

Bouygues Wins TF1 Licence

company Bouygues has won the licence for France's premier tv channel TFI beating the favourites, the publishing house Hachette. The announcement was confirmed by the

National Commission On Communication & Freedom (CNCL) last week and power will be handed over to Bouygues from the present president, Herve Bourges, on April 16. Bouygues will get 50% of TFI's capital (around three billion

francs), 40% will go on the stock market and 10% will go to the company's employees. The construction group can run the station for 10 years before having to apply to renew its concession. During that time, Bouygues intends to, "make a go of privatisation, give the channel an international stature, and pro mote French culture". The final line-up however is far

from totally French. Media mogul Robert Maxwell will be expanding his empire still further; of the 40% holding allocated to shareholders, Maxwell's Mirror Group, the Pergamon Media Trust, will have

The decision ends weeks of speculation and fierce discussions in the French media about the right candidate for the channel. Hachette had always presented itself as the 'official' candidate and the unexpected outcome invalidates contentions that the CNCL were mere puppets in the hands of the government and lacking in genuine independence. The final votes were eight for Bouygues, four for Hachette and one abstention.

The privatisation of a national television channel on the scale of TF1 is seen as a first in the world, as was the televised presentations by the two candidates.

UK Tax Concession

London- Protests over new tax regulations for foreign entertainers proposed by the British government (see M&M March 14) have been successful. Along with other music industry bodies, the Association Of Professional Recording Studios (APRS) opposed a move by the government to introduce rules that would have completely deterred foreign artists from recording and performing in the UK. In a meeting with Treasury officials, representatives from the APRS explained the grave damage the tax would inflict on studios and the knock-on effect on equipment manufacturers. As a result the government excluded royalties from the scope of the regulations

The number of stands for this year's international APRS Exhibition, held at the Olympia (June 24-26), has already been increased to 150 and the organisors are expecting a record attendance of over 6.000 visitors from the recording and music industry. This is the 20th year the exhibition is being held.

Clash Over Dutch French FM Radio Shake-Up **CD** Rental Shop

Hilversum- The Dutch national IFPI branch has called the opening of what is claimed to be Holland's first CD rental store, "an abominable development which could seriously damage compact disc sales".

Rob Edwards, Deputy Manag-

ing Director of the Dutch NVPI, says: "Renting out CDs, in combination with the DAT recorder, could deal the death blow to the CD business - but unfortunately, so far we're unable to do anything about it."

tribution of tv channels in France, it is now inviting representation for the authorisation of FM radio channels in the Paris region.

Yves Rocca of the CNCL has the responsibility of allocating 40 frequencies for which there are more than 200 candidates who have until continued on page 20 April 20 to present their creden-

tials. The central Parisian FM coverage will be divided into three classes according to transmission power. And these central Parisian stations will be augmented by 40 lower powered stations in the suburbe



RCA/Ariola Changes Tina Turner Tops New Name To BMG

The joint venture RCA/Ariola, founded in 1985 by the RCA Corporation and Bertelsmann AG and recently acquired by Bertelsmann, is changing its name to BMG Music and BMG Music International BMG Music will be the corporate umbrella of the RCA Records labels in the US and Canada, the RCA Red Seal Classical and Broadway label as well as the RCA/A&M/Arista distribution entity. They will all continue to use their respective labels and trademarks and the Nipper trademark associated with RCA will also be left unchanged.

BMG Music International will cover all the RCA/Ariola International record operations outside the US and Canada. The different local companies of BMG Music International will also adapt the BMG designation in their formal names. although present label names and trademarks will be unaffected.

BMG Music and BMG Music International are all part of the Bertelsmann Music Group which encompases all the worldwide record and music operations controlled by Bertelsmann AG including Arista

In a related statement, BMG confirmed the appointment of Heinz Henn as Vice President, International A&R Marketing, as reported earlier by Music & Media (M&M March 21).

The CNCL members will have their work cut out for them when it comes to re-allocating the FM frequencies in France. When Yves Rocca announced that roughly half of the FM stations would either be axed or the strength of their transmittors drastically reduced, he pointed out that 'tears would be shed'. This is bound to be the case since in the Paris-Ile-de-France area alone around 200-250 requests for frequencies are expected with only 40% having any chance of being satisfied. The shake up will not be without risks; many remember the tens of thousands of young people demonstrating through the streets of Paris in response to an appeal to safeguard NRJ's future.

France's Sud Radio To Be Privatised

Sud Radio, France's fourth peripheral station is to be privatised fol-

lowing an announcement by the Sofirad, the official organisation responsible for state affairs within radio. The decision was recently made public in an article in the French daily La Liberation.

Although 1986 saw net profits of seven million francs, it was the first time in five years that the station had shown profit. Sud Radio, which transmits on 370 medium wave and has 12 FM transmittors and 12 million listeners, is expected to be divided between five owners. A sum of 45 million francs is being suggested for the sale.

Several candidates have begun to place their bets, including the company Compagnie Luxembourgeoise De Television (CLT), Pierre Fabre and Manuel Diaz, Sud Radio's Marie-Ange Roig believes the privatisation could well be wrapped up before the summer.

The Cult Plug Into Electricity Straight From The 70s

The Cult have completely dismissed their psychedelic trademark and changed musical direction moving into a tight mixture of early 70s r&b and devilish, acid hard-rock on their new album, 'Electric', which has just been released by Beggars Banquet. Produced by Def Jam label boss Rick Rubin (Beastie Boys, Run DMC), and preceded by hit singles such as 'She Sells Sanctuary', 'Rain' (1985) and the recent 'Love Removal Machine', the album is expected to pick up lots of attention: The Cult's electrifying live performances have already done just that

'Electric' consists of 11 tracks made of guts, muscles and sweat. Heavily beating rhythms are provided by new drummer Les Warner but the rest of the band's line-up remains the same: Ian Astbury. the Bradford (UK) based founder of the group, adds haunted screaming vocals and a persistent tambourine. Billy Duffy (ex-Theatre Of Hate) delivers teasingly beefed-up lead & rhythm guitars and Jamie Stewart (ex-Ritual)

acid days. 'Lil' Devil' has sticky guitar solos backed by r&r rhythms, 'Bad Fun' is uptempo hard-rock, while 'King Contrary Man' has complex, alternating rhythms. Combining Stunning Performance With A Sensual Voice

Viktor Lazlo Set To Make European Breakthrough

Ithough the name would not suggest so, Viktor Lazlo is A a woman who combines a stunning performance with a sensual voice and all the signs point to her making a European breakthrough this year. With a new self-titled album released by Polydor on April 27 and her presentation of the Furovision Song Contest on May 9, Viktor Lazlo's rise to fame is even more likely.

in Belgium. Viktor Lazlo attended the University of Brussels where she learnt to speak English, French, Dutch, German and Italian fluently. After a successful modelling career she moved into the music scene and was discovered by producer and talent scout Lou Depriick in 1983, Depriick, who earlier launched the career of French punk star Plastic Bertrand ('Ca Plan Pour Moi'), was so overwhelmed by her looks and sultry voice that he invited Lazlo to work with him. Her first single, 'Casanova', was a Top 10 hit in France and Belgium and was followed by a contribution to the French movie, 'A Mort L'Arbitre', entitled 'Backdoor Man'. This sinale plus its follow-up, 'Last Call For An Angel', was included on her successful debut al-

Born in France and educated burn, 'She', released in 1985. The album came close to platinum status in Belgium and sold over 100.000 copies in Germany. In Japan too it attracted attention, selling over 60.000 copies.

Polydor has now re-issued this album which, apart from the above mentioned tracks. also contains a remarkable cover of Julie London's 1957 classic, 'Crv Me A River' (also covered by Mari Wilson in 1983) in a French version entitled 'Pleurer Des Rivieres'.

Most of Lazlo's material tends to late-night jazzy pop and Sade-type ballads, Although her new album will feature more contemporary un-tempo material. Lazlo's music is closely connected to her overall image where style, elegance and distinction are closely connected.

We were promised surprise guests at last week's International Aids Day concert at Wembley - but it seems nobody anticipated that the cause would reunite Wham. What, so soon? Andrew Ridgely joined George Michael on stage for a rendering of 'Everything She Wants' (although we can't guarantee that Andrew's guitar was actually plugged in) and George also duetted with Boy George. But it was really a night for testing new solo careers as Bob Geldof and Holly Johnson took to the stage and the presence of Andy Summers without the rest of Police can only fuel rumours of a split there. Defying the press to criticise him any further, Elton John turned up to sing, much earlier than his throat doctors advised ("I could do with some publicity." he joked) and other performers included Meatloaf, Ringo Starr's son Zak Starkey, and Kim Wilde.

And Boy George's interest in raising money for Aids research and sufferers seems to have helped him receive a conditional discharge following an appearance in court on a drugs charge. His barrister cited George's fund-raising efforts as an example to other reformed addicts and said the singer hopes to release a special benefit record later this

Amnesty International benefitted from an event last week known as 'The Secret Policeman's Third Ball'. Performers included Peter Gabriel, Kate Bush, Duran Duran, Nik Kershaw, Erasure and Joan Armatrading.

Latest additions to the Glastonbury CND festival line-up are Van Morrison and New Order. The organisers say there still remains one big name to be confirmed.

David Coverdale has confirmed that the Whitesnake line-up is somewhat in limbo at the moment as the musicians who played on the LP are not those featured in the video. Coverdale expects to use the new line-up for the forthcoming tour and denies that Whitesnake is a solo proiect. He says, "Whitesnake is a vehicle for good rock & roll songs," and he wishes to remain flexible within that particular framework.

It's interesting to note that the BPI have just ruled that as from June 1, sales of compact disc singles will no longer be eligible for the national singles chart, thus ending this particular means of 'creative marketing' on hits. If CD singles continue to be released after this date, a special chart will be created for them, just as it was for CD albums. In another move to stop the manipulation of the chart, they've ruled that from the same date, the maximum running time for any singles 'nackage' will be reduced from 25 minutes to 20, which means that it won't be so easy for companies to use such tactics as 'doublepack' releases which include a free single.

ROL was at one of Level 42's sell-out Wembley Arena shows last week and came away wishing they had been just a little more adventurous and that it had been a smaller venue - but Level are still a formidable live outfit, even if they're suffering from distinct tour-lag at the moment: the band's drummer Phil Gould tells us that both Mark King and Mike Lindup lost their voices towards the end of last week, Mike being told not to talk at all for three days. Their backing singer came much more into prominence at the later gigs and they even considered cancelling the Manchester shows altogether but decided to soldier on. Phil himself was suffering from sore hands, and even his voice was suffering because he was required to help out on some of the higher backing vocals. With the tour schedule continuing throughout almost the whole of 1987, it's going to be a long year. And Phil reports that as far as their next LP is concerned. they'll have to try and find time towards the end of '87 to write some

new material. So it sounds like we



A new no. 1 in the European Airplay Top 50 after the three week supremacy of Boy George's Everything I Own; while U2's album stays firmly at the top of the album charts, their single With Or Without You goes to the top after four weeks in the charts. It is the band's first chart topping single and album.

The highest entry in the Airplay Top 50 is for the charity single Let It Be. It enters at 16, followed by Herb Alpert's smooth Keep Your Eve On Me (new at 22) and The Cure's new single Why Can't I Be You (in at 35). It is good to see Living In A Box, one of our hot tips of last week, enter the Airplay Top 50 as well (new at

The most striking single to have landed on our desks this week is The Silencers' Painted Moon, Produced by Dave Bascombe (of It's Immaterial fame), the song features dramatic, soaring vocals over a crisp and sparkling pop tune. Fresh and fizzy pop that deserves to be heard by everyone. This Scottish band is currently on a European tour with The Pretenders.

Camy Todorow is one of the very few Eastern bloc artists to be signed to a western record label (Virgin). Born in Bulgaria, she defected in 1983 and is currently living in Munich. M&M spotted her talents way back in October 1985 (see issue 42) when her first single, 'Bursting At The Seams', was released. Her rendition of Don Covay's classic Chain Of Fools (orginally released by Aretha Franklin in 1967), evokes Tina Turner-like thrills in a very lively and energetic version.

Dublin based act In Tua Nua come up with a rather folky and country tinged single, Heaven Can Wait. Female vocalist Leslie Dowdall sings perfectly, assisted by a fairly traditional backing, including violin and pipes.

Go! Discs are well known for their special A&R policy; mostly in the acoustic folk vein, The Housemartins and Billy Bragg are amongst the best examples, and their new signing The Bathers tend to be in the same direction. With a remarkable vocalist (Chris Thomson, not to be confused with Manfred Mann's Chris Thompson) their new single Fancy Dress is an impressive and highly atmospheric debut.

Dance Like A Mother are a duo of two ex-Belle Stars whose Virgin debut You Ain't So Tough is worth checking. Co-written and (executive) produced by Narada Michael Walden, the single is a tight dance-floor fave, in a dense and suggestive production.

The store, Compact Sound in Hilversum, is owned by Bart Schadee and Frank Ten Doesschate and they insist that their only motive is to counteract the high cost of CD software. Pop CDs still cost almost £13.50 and classical titles more, which they say, is "an incredibly high price to pay." Their shop stocks more than 600 titles from a wide range of labels supplied by an anonymous wholesaler. Customers pay an annual £7.50 subscription and roughly 35 pence rental per record per day.

The record industry fears other rental stores with powerful backing could appear. Schadee and Doesschate insist they have set a trend which cannot be stopped and add that they will rent CD hardware too.

Other new entries for Club Nouveau's Lean On Me, Jan Hammer with another theme from the Miami Vice series called Crockett's Theme, Madonna and Herb Alpert (Keep Your Eve On Me).

ITALY

The Italian charts are a bit boring this week: Morandi, Ruggeri & Tozzi are steady on top for the sixth consecutive week followed by Fausto Leali's lo Amo and Simply Red (coming from 4). Spagna's Call Me moves from 9 to 5, Nick Kamen's Loving You Is Sweeter Than Ever enters at 8 and David Bowie at 25.

AUSTRIA

Bilgeri's Some Girls Are Ladies is on top for the third consecutive week (the single has already reached gold; see M&M New Talent next week for review). Other entries for Hot Chocolate's You Sexy Thing, Cook Da Books with Your Eyes, Europe's Carrie (in at 19 while their Rock The Night is still at 20), Ben E. King, and Bon Jo-

vi's You Give Love A Bad Name. Carly Simon's Coming Around Again jumped from 21 to 13 and Jackie Wilson's Reet Petite jumped eight notches from 22 to 16.

SWEDEN

John Farnham needed only two weeks to conquer the top with his You're The Voice. He is followed by Mixed Emotions' You Want Love and Hemliga Byran's Hei Hei Hemskt Mycket Hej. Additions to the top 10 are Alice Cooper who is back at 6 (coming from 17), Bryan Adams's Heat Of The Night (7-19), Dr. Feelgood with a version of the legendary See You Later Alligator (new in at 8) and David Bowie's Day In Day Out (new in at 9). Other entries are for Starship, Mel & Kim, Ben E. King and U2.

FINLAND

While Italian Spagna went from 9 to 5 in her home country, she entered the Finnish charts straight at no. 1 and replaced chart topper Gary Moore who had been no. 1 for four weeks with two different singles: three weeks with Over The Hills And Far Away and one week with Wild Frontier (the 'Wild Frontier' album is still at no. 1). Moore is now in second position. In third position is Robbie Nevil's C'Est La Vie. Other new entries for local act J. Karjalainen with Runo, Starhip, Freddie Mercury, Dutch trio the Star Sisters with a compilation of disco hits called Bad Girls (named after the Donna Summer hit), Expose with Come Go With Me. and Alison Moyet's Weak In The Presence Of Reauty

POLAND

Billy Joel is on top followed by Jennifer Rush's I Come Undone. Good jumps for Kim Wilde's You Keep Me Hangin' On, Sandra's Midnight Man and Tina Turner's What You Get Is What You See Red Box's For America has survived in the charts for the 11th consecutive week and the highest new entry is for German band Alphaville with their latest, Sensations. And in their report to M&M, Polskie Radio report that the most popular bands in Poland at the moment are Dead Or Alive, Duran Duran and A-Ha.
