# **Bowie Announces** Tyne Tees TV Tipped For **World Tour**

Glass Spider Tour Kicks Off In Rotterdam

by Machgiel Bakker

Amsterdam - At a press conference energetic and solid rock, in Bowie's held here on March 30, David Bowie presented his new band, gave a preview of his forthcoming album, 'Never Let Me Down' (released worldwide April 20), and details of his coming tour. It will be Bowie's first tour since the 'Serious Moonlight Tour' four years ago and will take Bowie and his six piece band to more than 100 cities over six continents. The tour kicks off in Rotterdam on May 30, followed by other

Australia, New Zealand and Japan. Having just re-signed a long term worldwide contract with EMI America, for whom Bowie made his first album, 'Let's Dance' in 1983, the new album contains II songs, eight of which were written by Bowie, two in collaboration with others and one cover, Iggy Pop's 'Bang Bang'. Bowie sang the latter at the press conference and its sound is indicative of the direction that Bowie takes on the new album:

London- Although no final decision has yet been made by the ITCA (the governing body of independent television in the UK), it seems almost certain that Tyne Tees will be given

The new package would be in direct competition for the mass pop audience so long enjoyed up by BBC TV's Top Of The Pops, which has been running well over 20 years.

It is rumoured that Alastair Pir rie is to produce the show called The Roxy and has staff, offices and a budget already allocated. The final go-ahead from the network chiefs is seen as being virtually cer-

While Top Of The Pops continues on early Thursday evenings, The Roxy will go out on Tuesdays at 7.30pm, with a specially edited version repeated during children's television on Saturday mornings. The chart will be that used by Independent Local Radio for its Sunday Network Show, though Pirrie is believed to be negotiating to have the airplay element removed for televi-

# **Dutch Industry Divided On Impact Of Satellites**

Because Holland and Belgium are the alleged pan-European character the most densely cabled countries in Europe, pan-European satellites have traditionally used the Benelux as a platform and a test market for their activities. However, some industry leaders are sceptical about

of the satellite services; Paul Hertog, Managing Director of Polydor: "At least 69% of all product shown is international and as there is hardly any budget to make videos for domestic acts, the chances of promoting your product abroad are getting less and less". Even more outspoken, is EMI's Managing Director Kick Klimbie, who says with more than a touch of irony: "It all leads to a certain shallowness of the general taste. If Sky and Music Box cease to exist tomorrow, there is a chance that national product will start selling again".

Jan Corduwener, Managing Director of Phonogram, disagrees and is glad with any form of visual

promotion, although he feels that Dutch product can never really compete in terms of quality as the Dutch industry can never make the same recording and promotion investments as foreign companies.

Bowie looked amazingly fresh and fit, answered journalists' questions in a playful way and seemed completely ready for the world tour. According to the man himself, the tour will be, "the most visual I've ever done, it will be very adventurous"

BBC Enterprises are planning a 'one-off' BBC Radio Show to celebrate 21 years of broadcasting by Radios 1, 2, 3 and 4. Peter Anslow, who was previously involved in the highly successful Daily Mail International Ski Show, is faced with the exciting task of organising the Radio Show which takes place in London, September 30-October 9. The show will revolve around a stage complete with broadcasting studio, from which programmes will be transmitted by household names such as Steve Wright, Gary Davies and Simon Bates.

Norway's Radio West's Tony Burton is delighted to see that CDs are beginning to be sent to his station as promotional material. Virgin have taken the initiative and he hopes (as, no doubt, all fellow stations do) to the companies will soon follow suit. France's Hit FM (no. 2 in

the FM popularity stakes according to the latest rating figures published by Mediametrie) is embarking on a major Huey Lewis campaign. The radio network's owners, UGC, also conveniently own a large chain of French cinemas so that the two media are joining forces. Hit FM's Catherine Costa says that Lewis is not a big seller in France at the moment They hope to remedy this by showing mini-clips in the cinemas, devoting lots of airplay to the singer and giving away tickets for his concerts in the US.

# TUNING IN



Robbie Robinson is Managing Director at the Dublin based independent station Radio Sunshine 101. Robbie Robinson (known as Robbie Dale on air) boasts an interesting and highly varied background. In 1965, he was the legendary 'Admiral Robbie Dale' at Radio Caroline (South) and in 1968 he joined the Dutch pirate Veronica. Once back on land, he produced one of Holland's first and 'zany' pop programmes 'Jam'. At the same time he was involved in writing and producing records at Dureco as well as having shows on the Dutch public radio channels

Finding himself outside the music business for a couple of years, he started what has now become Dublin's leading station, Radio Sunshine IOI, in 1980. Although independent broadcasting was not allowed in Iredand, Radio Sunshine IOI rapidly gained in importance and was dubbed the first Super pirate and immediately recognised as being very professional. Having

started with only six people, the staff has now expanded to 47, seven years later.

While strictly holding to an AC

format, recent figures indicate the station is number one in Dublin with 34% of the 15 to 35 year old age bracket, while at peak hours reaching 70%, amounting to 150,000-200,000 people (from a population of nearly one million). Robinson thinks the format is 'God' and describes it as "Hot Hits", a highly researched format that takes the American, British, Irish and continental European charts into account. Advised by an American radio consultant, Sunshine 101's format has three categories, A, B and C. all on a rotation system. The A-category has 10 to 15 records that rotate every three to four hours while 30 to 40 records fall into the B-category rotated on a four to 10 hours system. The C-section consists of 20 records that are going down the charts but still justify strong airplay.

Operating on the 539 medium wave and 101 stereo FM, Sunshine is in a very strong position to receive a license when the new Irish government introduces local radio legislation, hopefully before the summer of this year.

# **Yorkshire Goes Ahead** With Late Night TV

Yorkshire TV is to go ahead with night time transmission following a successful experimental period last year. But there could be a change from the previous fare of non-stop pop videos as well as a cut-off point at 3am.

Though no likely schedules have vet been revealed, a more varied programme output seems certain. During last year's experiment, which was watched closely by the other UK commercial tv stations,

programming consisted entirely of pop videos delivered from the Music Box satellite. A mixed bag of programmes is now favoured by York shire TV executives.

No firm start date has yet been announced because negotiations over payments are still being discussed with the unions. During the experiment, operators were paid £400,000 per night but this is seen as out of the question on a long term

#### Ludicrous Decision

Despite BBC Television's ban on David Bowie's controversial clip to 'Day In Day Out', it is being featured regularly on Sky Trax and Music Box. Michael Hurll, Executive Producer of 'Top Of The Pops' decided to ban the clip claiming it contained, "far too much gratuitous sex and violence". We've heard the rumour as many times as we've had hot dinners but Bill Wvman fuelled the fire last week when he made comments to the effect that the only way the band could play live again would be if Mick Jagger and Keith Richards could become friends again, and hinted that the tribute gig they played for part-time Stones member Ian Stewart at the 100 Club in London last year may well turn out to be their last. Bill holds Jagger responsible for the problem, saying he is the one who seems to want the solo glory.

Hugh Whittaker of the Housemartins has left the group to go to music college in their home town of Hull - meantime there'll be a new Housemartins single in May and a new album later in the year. His replacement is another Hull boy, Dave Hemingway, formerly with local band. The Velvetones.

The stranglehold on the London West End record retailing scene enjoyed by big boys Tower, HMV and Virgin took a couple of new twists last week when Tower announced the purchase of a 12.500 square feet site near Oxford Circus, in between the current Virgin and HMV locations, and Virgin countered with the news that they've bought the Smithers & Leigh building down at the other end of Oxford Street towards Marble Arch. A Virgin spokesman was probably understating the case just a little when he commented: "I woudn't advise any-

body else to open up there." Ugly scenes as The Cure played in Argentina recently at a Buenos Aires football stadium - hundreds of fans besieged their hotel and jostled for admission to the two shows, and the band had to have a constant 10-man security team, 30 people were injured in a riot outside the stadium when fans without tickets tried to get in and there were 137 arrests at the second show.

Alison Movet's new album 'Raindancing' is, at long last, released in the UK (April 6). Amazingly, it's taken her two years and five months to follow up the platinum LP 'Alf'.

The Thompson Twins, who'll be distressed to see their single 'Get That Love' already on its way out of the British charts after a paltry peak at no. 68, have announced the UK dates on their tour - they begin on May 14 in Liverpool, winding up at London's Hammersmith Odeon on May 27. The Twins have a new band lined up for the tour, featuring the former Gang Of Four member Sarah Lee on bass guitar, and onetime Art Of Noise associate Geoff Dugmore on drums.

Rock Over London has been chatting to Julian Cope who confirms he's back to stay. The current album is bringing him back into the limelight after a number of years following the demise of The Teardrop Explodes. And although he admits he's never been one to involve himself in contractual obligations, he's already planning another album for later this year. Julian starts a countrywide tour next week which coincides with the release of 'Eve's Volcano' his third single from the LP.



Former Manfred Mann's Earth band lead singer Chris Thompson has a single from the 'Playing For Keeps' soundtrack out here this week, a song called 'It's Not Over'.

A one-off performance of UK songwriter Mike Batt's musical 'The Hunting Of The Snark' takes place this week at the Royal Albert Hall starring Roger Daltrey, and to coincide. Julian Lennon has a single from the album out on Virgin called 'Midnight Smoke'.

# **Can Dutch Talent Still Travel?**

# Local Product Struggles To Survive

nce every year, Holland produces a genuine cross-over hit record. Apart from the Dutch wave of the 70s, when acts like George Baker, Tee-Set, Shocking Blue, Pussy Cat and of course Focus, hit the charts all over the world, the Dutch stake in the 80s became less prominent. Admittedly, the 80s brought world hits like 'The Stars On 45 Project' in 1981/82, the Art Company with 'Susanna' in 1984, Mai Tai in 1985 and M.C. Miker 'G' & Deejay Sven's 'Holiday Rap' last year. But compared to the last decade, it seems that the Dutch magic has somehow failed to make the same impact in the international music world. But not only has local product problems selling abroad, it also meets much more resistance by local buyers than 10 years ago. In other words, sales of domestic product have seen a severe drop and some pessimists want us to believe that with the increased possibility of receiving foreign channels, local product is close to fading away totally. M&M spoke to some of the industry leaders about their views on the slumping Dutch sales, the fate of domestic product and the continuing influx of foreign tv

rector of RCA/Ariola believes that the growing difficulties that artists have in crossing over is a year age bracket. We have to matter of the mentality of the artists themselves. "The fact that national product does not get enough attention on Dutch radio, a complaint often heard, cannot solely be ascribed to radio only. Although I feel that the amount of local product on Dutch radio should be increased, I also think that over the years, with all the technological innovations, artists have not developed likewise. The demands on artists are much heavier these days and some of them just can't fully meet them." An act that has been able to comnete on the international market are the Dolly Dots whose latest album and film 'Dutch Treat', has taken one and a half years of preparation. Another example he gives to defeat the theory of decreasing national sales, is that of Lee Towers, Holland's own Frank Sinatra whose whole album catalogue, some 14 albums, has exceeded one million sales, as well as Anita Mever, whose total album sales ap-

Although the general decrease in sound carriers is compensated by the enormous growth of CDs (from 12% in 1985 to 26% in 1986; the fourth

quarter of 1986 has seen CD sales almost just as much as during the whole of 1985), turnover of local repertoire decreased from 21% in 1985 to only 16% last year (according to figures published by the Dutch industry organisation NVPI). Paul Hertog, Managing Director of Polydor and one of the compilers of the NVPI figures. outlines the major factors contributing to last year's decrease in national repertoire. "The slight increase of 5.5% in total record industry turnover is mainly due to the compact disc sales. However, local repertoire available on CD is still low compared to the catalogue of international repertoire. Local repertoire on CD only takes 8% of total CD turnover, compared to 66% international. In fact, only since the end of last year have Dutch record companies shown more interest in releasing domestic repertoire on CD, now that the manufacturing problems

have largely been solved." Gauging the reactions on the arrival of pan-European satellites, most of the Dutch record companies are not so pleased about the popularity that the satellite services enjoy. Especially not in relation to local product. Hertog: "At least 96% of all product shown is international and as there is hardly any budget to make videos for domestic acts, the chances of promoting your product abroad are getting less and less."

There are some who even feel that if the satellite services disappear, sales of national product would get a renewed boost, Kick Klimbie, Managing Director of EMI Bovema, is very outspoken on the influence of the satellites: "Another three years of cable and satellite and we will all be driving in Japanese cars. It all leads to a certain shallowness of general taste. As a consequence the will to experiment fades away and everybody is opting for a more conservative course. If Sky and Music Box cease to exist tomor-

This very peculiar system, at least in comparison to the way in which other broadcasting systems are organised, guarantees that as many opinions or cultural movements as possible are being reflected in the media. Research figures supplied by the NOS reveal however that despite the increasing competition from abroad, most viewers spend the majority of their viewing hours watching the domestic channels. The NOS figures show clearly that the Dutch public broadcasting system has been able to face the competition from abroad.

The Conamus Foundation was established in 1960 to promote quality Dutch light music both within Holland and abroad. John de Mol, Managing Director of Conamus: "A survey three years ago showed Dutch audiences would like to hear up to 30-35% Dutch music on the radio, and 1986 figures still show that they only get 16%. I don't want to keep Anglo-American product out of the market but I want a fairer balance, the gap is too big af the moment. I'm working on that gap and on giving people what they want. We are subsidised by the Performing Rights Society to make sure Dutch music gets a fair share but I'm not against access to good music wherever it comes from."

Every year at Midem, Conamus presents the international record industry and publishing companies with a compilation album of best Dutch songs from the preceding year. This year, 2.000 copies of the double album (28 tracks), 'Music From Holland With Love, Vol. 17', were given away. De Mol, "It's

a nice way to bring Dutch music to the attention of the international industry. And I know absolutely that both sides appreciate it because they carry on asking me to do it."

The ALVM is planned to start in September and will be a two year course (Saturdays only) for around 22 young people. As well as practical and theory classes, there will also be training in tv studio work, theatre techniques (sponsored by the microphone manufacturers Sennheiser) and legal affairs such as authors' rights and publishing contracts. "I don't think there's another course like this one anywhere. I believe it's a necessity because it will turn good singers into real professionals. The reason Conamus is behind it is because I believe the way to promote Dutch music is through quality." The choir project is expected to start next year and its aim is to enable the 550,000 choirs in Holland to include more Dutch music in their repertoire.

Every year, Conamus presents Holland's most coveted awards, the Golden Harps, which last year went to producers Bolland & Bolland (Falco). radio and tv maker Herman Stok and entertainer Seth Gaaikema. The Foundation's Export Prize also went to Bolland & Bolland.

As far as pop music is concerned, Conamus works closely with the Foundation For Dutch Pop Music (SPN) in Amsterdam, a government subsidised organisation set up in 1975 to promote Dutch pop music. In 1986 SPN recieved a 430,000 Dutch guilders state subsidy for its own work plus 500,000 guilders for the 'podia circuit'; the latter is used to supplement musicians' fees. This year SPN expects to get 480,000 and 700,000 guilders respectively.


The Foundation holds various workshops and competitions (including 'Not The Same Old Song' for songwriters, 'De Grote Prijs' for the best emerging Dutch band and the annual guitar championships), organises festivals, publishes a regular magazine for pop musicians and produces LPs, mostly compilations. In 1984 the SPN set up teaching courses for experienced musicians who were giving classes and workshops in youth

Perhaps one of SPN's most important functions is as a central contact for Dutch pop musicians and the industry by providing detailed information and brochures on venues, taxes, record companies, labels, studios, etc.



# Boudisque Plans Benelux Indie Charts

One of Holland's most street- Music. wise indies is Amsterdam based Boudisque which started as a small specialist record store in 1968 and is now well established in the European music industry. Boudisque still has its own shop, selling records imported from all over the world, but today it is also a wholesaler and distributor with its own video label and two house labels.

The first real breakthrough for Boudisque came in 1981 when Nick Powell (who founded Virgin with Richard Branson) bought 95% of the company and provided the finance for it to grow. Powell went on to Boudisque's video label, Palace

But the majority of Boudisque's work is on the record side and it has two house labels, Torso (including Ramones, Gene Loves Jezebel, Sapho) and Megaton for the heavy metal repertoire. It also handles all the production and distribution for the US company Enigma, under the label Enigma Europe, and has various distribution deals with other labels. Boudisque's own artists roster has about six bands including Kiem (currently very successful in Spain and Italy), Edward Ka-Spel, Exises and a Hawaiian group called Sacred Rite.



# Is There Any New Talent In Belgium?

xcept for one small record company, no such thing as an A&R function exists in the whole of the Belgian record industry. Talent scouting for local product has become one of the first areas to be abolished by the industry as a consequence of the decreasing sales figures of Belgian national product, amounting only to about 3% of the total record industry turnover which itself has increased just 3.8% since last year.

Charles Licoppe, President of the national Belgian Phonographic Federation (SIBESA): "First of all, there is less production, or less good product, because companies nowadays cannot afford to spend a fortune on national talent. With the tv cable network offering more than 18 foreign programmes, Belgian viewers have too many alternatives - our national tv network has no budget for national talent. Apart from two occasional shows, there is no regular weekly ty show featuring both national and international artists, so there is very poor support from that side: producers would rather get high ratings with big stars than to work with what our own market has to offer.

"And of course there is the language problem: talent means sales and buying potential: with two strict language groups (Flemish and French) it's clear that our industry aims at the French language group (potential market of about 52 million) rather than the Flemish market (maximum of 18 million potential in Belgium and Holland). It's hard for a Flemish artist to make it outside Belgium in his own language."

Amongst one of the leading companies in the field when it comes to national talent is Carrere: half of the nation's top ten national singles are signed with Carrere, including Sandra Kim and Muriel Dacq. Carrere spent no less than \$65,700 on national talent last year, but even the double platinum success of Sandra Kim's 'J'Aime La Vie' (300.000 copies sold) brought back only a fraction of the company's investments in national artists, which amounts to 4%.

Francine van der Smissen. Carrere's Product Manager. points out: "Due to the fact that MUSIC & MEDIA - April 11, 1987

broadcasters for any back-up when it comes to breaking new talent. T'Aime La Vie' is the very first Belgian single ever to receive double platinum, but Muriel Dacq, who sold more than 450.000 copies in France ('La Ou Ea') didn't manage to sell 75.000 in Belgium. "As a consequence, only a

small percentage of our investments have really paid off, and we have, therefore, to be very careful next year when it comes to signing new talent, although we will keep on trying." Although there are no A&R

managers in the Belgian record industry, their task is often fulfilled by product managers or other executives and there is a slight improvement in this field: Polygram, whose 26% share of the Belgian market makes them the new market leaders, can still rely on Will Tura, but 1987 promises to be a big year for Jo Lemaire whose album is to be released this month. Polygram has now reserved a substantial budget for video clips and special photo sessions and will launch a promo campaign throughout Europe.

Former market leader RCA/ Ariola (now second with some 21.5% of the market share) struck gold with Viktor Lazlo's 'She' album last year, and with a new album to be released on the very day she hosts the Eurovision Festival (May 9), all looks


RCA/Ariola plan to give special attention for two artists in the coming months: Johan Verminnen, whose album 'Traag Is Mooi' was released on CD last month and is only the third national artist to have an album out on CD, and English speaking artist Elisa Waut, whose new album 'Commedia' has just been released on LP and CD and is the first ever English CD released by a Belgian

CBS, who hold a strong third place with almost 15% of the record market in Belgium, have done quite well with The Popgun, a duo signed by the independent, Antler Records, but distributed through CBS. The single 'Always Alone' received good airplay on both French and Flemish radio stations.

It took a long time for WEA to sign a Belgian artist, B-Art, but now that they have, François De Kock, Product Manager of WEA Belgium comments: "Being responsible for signing artists here I was very impressed by B-Art's remake of Adriano Celentano's 'Prisencolinensinaincusol' with its famous 'Allright' gimmick. The single is out in the Benelux, Germany and the UK, and besides tv appearances on the national network, we also have some very positive contacts with both RTL Luxembourg and Sky Channel." The record cracked the Belgian national top three just two weeks after its release.

EMI, with 10% of the Belgium music market, had only De Nieuwe Snaar on their books after TC-Matic dissolved and Amo Hintjens went to Virgin for his solo album. But now they will be working with the Soul Sisters (who have two sin-

# **CD Boom Stabilises Belgian Turnover**

Just as in the rest of Europe, compact discs save the rather poor turnover figures of the Belgian industry. According to figures by the Belgian Phonographic Industry Federation (SIBESA), turnover of 'pop and variety' is US\$51 million, a decrease of 0.75%. CDs show a 169% increase, with total units of 581,960, while total turnover in this section has decreased by 10.5%.

Local product adds up to only 3% of total turnover, despite the success of Eurovision Song Contest winner Sandra Kim, whose 'J'Aime La Vie' certified double platinum, the first Belgian artist to achieve such a success.

Charles Licoppe, President of SIBESA, comments on the 1986 results: "The main reason for these rather poor figures is still home taping, which is al-

most becoming an industry in itself with a yearly turnover of more than 10 million blank cassette units, equalling more than 16 million hours of recording time. The total amount of records sold here adds up to only 5.8 million hours of recorded music. The only way to fight this, as we see it, is an extra tax to be levied on blank audio tapes and tape-copying devices.

"Furthermore there is a clear discrepancy between music consumption and music sales," continues Licoppe, pointing out that it is only through records sold that money is available for new investments. In this

gles out) and a top class crossover band, Catalog Of Cool, two groups who have had the opportunity to appear on several natonal ty shows.

Indisc are currently working on the reunited Machiavel hoping to equal their 1978 mega hit 'Fly' and a new album is due this month.

The Leuven based company Antler is not a member of SIBE-SA and sales figures of their artists are not listed on the official SIBESA charts but they might just be the ones capable of raising the national market share of the Belgian record industry as some of their artists have done very well: Twee Belgen, Nacht Und Nebel, and currently, Poesie Noire who are becoming big names on Belgium's pop scene

Antler's managers spend just about every weekend in lo-

cal clubs and halls searching for new talent. Director Maurice Engelen, "We receive some 10 demos weekly and we used to release every artist we wanted to - this has changed now because of the crisis within the record industry in general. We are now restricted to Belgian artists which have the possibility of achieving success outside the country because of the very small market we have here. Newly signed bands include Pride And Passion (distributed through RCA/Ariola) and The Musical Reporters, both acts which aim mainly at a dance disco audience.

"With regard to media planning and promotion, we have established firm contacts with Sky Channel and FR3 for our artists. We suffer a lot from the fact that new talent get very few opportunities on national radio and tv. They would rather have Paul Young in their shows than any new Belgian band.'

It has taken only five weeks for Boy George's cover of David Gates' Everything I Own to make it to the number one spot of the European Hot 100 and the single also stands firm at the top of the Airplay chart.

Two rival singles are edging their way into the top 10. Prince's Paisley Park moves to 7 from 13, while Freddie Mercury's The Great Pretender climbs to 8 from 19. Prince is also moving up the Airplay Top 50, while Mercury drops four notches down to 10.

The Levi campaign makes its mark once again. Percy Sledge's When A Man Loves A Woman shoots up to 12 from 42, thanks to positions in the UK, German and Belgium.

Madonna's La Isla Bonita, the fifth single off her True Blue album, is highest new entry in both the Airplay Top 50 (in at 11) and the European Hot 100, straight in at 22.

Wet Wet (ves another new young band with a weird name) is a Glaswegian quartet who were signed to Phonogram two years ago and now release their first single. Wishing I Was Lucky. With its soulful vocals over an infectious and galloping rhythm, certainly a band to take notice of.

Although Arista act Latin Quarter have released some highly praised singles, such as the excellent 'Radio Africa', they are still very much a cult band. With their distinctive musicianship and their highly political recordings they never really broke on a wide scale. If their new single Nomzamo can change this remains to be seen but the song, a tribute to Nomzamo Winnifred Mandela is a highly inspired recording with its repetitive and hypnotic theme lingering on long after hearing. From the forthcoming album 'Mick And Caroline'.

Following the success of Hot Chocolate's remixed version of 'You Sexy Thing, EMI release a second remix, this time it's of the band's 1978 smash Every I's A Winner. With the economical and sharp remix ('groove mix') by Dutch DJ Ben Liebrand, it's likely to re-fuel interest in the band after their official split up earlier this year. The band is currently enjoying lots of success with the compilation album, 'The Very best Of Hot Chocolate', currently

topping the English album charts (their first no. 1 album<sup>†</sup>)

German DJs are giving good reports on Capitol act Crowded House's Don't Dream It's Over, the excellent and moody ballad off the band's splendid debut album released last year, one of M&M's favourite albums of 1986. The band still needs your support, in the States the single is at press time number 7 with a bullet in the Hot 100 Billboard chart.

Lots of tips are pouring in for American singer Donna Allen's disco single Serious on Portrait. Allen is a singer from Florida whose heavy hardcore disco soul song with a irresistable and tight hook, good take the European charts in a couple of weeks.

Although not yet showing in the European Airplay Top 50, initial sales on the Ferry Aid charity single Let It Be are very encouraging, especially in the UK. With the help of the star studded video, the single is expected to make inroads on the continent as well.

Living In A Box is a Chrysalis signed trio who recently recorded their debut album in San Francisco with Richard Burgess. The debut single, Living In A Box, is a very commercial hit record: elastic and bouncy disco, strong muscular vocals, catchy production and highly danceable!

We picked out two good singles for Eurocrossover this week; one by the Danish duo Laban called Prisoner and the other by Swedish pop act Trance Dance titled River Of Love. Both acts were extensively featured in our magazine, so don't say we haven't warned you!

# **Success Signs From The Prince Of Style**

Complete Artistic Control

by Pieter de Bruyn Kops

Discussing a new album by Prince is not the easiest thing to do, there are no criteria for measurement since Prince is a very innovative artist and with each new album he kind of changes the rules. So one simply cannot do anything other than accept whatever he does. He has an enormous influence on other artists and many are directly guided by him (The Time, Mazarati and Sheila E. among others). As an all-round musician, Prince was able to take complete artistic control of his products right from the beginning of his career. thus establishing himself as a performer composer and arranger as well as a creative personality to be reckoned with.

Most of the instruments and vocals are dealt with by Prince but here and there others appear, like Sheila E. The Revolution and saxophone player Eric Leeds.

'Sign O The Times' jumps one of the album's highlights is the thrilling 'If I Was Your Girlfriend' which is about a delicately rock & roll, soul, funk, rap, jazz erotic fantasy. Another highlight is 'Forever In My Life' which has sixteen mainly long tracks, so very nice backing vocals and very cool backings topped by affected lead vocals. The slick, swinging 'Slow

Love', very reminiscent of 'Under

The Cherry Moon' from the 'Parade' album is certainly commercial, 'Hot Thing', 'It' and 'Play In The Sunshine' are strongly driven rock songs, the latter with very high-pitched screaming vocals, a 70s feel and an amazing guitar solo. The rap tinged 'Housequake' has a strong party flavour. Prince creates an intimate atmosphere on 'The Ballad Of Dorothy Parker! On 'U Got The Look' Sheila E. is responsible for exciting elastic rhythms and Sheena Easton shares in the vocals; a very accessible track. So much happens on the arrangements of this double LP that it is almost too exhausting to listen to it all the way through, but separately all the tracks are very enjoyable and exciting; a goldmine of singles. And another alburn on which Prince is doing exactly what he likes

Prince has been compared to Jimi Hendrix, James Brown, Little Richard and Michael Jackson. Like them. Prince has made the successful crossover from black music to the mainstream popcharts, but there are also resemblances in vocal and instrumental achievements too. Nevertheless, Prince is very much a character in his own right; he combines styles, invents styles, changes styles and, last but not least, stylises styles, as his recent sparse arrangements on the 'Parade' album prove. After his early albums with Jimi Hendrix-like guitars and sexually explicit lyrcs, he really broke through in America with '1999'. The followup 'Purple Rain', probably his most commercial album to date, made him a huge star in Europe too and on the psychedelic 'Around The World In A Day' (Prince's own 'Sat. Pepper') his experimentation even gets freaky

and runs the risk of getting lost in details. On 'Parade', the third album Prince recorded with his backing group the Revolution, he introduces a very basic, sparse sound of which the megahit 'Kiss' is a good example. The influence of these sparse arrangements are very much in evidence in the present day's pop

On Prince's latest album, the double set 'Sign O The Times', the compostions are quite accessible some of them even commercial, but the arrangements are still very experimental

What Bangles' member Michael Steele once said about Prince might be typical of the way he works: "He's weird, he's an amazing talent. Watching him play in the studio is an amazing thing because he's one of those people who has no inhibitions. We watched him sit there once and he was like just playing guitar and he'd play something good and then he'd play something really bad. And he'd play drums and it would seem like he had no sense of time, but then, all of a sudden, he'd be playing all of this Tony Williams jazz stuff. It's like the guy has no fear of looking like a total fool..." (Q magazine, April

Euro-American Beat focuses on European acts that are hitting big in the American charts. Its author, Paul Grein, writes the popular Chartbeat column in Billboard and reports regularly on pop for both Billboard and the Los Angeles Times.

Europe (the group, not the continent) has accomplished something that eluded even the mighty Abba: it has become the first Swedish group to land a Top 10 album in the American charts

Europe's 'The Final Countdown' on Epic Records had climbed to no. 8 on Billboard's Top Pop Albums chart at press time. Abba's highest charting album, 'The Album', reached no. 14 in 1978. The title track of Europe's album was no. 8 on the Hot 100 at press time, an achievement matched by four Abba singles: 'Waterloo' (no. 6 in 1974), 'Dancing Queen' (no. 1 in '77), Take A chance On Me' (no. 3 in 78) and 'The Winner Takes It All'

(no. 8 in '81). 'The Final Countdown' was produced by Kevin Elson, whose other credits include Journey's 1983 album 'Frontiers'

While the two acts have worldwide success in common, their music is vastly different. Abba specialised in impeccably crafted, hook-filled pop singles, whereas Europe favours melodic or socalled 'lite' metal. That style is very hot in America at the moment: Bon Jovi's 'Slippery When Wet' has been listed in the Top 10 for six solid months (and has been Top 3 for all but two of those weeks). And Cinderella's 'Night Songs' has been Top 10 for more than three months, having climbed as high as no. 3.

'O' The Times, which is extensively discussed on page 22, another hot album for European radio is Bryan Adams' long awaited Into The Fire, the follow up to the 7 million worldwide seller Wreckless ('84). Boosted by a carefully orchestrated marketing campaign by A&M, the Canadian affiliate mounted the largest campaign in its history and the effect of this album will clearly be felt far into 1987. Co-produced by Adams and Bob Clearmountain and recorded at Adams' home, the LP includes 10 straightforward songs, topped by gritty vocals and energetic guitars. Starting off with the solid pop/rock of the current single Heat Of The Night, the album unfolds a full spectrum of rock alongside the rythmic drive of the melodious title track, the extensive guitar work on Native Son, the very harsh new version of Rebel and the uptempo r&r of Only The Strong Survive, something that Adams certainly will do.

Dream 6, a band from the Paisley Underground scene, changed their name into Concrete Blonde and signed to I.R.S. A self titled album is out now in Europe, about six months later than the American release. Female vocalist/bass player Johnette Napolitano wrote most of the material, which ranges from wild uptempo songs like Over Your Shoulder to rock ballads like Cold Part Of Town. Her vocals capture the ear in the pleasant True. Check too the cover of George Harrison's Beware Of Darkness, fitting Napolitano's voice well. In brief, a highly enjoyable set of rock songs.

One track, the current single Makossa '87 Big Blow, has a different line-up, including the outstanding Bootsy Collins (guitar), Robbie Shakespeare (bass), Herbie Hancock (piano) and Sly Dunbar (drums), backing Dibango's excellent saxophone and warm vocals. Other fave tracks: Massa Lemba, Bushman Promenade and the long complex Kango. The last couple of years have seen a discer-

nable trend to a return of American roots r&r and c&w. Although more eclectic, Green On Red is an exponent of this renaissance. Signed to a major, Phonogram, the new album The Killer Inside Me is a logical continuation of 'No Free Lunch': a flexible mix of country/pop/ rock, some folk and r&r, topped by Dan Stuart's intriguing vocals. Best tracks: Mighty Gun, Jamie and No Man's Land.

New act Isle Of Man have co-produced their self-titled LP with Spencer Proffer (Tina Turner a.o.). Full of bouncing rhythms, elastic vocals and dreamy guitars, the LP is reminiscent of Cock Robin whose Anna La Cazio performs a duet with lead singer, Robert Parlez, on Land Of The Heros. Watch out also for Tenderness and Speaking English
