

The organisation claimed that some 225 million viewers in 35 countries across four continents watched the three-hour programme, which included live segments from London, Los Angeles, Paris, Toronto, Sydney, Tokyo, Florence and Munich, coordinated via a fivesatellite link-up.

Despite the multi-national flavour of the event. British and American acts dominated the Top 20 awards, voted by viewers worldwide. Second place went to Peter Gabriel ('Sledgehammer'), followed by Wham! ('Edge Of Heaven'), Duran Duran ('Notorious') and Cyndi Lauper ('True Colors'). Only the Scandinavian acts Europe, in seventh place with 'The Final Countdown', and A-Ha, 11th with 'Hunting High And Low', interrupted the Anglo-Saxon dominance.



# UNITED KINGDOM




