially people from an academic background, under 30 years of age and living in Vienna were especially positive in it.

Sky Inks Deal With City Council

UNITED KINGDOM

Communards have made it to the top with *Don't Leave Me This Way*, making it their first no. 1 in their relatively short time of existence. After only being charted for two weeks **Frankie Goes To Hollywood** rises two notches up to no. 4 and a very impressive climb for Dutch duo **M.C. Miller "G" & Deejay Sven** (6-23; also only charted for two weeks). **Cutting Crew's** *If I Stay I Die In Your Arms* rises 6 notches to no. 8, and other good moves for **Cameo's** *Word Up* (13-28), American **Adidas** rap trio **Run DMC** who are breaking all over Europe currently with *Walk This Way* (15-37) and **Peché Moelle** Paris's *Pretty In Pink* from the A&M OST of the same name. **Samantha Fox's** third single from her "Touch Me" album, *Hold On Tight* rises 13 notches to no. 26 and **Michael McDonald's** *Sweet Freedom* from the motion picture *Running Scared* rises to 27 from 41. Five Star's latest single *Rain Or Shine* is highest new entry. It is the third single from their "Silk Or Steel" album which looks as if it might well follow in the footsteps of their previous LP, *Luxury of Life*, which had no less than 7 out of the 10 tracks released.

GERMANY

An unchanged top 3 in Germany consisting of **M.C. Miller "G" & Deejay Sven**, **Level 42** and **Trio Rio**. Moving up into the top 10 are **Chris De Burgh** and **Frankie Goes To Hollywood** and very good moves for **Human League's** *Human* (14-39) and **Hollywood Beyond's** *The Colour Of Money* (35-50). **Hollywood Beyond** already have a second single released which has entered in the English charts entitled *No More Tears*, produced by Stephen Hague of Pet Shop Boys fame. Highest new entry for **Kenny Loggins' Danger Zone** from the OST to the feature film *Top Gun*. The LP *Top Gun* moves up to the no. 1 position of the German album charts this week and the soundtrack is doing very well in the whole of Europe. **Kenny Loggins' Danger Zone** was written and produced by Giorgio Moroder and Tom Whitlock who also wrote and produced *Berlin's* *Take My Breath Away*, currently breaking all over Europe and at the moment no. 1 in the Billboard charts. Other new entries for ex-Chicago singer **Peter Cetera** with *Glory Of Love* and the local **Drafti** **Deutscher** with *Am Herz Geführt*.

FRANCE

Images persist at the top with *Les Demons De Minuit* followed by another solid French stayer **Gold** with *Willy De L'Amour*. Other local acts doing well are **Indochine** with *Tex Tex Nairs*, **Jaki Quartz** with *Vivre Ailleurs* and **Bibi with J'Veux Pas Le Savoir (16-34). They took longer to make it in France than in most other countries, but Dutch duo **M.C. Miller "G" & Deejay Sven** have finally entered in France this week at 23. Other entries for Miami Sound Machine's *Bad Boy*, **Elli Medeiros** with *Tot Mon Toit* ("You My Roof") and **Carol Arnaud** with *C'Est Pas Facile*.**

HOLLAND

UB40's *Sing Our Own Song* holds at no. 1 for the fourth consecutive week, but several songs are creeping their way up into the Top 10 as possible future contenders. These include **Bruce Hornsby & The Range's** *The Way It Is* (3-7), Swedish group **Europe** with *The Final Countdown* (6-13) and **Boris Gardiner's** *I Want To Wake Up With You* (9-16). Other good moves for **BZN** with *La France* (15-21) and **Hollywood Beyond's** *What's The Colour Of Money* (20-39). Highest debuting single for **Run DMC** and in line with most countries in Europe **Frankie Goes To Hollywood** enters with *Rage Heats*. Other entries for **Stan Ridgway**, **Her Goede Doel** and **Gwen Guthrie**.

BELGIUM

French act **Images** replaces **M.C. Miller "G" & Deejay Sven** from the top. After only being charted for two weeks **Frankie Goes To Hollywood** zooms up to no. 7 rising 20 notches and also climbing fast are **Sandra Kim's** *J'Aime La Vie* (21-35; her Eurovision Song winner has already been charted for 23 weeks and is continuously oscillating in the Belgium charts). Swedish group **Europe** (22-42) and **Boris Gardiner's** *I Want To Wake Up With You* (28-49) are also rising steadily. **Peter Cetera's** *Glory Of Love* is highest debuting single at 23 and French act **Les Avions** enters with *Watt, Sauvage*, as do **Will Tura** with *Oh Oh Madonna* and **Eurythmics** with *Thorn In My Side*.

IRELAND

Boris Gardiner remains at 1, but **Peter Cetera** jumps one notch to reach no. 2 and **Communards** jump 6 notches to reach no. 3 with *Don't Leave Me*

This Way. Another possible contender are **Frankie Goes To Hollywood** with an impressive jump to 5 from 28. More steady climbs for **Bruce Hornsby & The Range** (8-17) and **Janet Jackson** (14-24). **Talking Heads'** latest single *Wild Wild Life* is highest debuting single and other new entries for **Light A Big Fire** with *Charlene*, **Michael McDonald's** *Sweet Freedom* and **Iron Maiden's** *Hazed Years*.

SPAIN

As from this week, M&M will be using the official Spanish IFPI charts for the compilation for the European Hot 100 singles and albums and for the highlights page.

Wax remains at 1 with *Right Between The Eyes* followed by **Angel's** *Dancing In Paris* and local duo **Victor Manuel & Ana Belen** with *La Paqueta De Alcalá* (3-13). **Spandau Ballet** makes an impressive jump from 23 to 5 with *Fight For Ourselves* and also doing well in the Spanish charts are **Madonna** with *Papa Don't Preach* (16-19), **Queen** with *A Kind Of Magic* (11-21) and local artist **Ivan** with *Hey Mademoiselle* (12-25). Dutch duo **M.C. Miller "G" & Deejay Sven** seem to have made it in just about every country now: they are this week's highest entry in Spain at 15 with *Holiday Rap*. Italian singer **Eros Ramazzotti** enters as well with *Emozione Dopo Emozione*.


ITALY

Carefully Planned Campaign Should Break Tina All Over

1987 Sees The Queen Of Rock Touring Europe

by Machgiel Bakker

A very concentrated and carefully orchestrated European marketing campaign on Tina Turner's new album, 'Break Every Rule', should result in massive media and consumer response. The extensive campaign is scheduled to last till next July, most probably the closing date of a European tour. "Although everything is still subject to confirmation, we will definitely get Tina into Europe next year," explains Heine Henn, director European operations Caprio/EMI America/Manhattan. "We have set up an elaborate campaign in which everything, from single release dates and video scripts till marketing and promoters has been set up well in advance. And although release dates may vary from country to country, depending on the individual market needs, marketing and merchandising

materials are embodied in a year long strategy."

Currently Tina is in the middle of an extensive promotion tour through Europe, which started September 10th in London for a Top Of The Pop's recording. Further promotion work will bring her to Amsterdam (September 16th), recording for Veronica 'Countdown', Zurich (September 19th, 'Musicland'), Copenhagen (September 21st for a tv recording, with Joergen Mylius), a three day stint in Madrid (September 22-24, doing three tv shows: 'Tocata', 'Entre Amigos' and 'Informe Semanal'), Paris (September 25-26: Champs Elysees and the Patrick Sabatier show), Munich (September 27th: 'Western Mail'), Vienna the next day for three tv shows ('Music Scene', 'Brue Maultkorb', 'Die Grosse 10'), 'On-



sels on September 29th for 'Bingo', October 4 in Rome for 'Fantastico' and 'Donnicina In', Amsterdam for the Dutch record event 'Platen 10-daagse' on October 13th, Munich October 18th for 'Via So Wax', and finishing in Stockholm October 29th for 'Jacobs Ladder'. Two other European promotion tours will follow.

For Tina's new album Grammy-winning songwriters Terry Britten and Graham Lyle have contributed five tracks including 'Typical Male', 'What You Get Is What You See', 'Two People', 'Afterglow' (featuring Steve Winwood on synthesizer) and 'Till The Right Man Comes Along'. Other contributing songwriters include Bryan Adams/Jim Vallance ('Back Where You Started'), David Bowie ('Girls'), Paul Brady ('Paradise Is Now') and Mark Knopfler ('Overnight Sensation'). Producers include

Terry Britten, Bryan Adams/Rob Clearmountain, Rupert Hine and Mark Knopfler.


An impressive list of special merchandising material has been developed, tailored to suit the needs of each individual country. The company did an extensive advertising teaser campaign to anticipate the album release last week (September 5th). The release of the album and upcoming singles will be further supported by fly posters, special Tina Turner wallpaper for window and in-store display, three different sorts of adhesive window streamers, counter single display, 3-D album centre piece, four different logo boards, special shirts, press kits, biographies, sales folders and single picture discs. A tv campaign combined with radio spots will follow later.

New Talking Heads LP Sparks Off Side Projects

The Many Different Stories Of David Byrne

The release of the new Talking Heads' album, 'True Stories' (September 15th), marks another unique step in the band's recording career, that started nine years ago with their debut album '77'. The band has grown from a typical cult band to a band with a huge amount of followers and many successful albums. During their nine years of existence, the band has sparked off many solo recordings and

interesting side projects. In the same vein, 'True Stories' is not only the name of the new album but also of a forthcoming film, soundtrack and book. Roel Kruize, director A&R and marketing for EMI Music, explains: "The film 'True Stories' is directed (and narrated) by David Byrne and it uses the same songs as featured on the album though sung by the main characters of the film. Most of the ac-

tors are obviously not very experienced singers and this whole process of re-recording the songs as they originally appear on the album, is coached by Byrne. So, although the soundtrack features the same songs, they sound completely different from the album versions.

The release of the soundtrack in Europe will be dependent on the premiere dates of the film in the European box offices. Renowned to be a cult film, 'True Stories' will be released in the USA in October. Along-side with the film, the book 'True Stories' will appear containing sketches and the script of the movie.

The album features nine new tracks, all written by Byrne and full track listing is as follows: 'Love For Sale', 'Puzzlin' Evidence', 'Hey Now', 'Papa Legba' (based on a character from the Voodoo culture in Hawaii), 'Wild Wild Live', 'Radio Head', 'Dream Operator', 'People Like Us' and 'City Of Dreams'. The album will be a continuation of the 'Little Creatures' LP; catchy songs, amusing lyrics and a display of different sorts of musical styles. Just like the film, the LP forms a collage of songs highlighting the day-to-day life in the American countryside. Byrne tries his hand at c&w, cajun, pop and even some inclinations towards hard rock.

While the B-side of the single is special, as it contains the soundtrack version of 'People Like Us', the CD version of the LP will contain an extra remix of 'Wild Wild Live'. Most probably, David Byrne will undertake a couple of European promo dates in October.


Major European Support Tour In The Making

"The album really displays her versatility and we are all very excited about the LP," says Mark Collen, A&M marketing manager Europe.

"At the moment there are talks about a major support tour in October/November to take place in Germany, Benelux and parts of Scandinavia. Marti loves Europe and had a very good reception upon her first European promo tour (see also exclusive interviews with the artist in M&M No. 11, earlier this year edition). She was very much impressed by the climate here and she loves to come back. We will set up a full marketing in-store campaign and I am thinking of sending out a promotion sampler with four tracks, all emphasizing different sides of Marti's talent."

A&M will release a single as well, entitled 'Chance Of A Lifetime', a very melodic poppy tune with Beatles-esque backing vocals.

While the **Top Gun** Soundtrack is breaking into Europe (no. 24 in the Hot 100 Albums), the love theme of the film, **Take My Breath Away** by Gelfin recording artists **Berlin** is entering the lower half of the European Airplay Top 50 this week. Produced by Giorgio Moroder, it is a moodily mid-tempo ballad which will undoubtedly get a new boost next week.

Another Record Of The Week for the return of Pete Burns and his **Dead Or Alive** project. The "brand new" single, **Brand New Lover** is produced by the in-demand team of Stock, Aitken and Waterman who just helped Bananarama to their first hit in the US with "Venus". The single is less cant and tail wiggling than his '84 hit singles **Tha's The Way** and **You Spin Me Round** but will be assured of airplay with its economic and easily digestible production.

One of the hottest import dance records is by **The Timex Social Club**, abbreviated to **The Social Club**, to avoid legal hassles, following an injunction served by the Timex Watch Corporation for illegal use of their name. The single (remixed for Shep Pettibone) is worth your attention with its down to the bone rhythms and vocals resulting in a hot and catchy groove; a no. 1 Black Charting single in the US, a new entry in the English charts and the Continent is sure to follow!

Shep Pettibone also remixed the new **BB & Q** single (*Ifn A*) **Dreamer**. The track is taken from their 1985 album "Genie" and could do well with its succinct harmonies and smooth production.

Another hot dance record happening in the UK comes from **Chairman Of The Board** featuring General Johnson with the very soulful **Loverboy**. In the northern discos of the UK, the single proved to be highly popular in '84 and now gets a remix by Style Council's Paul Weller. The single has a typical sixties sound and could cross over to the general pop charts.

More US disco releases that might pick-up good reactions in Europe include **Levert** who are currently riding the Billboard black Hot 100 with (*Pop, Pop, Pop, Pop*) **Goes My Mind**. A wonderful love ballad, out on Atlantic with very good chances of breaking in Europe.

10 Records release a single by **Mancra**, enti-

led **Fish For Life**, a song featured on the original soundtrack of the soon-to-be-released film **Karate Kid** part 2. The song was co-written and produced by Ian Stanley, (a keyboard player and one of the writers for Tears For Fears) and Roland Orzabal, another TFF member. A definite sure shot for your playlist!

Madonna breaks yet another record this week by keeping her **Papa Don't Preach** for the 8th consecutive week at the top spot of the Hot 100 singles. Together with her earlier single **Live To Tell**, also for 8 weeks at no. 1, this is the longest no. 1 runner of this year. Only **Survivor** came very close with the seven weeks chart topper **Burning Heart**.

While Madonna is at 1, clones are ready to take over the throne. **Duch** duo **M.C. Mikler "G" &**

Deejay Sven take their **Holiday Rap** to the second spot of the Hot 100 this week by having top 10 in the UK, Germany, Belgium, Norway, Finland and Holland and top 20 positions in France and Spain. For those who love statistics (we do!), this makes **Holiday Rap** the most successful continental European production of the year, dismissing **A-Ha's Take On Me** as this was an English production. **Frankie** **Rages Hard** into top 10 (5-11), only in its second week's and **Human League** enter top 10 as well (10-18).

Coinciding with the release of their new album "Fore!", **Huey Lewis & The News** top the European Airplay Top 50 this week. On all European radio formats it is the most added single and it marks the first time that the American formation hits the top of the European Airplay Top 50.

STOP PRESS

What happened to **Paul McCartney**, nobody knows. On his latest album, *Press To Play*, he sounds more vital than ever and there is a definite urge to hit the grooves. With 6 out of the 10 songs co-written with BCC member Eric Stewart and with heavyweights such as Phil Collins, Jerry Marotta and Pete Townshend, plus the stellar production of Hugh Padgham, Paul comes up with one of the better LP's out of the 15 that has produced since the Beatles split up. Songs like *De-gry*, *Move Over Bunker* and *Talk More Talk* have more punch and bite than many of his earlier recordings. The LP debuts this week at no. 20.

Eddy Grant used to have hits with "I Don't Wanna Dance", "Can't Get Enough From You" and "Do You Feel My Love". Some time ago he moved from his London studios to the Barbados and listening to his latest album *Born Tuff*, one can surely tell he loves spending his time in the sun. Optimistic and agreeable party music with Caribbean, South-American and contemporary disco influences. We love the cheerful and uncomplicated atmosphere of *Dance Party*, with Tom Bailey and Allannah Curry of Thompson Twins fame doing backing vocals, as well as the tropical *Willage Life* and the up-tempo pop song *Blood Money* with its engaged lyrics. Especially "Blood Money" and "Dance Party" are good single candidates, able to attract good airplay reaction in Europe.

As you might have read on page 9 of the outstanding vocalist **Marti Jones** has teamed up again with producer Don Dixon for her second A&M album *Match Game*. The two definitely form a winning combination and everything from songwriting, sound, session musicians and overall arrange-

ments just click. It maintains a perfect balance between up-tempo, catchy pop radio formatted songs and the more moody and vulnerable tracks. In the former category we recommend *Chance Of A Lifetime* and *It's Too Late* while in the latter (and that's where we love her the most), there is the breathtaking beauty of *Touch Tone* and *Crazier*. One of those albums that you go after each play and we think European radio should give her all the support she deserves.




On her second album for EMI, *Breaking Away*, **Jaki Graham** continues her partnership with Derek Bramble who, apart from producing all her hit records, (e.g. "Could It Be I'm Falling In Love", "Round And Around", "Mated"), also wrote 8 of the 10 songs on this album, while the other two were co-written with David Grant and Alan Gorrie of Average White Band fame. New tracks on the album worth checking include *The Love Of Your Life*, *The Closest One* and the romantic *Sil In Love*.

The Canadian singer/songwriter **Bruce Cockburn**, despite a very long recording career, still has a relatively low profile in Europe. His folksy rock style is extremely popular in Canada as well as in the US where he did some successful tours. His latest LP for Revolver Records, *World Of Wonders* displays his unique style of songwriting with the personal lyrics and the fine arrangements.

First reports on the new **Tina Turner** album, *Break Every Rule* are beginning to pour in and tracks like *Tell The Right Man Comes Along*, *After Glow* (yet two other Britten/Lytle hit singles), and *Back Where You Started* (a powerful rock track by Bryan Adams and Jim Vallance) are getting favourable reception.

years in the joint venture with RCA. Through this agreement, Bertelsmann and RCA own equal shares of Arista in the US. RCA owns 75% of Arista International, and Bertelsmann has a 51% stake in Arista in Germany, Austria and Switzerland, with RCA holding 49% of the share.

The bid is widely seen as reflecting Bertelsmann's determination to secure US programming for its multimedia outlets. Some weeks ago, Dr. Woessner revealed that Bertelsmann was planning an investment of more than \$600 million in the US media market, including television programming and radio syndication. The group is looking for acquisitions in the printing, publishing, television and TV production areas, and is still negotiating to buy the book publishing operation Doubleday & Co.

In Europe, Bertelsmann is building up its interest in radio stations and has a 25% plus stake in Radio TeleLuxembourg.

One of the few major German companies to have built its profitability consistently over the last few years,

Bertelsmann, with a profit of nearly \$300 million last year, has earmarked substantial sums for investment. The acquisition of RCA would mean that Bertelsmann's multimedia operations in the United States, there will be controlled out of Europe.

The RCA/Arista record companies, music publishers and video operations are established in 18 countries.

RTL will be celebrating its 50th Dornverleihung on October 11th in Dortmund. The yearly festival gives the gold, silver and bronze 'Lion Award' for the most played records over the year on RTL Radio. aim is to further the causes of local television. Currently the only money that comes by the City Council is that from pay-TV whereas they have long stipulated that cable providers such as Sky Channel and Music Box should also be charged a basic carriage fee in order to enter the cable network.

The financing of the new institute is coming from Sky Channel which has pledged a loan of 2 million guilders together with the free use of their facilities at the Rembrandtplein studio complex here in Amsterdam. It is understood that the Institute is expected to find its own headquarters as soon as they are fully established, but Sky has guaranteed financial assistance until the end of 1987.

In exchange, the Institute has agreed to postpone any decisions affecting Sky Channel until the end of 1989. A council spokesman said that they preferred not to enter into local agreements with the cable station and that it was in the interests of Amsterdam to have Sky remain. The situation obviously pushes aside likely problems of admission onto the Dutch network.

Negotiations are currently underway with Music Box and a final decision is expected very soon.
