Live TV Broadcast In Many Countries

BBC's Michael Hurll, producer of the IMMC (International Music & Media Conference) Gala to be held in Montreux on May 15, has announced the names of the emerging international acts which will be presented to an estimated audience of over 100 million viewers in 15 countries

The acts have been selected from three continents and include Robert Cray, Robbie Nevil and Tesla from the USA; Mental As Anvthing, John Farnham and Crowded House from Australia; and from Europe, with the UK as talent leaders, come The Cure, Cutting Crew and the Scottish band Love & Money. Continental European entries are Stephanie from Monaco, Bonnie Bianco who is no. 1 in Germany at press time, plus Italian acts Gianna Nannini and Matia Bazar. Germany further presents new solo artist John Christian. UK signed act Terence Trent D'Arby brings the total to 15. Alison Moyet will be one of the special guest stars appearing



Swiss Lead The World In CD Sales

High per capita incomes combined with a traditional enthusiasm for new technology contribute to the strength of the Swiss CD market, which has also been boosted by drops in hardware costs. CD players at the lower end of the market now retail for only around £160, and though pop CD repertoire still sells

for about £13, lower software prices are expected by mid-summer. The buoyant CD sector helped make 1986 a satisfying year for the Swiss consumer electronics business generally, with retail sale of hardware plus blank audio and video worth almost £650 million. Philips, Panasonic, Technics and Sony, operating as importer/distributors, together account for about 40% of the market. Leading

CD hardware sales topped 100.000 products include VCRs (150.000 units sold), Walkman-type tape players (240.000 units) and tv receivers (300.000 units)

There are still some great barriers to be broken through in the way that vision and music can work together." Rose says he and Gibb originally got together on a project (yet to be

unveiled) with the working title 'Miami Nice', involving the many musicians living in the Miami area. Rose: "We're going to be a major player in the marketplace. George Harrison, made it over to films through his company Handmade, so it's only natural a Bee Gee should go for it as well."

GRO is to be based at Pinewood Studios, says Rose, "because of its creative community and extensive facilities and services". Rose produced 'The Kids Are Alright', the Who film. 

Under Way

Great Enthusiasm For CDV

CD-Video, the extension of compact disc technology into digital sound with pictures, is being warmly welcomed by the world's major record companies, most of whom plan to have music video titles available for the market launch of the system later this year.

Reporting this widespread enthusiasm, Jan Timmer, President of PolyGram International, said there has also been a good reaction from the Japanese hardware manufacturers and from the retail trade. Timmer was speaking on the eve

of a series of press conferences in Amsterdam (March 16, 17, 18) hosted by Philips Consumer Electronics Division to unveil the new CD

worldwide live ty broadcast of the IMMC Gala (May 15). A jury of 20 top television producers involved in music programming will make a decision on 15 different awards.

The PolyGram chief emphasised, "the enormous importance of the youth market in the music industry". CD-Video, he said, was a system to capture the imagination of young people, to create excitement and to attract them to the optical disc medium."

But he added that CD-Video could also help solve the record industry's problem with slumping singles sales. He said the cassingle (singles in cassette form) had not been "spectacularly" successful, but insisted CD-Video could, "more than compensate for the fall in 45rpm disc sales".



Most of his songs are carefully built up, leaving much room for improvisation and instrumental breaks. "To a certain extent, my music is also produced for those who listen to CD. It is music to really listen to or to relax to. I love to record acoustic instruments in combination with synthesizers or drum machines." This approach is the more apparent on a track like 'Cool Night Water', a very soothing number with a relaxed tone and beautiful dreamy piano and acoustic guitar parts.

Rita Farouz Breaks Those Walls

So far Israel has never produced any real pop stars; apart from some Eurovision acts, Israeli talent is virtually unknown in Europe. But Rita Farouz is going to change all this; in 1986 she dominated the Israeli charts where her debut single, 'Breaking Those Walls', held the no. 1 position for 37 weeks, while the album, of the same name, enjoyed similar success and went gold five times. With her deep and flexible

voice and material that is firmly rooted in the adult mainstream market, the 24-year-old singer has already attracted the attention of German ty producers. Although exact financing remains a problem, the assignment of the five channels on TV-SAT is a major breakthrough as it marks the first time that the private stations have direct access to the soon to be launched satellite. Two of the channels on TV-SAT will be made available for private stations, while the public stations ARD and ZDF take the other two. These private stations include the SAT1 consortium as well as RTL Plus, German's first private channel, owned by RTL and Bertelsmann. It has not yet been decided who will take the fifth channel

In order to start using the fourth channel on TV-SAT. ARD has to broadcast digital radio from lam to 6pm, after that the channel can be used for television programmes.

Despite all the problems that Boy George recently had to tackle with the press hysteria about his alleged drug addiction, he makes a glorious return to the European charts. Within three weeks, the cover of the David Gates song, Everything I Own is up to number one in the European Airplay Top 50, breaking the four weeks domination of Aretha & George.

Freddie Mercury collected good airplay points last week and his version of the Platters' classic The Great Pretender jumps from 17 to 6 while only in its second week. At press time, the new U2 single, With Or Without You, was officially out for just two days. We already received a tremendous amount of tips for this single last week. This week the response is absolutely overwhelming and U2 enters straight in at number 8 in the Airplay Top 50, making it the highest Airplay entry of this year. It does not often happen that a single-enters straight into the top 10 of the European Airplay and only five records have managed to get in higher than U2: Spandau Ballet with 'Only When You Leave' (in at 6), Queen with 'It's A Hard Life' (7), David Bowie with 'Blue Jean' (5), Bronski Beat's single 'Why' (4) and UB40 & Chrissie Hynde's 'I Got You Babe' (5)

Another newcomer to the top 10 is Allson Moyet's Weak In The Presence Of Beauty with a good move from 18 to number 10 in its third week. Coinciding with his European promo tour, John Farnham is picking up increasing radio response and bu're The Voice moves up with a bullet from 28 to 16.

Other good moves for Meutal As Anything (18-30), Genesis (19-41), Beastie Boys (20-38) and Nick Kamen (23-36).

The American formation Starship had their last hig European hit single at end of 1985/ beginning of 1986 with 'We Built This City' They are bound to make a comeaback with Nothing's Gama Stop US Now, co-written by Abert Hammond, the song is from the movie 'Mannequin'. Produced by Narada Michael Muden, it has undenable appeal both for the pop/rock and the mainstream radio formats. ber 30 in the Airplay charts this week. The third Airplay entry is for Club Nouweau's Lean On Me in at 32. Originally a Bill Withers' song from 1972, it is one of the fastest climbing number one hits of the 80s in the US Billboard charts where it hits the number I spot for the second time.

New in at 38 are the **Thompson Twins** with their first single for quite a while, Get That Low. The single signals a change in style and the track is very much Howard Jones-like (which isn't so surprising since they share the same producer, Rupert Hine). The band, now reduced to a duo, will release their new album Close To The Bone on March 30.



A very good jump for Bruce Willis who moves from 31 to 11 with his rendition of Respect Yourself. Quite strange because it was only about one-and-a-half years ago that the Kane Gang's version of that song hit the charts. Other good moves are for the Beastie Boys (14-21), Nick Kamen (17-25), The Mission's Severina (25-32), Billy Idol's Don't Need A Gun and Terence Trent D'Arby with If You Let Me Stay. Although we are still waiting for brother Michael's new release, Janet Jackson surprises us with the highest entry of the week, in at 31 with Let's Wait Awhile (for Michael?). Other entries are for American singer Lillo Thomas with Sexy Girl, a Freddie Jackson style song, and Fine Young Cannibals' newest Ever Fallen In Love. As expected, U2 and Simply Red entered straight into the album charts at no.1 and 2 respectively.

GERMANY

Bonnie Bianco & Pierre Cosso's track from the television play 'Cinderella' called Stay remains on top for the second consecutive week. Ben E. King jumps to the second position (coming from 8) and the Housemartins stick at three. Additions to the top 10 are for Pepsi & Shirlie (8-11) and John Farnham's You're The Voice (10-19). It looks like the second single by Mel & Kim is going to be even bigger in Europe than 'Showing Out' was, Respectable jumps this week from 56 to 18. Other good moves for Mixed Emotions' newest Bring Him Back, Frankie Goes To Hollywood (24-64). Tina Turner's world tour supporting act Glass Tiger with Someday (29-49) and Simply Red's The Right Thing. Highest new entry are Fine Young Cannibals with Ever Fallen In Love. German singer Juliane Werding enters at 50 with Viellicht Irgendwann (Maybe Someday) and M&M's Euro-crossover tip Alice's Nomadi enters at 70.

FRANCE

A quiet week. The theme from the film 'Le Passage, 'Francis Lalanne's On & Retroaven remains unbeaten at the top for the third consecutive week. Elso follows at 2 and 8 Stause Quo holds the third position for the fourth consecutive week. The rest of the charts are just as early for The Bangles' Hold Like Are Egyptian. Good jumps for Jeanne Mas' Suavey. Moi (B-26), keep an eye on her, Off's Electrica Good jumps for Jeanne Mas' Suavey. Moi (B-26), he Eurovision Song Contest presenter (Zh-36) and Hong Kong Syndikat with Concrete And Clay (24-42).

HOLLAND

Mel & Kim's Respectable needed only three weeks to reach the no. 1 spot. They are followed by Aretha & George and Level 42. German band The Scorpions with their two year old single Still Loving You entered the top 10 (19-13) just like Boy George's Everything I Own (10-18). Prince's Sign Of The Times jumps from 24 to 12 and Dutch singer Piet Veerman with his ode to Dutch salvagers called Sailing Home. Other good moved are for Ben E. King (18-31) and Europe's ballad Carrie (23-27). New entries are for Freddie Mercury's The Great Pretender, American band Billy Vera & The Beaters' At This Moment which was used twice in the popular tv series 'Family Ties' (Billy Vera wrote Dolly Parton's US no. 1 hit 'I Really Got The Feeling'), Bruce Springsteen's Fire, The Cult's Love Removal Machine, Oueen's Pain Is So Close To Perfection, and Dutch singer Cherry with a track from the movie 'Blonde Dolly' called My Second Skin. U2 is no. 1 in the tipparade and will certainly have a high entry in next week's chart.

SWITZERLAND

Richard Sanderson remains on top for the fourth consecutive week, followed by Pepsi & Shirlie and the Housemartins. Simply Red enters at 15 and the San Remo winners Morandi, Ruggeri & Tozzi enter with their Si Pao Dare Di Piu at 17. Other entries for Billy Idol and Wolf Tones with Fight Of The Earls. And it's nice to mention is that Ireland's pride U2 entered straight at no. 1 with the their album The Joshua Tree.

While Level 42 sicks at no. 1, Aretha & George creep up to no. 2. The faster mover this week is local pop act TV-2 with the song G? Mg Ly₂ (Just 60 Me). Their new album has just been released and is expected to go straight to the no. 1, spot. This CBS act is one of the best selling acoud 20000 to 300000 copies. Also new in the top 10 are Simply Red (5:12) and Prince with the lighest new entry at no. 10 with Sign Of The Times: There is a good move for Carly Simon (20:30) and Ben E. King has second best new entry with Stand By Me entering at 27.


