New German Radio **Competes With NDR**

Private Station Attracks 10% More Listeners by Wolfgang Spahr

Kiel-based private radio station Radio Schleswig Holstein is providing stiff competition for public broadcasting rival Norddeutscher Rundfunk in the north of West Germany. Launched July 1st this year, the music-only service has already overtaken NDR's three channels in terms of overall listenership.

A survey for the first two weeks of August shows RSH with a rating of 41% among listeners aged 14-41, compared with 40% for NDR 2, 13% for

NDR 1 and only 3% for NDR 3. RSH programme director Hermann Stumpert, formerly with Saarlandischer Rundfunk, claims market research indicates the private station has on average 10% more listeners than NDR 2.

However, NDR chiefs are refusing to panic. Director Hermann Rauker says the results reflect the extensive launch campaign undertaken by RSH's newspaper owners, and the fact that music-only broadcasting is a nov-



Rome- At the 1st European Conference of Independent Video Producers held September 12-14, representatives from ten European countries including Britain, West Germany, France, Holland and Spain met to discuss the problems and opportunities of Euronean co-production and distribution.

Separate sessions were held on the relationship between independent video producers and national tv broadcasters, on legal aspects of video and music copyright, and on the current state of Europe's tv and video markets. Organized by Eurocreation, the

French agency for European projects, the conference's main aim was to come up with concrete ideas and proposals for co-operative video production on the European level. As Eurocreation's director of projects Anne-Marie Autissier explained however: "In order to set up fruitful collaboration in this area we must first analyse each market in terms of its creative potential and the copyright and neighbouring rights problems involving audio-visual material. Only then can these meetings become a true platform for a pan-European dialogue."

The conference provided a useful opportunity for independent producers to present their material and put forward their ideas for co-operation with national broadcasters, but concrete suggestions as to how this might be done were less easy to come up with. The desire for European coproduction was clear but there was little agreement on how to go about it.

Most speakers stressed the role of the record companies. Vincent Lamy, the former FR3 producer now head of his own RIFF company, presented a co-production made with the backing of French company Barclay which he said could compete successfully with Anglo-Saxon material, but Jose Luis Lozano of ISIS noted that in Spain: 'Most of the record companies don't seem to be used to the idea of the promotional value of the video clip." And he added: "Without their investment we will never really be able to deliver quality programmes that can compete with the rest of Europe."

If there are difficulties with local collaboration, the problems of European collaboration are even greater. Music Box programme director Rob Jones stated: "We would love to play more music from continental Europe. but sometimes it is simply not made available to us. For instance the latest video by French band Gold, a million seller in France, was never cleared for

Jones nevertheless emphasized Music Box/Superchannel's commitment to Europe and urged independent producers to come up with material on their local bands. Britain's long dominance of pop music had tended to make it a little chauvinistic

German Saturn Store Celebrates 25th

Cologne- The German record store Saturn celebrated its 25th anniversary last week (September 27th). With 10,000 different titles, it is the biggest compact disc store in the world and there are 100,000 analogue records and cassettes on the shelf. The video department takes up 3,000 square metres and with its yearly turn-over of \$ 100 million it is the biggest store for

entertainment electronics and sound carriers in the world. Founded in 1961 by Wilhelm and Anny Waffenschmidt on a 120 square metres, the record store quickly developed into one of the trendsetting

stores in Europe and in 1984 the store was sold to the Tertia Management Company in Cologne, which in turn is part of the Kaufhof Department Store chain which opened its other two stores in Germany, one in Hannover and one in Munich

The anniversary will be celebrated with special customer activities in Cologne until October Ilth. Wilhelm Waffenschmidt, the founder says: "Saturn now, 25 years after we started, presents itself as a technical store full of superlatives, unparalleled anywhere in the world."

EEC Proposals At Brussels TV Conference

Club De Brussels Meeting Mid October

Brussels- The future of the European television industry will be discussed in a two day conference in Brussels on October 15-16, organised by the "Club De Bruxelles". Top representatives from industry and television networks will discuss EEC proposals concerning the audio-visual sector in the EEC The communication, advertising and audi-visual industries and government bodies will be represented and the debates will be covered by a large gathering of international press.

The first day of the conference will concentrate on the industry and the role of the EEC. In a debate entitled What is at stake for the European industry?', the strong and weak points of the consumer electronics industry in Europe will be explored, together with the relationship between new products and new services, and future prospects for European companies in the various sectors of the audio-visual industry. The European-Japanese conflict over High Definition Television in the aftermath of the Dubrovnik conference will be tackled, and further debates include ones on cable and satellite and on research programmes

by Cathy Inglis connected to the promotion and financing of European telecommuni-

> cations and electronics industries. A debate entitled 'Is EEC legislation an essential prerequisite for television without frontiers?' will kick off the second day. Questions will be raised and answered concerning deregulation, the controversial problem of copyright, television advertising in Europe and promoting an actual cultural identity for Europe. The future of multi-lingual channels and the relationship between state television bodies and private international groups will also be high on the agenda.

Speakers will be coming from as far afield as the States and Japan, but will mainly be Europeans. These include a.o. Lord Cockfield, vicepresident EEC Commission, Michele Cotta, president Haute Autorite de l'Audiovisuel France, Patrick Cox, md Sky Channel Hans van der Werf president Europa TV Hilversum. Massimo Fichera, md RAI in Italy, Silvio Berlusconi, president of Finnivest, as well as representatives from Philips RTL and ARC

Major UK Video Campaign Aiming At Rental Market

The UK video industry's biggest ever coverage will preside over a multipromotional campaign gets under way later this autumn, when the CBS/Fox, Embassy and Medusa labels start given away holiday discount vouchers with every cassette rented.

Running from November to January 1987, the campaign is valued at up to 90 million dollars. Robert Maxwell's Mirror Group Newspapers is also involved, and besides offering its own vouchers and saturation press million dollar tv advertising blitz. CBS/Fox chief Stewart Till describes the campaign, which will give heavy renters savings of up to 300 dol-

lars on 1987 package holidays, as "massive incentive to encourage rentals". Only 30% of UK VCR owners rent regularly, he adds, so this one campaign could in theory increase the rental market by as much as two-thirds

The DJM catalogue contains 14,000 titles, including pop classics like 'Billy Don't Be A Hero', 'I'd Like To Teach The World To Sing' and 'Don't Let The Sun Catch You Crying', plus the Lennon/McCartney songs 'Please Please Me' and 'Ask Me Why' and the Elton John material which includes 150 John/Bernie Taupin items PolyGram is also acquiring DJM

Records Ltd., which holds 14 Elton John albums made during the late 1960s and early 1970s. When the intention of selling DJM was first conceived. Dick James (the founder, who died early this year) and his son Stephen started the Dejamus group of music companies and all new writers and acquisitions have been signed to the UK or US operations under that

In 1962, Dick James set up Northern Songs specifically to handle Lennon & McCartney songs - the firm was later bought by Associated Television, and last year the Beatles' duo material was bought by Michael Jackson. James built his second pop fortune when he signed the John/Taupin team in 1967

In another major acquisition in London, the Chrysalis Group has bought Ensign, with its track record of more than 30 hit singles and albums. The label, founded by Nigel Grainge a decade ago, achieved an average of one Top 30 single to every three/four releases. It had nine hit singles and three major albums from Bob Geldof's Boomtown Rats



CBS Campaigns Shoot Top Gun To Top OST In Europe

CBS's OST to the feature film 'Top Gun' is taking Europe by storm. Both movie and soundtrack have exploded. with more than a quarter of a million albums sold in the last four weeks. Two singles have so far been released from the soundtrack, Kenny Loggins' 'Danger Zone' and the love theme from Top Gun, 'Take My Breath Away' performed by Berlin. Both were produced by Giorgio Moroder and both are breaking throughout Europe. Other groups featured on the soundtrack are Loverboy (Heaven In Your Eyes), Cheap Trick (Mighty Wings) and Miami Sound Machine (Hot Summer Nights).

The success of the OST is largely due to conserted marketing strategies which were coordinated by CBS at a very early stage with each UIP local office using the cinema as the point of promotion. Paul Berger, director marketing and sales Europe.comments: "It is an absolute explosion especially in view of the fact that the album has only effectively been marketed for one month. This is a prime example of what the cooperation of music in movies can do when it comes to cross-merchandising." The whole of Europe is actively

involved in the campaign. In Finland for example 25,000 discount notes for the album were printed for movie ticket buyers; in the Netherlands the video to Berlin's song is currently showing in 20 theatres; in France Kenny Loggins' video was broadcast in 150 cinemas four weeks prior to the movie opening and similar publicity took place in Germany. A vast nationwide marketing campaign was set up in Germany where 100,000 colour handflyers with consumer competitions advertising both the movie and the In were printed up front and distributed in cinemas and record stores Following this, the OST last week hit no. I of the German charts.





opening in France. Merchandising materials in each country were produced in cooperation with UIP and each single bears the album graphics. In addition numerous gimmicks such as pins and caps were

used to stimulate interest. The film has now opened in every country in Europe with only the UK, France and Italy scheduled to open this coming week. In only a short time since the release of the album, the OST has reached no. 1 in Germany and Switzerland, no. 3 in Finland, no. 6 in Sweden, no. 9 in Norway, 34 in Holland and 35 in Denmark. In Germany alone 120,000 copies of the alhum have been sold with on average 50,000 to 60,000 sales occuring each week. A total figure of 180,000 albums have been sold in Europe excluding the UK. At presstime the LP was 24 in the European Hot 100 Albums.

It looks more than likely that the association between the film and the record company will be as profitable as it was in the States, where the Paramount movie netted 119.1 million dollars at the box office. The OST reached no. 1 of the American Album Chart, became platinum record, and produced two number I hits on the Hot 100 Singles Chart, both Kenny Loggins' 'Danger Zone' and Berlin's 'Take My Breath Away'. Rocky was an immensely successful CBS soundtrack. Top Gun is following suit. and Berger says the company is looking forward to their next promising OST, 'Ruthless People' which will be out early December and will feature songs from a.o. Mike Jagger and Billy

Due to the fast changing nature of radio playlists, it doesn't happen too often that artists remain at the top of the European Airplay Top 50 for a number of weeks. The longest Airplay runners so far are A-Ha whose The Sun Always Shines On TV remained three consecutive weeks on the top, Bowie with Absolute Beginners (5 weeks), two records of Madonna: Live To Tell (4 weeks) and Pana Don't Preach (reaching the longest string of consecutive no. I's: 6 weeks) and Genesis' Invisible Touch (4 weeks). With Huey Lewis being 'stuck' for the third week at no. 1 in the European Airplay, it marks the second time this year that an American act is able to remain that long on the top.

The difference with Bruce Hornby's The Way It Is is still considerable and the band keeps on struggling to reach the top and sticks already for the 3rd week at no. 2. Further stiff competition comes from Tina Turner (who shoots up from 5 to 3), as well as from the continued airplay on Holiday Rap.

Two Harris/Lewis produced records shoot up the European Airplay as both Human League's Human (6-8) as well as Janet Jackson's When I Think Of You (18-21) move up with a bullet this week. Another successful and in demand team of producers are Stock, Aitken & Waterman who where responsible for the US no. 1 hit Venus by Bananarama (still no. 20 in the European Airplay) as well as providing successful hit productions for Princess, O'chi Brown, Dead Or Alive (Brand New Lover- 41 in the Airplay Top 50) and Brilliant. They were also at the knobs for a production for Rocket (Elton John's record company), helping to launch the dance club trio Splash with their debut single Qu'est Ce Que C'est?, a commercial and bubbling pop/dance track.

Hugh Padgham has two (co-)produced singles in the European Airplay Top 50 as well; while Genesis are still at 33 with In Too Deep, Paul Young has second highest entry this week with Wonderland. This demure ballad comes from his third album 'Between Two Fires', slated for an October release (for more details see last weeks Spotlight page). If Paul McCartney's 'Press To Play' was still in the European Airplay it would have made Padgham the most successful producer in the Airplay Top 50.

Madonna has already her third single from the 'True Blue' album released and the title track is this weeks highest entry in the Airplay top 50 at no. 24. It follows releases like 'Live To Tell', entering at 20 earlier this year and 'Papa Don't Preach', in at 39. Although True Blue is a very catchy Motown-like ditty, the best track from the LP is. we think, La Isla Bonita, a wonderful Mexican tinged poptune

Aretha Franklin comes up with a wonderful version of the Stones classic Jumpin' Jack Flash, produced by Keith Richards and also to be featured on the forthcoming 20th Century Fox Film Jumpin' Jack Flash, starring Whoopie Goldberg. It is one of Aretha's most raucous tracks ever and with backing musicians like Richards, Ron Wood, Chuck Leavell and Randy Jackson. Aretha's voice is irresistible, a killer track sure to pick up lots of

Stacey O is slowly getting tips in Europe with her Atlantic single Two Of Hearts; with its innocent poppy vocals over a memorable chorus the single is pretty much in the Madonna-type of style but having its own twists of originality.

Miami Vice star Don Johnson is getting first good reactions in Europe with Heartheat, a solid American rocker, catchy produced by Chaz Sanford. In the 70's Johnson wrote songs for the Allman Brothers Band including 'Eat A Piece' and 'Melissa'. On his album he gets help from luminaries like Willie Nelson, Ron Wood, Steve Ray Vaughan and Bonnie Raitt.

KING OF BLOOD

Blood And Chocolate is Elvis Costello's follow up to 'King Of America' and as such already his second outing of this year. Costello delivers songs one after the other and it is rather said that his unique individual style never really gets the commercial recognition it deserves. Unwilling to yield to commercial considerations, The Man delivers his songs this time with more bite and aggression than ever, not before witnessed since 'This Year's Model'. With all songs basically in a minimalistic and very sparse setting, the lp sports highlights such as Blue Chair, Crimes Of Paris, Home Is Anywhere You Hang Your Hat and the very intimate I Want You.

Helen Terry, once back-up singer for the Culture Club, comes up with a stunning debut album, the Don Was produced Blue Notes. With a voice that easily matches the range and intensity of singers like Alison Moyet and Sade, her material stretches from mainstream pop and soul to coctail jazz and r&b. Check out the glossy produced Come On And Find Me as well as Helen's moody rendition of the John Cale classic Close Watch. More suggestions for airplay include Right In Front Of You and Feelin' Your Heart.

Definitely the hottest album retail wise of this week is Cyndi Lauper's True Colors. The LP is the follow-up to the '83 worldwide platinum debut 'She's So Unusual', and Cyndi is now (together with Lennie Petze) herself at the knobs. With the help of cracks like Nile Rodgers, The Bangles, Billy Joel, Adrian Belew and Rick Derringer the album boasts several hit singles, once the succes of the title track has been faded out. It kicks off confidently with Change Of Heart, a danceable, poppy song featuring Nile Rodgers with his unmistakable

'elastic' guitar chords, followed by the doo-wop Maybe He'll Know and Boy Blue in which Cyndi is in terrific vocal form. Striking is Cyndi's cover of the Marvin Gaye 1970 all-time classic What's Going On with its good built up and atmosphere. This week's Albums Guide is full of female

singing artists; after Helen Terry and Cyndi Lauper. Gianna Nannini and Anna Domino release new LP's as well this week. Those of you who read M&M carefully are probably aware that we are big fans of the Italian singer Gianna Nannini and her latest Polydor album Profumo is another masterpiece. With a voice suited to please both the rock audiences as well as the lovers of the romantic and restrained pop material, Nannini has all the chances to break with tracks like Profumo ('The Smell Of You'), Come Una Schiava ('Like A Slave Girl') and Avventuriera ('Adventuress'). Wait for strong retail reaction in the GAS countries and hopefully Benelux and the UK to follow suit.

New Yorker Anna Domino has her self titled Polydor album produced by ex-Associates member Alan Rankine and Belgian musician/RTBF diproducer Marc Moulin. The result is a rich tapestry of hypnotic rhythms and brooding melodies. Recommended tracks include Summer (remix by Arthur Baker), Chosen Ones and Rythm.

The extensive European 'Revenge' tour of the Eurythmics is certainly paying off as the Revenge album moves to no. 2 this week, the highest position it reached sofar. Tina Turner 'breaks' into Top 10 (8-12) after her spectacular move of last week from 93 to 12.
