

5% Increase In Monetary Value

Despite unit sales being down in virtually all areas of the LP, cassette and singles sectors, the German record industry posted a 5% upturn in monetary value in the first half of this year

compared with the 1985 figures.
And compact disc sales action was
the prime reason. CD sales in Germany were up some 200% on the
January-June period of last year, according to figures from the German
Phono Association, which represents
99% of all domestic sales.

Aided by CD enthusiasm, the German industry has stabilised over the past couple of years, says association chairman Friedel Schmidt, also managing director of Ariola. Shortfall in CD software production will, he predicts, be overcome by the end of

this year, with another four CD plants set to go on stream, with more to follow in 1987

CD is the key source of optimism, says the association. First half sales of singles in Germany were 15.9 million units, down 10.2%, though maxisingle sales remained steady at 7.1 million. LPs sales weren't good; budget-priced sales down 20.7% to 7.3 million, and normal-priced product down 3.7% to 18.2 million.

Cassette sales were a shade better, by comparison. Bugglet cassettes were down just 1.9% to 15.5, standard price tapes down 8.3% to 4.4 million. And on the CD front, both pop sales and classical give a total CD sales figure of 4.6 million units in the first six months.

# Swiss Radio Band Folds Up

After 40 years of success, the SRG Radio Band is to disband at the end of the year. But the decision, from the director of the Swiss Broadcasting Assn. (SRG). Andreas Blum, comes as no real surprise to insiders.

A two-year experimental period to try to trim costs and find financial salvation for the band failed. It costs some \$ 1.5 million a year to run. The government-sponsored SRG network has a total operational budget of approximately \$ 30 million.

The problems for the Swiss government's stations have increased because of the competition from private broadcasting, which permits commercials on a restricted basis Now three musical directors and eight musicians will lose their jobs. The directors, Hans Moeckel, Cedric Dumont and Peter Jacques, have won wide acclaim for their work. The Syndicate of Swiss Media Workers says the SRG move is a "confession of cultural bankruptcy."

#### New Dutch Rock Label Founded

by Willem Hoos

Willem Jan van de Wetering, for six years general manager of the Dutch arm of French record company Carrere, has set up a new label to specialise in rock repertoire. He is also expanding into merchandising and book publishing.

First signing to Touch Down is Dutch veteran rocker Herman Brood and his band Wild Romance, with a debut single 'Weep' just out. Other names on the roster: One Fine Day, a new Dutch seven-piece band; new five-strong band The Dame, just out with an LP, a classically-slanted girl rock team, featured September 29th on a VARA half-hour TV special; the girl duo Bombitas, formerly with Wild Romance: and soon to be signed is Roberto Jacketti and The Scooters.

Carrere product is distributed by CNR in the Benelux. Van de Wetering has also set up Artist Merchandising, with an initial deal with Dutch girl disco trio Mai Tai, set to lend their name to cosmetic lines, and other major Dutch names will follow

Centaur Books, his publishing venture, is launched with investment from CNR president Willem van Kooten. Like Artist Merchandising and Carrere, it will be housed in CNR's Weesp headquarters. Reviewing WEA's performance in Europe, Loch said that while the overall turnover in the market was up by 5 percent thanks to CD the WFA growth factor had been of the order of Il percent, with a tally of 100 certified discs (double platinum, platinum, gold and silver) achieved in the first nine months of this year.

"This success is firstly due to the repertoire we received from our three American labels," Loch said, "espe cially Warner Bros. Our business with

product from the American companies has increased by 18 percent over last year." The UK had also been a tremendous source of talent over the

On the subject of promotion, Loch sounded a warning, pointing out that although it was an important element in marketing, it was only good as long as it helped to build artists and sell product. "Many come to us and ask for our repertoire free of charge because they feel they are promoting our products. I do not necessarily believe this. And we certainly have to charge for the use of our repertoire in such forms of media as cable television.

#### **Superchannel Promotes Dutch 'Cultural Capital'**

Amsterdam- At a recent press conference given by Superchannel and the City Council of Amsterdam, it was announced that Superchannel had agreed to contribute to the Cultural Capital Calender in 1987. Each year, one European city is nominated 'Cultural Capital' by the EEC to encourage European artistic activities and Amsterdam is the city chosen for 1987. Since Superchannel professes that its aim is to provide the premier English language television service for Europe, it is now offering help to local tv and radio programme makers for promotion and coverage events in the Cultural Capital Calender.

The cable network will also produce and transmit commercials relating to events within the calender and will provide pan-European transmission of salacted events

The Amsterdam cable operator. KTA, has separately confirmed that Music Box and Superchannel when it is launched, will continue to have a separate 24-hour channel on the Amsterdam cable networks until 1990. without any payment of carriage fees.

Charles Levinson, joint managing director of Superchannel/Music Box commented: "We at Superchannel strongly believe in the promotion of European cultural activities and in publishising each country's nation culture to all others in the European community."

#### MTV Shifts To New Programming

All labels emphasized the large amount of artists

that broke on a worldwide scale in '86. Tom Ruffino, vice-president international of Warner Bros presented the total worldsales based on the international royalty income, for Warner, European performances compared to 1985 showed a staggering 122.7% increase. Especially artists like A-Ha, Rod Stewart, Van Halen, ZZ Top, Prince and Madonna contributed to the overall success of WEA in 1986.

New Warner product included a new ballad by Sheila E. ('Touch Me'). the new Eric Clapton album 'Tearing Us Apart' produced by Phil Collins and featuring a duet with Tina Turner. and the new album of A-Ha entitled 'Scoundrel Days'. Fleetwood Mac have reunited for an album release in November and a track of that album, 'I Wanna Be With You Everywhere'. was highlighted. The new Madonna video 'Open Your Heart' had a world premiere at the WEA Roadshow and the rather explicit video with Madonna as the sexy dancer in a peepshow, was an unforgettable experience for some of the delegates.

Highlights of the Atlantic presentation included disco singer Stacey O who is picking up good media reactions with her single 'Two Of Hearts', metal outfit Ratt, Bad Company with a new single called 'This Love' and new material from Yes.

The hottest addition this week on European radio is Don't Stand So Close To Me, The Police's first single for three years. This Laurie Latham produced single is a re-recording of the old hit single and comes from the forthcoming album 'Every Breath You Take - The Singles', due out October 27. For those of you who can't get enough of this song, the 12" features, apart from the '86 version, a dance mix, a live version as well as the original version as it appeared on the 1980 album 'Zenyatta Mondatta'

Farley "Jackmaster" Funk's Love Can't Turn Around is beginning to get good reports from the continent, following its success in England. The disco single is second highest entry, following the Police debut at 37.

The Pet Shop Boys, the illustrious duo that put so much high energy and Italian disco into their material, have yet another single issued from their 'Please' album. Surburbia follows on the heels of hit singles like 'West End Girls', 'Opportunities' and 'Love Comes Quickly' and is new in the European Airplay Top 50 at 42 this week. On the B side of the single is the track Paninaro, a new song inspired by the Italian Paninari youth cult, featuring Chris Low rapping for the first time and produced by Pet Shop Boys. In Italy this track is released as a single. For the absolute Pet Shop Boys freaks there is also a 12" single consisting of Suburbia ('The Full Horror'-mix), 'Paninaro' and 'Jack The Lad', another new song produced by the

Other Airplay entries for Depeche Mode. German singer Sandra with her latest Hi! Hi! Hi! (from her forthcoming second album 'Mirrors'), and Kim Wilde.

Turning to the Hot 100 Singles, 4 new entries make up for a lively Top 10. While Holiday Rap sticks at no. 1 for the 4th consecutive week (together with A-Ha, the longest Continental top runner) and Rage Hard staying at 2 (the 2nd longplayer, Liverpool, out next week), Communards creep up to no. 3. Madonna could deliver her 3rd no. I hit in Europe as True Blue storms up the Hot 100 from 16 to 4, only in its second week! It is one of the fastest moving singles of this year, only equalled by the spectacular jumps earlier this year by Survivor's Burning Heart (from 19 to 4 in its

second week) and Stephanie's Ouragan (from 95 to II in its second week!).

Kim Wilde delivers her version of the Tamla-Motown classic You Keep Me Hangin' On, a single also to be found on her new album 'Another Step' released this week (see Albums Guide). Kim Wilde has a full European tour planned for October/December including concerts in Germany, Switzerland, Holland, Belgium, Scandinavia and France. An extensive European ty schedule is also

The farewell single of Wham!, Where Did Your Heart Go, is out this week and is getting the first tips of our correspondents although not in the same amount as used to be the case with other Wham! releases in the past.

The Stranglers come up with one of their most commercial singles for a long time, the Lou Reedlike Always The Sun, out on Epic this week.

Red Box release the follow up to last year's hit 'Lean On Me' entitled For America, Just like last year's hit it is a rather weird amalgam of different musical styles



With a truly glossy and futuristic album cover, the digital processing and Martin Birch's stellar production, the album brings the band back in the European Hot 100, as the album is this week's highest entry in the Hot 100 at no. 15.

Their second album Scoundrel Days is out this week and looking at the first reactions, it could follow the same course as the debut. Already the second best played album in Europe this week, it sees the band from a rougher edge and the band is suited to please both the older fans as well as bringing in new ones. Recommended: Scoundrel Days, Swing Of Things, Soft Rains Of April and The Weight Of The Wind.

Another new album, picking up considerable attention in its first week of release, is OMD's The Pacific Age. It is OMD's 7th album, following hit albums like 'Junk Culture' and 'Crush'. The duo, Andy McClusky and Paul Humpreys, (joined by four new bandmembers) have found their niche with their smooth and commercial brand of synthipop melodies tinged with elaborate symphonic arrangements. Best tracks include The Pacific Age, The Dead Girls and Goddess Of Love.

Kim Wilde releases her first album in two years entitled Another Step, the follow up to Teases And Dares'. The lp includes the recent hit 'Schoolgirl' as well as the title track performed with Junior. Also included is Say You Really Want Me, taken from the OST 'Running Scared'. With production credits shared by Richard James Burgess, Rod Temperton and Reinhold Heil (of Nenafame), the album is neatly divided in an up-tempo side and one filled with slower, moody ballads. Stand-outs include, I've Got So Much Love, Brothers and Missing.

Iggy Pop releases his debut album for A&M entitled Blah-Blah-Blah produced by David Bowie and David Richards. Featuring nine tracks of which five were co-written by Pop and Bowie. Although Iggy Pop still ventilates the 'angry young man' stance, the 'enfant terrible of rock' has softened his approach somewhat, especially through the inclusion of synthesizers in his music and several string arrangements. Nevertheless songs like Real Wild Child, Baby It Can't Fall and Cry For Love, still make him the punk rocker

We were always strong supporters of the Scottish band The Big Dish. Their first three singles, Big New Beginning, Prospect Street and Slide were long time favourites and as such heavily tipped in M&M. One by one, they all failed to make any impact, anywhere at all, which was of course a crying shame. Their debut album for Virgin, Swimmer, continues the brilliance of the former singles with material alternating between guitar-influenced and atmospheric, melodic material. Other key-cuts include Swimmer, the introspective Jealous and Beyond the Pale. Although Big Dish's material may tend to anonymity in the end, the strong vocals of Steven Lindsey lift the material up to a higher plane.


